### OFF THE TOP

- Arizona will enter the 2016 NCAA Tournament with a record of 25-8, which marks the program's fourth consecutive season of 25 wins or more. Under head coach Sean Miller, the Wildcats have won 23 or more games in each of the last six seasons while averaging 28.7 wins per season since the 2010-11.
- Kaleb Tarczewski became the winningest player in program history with career victory number 110 over Colorado in the Pac-12 Tournament. Tarczewski's 110 wins have come in 134 career appearances as he enters his fourth NCAA Tournament for an 82.1 winning percentage in a Wildcat uniform.
- The Wildcats' appearance in the "Big Dance" this season is the 33rd NCAA Tournament berth in program history and the fifth in the seven seasons of the Sean Miller era. Arizona has posted a record of 11-4 (.733) in 15 NCAA Tournament games under Miller.
- UA's arrival in the Dunkin' Donuts Center in Providence, R.I. (2,600 miles) marks the farthest site the program has ever played a NCAA game in, surpassing Philadelphia (2,300 miles) in the 2006 NCAA Tournament.
- Ryan Anderson, who is averaging 15.5 points and 10.1 rebounds per game, is on pace to become the first Wildcat to average a double-double since Jordan Hill (18.3 ppg, 11.0 rpg) in the 2008-09 season. Anderson's 17 double-doubles this season rank 18th in the nation.
- Gabe York (nine) and Kaleb Tarczewski (eleven) have combined to play in 20 NCAA Tournament games. The York-Tarczewski duo entered this year's tournament tied with Wichita State's Ron Baker (ten) and Fred VanVleet (ten) as the most experienced duo in the post season. The Shocker duo will get one extra game in their First Four match-up with Vanderbilt before possibly facing Arizona. Duke's duo of Marshall Plumlee and Amile Jefferson have also combined to appear in 20 games in the NCAA Tournament, but Jefferson will miss this year's postseason with a foot injury.

## HISTORY VERSUS OPPONENTS

Whether meeting the Shockers or the Commodores, the Wildcats have faced each program only twice before. UA is 0-2 against Vanderbilt with the most recent meeting coming during the 2009-10 season. Arizona has not faced Wichita State since the 1950's when they split games in 1951 and 1954.

The Wildcats are 13-11 (.542) against Missouri Valley schools in program history while posting a mark of 23-26 (.469) against the current SEC membership. Arizona's winning mark of 46.9 percent against the SEC is the lowest among all Power 5 conferences.

## BIG GAME EXPERIENCE

Gabe York (nine) and Kaleb Tarczewski (eleven) have combined to play in 20 NCAA Tournament games. The York-Tarczewski duo entered this year's tournament tied with Wichita State's Ron Baker (ten) and Fred VanVleet (ten) as the most experienced duo in the post season. ## ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS IN THE LAST TWO YEARS

Entering the NCAA Tournament, Arizona is one of the winningest programs in the nation since the beginning of the 2013-14 season. Arizona and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation over the last 2+ seasons.

It's just part of the winning culture instilled on the Arizona Basketball program since the arrival of head coach Sean Miller. In Miller's seven seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 26.8 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 172-45 (.793) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12.

## SEAN MILLER IN THE BIG DANCE

Arizona head coach Sean Miller has advanced to the Sweet 16 or beyond in six of his nine NCAA Tournament appearances as head coach at both Arizona and Xavier. His six Sweet 16's since 2008 are tied with John Calipari for the second most behind Tom Izzo with seven. Miller is just ahead of Mike Krzyzewski and Bill Self at five.

## TOUGH TO BEAT

Arizona has lost eight games this season, but it wasn't easy for the opponents. The Cats' eight losses have come by a total of 33 points, which is an average margin of defeat of 4.71 points. UA has not lost a game by double digits in its last 20 losses going back to its 89-78 loss at USC on Feb. 27, 2013.

## TARCZEWSKI AT THE PINNACLE OF HIS CAREER

Kaleb Tarczewski has hit his stride and playing the best basketball of his career over the final 11 games of his senior season. The center is averaging 8.1 points, 10.9 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game during that span. Tarczewski's best season averages of his career entering this season were 9.9 points, 6.3 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game in 2013-14.

## WILDCATS CONTINUE TO BUILD ON RANKINGS STREAK

The Wildcats have been ranked in 78-consecutive AP polls and 81-straight coaches polls. The 78-consecutive weeks in the AP poll is currently the second-longest streak in the nation behind Kansas. Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Arizona has spent 56 weeks ranked in the top 10 of the AP poll during that span. UA took over the No. 1 ranking in the AP poll on Dec. 9, 2013, marking its first top ranking since 2003 and the first time a Pac-12 team had garnered the top spot since 2006.

