


# 1996 Season Review

Arizona finished the 1996 season 20-10 and was eliminated in the second round of the NCAA Tournament by Pacific in a four-game match at Stockton, Calif. The NCAA appearance was the Cats' third in four seasons, and the 20-win season was just their second since 1982 (eighth overall). The UA finished fifth in Pac-10 with a 10-8 mark after winning seven of its final nine conference matches. Arizona's victory over San Diego in the NCAA Tournament was the only win by a road team in the first round last season. The Cats were ranked 23rd in the AVCA/USA Today's final poll.

Senior outside hitter Barb Bell paced the Cats in kills for the third-straight season, breaking Terry Lauchner's Arizona career mark in the process. She also was named All-Pac-10 for the third time in her career. Bell's 517 kills were just three fewer than Lauchner's single-season record, set in 1988. Bell was fifth in the Pac-10 in kills per game (4.66) and she also led UA in digs with 2.81 a game. Freshman Erin Aldrich became just the third Cat ever to hit .300, setting an Arizona freshman record for hitting percentage. Aldrich earned Pac-10 All-Freshman honors for her efforts.

"In many respects, it was a very fulfilling season because of the way we were able to overcome obstacles midway through the season," head coach David Rubio said. "You feel good about the way individuals on the team were able to come together and play as one at the finish. I feel like the whole team, players and coaches, came together at the right time in able for us to get in the tournament and meet some of the goals we set for ourselves at the beginning of the year.

"The team had to overcome some chemistry problems. It was never really a physical problem for us, it was getting everyone on the same page and communicating well. Fortunately, we were able to do that. You feel good about the players being able to overcome some of those obstacles."

# 1995 Season Review

The Wildcats entered last season ranked at No. 16 by the *USA Today*/AVCA polls and swept their first two tournaments of the season, the Wildcat Classic and the Hotel Park Invitational. After losing to ASU in a hard-fought five-game match, the Cats rebounded by winning the Ohio State Invitational Tournament, which improved their record to 8-1 and moved them into the No. 12 spot in the polls. Arizona spent the remainder of the first half of the season facing Pac-10 foes and remained steady at No. 13.

The Cats began the second half of their season with an overall record of 10-2, 3-3 in Pac-10 play. After their win over Oregon, Arizona lost the next three matches, all against Pac-10 teams, but were able to rebound against No. 5 Washington State, upsetting the Cougars 3-2 on Oct. 21.

The Cats seemed to be on the rise again, but weren't able to keep the winning streak going as they lost the next two matches to California and No. 4 ranked Stanford. The Wildcats were able to get a win on the road at Oregon on Nov. 3, but this would be their last win of the season as they lost the final six matches of the season.

During the season, team high matches included 88 digs vs. Southern California on Oct. 14, 85 kills vs. Oregon State on Nov. 5 and 22 total blocks vs. Oregon State on Oct. 7 and Southern California on Nov. 11. Individual match highs included 31 kills for Barb Bell vs. Southern California on Nov. 11, 71 assists for Bartsch vs. Oregon State on Nov. 5 and 10 total blocks for Stephanie Venne on Oct. 7 vs Oregon State.

Arizona ended its season 14-14, 6-12 in the Pac-10. Bell was named All-Pac-10, her second time receiving this honor. Redshirt freshman Keisha Johnson was named to the All-Pac-10 Freshmen team.





# 1994 Review

It was pretty much a tale of not two, but three seasons for the Wildcats in 1994. The season began with the Wildcats winning seven of their first nine matches that included wins over 13th-ranked USC and 20th-ranked Oregon State. During that stretch, Arizona won a school-record tying six consecutive matches.

The Cats then began a tailspin that saw them lose six of their next eight matches. Despite losing the six matches to teams ranked higher than the Cats, the slump caused coach David Rubio to finker with the lineup. He elected to start a pair of freshman in setter Michaela Ebben and rightside hitter Michelle Fanger.

The shuffle got the attention of the team and after reinserting setter Laura Bartsch and rightside hitter Heather Flachsbarth into the lineup the Cats closed out the regular season by winning six of their last seven matches. The Cats finished the regular season with a 15-9 record and finished 10-8 in Pac-10 play, good for fifth place.

With the late season surge, the 16th-ranked Cats were successful in securing their second consecutive at-large berth in the NCAA tournament. Arizona hosted Loyola Marymount in First Round action and defeated the Lions in four games. Second Round play was to be a little more difficult as the Cats had to travel to No. 8 Brigham Young. A little more difficult, but not much as Arizona again won in four games and advanced to the Sweet Sixteen for the second consecutive year. Unfortunately, this is where the 1994 season ended for Arizona as the Cats fell to USC in three games. For the season, Arizona finished with a record of 17-10.

# 1991 Review

The Arizona Wildcats struggled through their most difficult season in school history as they finished with a record of 4-26 and went winless in the Pac-10 at 0-18. It was the first losing season for Arizona since the 1986 squad finished 14-15, and it was the third losing season in school history. The team won the season opener over Miami, and continued the first week of play with a victory over then 18th ranked Wyoming. However, things began to fall apart for the Cats as they lost a school record 14 matches in a row and 20 of their last 21 matches. The Wildcats became just the third team in Pac-10 play to go an entire season without a conference victory (USC - 1986; Oregon State - 1987). The rough season could also be pointed at the strength of the 1991 schedule as the Cats played 11 matches against teams ranked in the top 20, while 19 of their 30 matches were against teams who went on to make post-season appearances. Kristi Colson, Arizona's lone senior last season, ended her Wildcat career on a positive note as she was named to the season-ending Albuturkey Classic All-Tournament Team. It was the second all-tournament selection of the season for Colson as she was honored at the Wildcat Classic as well. Colson became the fifth Wildcat to record more than 1,000 kills in her career as she recorded 1,044 kills, good for fourth on the career kill list. Heather McCormack earned all-tournament honors at the season-opening Pittsburgh Classic. Her 1,198 assists last season moved her into the number two spot on the Arizona career assist chart. Lynn Fields became an offensive threat for the Wildcats and was named to the All-Tournament Team at the SportMart Classic.



