

Fresno State - Arizona Notes

- Arizona recorded an assist on eight of their first eleven made field goals of the game. UA had eight assists total in their win at Gonzaga in their previous game.
- Gabe York's first points of the game came on his buzzer-beating lay-up going into halftime. He recorded four assists prior to his made basket, which eclipsed his season high of three assists versus Santa Clara.
- Allozno Trier (10) and Ryan Anderson (8) combined to score 18 of their team's first 26 points (69.2 percent).
- Arizona took control of the game with a 15-2 run in a span of 4:53 to take a 69-60 lead with 7:18 remaining in the game.
- Freshman Chance Comanche's first-half dunk was the first made field goal of his career. The center had scored four points this season, all of which came at the free throw line. Comanche's first made field goal came on the ninth shot attempt of his career.
- The Wildcats had five players shoot 50.0 percent or better from the field for the game. Trier and Anderson's combined 15 of 26 (.577) performance from the field was rivaled only by their 11 of 14 (.786) shooting as a duo at the free throw line.
- Allonzo Trier's 27 points were the most by a UA freshman since Derrick Williams scored 28 points vs. UNLV (12-2-2009). Other notable freshman season-high scoring performances since then include Stanley Johnson (22 points), Aaron Gordon (23 points), Rondae Hollis-Jefferson (18 points), Brandon Ashley (20 points), Nick Johnson (20 points).
