OFF THE TOP

- Arizona plays its first game in six days when it takes on NC State. Arizona posted a 91-59 win over CSU Bakersfield in its last game on Thursday, Nov. 16 in McKale Center. Allonzo Trier scored a game-high 28 points on a ridiculous eight-of-nine shooting night from the field. Trier was two points shy of becoming just the second Wildcat in program history to score 30 or more points in three consecutive games.
- Freshman Deandre Ayton finished his night with 18 points and 10 rebounds versus CSU Bakersfield. Ayton became the first UA freshman to open his college career with back-to-back-to-back double-doubles. He also became just the fourth Wildcat overall to tally three consecutive double-doubles at any point in his first NCAA season.
- Arizona boasts an all-time record of 25-12 (.676) in games played outside the continental United States, going back to the 1968-69 Rainbow Classic in Hawai'i. The Battle 4 Atlantis will be the first additions to those 37 games not played in Hawai'i or Alaska.
- The Arizona coaching staff feature a pair of former Wolfpack coaches. Head coach Sean Miller served as an assistant to Herb Sendek in Raleigh from 1996 to 2001 while assistant coach Mark Phelps also on Sendek's staff at NC State from 1996 to 2006.
- UA's participation in this year's Battle 4 Atlantis will feature a homecoming for forward Deandre Ayton. The freshman is a native of Nassau where he played soccer and participated in band as a child in the Bahamas before moving to the United States and discovering basketball in high school. Ayton's homecoming with the Wildcats in the Battle 4 Atlantis comes as a twist of fate as the program signed to play in the event years before Ayton even committed to play for the University of Arizona.

SUCCESS IN NON-CONFERENCE TOURNAMENTS

Going back to the 1949-50 Sun Bowl Tournament, UA has played in over 150 games in multi-day events in non-conference play. The Wildcats are an impressive 124-42 (.747) in those games, including 24-6 (.800) under head coach Sean Miller. Miller-coached Arizona teams have won the 2012 Diamond Head Classic, 2013 NIT Season Tip-Off and the 2014 Maui Invitational.

ARIZONA ADDS A FUTURE PAIR OF WILDCATS

The University of Arizona Basketball program and head coach Sean Miller have added a pair of commitments to its recruiting class during the fall signing period. Guard Brandon Williams from and forward Shareef O'Neal with both join UA's 2018 recruiting class from Southern California. Williams and O'Neal will play their senior season of their prep careers before joining the Wildcats next season as freshmen.

Brandon Williams – 6-foot-2-inch 185 pounds – Guard – Encino, Calif.

- Evaluated as a five star recruit at the time of his commitment
- Widely-considered one of the top point guard prospects nationally for the 2018 class
- Scored 16 points in CIF Division I Finals versus Berkeley as a sophomore
- Product of Crespi Carmelite High whose alumni include former UVA guard London Perrantes

Coach Miller on Brandon: "Brandon did not sustain an injury, and that's important to note. He had some genetic issue with his leg that he was able to get fixed. To his family's credit, they were able to do it in time, but he missed a lot of action. He wasn't on the circuit this spring and summer. If he would've been, I believe he would've been a McDonald's All-American guard. What we love the most about him is that he can score and be a playmaker. He can score off the dribble, he's physically strong and he can shoot the three-point shot. The way the game is changing, you can put different guards out there at the same time and Brandon can play with anybody. We are looking at him to have an immediate impact. We are thrilled to have him. He also plays for a great high school coach, in a high school program that has produced some very good guards recently that have gone to college and have had success."

Shareef O'Neal – 6-foot-9-inch 215 pounds – Forward – Los Angeles, Calif.

