OFF THE TOP

- The Wildcats head into Saturday following their 62-53 victory over the Oregon State Beavers on Thursday. UA overcame a slow offensive start, erasing a 12-2 deficit at the first media timeout, to turn in its best defensive performance of the season. Allonzo Trier led all scorers with 21 points for his eighth game of 20 or more points this season. The Cats' defensive effort allowed for a victory with 62 points on offense, which were the team's fewest points scored in a win since defeating Northwestern State 61-42 on Nov. 22, 2015.
- Arizona has won 79 of their last 81 games in McKale Center going back to the 2012-13 season. The Wildcats are 132-13 (.910) in Tucson under head coach Sean Miller with a mark of 65-9 (.878) in Pac-12 games. UA's two home losses since the start of 2013-14 season are the fewest in NCAA Division I in that span.
- Forward Deandre Ayton tallied 14 points and 10 rebounds in the win over OSU. It was his 12th double-double of the season (in 17 games), which tied the Arizona freshman double-double record held by Michael Wright (1998-99) and Al Fleming (1972-73).
- Arizona and Oregon will meet for the first time since the 2017 Pac-12 Tournament Championship when the Wildcats downed the Ducks 83-80. The win in Las Vegas snapped Arizona's three-game losing streak to Oregon. Allonzo Trier scored 23 points in the victory and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.
- The last time the two teams met in McKale Center, Oregon snapped Arizona's 49-game home court winning streak. The Wildcats' all-time home record against the Ducks stands at 29-8 (.784) going back to UA's entrance into the then Pac-10 Conference prior to the 1978-79 season.
- Rawle Alkins' return to the Wildcats has seen increased defensive play. Alkins had 33 steals in 37 games as a freshman, good for a 0.89 steals per game average. He has recorded at least one steal in all eight of his games this season and tallied 14 steals in those games for a 1.75 steals per game average.

MCKALE CENTER DOING WHAT IT ALWAYS DOES

With a conference-leading average home crowd of 14,410, Arizona and its beloved McKale Center have now led the Pac-12 in attendance for 33 consecutive seasons. UA's average home crowd was nearly 2,000 people larger than second place Utah a year ago. The 14,410 average for the 2016-17 season ranked 15th nationally and accounted for 98.4 percent capacity for the season.

TOUGH OUT

Not only does Arizona have a high winning percentage in its last five-plus seasons, but the Wildcats have been a tough out even in defeat. UA's last 30 losses, dating back to the 2012-13 season, have been by a total of 171 points for an average margin of defeat of 5.70 points. In those 30 defeats, 27 have been by single digits with 13 coming in one-possession games.

ONE OF THE WINNINGEST PROGRAMS OVER THE LAST FIVE YEARS

With the 2017-18 season officially hitting the 2018 calendar year, Arizona has solidified itself as one of the winningest programs in the nation in the past five seasons. Arizona, Villanova and Kentucky have jockeyed for the title of winningest program in the nation during this five-year span.

In Miller's eight seasons in Tucson, UA has averaged 27.5 wins per season. Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Wildcats have a 217-55 (.798) record, both the most wins and best winning percentage in the Pac-12 in that span.

COACHING CREDENTIALS

Head Coach Sean Miller has won three coach of the year awards as a part of the Pac-12 Conference while associate head coach Lorenzo Romar is also a three-time Pac-12 Coach of the Year. The Wildcat coaching staff's six Pac-12 Coach of the Year awards are more than the rest of the current Pac-12 coaches combined (four).

A LOT OF WINNING

Fourth-year seniors Parker Jackson-Cartwright and Dusan Ristic are playing in their final seasons in Tucson with impressive career marks and pathways to become two of the all-time winningest players in program history. Following the LBSU win, Jackson-Cartwright has played in 116 games through his first three-plus seasons, posting a record of **96-20 (.828)** in those appearances. Ristic has appeared in 123 games in his UA career with a mark of **101-22 (.821)**. The two seniors are on pace to climb up the all-time wins record at Arizona, which is currently held by Kaleb Tarczewski and Matt Muehlebach at 110 wins in a career.

BEST OF THE BEST UNDER 50

Arizona head coach Sean Miller is coaching in his ninth season at the helm of the program in Tucson and in his 14th year as a college head coach at the age of 49. His 353 career victories as a head coach makes him the second-winningest active coach in NCAA Division I under the age of 50.

THE SENIOR GRADUATION STREAK

Kadeem Allen, the lone senior on the 2016-17 roster, extended the program's impressive graduation streak. All 20 of the UA seniors who have completed their eligibility under Sean Miller has earned their college diploma. The impressive streak extends beyond Arizona for Sean Miller. Every one of the 37 college seniors that have played for Miller at Xavier or Arizona have fulfilled the requirements for their undergraduate degrees.

ANOTHER CHAPTER OF ARIZONA IN THE NBA DRAFT

The 2017 NBA Draft saw both Lauri Markkanen and Kadeem Allen hear their names called. Markkanen, the freshman forward, was selected with the seventh overall pick by the Minnesota Timberwolves before being traded to the Chicago Bulls. The Finland native became the fourth top ten NBA draft pick during the Sean Miller era (2009 to present). He also advanced another impressive NBA Draft stat. 12 of the last 15 former Wildcats selected in the first round have gone in the lottery. Kadeem Allen was the 53rd overall selection of the Boston Celtics. He, teamed with Markkanen, give the Arizona program a total of 71 NBA Draft picks.

1.25 BILLION AND COUNTING IN NBA CONTRACTS

Former Wildcats continue their storied NBA careers after eclipsing the \$1 billion mark in NBA contracts signed prior to the 2013-14 season. Sean Miller era Cats have now inked \$129 million in NBA contracts since his arrival in Tucson prior to the 2009-10 season. Arizona also boasts six former players who have each earned in excess of \$100 million in NBA deals, including Gilbert Arenas, Mike Bibby, Andre Iguodala, Richard Jefferson, Damon Stoudamire and Jason Terry. Arizona products have signed for over \$62 million in NBA contracts for the 2017-18 season alone.

ARIZONA: A FREQUENT HOME FOR MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

A pair of McDonald's All-Americans joined Arizona as part of the 2017 recruiting class. Deandre Ayton, an incoming freshman and top recruit nationally for the class, is joined by Duke transfer Chase Jeter. Jeter was a McDonald's All-American as part of the 2015 recruiting class. Ayton and Jeter give UA 24 McDonald's All-Americans in program history. After landing 15 All-Americans from 1984 to 2007, Arizona has inked nine since 2012.

This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach.

The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him seven for his career. Since 2008, Miller is one of five coaches nationally to lead a team to seven Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.


