OFF THE TOP

- The Wildcats return to the Grand Canyon State for a showdown versus No. 7/9 Texas A&M in a neutral site game at the home of the Phoenix Suns, Talking Stick Resort Arena. Arizona is 7-0 in non-conference games played in Phoenix since 1992.
- UA earned a 91-88 victory in overtime at UNLV on Saturday. The Cats overcame a 13-point deficit in the second half courtesy of 57 combined points from Allonzo Trier and Deandre Ayton. Ayton's final line for the night was 28 points, 10 rebounds and 3 blocks in 39 minutes of action, which helped the 7-foot-1-inch forward earn Pac-12 Player of the Week honors.
- Freshman Deandre Ayton enters the week as one just four players in the nation to average at least 20 points and 10 rebounds per game while shooting 60 percent or better from the field. Three of those four players are freshmen with Marvin Bagley III (Duke) and Brandon McCoy (UNLV) joining Ayton in that distinction.
- Arizona's all-time record of 25-26 (.490) against the SEC is the program's lowest mark against any conference. The Wildcats are 5-3 versus SEC members under head coach Sean Miller with a current streak of four consecutive wins.
- Allonzo Trier, the leading scorer in the Pac-12 Conference, is averaging 23.9 points per game while also ranking seventh nationally in scoring. The junior has scored 25 or more points in six of his eight games this season.
- Tuesday's game with the Aggies is the backend of a semi-neutral, home-and-home series. A short-handed Arizona team, with only seven available players, held on for a 67-63 victory in Houston last season. Texas A&M took the Wildcats to the brink as they scored 18 unanswered in the waning minutes before a pair of Rawle Alkins free throws put away the game. Dusan Ristic led UA with 18 points, which stands as the third-highest scoring game of his career.

AYTON EARNS CONFERENCE HONORS

Arizona freshman Deandre Ayton has been named the Pac-12 Player of the Week following a pair of wins over LBSU and UNLV. Ayton averaged 20.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per game while shooting 62.1 percent from the floor for the week. The Nassau, Bahamas native becomes the second Wildcat to earn the conference honor this season, following Allonzo Trier's winning of the first weekly honor of the year. The big week from the freshman was punctuated by his 28 points, 10 rebounds and 3 blocks in Arizona's overtime win at UNLV.

Ayton is currently one of only four players in the nation to average 20 points and 10 rebounds a game while shooting 60 percent or greater from the field. The freshman has tallied six double-doubles in the first eight games of his career, which places Ayton fifth in UA freshman history after the first month of the season.

The 7-foot-1-inch forward was an ESPN Preseason All-America Third Team member while also earning spots on watch lists for the John R. Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and the Oscar Robertson Trophy. Ayton becomes the fourth UA freshman in as many seasons to be named Pac-12 Player of the Week, following Lauri Markkanen, Allonzo Trier and Stanley Johnson.

20-POINT DUOS

Arizona is one of only three teams to have two players averaging 20 or more points per game, joining Marquette and Oakland.

SUNSHINE SUCCESS

UA's recent history of games played up I-10 has been a resounding success with wins in the last seven non-conference games played in Phoenix. Five of those seven victories have come against nationally-ranked opponents, including three versus top-five ranked foes.

THREE-PRONGED ATTACK

The trio of Deandre Ayton (5th - .614), Dusan Ristic (7th - .596) and Allonzo Trier (T-9th - .571) each rank in the top ten of the Pac-12 Conference in field goal percentage. The three efficient Wildcats make Arizona the only program in the ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big XII or SEC to have three players ranked in the top ten in field goal percentage in a conference.

CONTINUED OFFENSIVE COHESION IN MILLER ERA

KenPom's adjusted offensive efficiency metric measures points scored per 100 possessions with adjustments for the quality of opposing defenses, the site of each game, and when each game was played (recent games get more weight). Arizona has posted a top-20 season nationally in this statistic in each of the last five seasons. The 2017-18 season is continuing this trend.

