

Arizona-Oregon State Notes

- The Wildcats were down 12-2 at the first media timeout before erasing the lead. It was the second time this season Arizona has erased a double-digit deficit. UA was down as many as 13 points before beating UNLV in overtime.
- Arizona's 62-53 win over the Beavers gave UA its 79th home win in its last 81 home games going back to the 2012-13 season.
- UA held Oregon State to 53 points, which were 22 fewer than their season average coming into the game.

On Deandre Ayton...

- Finished with 14 points and 10 rebounds, good for his 12th double-double of the season.
- His 12 double-doubles in the first 17 games of the season ties the UA freshman record for double-doubles in a season with Michael Wright (1998-99) and Al Fleming (1972-73).

On Allonzo Trier...

- Scored a game-high 21 points for his eighth game of 20 or more points this season.
- The junior tallied 15 of his 21 points in the second half. Thursday's second half marked the sixth game this season that Trier has scored 15 or more points in the second half, which includes a two second halves of 20 or more points.
- Missed on his fourth free throw attempt of the game, snapping a streak of 16 consecutive makes. In his last eight games (going back to the Alabama), Trier has made 45 of his last 50 free throw attempts (.900).

On Brandon Randolph...

- Had season/career highs in assists with four and steals with three. Going into the Oregon State game, Randolph had tallied a total of 14 assists and nine assists in his first 15 games of the season.