- Rated as a 5-star prospect, top-3 recruit in California and 24th overall by ESPN
- Son of NBA legend Shaquille O'Neal
- Former teammate of current Wildcat Ira Lee at Crossroads School in Santa Monica, Calif.
- Averaged 14 points and 7 rebounds a game as a junior, guiding Crossroads to California state semifinals

Coach Miller on Shareef: "Shareef O'Neal, because he is Shaquille's son, we almost want to compare the two but they are very different. Shareef is a versatile forward and wing player. He is very skilled and can shoot the three-point shot. I believe as he continues to develop, he'll be able to go inside and outside and for those who follow our program, it's that type of hybrid forward that thrives. I believe he will do those same things. Both are excellent kids and they know each other, which is awesome. It's exciting for all of us. It's exciting to have both those guys in our future."

ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS OVER THE LAST FOUR YEARS

With the 2017-18 season officially underway, Arizona has solidified itself as one of the winningest programs in the nation in the past four seasons. Arizona, Villanova and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation during this four-year span.

It's just part of the winning culture instilled on the Arizona Basketball program since the arrival of head coach Sean Miller. In Miller's eight seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 27.5 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 207-51 (.802) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

ON BACK-TO-BACK NIGHTS

UA head coach Sean Miller has always looked forward to non-conference tournaments, with back-to-back game days, as preparation for the postseason. His team's record when playing a second or third game in as many days is 9-4 (.692) since the start of the 2013-14 season.

WILDCATS CONTINUE TO BUILD ON RANKINGS STREAK

The Wildcats have been ranked in 100-consecutive AP polls and 102-straight coaches polls. The 100-consecutive weeks in the AP poll is currently the second-longest streak in the nation behind Kansas. Since the start of the 2012-13 season, Arizona has spent 71 weeks ranked in the top 10 of the AP poll during that span. UA took over the No. 1 ranking in the AP poll on Dec. 9, 2013, marking its first top ranking since 2003 and the first time a Pac-12 team had garnered the top spot since 2006. The Wildcats held the top spot for a program-record eight straight weeks.

Arizona was one of just 11 programs in the nation to appear in all 20 Associated Press polls in 2012-13, and one of just eight programs nationally to do so in 2013-14. UA was the only program in the nation to be ranked in the top 10 in every AP poll in the 2013-14 and the 2014-15 seasons. The Wildcats spent 24 weeks during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons in the top 15 of the poll.

ROAD WARRIORS

In addition to holding one of the highest home court winning percentages in the nation, Arizona has shown a knack for continuing its winning ways outside of Tucson. Since Sean Miller's arrival prior to the 2009-10 season, the Wildcats have posted a record of **97-52 (.651)** away from McKale Center. That mark improves to **41-20 (.672)** at neutral site locations. UA's records in the last four seasons are **57-20 (.740)** outside of Tucson and **26-8 (.765)** in neutral sites.

HONORS AND ACCOLADES

Arizona's individual accolades came in waves during the preseason with Allonzo Trier being named a Preseason All-American by ESPN, AP, Sports Illustrated and Sporting News while Deandre Ayton earned a spot on Preseason All-America teams by ESPN and Sporting News as a freshman. The Trier-Ayton duo was also named to prestigious watch lists for the Oscar Robertson Trophy, John R. Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy.

Rawle Alkins, although injured, also joined Ayton and Trier on the John R. Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy watch lists.

Alkins, Ayton and Trier were joined by Dusan Ristic on positional season watch lists, nominated by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Alkins earned the nod as a small forward (Julius Erving Award), Ayton as a power forward (Karl Malone Award), Ristic as a center (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) and Trier as a shooting guard (Jerry West Award).

A LOT OF WINNING

Fourth-year seniors Parker Jackson-Cartwright and Dusan Ristic are playing in their final seasons in Tucson with impressive career marks and pathways to become two of the all-time winningest players in program history. Entering the Battle 4 Atlantis, Jackson-Cartwright has played in 103 games through his first three-plus seasons, posting a record of **87-16 (.845)** in those appearances. Ristic has appeared in 110 games in his UA career with a mark of **92-18 (.836)**. The two seniors are on pace to climb up the all-time wins record at Arizona, which is currently held by Kaleb Tarczewski and Matt Muehlebach at 110 wins in a career.

