



2004 Season In Review

The 2004 season was a frustrating one for the Arizona volleyball team. With more than half of the team battling injuries at some point during the season, the Wildcats never hit full stride. The squad finished the season 19-11 overall and 10-8 in the Pac-10, good for sixth place.


During the season, the Wildcats defeated four ranked teams (No. 9 Pepperdine, No. 18 Louisville, No. 12 UCLA and No. 14 California). Meanwhile, 10 of Arizona's 11 losses came at the hands of ranked foes. At the conclusion of the season, Arizona was tabbed No. 22 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll.

The injuries forced Head Coach Dave Rubio to use several different line-ups throughout the course of the season, which never allowed the team to gel. Towards the end of the season, however, Arizona was most consistent, defeating UC Irvine in the first round of the NCAA Tournament before losing a heartbreaking five-game match to host San Diego in the second round.

Junior Kim Glass, who missed the entire non-conference season with a shoulder injury, was named to the All-Pac-10 team for the third year in a row. However, she was ineligible for all-region and All-America honors because she hadn't played enough games.

Joining Glass on the all-conference squad was first-time honoree senior Jolene Killough, who ranked third in the league in hitting percentage (.388) and eighth in blocks (1.11). Meanwhile, junior Bre Ladd was named honorable mention All-Pac-10.

As a team, Arizona ranked third in the Pac-10 in service aces, fourth in both kills and hitting percentage, and fifth in blocks and opponent hitting percentage. In addition, several players ranked in the Top 10 in the conference in individual statistical categories. Setter Stephanie Butkus was third

in assists per game (12.41), while Kristina Baum ranked seventh in hitting percentage (.316). Senior libero Kelli Mulvany was 10th in the league in digs (3.46).

In the classroom, several Wildcats excelled. Butkus, Glass, Killough and Meghan Cumpston were all named honorable mention Pac-10 All-Academic.

Several Wildcats finished the season ranked in the Top 10 in various season statistical categories. Mulvany boasted the best ever digs per game average and ranked seventh in digs with 353. Killough was third in hitting percentage, while Glass ranked fourth in kills per game (4.85), and sixth in both 20+ kill matches (8) and service aces per game (0.42). Butkus was sixth in assists per game and ninth in assists (1,266).

Killough finished her career ranked second all-time at Arizona in hitting percentage (.349) and eighth in blocks (0.94). Mulvany closed out her career ranked second in both digs (1,203) and digs per game (2.85).
