ON THE PITCH

First Round Results

After an early goal by the Horned Frogs on Friday, Arizona rallied with nine shots in the second half (holding TCU to only one) and knocked in two goals from Samantha Falasco and a screamer from Cali Crisler that found the back of the net from distance.

No-Goal Zone

This one is for the defense. Arizona has only lost one match when they've scored this season (No. 7 UCF, 2-1). In every other match when the Wildcats have scored at least one goal, they have won or tied the match. That's attributable to the rock-solid defense that has allowed only 95 shots-on-goal (5.00 per game) and have been a major component of Burdett's seven shutouts.

In the Burdett Cage

Junior Burdett has played all 19 matches for the Wildcats this season. Her goals-against average in those matches is only 0.789 as she has allowed only 15 goals. Although Burdett has a strong defensive line in front of her that has prevented most shots from finding the frame, Burdett has made some really huge saves this season. The match against Stanford saw 11 saves (career high) for Burdett, each one trumping the last as she used fingertips, kick saves, and fully-extended dives to hold back the Cardinal's swell of shots. Burdett has seven shutouts on the season (including against former No. 11 California), pushing her career count to 19 (2nd all-time). She has 193 career saves which is eighth all-time.

Unbeaten Streak

Gone slightly unnoticed, these Wildcats are unbeaten in their last eight matches with ties against Colorado at 0-0 (outshot 29-16) and No. 8 UCLA at 2-2. This is the second-longest unbeaten streak in Arizona history and the second-longest in the Pac-12 behind Stanford (W16).

- Of the four ranked teams that FSU has played this season, they have only defeated one - No. 10 Florida. They have otherwise fallen to Duke, Wake Forest, and UNC twice.
- Deyna Castellanos of FSU has (yes, count them) 17 goals on the season and three assists for a total of 37 points. A resident of Maracay, Venezuela, she competes for the country's national team. Castellanos tops the stat sheet for the Seminoles.
- Cassie Miller tends the net for FSU, and has competed in all 19 matches for the squad this season. She has a respectable GAA of 1.04 with 20 goals allowed.

Team Accolades

This group of seniors (Bollinger, Brascia, Crisler, Park, and Crisler) has now become the first such group to earn three tournament berths in four years. That's a big milestone for head coach Tony Amato and it comes behind 45 total wins for the group (most in program history). Additionally, Lainey Burdett, Morgan McGarry, and Gabi Stoian earned All-Pac-12 Honors last week.

Distributed Attack

Try marking this: twelve different players have scored for the Wildcats this season, including one defender and five bench players. This allows the Wildcats to develop their attack in multiple different ways – whether they are passing directly to their striker's feet or over the top for speedy forwards to run onto, you can be sure Arizona has someone who can put the ball into the back of the net.

Crisler's Assist-ers

Cali Crisler is in the number one spot on the stat sheet this season because she has seven assists, her most recent one coming against Washington several weeks ago. She also earned her second goal of the season on a well-placed shot into the side netting against TCU. Arizona has taken 106 corners this season, over 80% of those coming from Crisler which have added to her ability to assist.

One More Go Around for Gabi

Senior Gabi Stoian is poised to finish her career as the most decorated player in Arizona history. Despite an injury early in the season, she has played just over 1,000 minutes for the Wildcats and has tallied four goals and two assists. She sits at second all-time in goals (29), assists (22), and points (79). She needs only four more goals, three assists, and four points to break into the number one spot in each category. With a (hopefully) long gambit of postseason matches, Stoian may just crack the number one spot after all.

MULCAHY STADIUM

The University of Arizona women's soccer program plays and competes at one of the most captivating settings in soccer, Murphey Field at Mulcahy Soccer Stadium, with a spectacular view of the mountains, palms trees and southwestern landscape of Tucson, Ariz. Tucson's climate and the year-round maintenance allow the facility to be in game-ready condition throughout the year. The home of the University of Arizona women's soccer team at Murphey Field was opened on Sept. 15, 1996 as the Wildcats hosted the University of San Francisco. In 2006, Arizona hosted the defending national champion Portland Pilots, televised on Fox Sports Net, the first match at Mulcahy Stadium to be televised. There have been many additions to the



stadium including the Arizona Soccer Fieldhouse, including a team locker room, an athletic training room, official's area, concession area, ticket office and just recently, a new scoreboard and sound system. In 2011, new state-of-the-art lights were installed over Murphey Field to enhance competition at night for all of the televised games on Pac-12 Networks. Murphey Field at Mulcahy Stadium is located at the corner of Plumer Avenue and 15th Street. The grading and sodding of the field and the installation of lights to play at night on Pac-12 Networks was made possible by the generous assistance of Tucson's Murphey Foundation.

