OFF THE TOP

- Arizona opens Pac-12 play with No. 3/4 Arizona State inside McKale Center with the last four meetings between the two programs having gone to the Wildcats. UA has won 17 of the last 20 head-to-head meetings in Tucson going back two decades with a home record of 7-1 versus the Sun Devils under head coach Sean Miller.
- The Wildcats closed out non-conference play with a 73-58 victory over UConn on Dec. 21 to push the program's win streak to seven games. Senior Dusan Ristic tallied his second double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds against the Huskies. Guard Rawle Alkins supported Ristic with 20 points in the win, giving the sophomore his second game of 20 points or more in his last three appearances. The 58 points allowed by the UA defense marked the second consecutive opponent held below the 60-point mark. After allowing 73.8 points per game in the first 11 games of the season, Arizona's defense held NDSU and UConn to an average of 55.5 points per game.
- Saturday's game between intrastate rivals marks the first time the Wildcats and Sun Devils have met while both being ranked in the Top 25 since March 11, 1995 when No. 18 Arizona State downed No. 12 Arizona in double overtime in Tucson.
- Junior Allonzo Trier is 16 points shy of becoming the 51st Wildcat to score 1,000 points in a career. Trier's 984 points have come at an average of 17.0 points per game for his career. The Seattle native will become the eighth UA player to reach the 1,000-point mark during the Sean Miller era of 2009 to present.
- UA enters the ASU game as winners of 77 of its last 79 games inside McKale Center going back to the 2012-13 season. Arizona is 130-13 (.909) at home under head coach Sean Miller with a mark of 63-9 (.875) in Pac-12 home games.
- The Wildcats and Sun Devils will meet for a 233rd time in their all-time series going back to 1913. Arizona State was the first college team UA ever faced on Dec. 13, 1913 after playing primarily YMCA's and Tucson High School alumni teams starting in 1904.

PAC-12 OPENER #40

Since joining the Pac-12 Conference prior to the 1978-79 season, Arizona is 29-10 in conference openers. That record improves to 16-1 when the first conference game of the season is played inside McKale Center. Arizona has also won its last seven consecutive Pac-12 openers.

DEANDRE DROPPING DIMES

Deandre Ayton, at 7-foot-1-inch, led Arizona in assists in the win over UConn. Ayton tallied five assists coming out of numerous double teams in the post. Four of his five assists were converted for three-pointers with the fifth leading to a dunk.

5 WINS VERSUS THE TOP 5

Since Sean Miller's arrival in Tucson in 2009, the Wildcats have a record of 5-2 versus opponents ranked in the top five of the AP poll. Only two of those seven games were played in Tucson, including a 65-64 victory over No. 5 Florida on Dec. 15, 2012 and a 72-77 loss to No. 3 UCLA on Feb. 25, 2017.

OPENING WITH ASU

Of Arizona's 39 conference openers as a member of the Conference of Champions, Arizona State is tied with California as the Wildcats' most common opponent to open league play. Including Saturday, UA has faced the Sun Devils in their Pac-12 opener four times since 2011-12.

PJC FACING THE SUN DEVILS

Parker Jackson-Cartwright has played some of the best basketball of his career against the Sun Devils. In five career appearances versus ASU, PJC is shooting 57.1 percent from beyond the arc while tallying 16 assists to just one turnover.

IN ELITE CONFERENCE OF CHAMPIONS COMPANY

Through his first seven seasons as the head coach at the University of Arizona, Sean Miller has amassed a record of 91-35 (.722) in Pac-12 games. As he continues to win Pac-12 games in 2016-17 that conference winning percentage continues to solidify his place in the history of the Pac-12 for coaches with six or more seasons in the league.

MCKALE CENTER DOING WHAT IT ALWAYS DOES

With a conference-leading average home crowd of 14,410, Arizona and its beloved McKale Center have now led the Pac-12 in attendance for 33 consecutive seasons. UA's average home crowd was nearly 2,000 people larger than second place Utah a year ago. The 14,410 average for the 2016-17 season ranked 15th nationally and accounted for 98.4 percent capacity for the season.

A LOT OF WINNING

Fourth-year seniors Parker Jackson-Cartwright and Dusan Ristic are playing in their final seasons in Tucson with impressive career marks and pathways to become two of the all-time winningest players in program history. Following the LBSU win, Jackson-Cartwright has played in 112 games through his first three-plus seasons, posting a record of **93-19 (.830)** in those appearances. Ristic has appeared in 119 games in his UA career with a mark of **98-21 (.824)**. The two seniors are on pace to climb up the all-time wins record at Arizona, which is currently held by Kaleb Tarczewski and Matt Muehlebach at 110 wins in a career.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE DEANDRE

Deandre Ayton's pace for double-doubles has already sky rocketed him up the freshmen double-double list in the Arizona record books.

THE SENIOR GRADUATION STREAK

Kadeem Allen, the lone senior on the 2016-17 roster, extended the program's impressive graduation streak. All 20 of the UA seniors who have completed their eligibility under Sean Miller has earned their college diploma. The impressive streak extends beyond Arizona for Sean Miller. Every one of the 37 college seniors that have played for Miller at Xavier or Arizona have fulfilled the requirements for their undergraduate degrees.

ANOTHER CHAPTER OF ARIZONA IN THE NBA DRAFT

The 2017 NBA Draft saw both Lauri Markkanen and Kadeem Allen hear their names called. Markkanen, the freshman forward, was selected with the seventh overall pick by the Minnesota Timberwolves before being traded to the Chicago Bulls. The Finland native became the fourth top ten NBA draft pick during the Sean Miller era (2009 to present). He also advanced another impressive NBA Draft stat. 12 of the last 15 former Wildcats selected in the first round have gone in the lottery. Kadeem Allen was the 53rd overall selection of the Boston Celtics. He, teamed with Markkanen, give the Arizona program a total of 71 NBA Draft picks.

1.25 BILLION AND COUNTING IN NBA CONTRACTS

Former Wildcats continue their storied NBA careers after eclipsing the \$1 billion mark in NBA contracts signed prior to the 2013-14 season. Sean Miller era Cats have now inked \$129 million in NBA contracts since his arrival in Tucson prior to the 2009-10 season. Arizona also boasts six former players who have each earned in excess of \$100 million in NBA deals, including Gilbert Arenas, Mike Bibby, Andre Iguodala, Richard Jefferson, Damon Stoudamire and Jason Terry. Arizona products have signed for over \$62 million in NBA contracts for the 2017-18 season alone.

ARIZONA: A FREQUENT HOME FOR MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

A pair of McDonald's All-Americans joined Arizona as part of the 2017 recruiting class. Deandre Ayton, an incoming freshman and top recruit nationally for the class, is joined by Duke transfer Chase Jeter. Jeter was a McDonald's All-American as part of the 2015 recruiting class. Ayton and Jeter give UA 24 McDonald's All-Americans in program history. After landing 15 All-Americans from 1984 to 2007, Arizona has inked nine since 2012.

This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him seven for his career. Since 2008, Miller is one of five coaches nationally to lead a team to seven Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.




