#### **GOVERNORS NOTABLY**

**Corey Gipson** was named the 14th head men's basketball coach in Austin Peay history in March. A two-time graduate of Austin Peay, Gipson was the starting point

guard for the Governors for two seasons (2002-04) and an assistant coach for Dave Look for three seasons (2012-15). During his tenure as a player, the Governors went 45-18 and never lost a game in the Winfield Dunn Center, going 27-0 at home. He also helped the Govs to back-to-back Ohio Valley Conference Regular Season Championship and the 2003 OVC Tournament title. Nearly all of Gipson's coaching staff from Northwestern State joins him during his first year at the helm of the APSU men's basketball program, with associate head coach Rodney Hamilton, and assistant coaches Tim Ward and Jimmy Lincoln.

In addition to his three assistant coaches and five support staff members that Gipson brought with him from Northwestern State, where he was the head coach last season, he also brings six players from the Demons' lineup. Those six players are highlighted by a pair of All-Southland Conference selections in **DeMarcus Sharp** and **Ja'Monta Black**.

The 2022-23 Southland Conference Player and Newcomer of the year, a First Team All-Southland Conference selection, and All-Defensive Team recipient, Sharp led the Demons in scoring, assists, steals, blocks, field goals made and attempted, three-point percentage, and minutes while starting all 33 games. He averaged 19.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game, and was tabbed as a Lou Henson Award Finalist for the best midmajor basketball player in Division I.

The top-returning three-point scorer in the nation, Black finished fourth in Division I with 122 made triples and 3.81 per game last season at Northwestern State. A Second Team All-Southland Conference selection, Black broke NWST's single-game and single-season three-pointer record last season with nine threes in a 31-point performance against Houston Christian. The Columbia, Missouri native started 32 games last season, while scoring in double figures 27 times.

The grandson of Austin Peay and OVC Hall of Fame head coach Dave Loos, **Daniel Loos** returns to his hometown after spending the last three seasons at Christian Brothers where he averaged 9.7 points, 4.7 rebounds and 59.3 percent from the floor during his three seasons in Memphis.

The Govs' lone freshman on the 2023-24 roster is **Dez White**, who graduated from Helias Catholic High School also prepped at The Skills Factory Prep. White shot 48.0

percent from three during his career at The SKills Factory Prep, helping them reach top 20 in the nation. He also holds HCHS' singlegame and single-season scoring record with 51 and 699 points, respectively.

Another electric shooter that comes via Northwestern State is **Isaac Haney** who scored in double figures 19 times as a sophomore for the Demons and averaged 11.0 points, 4.6 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game.

Harrison Black, Jordan Wilmore, and Hansel Enmanuel are the final newcomers come from

Northwestern State. Black appeared in six games for the Demons, while Enmanuel started the final five games of the season and made 20 appearances. A 7-3 center, Wilmore appeared in 28 contests, making 12 starts, and had a season-high of eight rebounds.

**Sai Witt** comes to Clarksville after spending his sophomore and senior season at Lincoln University of Missouri. He averaged 15.9 points and 8.0 rebounds as a sophomore and was a finalist for the Black College Sports Network NCAA Division II Player of the Year. He then averaged averaging 13.5 points and 7.6 rebounds per game during his senior season

**Jalen Ware** is the lone returner from last season's team after averaging 5.1 points and 4.1 rebounds per game while shooting 49.1 and 35.5 percent from the field and three-point range, respectively.

A two-year starter at Quinnipiac, **Dezi Jones** started 59-of-63 games for the Bobcats as a junior and senior, averaging 12.0 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 3.4 assists per game during his career in Quinnipiac, Connecticut.

**Anton Brookshire** made 32 appearances off the bench during his sophomore season at Iona, helping the Gaels win the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Regular-Season and Tournament Championship and earn a spot in the 2023 NCAA Tournament. He averaged 4.2 points per game while shooting 43.1 and 38.8 percent from the field and three-point range, respectively.

**Jonathan Dunn** sat out his freshman season at Missouri State, but averaged 23.0 points and 4.7 rebounds per game while shooting 62.6 percent from the field at

#### **Gipson Named 14th Head Coach - March 12**

Corey Gipson is coming home. A two-time Austin Peay graduate who played at Austin Peay for two seasons (2002-04), and was an assistant coach for three seasons (2012-15), Corey Gipson was named the 14th head coach in Austin Peay men's basketball history, March 12.

