## OFF THE TOP

- The Arizona Wildcats return to McKale Center on Thursday evening to host the Cal State Bakersfield Roadrunners. The Cats have won 42 consecutive non-conference home games, which is the longest streak in program history.
- UA wrapped up its opening weekend of the season with 103-78 victory over UMBC on Sunday in McKale Center. Allonzo Trier scored 30 points on 10-of-18 shooting (.556) from the field for a second consecutive 30-point game. Trier became the second player in Arizona history to open a season with back-to-back 30-point outings, joining Michael Dickerson in the 1996-97 season.
- Allonzo Trier was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week for his 62-point weekend to open the season. Trier averaged 31.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a pair of wins for the Wildcats. The Seattle native scored his points with efficiency as he shot 64.5 percent from the field, 50.0 percent from beyond the arc and 83.3 percent from the free throw line for the week. He was one of only two players in the NCAA to score 30 or more points in two games over the opening weekend. California's Don Coleman was the only other player with back-to-back 30-point games in the first two games of the season last weekend.
- Arizona scored 103 points against the Retrievers on Sunday after tallying 101 points versus NAU in the season opener on Friday night. That marks the first time since the 2002-03 season that UA has opened a season with back-to-back 100-point games. The wins over the Lumberjacks and Retrievers were also Arizona's first consecutive games of 100 points or more since the 2006-07 season.
- Deandre Ayton opened his freshman season with the Wildcats by posting back-to-back double-doubles, becoming just the second Arizona freshman with double-digit scoring and rebounding games in each of his first two career games. Ayton did so while averaging 19.0 points and 12.5 rebounds per game while the other freshman Wildcat to achieve the feat, Aaron Gordon in 2013-14, did so while averaging 13.5 points and 10.0 rebounds per game.

The 42 consecutive wins at home in non-conference play is not only of historical significance in the Arizona record books, but it also ranks among the longest active streaks nationally.

## MORE ON THE STREAK

During its current 42-game non-conference home winning streak, Arizona's average margin of victory is 22.8 points per game. Of those 42 victories, only four have been by fewer than 10 points.

## PJC IN FINE FORM

After a flawless night of eight assists and zero turnovers in the season opener, Parker Jackson-Cartwright finished the second game of the season with nine assists and three turnovers. The total of 17 assists versus UMBC and NAU is the second highest two-game total of his career. PJC tallied 18 assists in wins over the Washington schools during his sophomore season of 2015-16.

## TRIER'S 30-POINT COMPANY

Junior Allonzo Trier earned prestigious UA company with his back-to-back 30-point outings. He became the eighth Wildcat to score 30 or more points in consecutive games and the first since Jerryd Bayless in the 2007-08 season. Bayless, now with the Philadelphia 76ers, went on to become the only Arizona player to score 30 or more in three straight games.

## ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS OVER THE LAST FOUR YEARS

With the 2017-18 season officially underway, Arizona has solidified itself as one of the winningest programs in the nation in the past four seasons. Arizona, Villanova and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation during this four-year span.

It's just part of the winning culture instilled on the Arizona Basketball program since the arrival of head coach Sean Miller. In Miller's eight seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 27.5 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 206-51 (.801) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

## NIGHT MOVES

Thursday's 8 p.m. tip locally in Tucson means Arizona will look to defend its late-night winning streak. Going back to the 2015-16, Arizona has won its last 13 consecutive games that started at 8 p.m. local or later. Last year's meeting between Arizona and CSU Bakersfield was also an 8 p.m. (MST) tip.

## WILDCATS CONTINUE TO BUILD ON RANKINGS STREAK

The Wildcats have been ranked in 99-consecutive AP polls and 101-straight coaches polls. The 99-consecutive weeks in the AP poll is currently the second-longest streak in the nation behind Kansas. Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Arizona has spent 70 weeks ranked in the top 10 of the AP poll during that span. UA took over the No. 1 ranking in the AP poll on Dec. 9, 2013, marking its first top ranking since 2003 and the first time a Pac-12 team had garnered the top spot since 2006. The Wildcats held the top spot for a program-record eight straight weeks.

Arizona was one of just 11 programs in the nation to appear in all 20 Associated Press polls in 2012-13, and one of just eight programs nationally to do so in 2013-14. UA was the only program in the nation to be ranked in the top 10 in every AP poll in the 2013-14 and the 2014-15 seasons. The Wildcats spent 24 weeks during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons in the top 15 of the poll.

## HOME SWEET HOME

In addition to its current 42-game non-conference home winning streak, the Wildcats have won 69 of their last 71 contests inside McKale Center. Arizona is 124-13 (.905) in Tucson under head coach Sean Miller.

## WHEN IN THE TOP 5

UA is ranked third nationally in the Associated Press Top 25 poll again this week. The program boasts a record of 63-11 (.851) when ranked in the top five of the AP poll during the Sean Miller era of 2009 to present.

## HONORS AND ACCOLADES

Arizona's individual accolades came in waves during the preseason with Allonzo Trier being named a Preseason All-American by ESPN, AP, Sports Illustrated and Sporting News while Deandre Ayton earned a spot on Preseason All-America teams by ESPN and Sporting News as a freshman. The Trier-Ayton duo was also named to prestigious watch lists for the Oscar Robertson Trophy, John R. Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy.