THE COACHING STAFF



Head Coach
Tony Amato

- Tony Amato enters his fifth year at the helm of the Arizona soccer program. He was introduced as head coach on Dec. 5, 2012.
- Entering the 2017 season, Amato carried an overall career record of 170-79-23 (43-30-9 at Arizona) in 14 seasons as a head coach.
- At the beginning of 2017, Amato owned a combined Division I record of 88-42-12 at Arizona and Stephen F. Austin University (SFA) and a Division II record of 82-37-11 at Rollins.
- In 2016, under Amato's leadership the Wildcats went 9-9-1 (4-7 Pac-12). They played six matches where they fell by only one goal. Had they converted a few of those games into ties or wins, the team would have earned its third consecutive NCAA tournament berth as they finished 7th in the Pac-12 and the top six teams qualified.
- Not only have the Wildcats succeeded on the pitch, they have also succeeded in the classroom under Amato. In the 2014 season, five student-athletes were named to the Pac-12 All-Academic Team. Jaden DeGracie, Lexe Selman and Skadsen were on the first team while Alexandra Doller and Haley Silverberg were on the second team. Similarly, Skadsen, DeGracie, and Selman were named Pac-12 All-Academic and Skadsen also earned the rank of COSIDA Academic All-American in 2015.
- Amato has coached an All-Pac-12 player in three of his four seasons. Jazmin Ponce was First Team All-Pac-12 in 2013 and Gabi Stoian was Second Team All-Pac-12 in 2014 and First Team All-Pac-12 in 2015, while Sheaffer Skadsen was named an All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention in 2015.
- Prior to accepting the Arizona position in 2012, Amato led Stephen F. Austin to victories over SEC, Big 12, and CUSA opponents to produce a national RPI ranking (31) and a top 50 finish (45) in 2011. Both rankings were the highest in the history of the SFA program.
- Amato coached the SFA Ladyjacks to conference titles in 2011 and 2012 with a combined 17-0 league record. His marks in three years at SFA were 13-5-2 in 2010, 15-3-1 in 2011 and 17-4 in 2012. The Jacks lost to Texas A&M, 1-0, in NCAA Championships first-round action in 2012.



Asst. Coach
Paul Nagy

- Paul Nagy enters his fifth year with the Wildcats as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Tony Amato.
- He came to the Wildcats after spending three seasons on Amato's coaching staff at Stephen F. Austin University (SFA) in east Texas. With Nagy's 12 years of college coaching experience, he has been able to live and coach all over the country before coming to Arizona.
- During the 2015 season, Nagy helped lead the Wildcats to a 14-6-2 record, the second best record of all-time for Arizona Soccer.
- Nagy assisted in guiding the Wildcats to an 11-8-2 record in 2014, the third-best record in Arizona history.
- In his first season at Arizona, Nagy helped coach the Wildcats to a 9-7-4 record, while competing in the Pac-12 Conference that is considered the toughest conference in the NCAA.
- As a player, Nagy was a goalkeeper that played professionally from 2001-2005 for the Dallas Burn (MLS), Syracuse Salty Dogs (A-League), Hershey Wildcats (A-League) and Orlando Sharks (MISL).
- He was a four-year letterman on the Saint Louis University men's soccer team from 1997-2000, earning first-team All-Conference USA and Midwest All-Region honors. He also played for the SLU team that reached the NCAA Division I Final Four in 1997 while also winning four Conference USA titles in four years.



Asst. Coach
Kate Norton

- University of Arizona head women's soccer coach Tony Amato added Kate Norton as an assistant coach to his staff on May 31.
- Prior to working in Seattle, Norton was a major soccer figure in Tucson as she worked as the Camps and Clinics Director for FC Tucson from 2012 to 2016 and was also the FC Tucson Academy Girls' head coach in 2015. Additionally, she was the Director of the Tanque Verde Soccer Club from 2010 to 2016 while also serving as the head coach.
- Norton got her coaching career started in 2008 as an assistant coach at Southwestern College until 2010 while also being on staff in the Kansas Olympic Development Program during that time.
- During her playing days, Norton was a four-year starter for the Cincinnati Bearcats, where she was named Cincinnati's Freshman of the Year in 2003 and earned the Coaches Award in 2006. She was a defender for the team but still managed to tally four goals and three assists in her time. Professionally, she played for the Michigan Phoenix in the WPSL in 2006 and finished her playing career in the Czech Republic by playing for FC Slovacko in 2007 and 2008.
- Originally from Pittsburgh, Penn., Norton lived in Tucson before she moved to Seattle to work with the Sounders. She studied Early Childhood Education at the University of Cincinnati where she was consistently provided with academic awards. She also earned a masters in Leadership at Southwestern college in 2012.
