### QUICK NOTES

- Arizona is looking to get off the schneid on Thursday after five-straight losses, with the last coming to San Diego State on Sunday afternoon. The Wildcats and the Lumberjacks are facing off against each other for the 37th time in history and the first since 2010.
- Jalea Bennett is on a roll in the last two weeks as she has averaged 18.8 points per game in her last five contests and 21.7 points over her last three after scoring over 20 points in back-to-back games for the first time in her career. On the season, Bennett averages a team-high 15.9 points, which would be a huge career high for the senior. She scored a career-high 24 points on Nov. 28 against Long Beach State and followed that up with 23 against San Diego State on Dec. 3.
- Marlee Kyles has been a scoring fiend off the bench this year as she scores 11.9 points per game (second on the team) in 24.3 minutes per game. The freshman has games of 17, 18 and 19 points this season with her career-high coming against San Diego State on Dec. 3.
- Sam Thomas and Kyles are the first pair freshmen to have both scored at least 19 points in one game in the first six games of the season since 2001 when Dee-Dee Wheeler and Robin Roberson did it.

**Scouting the Lumberjacks**

Arizona has won eight straight and 11 of the last 12 matchups versus Northern Arizona, with the last loss coming on Dec. 9, 1988. In their eight-game winning streak, the Wildcats have an average margin of victory of 21.6 points. NAU is led by the trio of Olivia Lucero, Kenna McDavis and Kaleigh Paplow. Lucero leads the team with 18.5 points per game, McDavis averages a double-double with an impressive 17.2 points and 11.2 rebounds with three made three-pointers per game and Paplow chips in 14.2 points per game. The Lumberjacks won two-straight after dropping the first three games of the season, but lost at Denver on Sunday by a score of 80-73.

**We See Ya JaLea**

JaLea Bennett is one of the two seniors on the team (Kat Wright) and will be looked upon as a leader for the young group of Wildcats this year. Along with Destiny Graham, they are the two remaining student-athletes that played for former head coach Niya Butts. Bennett has turned up the scoring in the past two as she averages 18.8 points per game in her last five contests and 21.7 over her last three. Bennett did something last week she has never done before, and that is score at least 20 points in back-to-back games. Against Long Beach State, she poured in a career-high 24 points and followed that up with 23 against San Diego State. She has scored in double-figures in six of Arizona's seven games, which leads the team. After leading the Wildcats in scoring in four of the last five games, Bennett is now tied for sixth in scoring in the Pac-12.

**Thomas Does It All**

Freshman forward Sam Thomas has been Arizona's version of Draymond Green through the first three games of her collegiate career as she has averaged 10 points, eight rebounds, 2.3 steals and 2.1 blocks per game while being off the floor for just 18 minutes this season. While being fifth in the nation among freshman in blocks per game, Thomas is third in the Pac-12 and first among freshmen in blocks, sixth in the Pac-12 and first among all freshmen in rebounding while ranking fifth in offensive rebounds per game (2.9) and is sixth in the Pac-12 and first among freshmen in steals. The freshman is also second in the Pac-12 in minutes per game (37.4) just behind Lucia Alonso. Thomas had a monster game against TCU (11/24) as she scored 20 points on 7-10 shooting with seven rebounds and two blocks and recorded 11 rebounds against Long Beach State (11/28). She is the first freshman since

Taryn Griffey to score 20 points in a game and is the first freshman to have two double-figure rebounding games in the first six games of the season since Erica Barnes in 2010. Additionally, 11 rebounds are the most for a freshman since LaBrittney Jones had 11 in a game back in 2014.

**It's Her Destiny**

Destiny Graham has stepped up her game so far in 2017. She is third on the team in scoring with 10.9 points per game to go along with 5.7 rebounds per game, which is second on the team. Graham scored a career-high 17 points against CSUN (11/25) and tied her career-high with 11 rebounds against TCU (11/24). The junior has done a good job of getting to the line and making her free throws as she is 22-26 (85%) from the charity stripe, which is third in the Pac-12. Coming into the 2017 season, Graham had scored in double-figures just three times and has already scored in double-figures four times this season after dropping 14 against San Diego State (12/3).

**Marlee Gets Buckets**

Freshman Marlee Kyles is Arizona's second leading scorer through the first seven games of the season by averaging 11.9 points per game off the bench while playing 24.3 minutes per game, which is the sixth-fewest on the team. She scored 17 in the season opener against Iona (11/10), had 18 against Loyola Marymount (11/22) and had a career-high 19 against Long Beach State (11/28). Although she struggled to score against San Diego State, Kyles did pitch in a career-high six rebounds. Kyles is third amongst all freshmen in scoring in the Pac-12.