The Wildcats held the top spot for a program-record eight straight weeks. Arizona was one of just 11 programs in the nation to appear in all 20 Associated Press polls in 2012-13, and one of just eight programs nationally to do so in 2013-14. UA was the only program in the nation to be ranked in the top 10 in every AP poll in the 2013-14 and the 2014-15 seasons.

## CHANCE COMANCHE AS OF LATE

Chance Comanche continues to give Arizona plenty of quality minutes as a freshman off the bench. The 6-foot-11-inch center scored 9 points in his team's two Pac-12 Tournament games. It was his highest-scoring back-to-back games of the season. This coming off his pair of crucial baskets against Utah and Jakob Poeltl in UA's second-half comeback at Utah.

## THE OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER OF THE 2015-16 WILDCATS

How good has the Arizona offense been this season? The Wildcats finished league play ranking in the top three in the Pac-12 in scoring (2nd - 82.4), scoring margin (1st - +10.2), free throw percentage (3rd - .736), field goal percentage (1st - .491), three-point field goal percentage (1st - .412) and assists per game (3rd - 14.1).

## GABE YORK'S SEASON FROM DEEP IN PERSPECTIVE

While Gabe York has already cemented his place in the career three-point shooting record books after rising into the top five in program history in made three-point field goals and three-point field goals attempted in a career, his senior season has reached historical proportions from beyond the arc. York has cracked the top five in made three-pointers in a single season in UA history.

## A DOMINATION OF THE GLASS FOR THE AGES

The Wildcats' dominance of the glass has been to a national and historic extent as they currently rank seventh in rebounding margin at +9.2. If the season ended today, UA's +9.2 rebounding margin would rank third in Arizona history trailing the 1950-51 Wildcats who posted a ridiculous +19.3 rebounding margin and the 1976-77 Wildcats' +9.7 mark.

## ARIZONA IN THE LAST FIVE SEASONS

While Sean Miller and Co. arrived in Tucson for the 2009-10 season, the 2010-11 campaign effectively marks the beginning of the Miller Era. Six years ago, the Wildcats claimed their first conference championship under Miller and made a run to the Elite Eight that ended at the hands of eventual national champion Connecticut. While UA has led the nation in wins in the last two seasons, the last four seasons of Arizona hoops have been among the best in the nation as well.

## TARCZEWSKI & YORK: A WINNING DUO

While Kaleb Tarczewski passed Matt Muehlebach as the all-time winningest player in Arizona history with 110 victories, Gabe York has climbed his way into the top ten career wins list as well. York enters postseason play with 105 career wins, which ranks tied for fifth in the UA record books. Tarczewski and York have combined for the most wins of any Wildcat duo in program history.

## GABE YORK EARNS FINAL PAC-12 WEEKLY AWARD OF THE SEASON

After a poetic Senior Day week that included a pair of victories over California and Stanford, Gabe York was named the Pac-12 Conference Player of the Week. York averaged 25.5 points per game while shooting a scorching-hot 60.7 percent from the field. The senior's week was highlighted by his career-high 32 points in the Wildcats' win over Stanford on Senior Day that saw York match a McKale Center record with nine made three-point field goals.

The California native opened his week by playing the role of catalyst in Arizona's come-from-behind win over No. 25 California on Thursday night. York scored all 19 of his points in the second half, including a trio of three-pointers in the final two minutes. Arizona went on to score 11 consecutive points in the final two minutes to defeat the Golden Bears 64-61.

The senior guard did not wait until the second half versus Stanford to start his offensive onslaught. York buried four of his nine record-setting three-pointers in the first half in his team's 94-62 victory over the Cardinal on Senior Day. His performance from beyond the arc matched Salim Stoudamire's nine made three-pointers versus Oregon State in 2005 as the McKale Center record.

## ANDERSON NAMED TO ALL-DISTRICT TEAM

One day after garnering First Team All-Conference honors from the Pac-12, Arizona forward Ryan Anderson was named to the USBWA's All-District Team. Anderson was one of ten players selected to the team for District IX, which includes all players from California, Oregon, Washington, Hawaii, Alaska and Arizona.