# 1990 Review

The Wildcats opened the season with a bang as they jumped out to a 7-1 start and were among the top fifteen teams according to several volleyball rankings. However, the Cats hit idle and went 11-12 the remainder of the season. Despite finishing the 1990 campaign with an 18-13 record Arizona did not make NCAA post-season play for the first time in 10 seasons. Conference play provided the Cats with their second consecutive 8-10 season, good for a fifth place finish. The post-season absence did not mar a successful season for several of the players. All-Tournament honors were passed out to the Cats at the Arizona Invitational (Kristi Colson, Terry Lauchner, Trina Smith), Rhode Island Invitational (Colson, Lauchner (MVP), Smith), and the Hilton/Wildcat Classic (Colson, Lauchner).

Several Wildcats inked their name into the Arizona record books with outstanding performances. Heather McCormack set a single season mark with 1,478 assists and led the Pac-10 with 12.53 assists per game, her 76 assists against Fresno State tied an Arizona single match record. Terry Lauchner set several records and is now Arizona's all-time leader with 1,837 kills, 1,301 digs and 155 aces. Caylin Combs finished her career recording 904 kills (5th on the all-time list) and 883 digs (4th on the all-time list). Shelley Woloski picked up 29 digs against New Mexico State, the fourth best performance by a Wildcat in a single match. Trina Smith had seven solo blocks against Washington, the top effort by an Arizona player in a single match.

# 1989 In Review

**1989 Season Recap** -- Arizona opened up the 1989 season on the right foot by winning its first five matches. The Cats were victorious at the Baden/Wyoming Invitational as Mary Linton earned MVP honors, while teammates Terry Lauchner and Caylin Combs were selected to the All-Tournament team. Arizona then finished second at the Louisiana State Classic, as Linton and Lauchner earned All-Tournament honors.

The Cats were then hosts to the Tucson Hilton East Classic. Arizona successfully defended its title by defeating Brigham young and Colorado State. Trina Smith and Kelly Waage were All-Tournament selections.

Arizona opened up Pac-10 play with victories over the Oregon schools and were headed for a 5-4 record in the first half of conference play. Coming off back-to-back victories, including an impressive victory over USC on the Prime Network, the Cats seemed to be on a roll at 14-5.

The team began to stumble, losing seven of their last 10 matches in regular season play. Arizona saw its No. 6 ranking drop to No. 13 in the AVCA poll and No. 15 in the NCAA poll. At one point the Cats had lost four in a row, finishing Pac-10 play at 8-10.

However, the Cats did close out the regular season on a winning note with a road victory against a tough Brigham Young squad. The Cats finished the regular season at 17-12.

The Wildcats were hosts to the NCAA First Round and swept Oregon for their first post-season victory since 1985. Arizona then advanced to the West Regional where they battled No. 1 UCLA. The Cats came up short losing to the Bruins in three games and finished the season at 18-13. Terry Lauchner was selected to the All-Regional team.

Several Cats earned Pac-10 honors to highlight a successful season. Lauchner and Linton were selected to the 1989 All-Pac-10 Team, while teammate Smith was named to the Pac-10 All-Freshman Team.



## The University of Arizona

Growth has been the story of the University of Arizona, now celebrating its Centennial Year.

The University was founded in 1885 by an act of the Thirteenth Territorial Legislature. The Legislature appointed \$25,000 to fund the University—but it gave it no land.

One of the conditions of the establishment was for the City of Tucson, or Pima County to provide the land. Neither wanted the University—they wanted the State Capitol or the Insane Asylum.

So it was left to the defiled Legislators to find the land to start the campus.

A saloon Keeper and two gamblers came up with 40 acres of land with the deed filed on November 27, 1895. Thus, from these meager beginnings the University got its roots.

Even then the 14th Legislature was not satisfied and an attempt was made to repeal the University Act. This attempt failed and the University of Arizona finally got its start. This time the first priority—as it is today—was water. The Regents tried to get the community involved in the solicitation of funds to drill an artesian well, but to no avail so they settled for a \$100 expenditure to clear out an old Mexican well on the campus grounds. Next came the building project and the

University was on its way in becoming a reality.

The School of Mines building (now Old Main) became the first building at a cost of \$24,893. Ground was broken on Oct. 27, 1887 and classes began at the UA on Oct. 1, 1891, with 32 students and a faculty of six.

From this meager beginning the University now has a student body in excess of 30,000, a faculty of nearly 2,000 and a combined work force of around 13,400 with an annual payroll of more than \$200 million. The campus now covers some 325 acres and has 138 buildings.

The enrollment climbed steadily from those early days. The 1,000 student mark was reached after World War I when the student body numbered 1,088 in the 1919-20 year. It hit the 5,000 mark after World War II when 5,062 enrolled in 1946-47. It broke the 10,000 mark in 1959-60 with 10,954 students enrolled. The 20,000 mark came three years later when 20,367 counted for the 1963-64 year. The first time 30,000 students were recorded was in 1970-71 academic year with 30,146 students receiving instruction at the UA.

Back when the University was established the City of Tucson had a population of 5,150 and was two square miles in area. The State (then a Territory) had a population of 88,243.