It's just part of the winning culture instilled on the Arizona Basketball program since the arrival of head coach Sean Miller. In Miller's eight seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 27.5 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 209-54 (.795) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

PJC OFF TO A STRONG START

Parker Jackson-Cartwright's strong play to start the season has propelled the senior to the best non-conference season of his career. The senior is shooting 57.9 percent (11 of 19) from deep, which ranks first in the conference. The Los Angeles native has used his sharpshooting from beyond the arc to tally four double-digit scoring games this season. By comparison, Jackson-Cartwright scored ten or more points a total of three times in non-conference play in his entire career before this season. ARIZONA ADDS A FUTURE PAIR OF WILDCATS

The University of Arizona Basketball program and head coach Sean Miller have added a pair of commitments to its recruiting class during the fall signing period. Guard Brandon Williams from and forward Shareef O'Neal with both join UA's 2018 recruiting class from Southern California. Williams and O'Neal will play their senior season of their prep careers before joining the Wildcats next season as freshmen.

Brandon Williams – 6-foot-2-inch 185 pounds – Guard – Encino, Calif.

- Evaluated as a five star recruit at the time of his commitment
- Widely-considered one of the top point guard prospects nationally for the 2018 class
- Scored 16 points in CIF Division I Finals versus Berkeley as a sophomore
- Product of Crespi Carmelite High whose alumni include former UVA guard London Perrantes

Coach Miller on Brandon: "Brandon did not sustain an injury, and that's important to note. He had some genetic issue with his leg that he was able to get fixed. To his family's credit, they were able to do it in time, but he missed a lot of action. He wasn't on the circuit this spring and summer. If he would've been, I believe he would've been a McDonald's All-American guard. What we love the most about him is that he can score and be a playmaker. He can score off the dribble, he's physically strong and he can shoot the three-point shot. The way the game is changing, you can put different guards out there at the same time and Brandon can play with anybody. We are looking at him to have an immediate impact. We are thrilled to have him. He also plays for a great high school coach, in a high school program that has produced some very good guards recently that have gone to college and have had success."

Shareef O'Neal – 6-foot-9-inch 215 pounds – Forward – Los Angeles, Calif.

- Rated as a 5-star prospect, top-3 recruit in California and 24th overall by ESPN
- Son of NBA legend Shaquille O'Neal
- Former teammate of current Wildcat Ira Lee at Crossroads School in Santa Monica, Calif.
- Averaged 14 points and 7 rebounds a game as a junior, guiding Crossroads to California state semifinals

Coach Miller on Shareef: "Shareef O'Neal, because he is Shaquille's son, we almost want to compare the two but they are very different. Shareef is a versatile forward and wing player. He is very skilled and can shoot the three-point shot. I believe as he continues to develop, he'll be able to go inside and outside and for those who follow our program, it's that type of hybrid forward that thrives. I believe he will do those same things. Both are excellent kids and they know each other, which is awesome. It's exciting for all of us. It's exciting to have both those guys in our future."

ARIZONA IN THE LAST SEVEN SEASONS

While Sean Miller and Co. arrived in Tucson for the 2009-10 season, the 2010-11 campaign effectively marks the beginning of the Miller Era. Six years ago, the Wildcats claimed their first conference championship under Miller and made a run to the Elite Eight that ended at the hands of eventual national champion Connecticut. While UA has led the nation in wins in the during parts of the last four seasons, the last seven seasons of Arizona hoops have been among the best in the nation as well.

A LOT OF WINNING

Fourth-year seniors Parker Jackson-Cartwright and Dusan Ristic are playing in their final seasons in Tucson with impressive career marks and pathways to become two of the all-time winningest players in program history. Following the LBSU win, Jackson-Cartwright has played in 108 games through his first three-plus seasons, posting a record of **89-19 (.824)** in those appearances. Ristic has appeared in 115 games in his UA career with a mark of **94-21 (.817)**. The two seniors are on pace to climb up the all-time wins record at Arizona, which is currently held by Kaleb Tarczewski and Matt Muehlebach at 110 wins in a career.

ALLONZO INITIATING OFFENSE

Allonzo Trier has already tallied three games of four assists or more in the first seven games of this season. By comparison, Trier recorded four games of four or more assists in his first 45 appearances as a freshman and sophomore.

PJC AND THE 3-5-0

Point guard Parker Jackson-Cartwright enters Saturday's game five assists shy of 350 for his career after tallying 42 in his first eight games of this season.

TRIER'S AWARD-WINNING START TO THE YEAR

Arizona junior Allonzo Trier was named the Pac-12 Conference Player of the Week for the first week of the college basketball season. Trier averaged 31.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game in a pair of wins for the Wildcats. The Seattle native scored his points with efficiency as he shot 64.5 percent from the field, 50.0 percent from beyond the arc and 83.3 percent from the free throw line for the week.