Anderson finished the regular season leading the Wildcats in scoring (15.8 ppg) and rebounding (10.2 rpg). The senior was the USBWA National Player of the Week after averaging 26.5 points and 13.5 rebounds per game in a pair of wins at Washington and Washington State. His big week in the Evergreen State also garnered weekly honors from the Pac-12. Anderson tallied 16 double-doubles in 30 appearances this season with his best coming at Washington State with 31 points and 12 rebounds.

## ARIZONA DRAWS A CROWD WHEREVER IT GOES

Arizona not only lead the Pac-12 Conference in home attendance for a 32nd consecutive season with an average crowd of 14,527 this season, but UA is boosting road attendance as well. The conference tournament in Las Vegas was yet another neutral site that had an overwhelming pro-Arizona crowd.

## 1,000 POINT SCORERS ON THE SAME TEAM

The Wildcats became the only program in the nation to have four players with 1,000 career points at the NCAA Division I level when Gabe York became the 50th Wildcat to score 1,000 points in a career against versus USC on Feb. 14. Arizona has been joined by a handful over other programs in that distinction as Pittsburgh, Oklahoma, George Washington, Army and North Florida all have at least four players with 1,000 career points or more. The quartet of Ryan Anderson (1,779 points), Mark Tollefson (1,253 points), Kaleb Tarczewski (1,177 points) and Gabe York (1,118 points) have combined for a total of 5,327 points in their careers.

## GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE

Arizona has made attacking the basket a point of emphasis on offense and it's paying off. The Wildcats are in the top three in free throw percentage in the Pac-12 in all games (.724) and in conference play (.736), trailing the league leader by less than one percent in both categories. UA currently ranks 12th in the nation in total free throws attempted at 848 and 12th in free throws made with 613.

## SHOOTING EFFICIENCY AS A TEAM

After shooting 45.2 percent from the field in the second half against Oregon, Arizona ranks **19th** in the nation in field goal percentage at **48.2 percent**. It's a continuation of the productiveness of Sean Miller-coached teams on the offensive end that have finished in the top 30 in the NCAA in field goal percentage four separate times entering this year.

Point guard Kadeem Allen is blocking shots at an accelerated rate with his 6-foot-3-inch frame. His 25 blocks (nearly one per game) leads all Arizona players through the first 31 games of the season with 16 of those blocks coming in Pac-12 play. Allen's 25 blocks are the most by any player 6'3" or shorter in the Pac-12. Gabe York and Parker Jackson-Cartwright also represent Arizona in this statistical category.

## LAURI MARKKANEN INKS NLI WITH WILDCATS

The Arizona Basketball program picked up a commitment from a future Wildcat during the early signing period this fall. UA signed Finnish forward Lauri Markkanen to a national letter of intent. The 7-foot forward will join the team as part of the freshmen class of the 2016-17 season.

Markkanen represented his country in both the FIBA U16 and U18 European Championships. He led all players in the 2015 U18 European Championships in scoring at 18.2 points game while also grabbing 6.3 rebounds per game. His play this past summer in Greece was highlighted by his 27-point, 10-rebound performance in Finland's win over the Ukraine. Lauri Markkanen is the son of Pekka Markkanen who lettered in basketball at Kansas University before playing professionally in Finland and on Finland's national team.

## @APLAYERSPROGRAM TO THE NBA

Rondae Hollis-Jefferson (23rd overall pick, traded to Brooklyn) and Stanley Johnson (8th overall pick by Detroit) were both selected in the first round of the 2015 NBA Draft. The duo represented numerous NBA milestones for Arizona Basketball:

- 21 Arizona players have been selected in the first round of the NBA Draft
- 12 of Wildcats' last 14 first round selections have been lottery picks.
- The program, in the Sean Miller era, has produced seven NBA Draft picks.
- Arizona is one of just five programs in the nation to have three top-10 NBA Draft picks since 2011.
- 40 Wildcats have been selected in the NBA Draft since 1988, third most in the nation.

Arizona has led the Pac-12 in attendance every year since 1984-85, a streak of 31 consecutive seasons.

Arizona is the only school in the nation to have two home-court winning streaks rank among the top 10 in NCAA Division I history. UA's 81-game win streak in Bear Down Gym from 1945-51 ranks fifth, while the 71-game win streak in McKale Center from 1987-92 ranks 10th.

### A HISTORY OF GOLD MEDALS WITH TEAM USA AS A PLAYER AND A COACH

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

### MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 17th Sweet 16 appearance in 2015, marking the program's third in a row and fourth in five years. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him six for his career.

Since 2008, Miller is one of four coaches nationally to lead a team to six or more Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 13-1 (.929) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams, the best record in the history of the event.