Gipson previously served as the head coach of Northwestern State. During his season in Natchitoches, Louisiana, Gipson led Demons to a 22-9 record - the largest single-season turnaround in program history, the program's first win against an AP Top 25 program, and the No. 2 seed in the 2023 Southland Conference Tournament.

#### **Gipson Finalizes Inaugural Coaching Staff - March 30**

Corey finalized his inaugural coaching staff for the 2023-24 season with the addition of associate head coach Rodney Hamilton, and assistant coaches Tim Ward and Jimmy Lincoln. All three coaches spent last season on Gipson's staff at Northwestern State

Hamilton brings over a decade of experience to Clarksville, after spending seasons at Northwestern State (2022-23), Memphis (2018-22), Tennessee State (2012-18), Indiana Tech (2009-12), Southeast Missouri (2007-09) and Crichton College (2005-07).

Prior to his year at Northwestern State, Ward was an assistant coach at Moberly Area Community College (2021-22), Talladega College (2020-21) and Arkansas Tech).

Lincoln brings over 25 years of coaching experience, and was the special assistant to the head coach last season at Northwestern State.

# Men's Basketball Announced 16-Game ASUN Campaign - July 6

The Governors' 2023-24 ASUN season features eight games in the new F&M Bank Arena, including six of the final eight contests. Austin Peay is 144-117 all-time against ASUN opponents, with its most wins against a single opponent being 64 against Eastern Kentucky. The Govs also have a .500-or-better winning percentage against 8-of-11 ASUN teams.

## Gipson Announces Star-Studded 12-Man Signing Class - Sept. 8

The 2023-24 Austin Peay men's basketball roster has been established.

Head coach Corey Gipson's 12-man signing class consists of 11 transfers with collegiate experience, including six players from Northwestern State, where Gipson was the head coach during the 2022-23 season.

His 11 veteran newcomers have combined for 6,300-career points, 2,231 rebounds, 1,291 assists, 470 starts, and 640 games played in their careers entering their first season as a Governor.

### Schedule's Set: Men's Basketball Announces 2023-24 Nonconference Slate - Sept. 6

Austin Peay men's basketball and first-year head coach Corey Gipson finalized the Governors' 15-game nonconference schedule featuring six home games on Gary Mathews Court at F&M Bank Arena, a trip to California, and the continuation of numerous decades-old rivalries.

Austin Peay is 322-381 all-time against its 2023-24 schedule and will play six opponents that it has played at least 50 times in program history in Murray State (140 all-time meetings) Eastern Kentucky (120), Morehead State (115), Tennessee State (84), Lipscomb (75), and Western Kentucky (57).

## Terry Taylor Returns to Nashville for Bulls Training Came - Oct. 6

Austin Peay men's basketball alum and current Chicago Bull Terry Taylor began his third season in the National Basketball Association, Oct. 2-6, at the Brockett Center in Nashville, as the Bulls participated in training camp at Belmont's facility

A two-time Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year and the Governors' all-time scoring leader, Taylor was the Bulls' final signing of the offseason after spending last two months of the 2022-23 campaign on a two-way contract with the organization.

Taylor's 62 appearances and nine starts in the Association are the second-most by an Austin Peay alum, trailing only Trenton Hassell's 644 appearances and 428 career starts during his NBA tenure from 2001-10.

The 2022-23 Southland Conference Player and Newcomer of the Year... Was First Team All-Southland Conference and named to the Southland Conference All-Defensive Team... One of six players who come to Clarksville from Northwestern State under Governors' first-year head coach Corey Gipson... Led Northwestern State in scoring (644), assists (165), steals (64), blocks (26), field goals made (251) and attempted (544), three-point percentage (.547), and minutes (1,135) while starting all 33 games... Finished his senior season ranked in the top 100 nationally in nine statistical categories, including field goals attempted (11th), field goals made (15th), and points per game (32nd)... Scored at least 10 points 29 times, 20 points 16 times, 30 points six times, and 40 points once... Scored 19 points in Northwestern State's first win against an Associated Press Top 25 team at No. 15 TCU... Had his first 20-point performance following the upset against TCU with 23 points on 10-of-20 shooting at Illinois State... Scored 30+ points in back-to-back games against Stephen F. 

## COREY GIPSON

Corey Gipson is coming home.