**Buenos Dias, Lucia**

It's hard to believe, but Lucia Alonso is already the third-longest tenured Wildcat on the 2017-18 roster as a sophomore. Alonso has been good from beyond the arc as she is shooting a team-high 45%, which is first in the Pac-12. Additionally, Alonso is fifth in steals (2.4) and first in minutes per game (37.6). Against Utah State (11/17), she tied her career highs with 15 points, four made three-pointers and four steals and followed that up with 13 points and three made threes. Against Long Beach State, she hit double-figures for the third time this season with 11 points and dished out a season-high five assists. The sophomore was held scoreless against San Diego State (12/3), but she did dish out seven assists. In her last two games, Alonso has an assist/turnover ratio of 12/3.

**Sammy Gets Her Chance**

Coming into the San Diego State game (12/3), Sammy Fatkin hadn't played more than eight minutes in a game and hadn't scored since the Utah State game (11/17). However, against the Aztecs, she played 18 minutes and scored 11 points with three made three-pointers.

**Your Newest WildKAT**

After visiting campus this past April, Kat Wright decided to finish out her college career at the University of Arizona. A transfer from Florida Atlantic University, Wright has 158 career made three-pointers, which would be sixth all-time in Arizona history. Wright was forced to sit out the 2016-17 season due to injury, but during her junior year in 2015-16, Wright lit it up as she made 87 trey balls on 40% shooting while scoring 11.7 points per game. To put that into perspective, only one Wildcat has made more than 82 three-pointers in one season, and that was Lisa Griffith who made 92 in the 1996-97 season. The highlight of her career came on Jan. 30, 2016 when she drained 11 three-pointers against Charlotte, which is the second-most made three-pointers in NCAA history in a single game. Wright has made at least one three-pointer in each game this season and ranks 10th in made triples per game in the Pac-12 (1.9).

**They're Called Free Throws for a Reason**

Arizona has done a good job of converting their free throws this season as they are shooting at an 77% clip, which is second in the Pac-12. Last season, the Wildcats shot 70% from the charity stripe. Destiny Graham ranks third in the Pac-12 in free throw percentage (85%).

**Barnes' Numbers vs. NAU as a Player**

Against NAU, Barnes averaged 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds over two games in 1996 & 1997. On Dec. 13, 1996, she scored 25 points, grabbed 10 rebounds and dished out four assists in an 86-54 victory.

**Lots of New Faces**

Of Arizona's 13 players on the roster, 10 of them are newcomers. Those newcomers include Kat Wright, Sam Thomas, Sammy Fatkin, Markee Kyles, Kiana Barkhoff, Ali Reese, Lindsey Malecha, Aarion McDonald, Dominique McBryde and Tee Tee Starks. Thomas, Fatkin, Kyles, Barkhoff and Reese are incoming freshmen, Wright, McDonald, McBryde and Starks are transfer students and Malecha was added as a walk-on, but is an incoming junior. Ten newcomers is the most in the Pac-12 this season. The last time Arizona had at least five freshmen was the 2008-09 season.

**Valley Teams Up with Barnes (again)**

As soon as there was an opening on Barnes' coaching staff, she looked no further than Morgan Valley. During the 2015-16 season, Barnes and Valley were assistant coaches at Washington, where they made a historic run to the Final Four on the backs of Kelsey Plum and Chantel Osahor. All Valley knows is winning as she has been a part of five Final Fours, four of them as a player at UConn in which she won three National Championships playing for Geno Auriemma. She is just one of two Division I assistant coaches to have played in four Final Fours and three National Championships.

**Barnes Loves the Season Openers**

Adia Barnes is the third head coach in Arizona history to win her first two season openers. The other two were Lois Sheldahl (72-73) and Nancy Trego (74-75).

**Where Barnes Sits in UA History**

With 14 wins last season, head coach Adia Barnes won the second-most game of any other first-year coach at Arizona. Wendy Larray had a record of 19-9 in the 1985-86 season. Niya Butts holds the record for the most wins in a second season as a head coach as the Wildcats won 14 games in 2009-10. Barnes needs to lead the Wildcats to 16 wins this season to tie the record for most wins through two years as a head coach.

