Postgame Notes

- Senior running back Nick Wilson finished with 51 rushing yards Saturday night, giving him 3,009 yards for his career. Wilson is the seventh player in school history to reach the 3,000-yard mark, joining Ka'Deem Carey, Trung Canidate, Ontiwaun Carter, Art Luppino, Mike Bell and Hubie Oliver.
- Redshirt freshman cornerback Lorenzo Burns collected his fifth interception of the season on Saturday. He's the first Arizona player to have five interceptions in a season since Trevin Wade in 2009. Burns entered the game tied for the national lead in interceptions among freshmen.
- Sophomore quarterback Khalil Tate scored his 12th rushing touchdown of the season in Saturday's first half. That moved him into eighth place on Arizona's single-season rushing touchdown list. With one more, he'll tie Nic Grigsby and B.J. Denker for seventh. Denker's 13 touchdowns are the most in school history by a quarterback.
- Senior running back Zach Green scored his 11th rushing touchdown of the season and is tied with Trung Canidate for ninth in Arizona's single-season rushing touchdown list.
- Redshirt sophomore defensive tackle Finton Connolly made his first career start Saturday. He had four tackles and one sack in his starting debut. Redshirt senior defensive end DeAndre' Miller made his first start of the season and the 18th of his career.
- Freshman linebacker Colin Schooler had two tackles-for-loss Saturday. He has multiple tackles-for-loss in three straight games. Schooler had three TFLs in back-to-back games against Oregon State and Oregon, before his performance Saturday. Schooler finished with 13 total tackles, two off his career high.
- Arizona rushed for 245 yards Saturday and have now rushed for at least 150 yards in 18 straight games, which is the longest streak of coach Rich Rodriguez's career. Arizona rushed for at least 150 in all 12 regular season games this season.
- Arizona had four rushing touchdowns Saturday and finished the regular season with 48 rushing scores. The Wildcats' previous best for a season was 36 touchdowns.
- Arizona has posted multiple rushing touchdowns in 10 straight games after reaching the end zone four times Saturday on the ground. Arizona has scored at least one rushing touchdown in 15 straight games, dating back to last season.
- Freshman linebacker Tony Fields II had 10 tackles Saturday, giving him 91 for the season. That's the highest total by an Arizona defender since Scooby Wright had 163 in 2014. Colin Schooler has 88 tackles on the season, which is also the highest total by an Arizona defender since Wright in 2014.
- Arizona held Arizona State to 163 passing yards Saturday, which is the fewest allowed this season in a game. It's the lowest total since giving up just 104 passing yards to Stanford last season.
- Senior wide receiver Shawn Poindexter finished with a career-high 53 receiving yards. His previous best was 43 set earlier this season against Washington State. Poindexter's 48-yard catch in the second half was the longest of his career.