ALEX BARCELLO TO INFINITY

Another freshman making an impact for the Wildcats to open the season has been point guard Alex Barcello. The Chandler, Ariz. native is averaging 7.7 points, 3.3 rebounds and 3.7 assists per game while shooting 58.3 percent from the field, 57.1 percent from deep and 83.3 percent at the foul line. His 11 assists to zero turnovers leads the Pac-12 Conference. His assist-to-turnover ratio is so good that the conference's stat report lists his ratio at "infinity".

BEST OF THE BEST UNDER 50

Arizona head coach Sean Miller is coaching in his ninth season at the helm of the program in Tucson and in his 14th year as a college head coach at the age of 48. His 342 career victories as a head coach makes him the second-winningest active coach in NCAA Division I under the age of 50.

TRIER'S AWARD-WINNING START TO THE YEAR

Arizona junior Allonzo Trier has been named the Pac-12 Conference Player of the Week for the first week of the college basketball season. Trier averaged 31.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a pair of wins for the Wildcats. The Seattle native scored his points with efficiency as he shot 64.5 percent from the field, 50.0 percent from beyond the arc and 83.3 percent from the free throw line for the week.

Trier opened the 2017-18 season with a bang, setting a new career high in scoring with 32 points in a 101-67 win versus Northern Arizona. His 32 points were the most scored by a Wildcat on opening night in four decades and the third most ever in program history in a season opener. The junior followed up his career night with 30 points in his team's 25-point handling of UMBC. Furthermore, Trier is one of only two players in the NCAA to score 30 or more points in two games over the opening weekend. California's Don Coleman was the only other player with back-to-back 30-point games in the first two games of the season last weekend.

By scoring 30 or more points in consecutive games, Trier becomes the eighth Wildcat with back-to-back 30-point games and the first since Jerryd Bayless during the 2007-08 season. He also became the second player in program history with a pair of 30-point games in the first two games of the season, joining Michael Dickerson in 1996-97.

ANOTHER CHAPTER OF ARIZONA IN THE NBA DRAFT

The 2017 NBA Draft saw both Lauri Markkanen and Kadeem Allen hear their names called. Markkanen, the freshman forward, was selected with the seventh overall pick by the Minnesota Timberwolves before being traded to the Chicago Bulls. The Finland native became the fourth top ten NBA draft pick during the Sean Miller era (2009 to present). He also advanced another impressive NBA Draft stat. 12 of the last 15 former Wildcats selected in the first round have gone in the lottery. Kadeem Allen was the 53rd overall selection of the Boston Celtics. He, teamed with Markkanen, give the Arizona program a total of 71 NBA Draft picks.

THE SENIOR GRADUATION STREAK

Kadeem Allen, the lone senior on the 2016-17 roster, extended the program's impressive graduation streak. All 20 of the UA seniors who have completed their eligibility under Sean Miller has earned their college diploma. The impressive streak extends beyond Arizona for Sean Miller. Every one of the 37 college seniors that have played for Miller at Xavier or Arizona have fulfilled the requirements for their undergraduate degrees.

COMING OFF LAST YEAR

The Arizona Wildcats enter the 2017-18 season following a 32-5 season one year ago. It was the seventh season of 30 or more wins in program history and the fourth under head coach Sean Miller. UA is the defending Pac-12 regular season and tournament champions after splitting the season title with Oregon with an impressive 16-2 record in league play and defeating a pair of top-5 ranked teams in back-to-back nights en route to the tournament crown. Arizona participated in its 32nd NCAA Tournament in program history while advancing the program's NCAA record under Miller to 13-6 (.684) and its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in program history.

MCKALE CENTER DOING WHAT IT ALWAYS DOES

With a conference-leading average home crowd of 14,410, Arizona and its beloved McKale Center have now led the Pac-12 in attendance for 33 consecutive seasons. UA's average home crowd was nearly 2,000 people larger than second place Utah a year ago. The 14,410 average for the 2016-17 season ranked 15th nationally and accounted for 98.4 percent capacity for the season.

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him seven for his career. Since 2008, Miller is one of five coaches nationally to lead a team to seven Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.