Adia Barnes is back in Wildcat Country, and this time it's as the head coach of the University of Arizona. Barnes is known as one of, if not the best women's basketball player to come through Tucson. As a player, she is the program's leading scorer as she finished with 2,237 career points (18.5 ppg). She is also second all-time in career rebounds (921). During Barnes' freshman year in the 1994-95 season, the Cats finished with a record of 11-19. The next three years were a complete turnaround as the Wildcats won at least 22 games in each season and made a three-straight postseason appearances. Over those three years, Arizona was 68-23, which is still the best three-year stretch in Arizona history.

When Adia Barnes was deciding who she would hire for her three assistant coach spots, she looked no further than her husband Salvo Coppa, who has coached all over the world. Some of his coaching stops include Italy, Thailand, Sicily, Malta, the Seattle Storm and Montana State. Coppa is a certified FIBA coach and is also fluent in English, Spanish, French and Italian. He is the son of legendary international coach Santino Coppa, who founded and coached the club Trogylos Priolo, who has won two Italian league titles and one European Cup. Barnes and Coppa also have a two-year old son, Matteo.

**Lights, Camera, Action**

13 of Arizona's 18 conference games will be televised by Pac-12 Networks this season. Among the scheduled television games: home contests with Stanford, California, Colorado, Utah, Washington State, Arizona State, Oregon State and Oregon.

### Arizona Signs No. 5 Class in the Country

Adia Barnes and the Arizona women's basketball team have completed their 2018 class as they received five National Letters of Intent from Bryce Nixon, Semaj Smith, Cate Reese, Shalyse Smith and Valeria Trucco. ProspectsNation.com ranks Arizona as the fifth-best recruiting class in the country and first in the Pac-12, which is the highest ranked class Arizona has ever signed. Take a look at Arizona's five signees on the next page.

### Bryce Nixon

Nixon, a Phoenix, Ariz. native is rated as a four-star guard by ProspectsNation.com. She has consistently been an Arcadia High School standout as she was named First-Team Division II All-Arizona while averaging 20 points, five assists, four rebounds and three steals per game during her junior season. She scored in double-figures in each game and had a season-high of 31 points twice (back-to-back games). The 5'10" guard made over two three-pointers per game, had seven 7+ assist games and had eight steals in one game twice last year.

### Semaj Smith

Semaj Smith, a native of Long Beach, Calif., is rated as a five-star recruit and the No. 9 post player in the country as well as the No. 52 prospect. Smith, the tallest player in the class at 6'5", helped lead St. Anthony High School to the semifinals of the 2017 CIF 1AA Playoffs last year by dominating in the post. She averaged an impressive 15.9 points, 15.2 rebounds and 5.7 blocks last year as a junior.

### Cate Reese

Reese is tabbed as a five-star recruit and the fourth-best post player in the country. Coming in as the 14th-best prospect in the country, Reese will be the highest ranked prospect Arizona women's basketball has ever signed. The Cypress, Texas native was named TABC 6A All-State two times during her high school career at Cypress Woods High School. Last year, the 6'3" forward scored 22.3 points per game and grabbed 13.2 rebounds per game. She scored over 30 points three times with a season-high of 36. Additionally, she had a stretch of 13-straight double-doubles and had one 20/20 game where she scored 27 points and had 20 rebounds. Reese had three such games where she grabbed 20 rebounds with a season-high of 22.

### Shalyse Smith

Shalyse Smith was the first to commit to Arizona in the class of 2018. She is rated as a four-star forward by ProspectsNation.com as well as the No. 7 forward and the No. 48 player in the country. The Tacoma, Wash. native was named USA Today Honorable Mention All-Western Washington at Bellarmine Prep last year as she averaged 15.8 points, 11.3 rebounds, two steals and 1.6 blocks per game, helping her team to a third-place finish in the 4A State Tournament. The 6'1" exceptionally athletic forward recorded 15 double-doubles last season with eight games of 20+ points and a season high of 24 (twice). One game stood out last year for Smith on the glass as she grabbed 25 rebounds with 13 of them on the offensive end.

### Valeria Trucco

Trucco is rated as a five-star post player by ProspectsNation.com out of Torino, Italy. The 6'4" forward is arguably one of the top young players to come out of Europe in 2018. She currently plays for the Torino Basketball Club and has been a member of the U16, U17 and U18 Italian National Teams. During her time playing with Italian National Teams, she won a Silver Medal with the Italian U17 World Championship team and competed on both the U16 and U18 Italian European Championship teams.