Trier opened the 2017-18 season with a bang, setting a new career high in scoring with 32 points in a 101-67 win versus Northern Arizona. His 32 points were the most scored by a Wildcat on opening night in four decades and the third most ever in program history in a season opener. The junior followed up his career night with 30 points in his team's 25-point handling of UMBC. Furthermore, Trier was one of only two players in the NCAA to score 30 or more points in two games over the opening weekend. California's Don Coleman was the only other player with back-to-back 30-point games in the first two games of the season last weekend.

By scoring 30 or more points in consecutive games, Trier becomes the eighth Wildcat with back-to-back 30-point games and the first since Jerryd Bayless during the 2007-08 season. He also became the second player in program history with a pair of 30-point games in the first two games of the season, joining Michael Dickerson in 1996-97.

HONORS AND ACCOLADES

Arizona's individual accolades came in waves during the preseason with Allonzo Trier being named a Preseason All-American by ESPN, AP, Sports Illustrated and Sporting News while Deandre Ayton earned a spot on Preseason All-America teams by ESPN and Sporting News as a freshman. The Trier-Ayton duo was also named to prestigious watch lists for the Oscar Robertson Trophy, John R. Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy.

Rawle Alkins, although injured, also joined Ayton and Trier on the John R. Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy watch lists.

Alkins, Ayton and Trier were joined by Dusan Ristic on positional season watch lists, nominated by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Alkins earned the nod as a small forward (Julius Erving Award), Ayton as a power forward (Karl Malone Award), Ristic as a center (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) and Trier as a shooting guard (Jerry West Award).

A CLOSER LOOK AT NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

The Wildcats' non-conference slate features a handful of teams ranked in the preseason AP and USA Today Coaches' Polls. Those non-conference foes also include plenty of teams with strong showings in preseason conference polls with six set opponents finishing fourth or better in their respective conference polls.

Alex Barcello continues his passing efficiency in the early part of his freshman season in Tucson. The Chandler, Ariz. native is up to 15 assists to just four turnovers. Although his 3.75 assist-to-turnover ratio does not meet minimum assists per game requirements for league rankings, if included he lead the Pac-12 in the statistical category.

THE SENIOR GRADUATION STREAK

Kadeem Allen, the lone senior on the 2016-17 roster, extended the program's impressive graduation streak. All 20 of the UA seniors who have completed their eligibility under Sean Miller has earned their college diploma. The impressive streak extends beyond Arizona for Sean Miller. Every one of the 37 college seniors that have played for Miller at Xavier or Arizona have fulfilled the requirements for their undergraduate degrees.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE DEANDRE

Deandre Ayton's pace for double-doubles has already sky rocketed him up the freshmen double-double list in the Arizona record books.

ANOTHER CHAPTER OF ARIZONA IN THE NBA DRAFT

The 2017 NBA Draft saw both Lauri Markkanen and Kadeem Allen hear their names called. Markkanen, the freshman forward, was selected with the seventh overall pick by the Minnesota Timberwolves before being traded to the Chicago Bulls. The Finland native became the fourth top ten NBA draft pick during the Sean Miller era (2009 to present). He also advanced another impressive NBA Draft stat. 12 of the last 15 former Wildcats selected in the first round have gone in the lottery. Kadeem Allen was the 53rd overall selection of the Boston Celtics. He, teamed with Markkanen, give the Arizona program a total of 71 NBA Draft picks.

1.25 BILLION AND COUNTING IN NBA CONTRACTS

Former Wildcats continue their storied NBA careers after eclipsing the \$1 billion mark in NBA contracts signed prior to the 2013-14 season. Sean Miller era Cats have now inked \$129 million in NBA contracts since his arrival in Tucson prior to the 2009-10 season. Arizona also boasts six former players who have each earned in excess of \$100 million in NBA deals, including Gilbert Arenas, Mike Bibby, Andre Iguodala, Richard Jefferson, Damon Stoudamire and Jason Terry. Arizona products have signed for over \$62 million in NBA contracts for the 2017-18 season alone.

ARIZONA: A FREQUENT HOME FOR MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

A pair of McDonald's All-Americans joined Arizona as part of the 2017 recruiting class. Deandre Ayton, an incoming freshman and top recruit nationally for the class, is joined by Duke transfer Chase Jeter. Jeter was a McDonald's All-American as part of the 2015 recruiting class. Ayton and Jeter give UA 24 McDonald's All-Americans in program history. After landing 15 All-Americans from 1984 to 2007, Arizona has inked nine since 2012.

This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. 


