

Arizona-CSU Bakersfield Notes

- Arizona extended its longest non-conference home winning streak in program history to 43 games with Thursday's 91-59 victory over CSU Bakersfield.
- Thursday's win pushes UA's winning streak to 14 in games played at 8 p.m. local time or later.
- The Wildcats started the season 3-0 with all three wins coming in six days. Arizona will play its next three games of the season in three days in the Battle 4 Atlantis.
- UA led for 37:02 of the 40 minutes of the game.

On Deandre Ayton...

- Finished with 18 points and 10 rebounds to become the fourth freshman in UA history to record three consecutive double-doubles. He joins Al Fleming in 1972-73, Bob Elliott in 1973-74 and Frank Smith in 1979-80. Elliott went on to become the only Arizona freshman to tally four-straight double-doubles. Ayton becomes the first UA freshman ever to open his NCAA career with three straight double-doubles.
- While collecting three consecutive double-doubles to open the season, Ayton is averaging 18.7 points, 11.7 rebounds per game. He became the first UA player, of any class, to tally three consecutive double-doubles since Ryan Anderson in the 2015-16 season.
- Ayton does become the first Arizona player to open a season with three double-doubles since Jordan Hill in 2008-09.

On Allonzo Trier...

- Finished with 28 points on just nine shots (made eight) from the field. In his first three games of the season, Trier is averaging 30.0 points per game on 70.0 percent shooting from the field, 58.8 percent from beyond the arc and 80.0 percent from the charity stripe.

On Alex Barcello...

- Barcello has tallied 11 assists without a turnover through the first three games of his career. The Pac-12 Conference, on its conference-wide reporting stat report, lists his assist-to-turnover ratio as "infinity".