Vice President and Director of Athletics Gerald Harrison announced that Gipson has been named the 14th head men's basketball coach in Austin Peay State University history, March 2023

Gipson, a two-time Austin Peay graduate who played at Austin Peay for two seasons (2002-04) and worked as an assistant coach for Dave Loos for three seasons (2012-15), was the head coach at Northwestern State during the 2022-23 season. In his head coaching debut, Gipson turned around a Demons program that won nine games the year prior his arrival. He led the Demons to a 22-9 record, a win at then-No. 15 TCU, and a No. 2 seed in the Southland Conference Tournament.

In his lone year at Northwestern State, Gipson is a finalist for the Ben Jobe Award, which is presented annually to the nation's top Division I minority coach. He also is a finalist for the Hugh Durham Coach of the Year Award, which is annually given to the top DI mid-major head coach, and the Joe B. Hall Award, which is annually presented to the top first-time head coach at the DI level.

Gipson led the Demons to their first 20-win season in a decade and became the first coach in program history to win 20 games during their debut season. Gipson's 64-63 win at TCU, Nov. 14, also was the program's first win against an Associated Press Top 25 team since the 2006 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

Gipson also helped Northwestern State senior guard DeMarcus Sharp earn 2023 Southland Conference Player of the Year, Newcomer of the Year, and First Team All-Conference honors during his time in Natchitoches. Sharp also is a finalist for the Lou Henson Award, which is annually given to the top Division I mid-major basketball player. Sharp averaged 19.5 points per game during the 2022-23 season, which led the Southland and ranked 35 in the NCAA. Sharp also ranked 31st in the NCAA in assists (165), 41st in assists per game (5.0), and 31st in steals (64) – he ranked second in Southland in all three categories.

Under Gipson, Ja'Monta Black also earned Second Team All-Southland Conference recognition and proved to be one of the nation's top three-point shooters. During the 2022-23 season, Black ranked fourth in the NCAA in three-pointers per game (3.81), fourth in total threes

made (122), and third in three-pointers attempted (326) – he led the

Southland in all three categories.

Before his time at Northwestern State, Gipson spent seven years at Missouri State and was the Bears' associate head coach for six of those seasons. The Bears won 13 games during Gipson's first year in Springfield, before averaging 17.8 wins per season during his six years after being promoted to associate head coach.

During his time at Missouri State, Gipson coached three MVC Newcomers of the Year – Dequon Miller, Alize Johnson, and Tulio Da Silva – to go along with 10 All-MVC selections, seven MVC All-Newcomer Team selections, three MCV All-Freshman Team selections, four MVC All-Defensive Team selections, two MVC All-Bench Team selections, two MVC Most-Improved Team selections, and three MVC Scholar-Athlete Team selections.

Gipson was an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Austin Peay for three seasons. During that stint in Clarksville, Gipson helped develop 2013 Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Year Chris Horton, who finished his career as one of just 13 DI players to score 1,500 points, grab 1,000 rebounds, and block 300 shots. Horton holds the Austin Peay record with 325 blocked shots, ranks second in program history with 1,261 rebounds, and ranks sixth in scoring with 1,705 points.

Before coaching at his alma mater, Gipson three years at UNC Greensboro and served as the associate head coach for the final two seasons. Gipson began his coaching career at DII Virginia State, where he worked as an assis-

tant coach for longtime Austin Peay assistant coach Tony Collins, who recruited Gipson to APSU.

As a player at Austin Peay, Gipson was a two-year starter at point guard, helping the Govs become the top defensive team in the OVC in 2002-03 and 2003-04. The Govs went 45-18 in his two seasons and Gipson never lost a game in the Winfield Dunn Center, with the Govs going 27-0 at home during his time in Clarksville.

In his first game at Austin Peay, Gipson scored a team-high 19 points and led the Governors to an upset win at Memphis, beating the Tigers, 81-80, in overtime at the Memphis Pyramid. The Govs went 23-8 in Gipson's first season, winning the 2003 OVC Regular-Season and Tournament Championships before falling to Louisville, 86-64, in the first round of the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

A native of Sikeston, Missouri, Gipson began his collegiate career at Three Rivers Community College, where he earned an associate's degree before transferring to Austin Peay. During his prep career at Richland High School, Gipson was a Missouri Mr. Basketball nominee during his senior season, where he averaged 30.9 points per game and earned all-state honors that season.