Rawle Alkins, although injured, also joined Ayton and Trier on the John R. Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy watch lists.

Alkins, Ayton and Trier were joined by Dusan Ristic on positional season watch lists, nominated by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Alkins earned the nod as a small forward (Julius Erving Award), Ayton as a power forward (Karl Malone Award), Ristic as a center (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) and Trier as a shooting guard (Jerry West Award).

## A LOT OF WINNING

Fourth-year seniors Parker Jackson-Cartwright and Dusan Ristic are playing in their final seasons in Tucson with impressive career marks and pathways to become two of the all-time winningest players in program history. Jackson-Cartwright has played in 100 games through his first three-plus seasons, posting a record of 84-16 (.840) in those appearances. Ristic has appeared in 107 games in his UA career with a mark of 89-18 (.831). The two seniors are on pace to climb up the all-time wins record at Arizona, which is currently held by Kaleb Tarczewski and Matt Muehlebach at 110 wins in a career.

## A CLOSER LOOK AT NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

The Wildcats' non-conference slate features a handful of teams ranked in the preseason AP and USA Today Coaches' Polls. Those non-conference foes also include plenty of teams with strong showings in preseason conference polls with six set opponents finishing fourth or better in their respective conference polls. That number could grow depending on the match-ups in the Battle 4 Atlantis Tournament in the Bahamas over Thanksgiving.

## ARIZONA IN THE LAST SEVEN SEASONS

While Sean Miller and Co. arrived in Tucson for the 2009-10 season, the 2010-11 campaign effectively marks the beginning of the Miller Era. Six years ago, the Wildcats claimed their first conference championship under Miller and made a run to the Elite Eight that ended at the hands of eventual national champion Connecticut. While UA has led the nation in wins in the during parts of the last four seasons, the last seven seasons of Arizona hoops have been among the best in the nation as well.

## NATIONALLY-RANKED OPPONENTS

Arizona's non-conference and Pac-12 schedules are littered with nationally-ranked opponents. The Wildcats were one of four Pac-12 teams ranked or receiving votes in the USA Today Preseason Coaches Poll. UA was voted fifth with USC (11th), UCLA (18th) and Oregon (RV) rounding out the quartet. Non-conference foes Alabama (25th) and Texas A&M (RV) bolster the out-of-conference slate along with possible Battle 4 Atlantis opponents Villanova (sixth), Purdue (21st) and SMU (RV).

## ANOTHER CHAPTER OF ARIZONA IN THE NBA DRAFT

The 2017 NBA Draft saw both Lauri Markkanen and Kadeem Allen hear their names called. Markkanen, the freshman forward, was selected with the seventh overall pick by the Minnesota Timberwolves before being traded to the Chicago Bulls. The Finland native became the fourth top ten NBA draft pick during the Sean Miller era (2009 to present). He also advanced another impressive NBA Draft stat. 12 of the last 15 former Wildcats selected in the first round have gone in the lottery. Kadeem Allen was the 53rd overall selection of the Boston Celtics. He, teamed with Markkanen, give the Arizona program a total of 71 NBA Draft picks.

## COMING OFF LAST YEAR

The Arizona Wildcats enter the 2017-18 season following a 32-5 season one year ago. It was the seventh season of 30 or more wins in program history and the fourth under head coach Sean Miller. UA is the defending Pac-12 regular season and tournament champions after splitting the season title with Oregon with an impressive 16-2 record in league play and defeating a pair of top-5 ranked teams in back-to-back nights en route to the tournament crown. Arizona participated in its 32nd NCAA Tournament in program history while advancing the program's NCAA record under Miller to 13-6 (.684) and its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in program history.

## RETURNING TO #BEARDOWN

Arizona returns a trio of starters and a healthy dose of lettermen in 2017-18. Rawle Alkins, Dusan Ristic and Allonzo Trier are three returning players with a combined 73 games started between them. Arizona's five returning scholarship players, as a whole, bring a wealth of experience back as well. The five returners have appeared in a total of 322 games with 130 starts included in those games played.

## ALEX BARCELLO TO INFINITY

Another freshman making an impact for the Wildcats to open the season has been point guard Alex Barcello. The Chandler, Ariz. native is averaging 8.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game while shooting 62.5 percent from the field, 50.0 percent from deep and 83.3 percent at the foul line. His nine assists to zero turnovers leads the Pac-12 Conference. His assist-to-turnover ratio is so good that the conference's stat report lists his ratio at "infinity".

## MCKALE CENTER DOING WHAT IT ALWAYS DOES

With a conference-leading average home crowd of 14,410, Arizona and its beloved McKale Center have now led the Pac-12 in attendance for 33 consecutive seasons. UA's average home crowd was nearly 2,000 people larger than second place Utah a year ago. The 14,410 average for the 2016-17 season ranked 15th nationally and accounted for 98.4 percent capacity for the season.

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

### MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him seven for his career. Since 2008, Miller is one of five coaches nationally to lead a team to seven Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.




