

### Arizona-SMU Notes

- Arizona dropped its second consecutive non-conference game in the 60-66 loss to SMU on Thanksgiving Day. It's the first time UA has dropped back-to-back games before conference play since the 2011-12 season.
- Freshman Deandre Ayton finished Thursday's game with 17 points and 15 rebounds to secure his fifth consecutive double-double of his young career. He is the first Arizona freshman in program history to tally five straight double-doubles. Ayton also became the first Wildcat, of any kind, to record five consecutive double-doubles since Ryan Anderson in the 2015-16 season.
- With 22 points against SMU, Allonzo Trier has now scored 20 or more points in each of the Wildcats' first five games of the season. Trier became the first Wildcat to open a season with five consecutive games of 20 or more points since Chase Budinger in 2008-09.
- Ira Lee played a quality, complete game of his freshman season in the loss to SMU, finishing with five points, six rebounds and two blocks in just 14 minutes.