**Adia Barnes** was introduced as Arizona's head women's basketball coach on April 4, 2016. The leading scorer in Arizona women's basketball history and a WNBA Champion, Barnes came to Tucson after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Washington for five seasons.

Barnes led the Wildcats to a 14-16 record in her first year at the helm with a 5-13 Pac-12 record. 14 wins is the most since the 2011-12 season and five conference wins is the most in the Pac-12 era for the Wildcats.

Under her direction, five Wildcats averaged their career-high in scoring, including LaBrittney Jones, who was named All-Pac-12 by averaging 15.6 points, 6.8 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game. Jones is the first Wildcat to be named to the All-Pac-12 team since Davellyn Whyte made the 2013 team.

Throughout the season, the Wildcats showed that they never gave up, which is a trait that Barnes instilled in the team. A perfect example was at the end of the season when the Wildcats were on a seven-game losing streak, but were able to finish off the season 3-3.

On Feb. 17, 2017, the Wildcats broke a four-game losing streak to rival Arizona State as they beat the Sun Devils by a score of 62-58. It was also special because at the time, Barnes had never lost to Arizona State as a player or coach at the time.

Known as a stellar recruiter, Barnes brought in five recruits for the 2017 class, which was ranked 30th in the country. Those five include Kiana Barkhoff, Sam Fatkin, Marlee Kyles, Sam Thomas and Mallory Vaughn. Of those five signees, four of them were rated three stars by ESPN.com and Thomas was rated four stars. Four of the five signees were named Player of the Year in their respective states.

Prior to bringing on five 2017 signees, Barnes had to work quickly as she brought in guards Lucia Alonso and Bria Rice to the team in 2016. Alonso started 27 games at the point guard position and shot 43% from three, which is the second-highest single-season three-point percentage in school history.

Additionally to her success on the court and in recruiting in 2017, Barnes made it a point to get better in the classroom and in the community. The Wildcats had their best academic semester in a decade and also led the athletic department in community service hours.

Barnes joined the staff at Washington in 2011 and helped boost the Huskies profile in the Pac-12 and nationally, culminating in a trip to the Final Four this year. After three seasons on staff, Barnes was promoted to recruiting coordinator, where she handled all aspects of recruiting including budget, compliance and planning, in addition to her role in player development.

Prior to Barnes arrival for the 2011-12 season, Washington hadn't posted a 20-win season in six years. Since then, the Huskies have posted five straight, including a 26-win season this year.

While at Washington, Barnes coached Kelsey Plum, who was Washington's first ever WBCA All-American in the 2015-16 season. She led the conference and was fourth in the nation as she scored 25.9 points per game during the 2015-16 season and led the country in free throws made with 266. Plum became the fastest player in the Pac-12 and the seventh-fastest player in NCAA history to reach 2,000 points.

As a sophomore, she was named a Wooden Top-15 Nominee as she averaged 22.6 points per game and set a Washington school record as she scored 45 points on Nov. 14, 2015. Plum set the Washington single-season and Pac-12 record for points with 712 and was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

Barnes also coached Chantel Osahor, who became a star in the 2016 NCAA Tournament. As a junior, she started every game and averaged a double-double with 10.1 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. She broke the Washington single-season record with 417 boards in 2015-16. Osahor was named the NCAA Lexington Region MVP as she averaged 14.5 points and 15 rebounds per game. She dominated in the Regional Final as she scored 24 points and grabbed 18 boards.

A three-time all-conference selection and '98 graduate of Arizona, Barnes was voted USBWA first-team All-American and Pac-10 player of the year in 1997-98. Her 2,237 career points currently rank ninth on the Pac-12's all-time scoring list. Following her collegiate career, Barnes played professionally for 12 seasons in the WNBA and overseas. She won a WNBA Championship with the Seattle Storm in 2004, was named to the Storm's All-Decade Team, and also played for Cleveland, Minnesota and Sacramento. Her overseas career included stops in the Ukraine, Israel, Turkey, Russia and Italy.

In addition to her playing and coaching career, Barnes has been extremely active in the community through the Adia Barnes Foundation, which mentors under-served youth and conducts charitable events and community service projects such as school supply drives. Barnes spent 10 years as the Seattle Storm's TV analyst for NBA TV and FOX Sports Northwest and also spent time as the color commentator for Storm radio broadcasts.

A native of San Diego, Calif., Barnes is married to Salvo Coppa, who coached for 14 seasons, including 10 professionally in Italy and with three separate national teams. She is also the mother of one son, Matteo.
