#### FROM THE TIP

- Arizona is playing in their first postseason game since the 2011 WNIT and are hosting their first postseason game since the 2001 WNIT.
- The Wildcats are facing Idaho State for the second time this season. Arizona beat the Bengals in the season opener on Nov. 9 by a score of 71-46.
- Arizona is the only team representing the Pac-12 in the WNIT.
- The Wildcats, led by sophomore Adia Barnes, won the 1996 WNIT.
- Aari McDonald owns the Arizona single-season scoring record and is currently seventh on the Pac-12 single-season scoring list. She joins Kelsey Plum as the only two players in conference history to have 750 points and 130 assists in one season.
- Arizona has won 18 games for the first time since the 2010-11 season when the Cats won 21 games.
- Arizona had their highest margin of victory in a Pac-12 Tournament game over USC after winning

A Win for Arizona Would Mean...

- Would be the first postseason win since Mar. 20, 2005 at the NCAA Tournament.
Would be the first time Arizona has won a game in the WNIT since 2001.
Would be the first time Arizona has won 19 games since 2011.
Would be the second time Arizona has beaten Idaho State this season.

Aar it Out

Aari McDonald has been the catalyst for Arizona all season. Below is a list of accomplishments she has achieved this season.

- Owns the Arizona single-season scoring record (774).
Tied the Arizona single-game scoring record (39).
Fastest player in school history to 500 and 600 points and is the only with 700 points in a season.
Has scored over 1,000 career points.
Became the first Pac-12 player to score 30 points in three-straight games since the NCAA's all-time leading scorer Kelsey Plum had four-straight in Jan. 2017.
Only player in school history to have eight 30-points game.
Joins Kelsey Plum, as the only players in conference history to have 750 points and 130 assists in one season.
Has scored in double figures in every game this season.
Became the 12th player in Pac-12 history to score 700 points in a season.
Set the Arizona conference tournament record with 34 points against Oregon on Mar. 8.

The 600 Club

Aari McDonald became the 36th player in Pac-12 history to join the 600-point club as well as the 11th sophomore in Pac-12 history. The only other player in school history to score 600 points in one season was Adia Barnes. After scoring 26 points against Utah (2/15), she became the third-fastest Pac-12 player since 2000 to score 600 points. Only Kelsey Plum and Chiney Ogumike did it faster. For reference, Plum, who is the NCAA's all-time leading scorer, scored her 600th point in the 26th game of the season while it took McDonald 24 games.

The 700 Club

McDonald became the 12th player in Pac-12 history to score 700 points in one season. She is also the sixth sophomore in Pac-12 history to score 700. McDonald joins Kelsey Plum, Candice Wiggins and Sabrina Ionescu as the only players in Pac-12 history to score 700 points and have 120 assists in one season.

Another Invite?

McDonald is 26 points away from becoming the fourth player in conference history to score 800 points in one season. It has been done five times by Kelsey Plum, Chiney Ogumike and Nnemkadi Ogumike.

McDonald Garnering National Recognition

Earlier this season McDonald was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 list on Jan. 9 and became the first Wildcat since Shawn-tinice Polk (2003-04) to be named to the list. In mid-February, she was named to the Dawn Staley and Ann Meyers Drysdale Watch List.

A Premier Bucket Getter

No player in Arizona history has led the nation in scoring and only two Wildcats (Adia Barnes and Dee Dee Wheeler) have led the conference in scoring. In fact, only Barnes averaged at least 20 points per game in one season when she scored 21.8 per game during her senior season (1997-98). She has scored in double-figures in every game this season and is trying to become the first player since Dee-Dee Wheeler to hit double-figures in every game in one season.

**Three-Time Pac-12 Player of the Week**

Aari McDonald was named Pac-12 Player of the Week for the third time this season on Jan. 7 after averaging 33 points, eight rebounds and five steals per game against Colorado and Utah on the road. She won her second on Dec. 3 after averaging 26.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals in Arizona's two wins against Incarnate Word and San Diego State and won her first on Nov. 19 after averaging 32 points, 5.7 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 2.3 assists and 2.7 three-pointers per game on 56% shooting from the field over the three games.

**Reese's Buckets**

Cate Reese, who was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team, became the first Wildcat since Shawntinice Polk in 2002 to record a double-double in her collegiate debut and became the first freshman to score at least 20 in her first career game since Davellyn Whyte in 2008 after scoring 21 points in the opener against Idaho State. Reese averages 11.4 points and 6.9 rebounds per game, making her the leading rebounder and second-leading scorer among freshmen in the Pac-12. Reese made her presence felt in her first career Pac-12 Tournament game as she recorded her sixth double-double of the season with 19 points and 11 rebounds and followed that up with 12 points against Oregon.

**Reese's Boards**

Against Montana, Cate Reese became the 10th Wildcat to grab at least 18 rebounds in a game, was the first since lfy Ibekwe (Feb. 13, 2011) and is the first freshman to do so since Polk (Dec. 22, 2002). Reese, who had her first double-figure rebounding effort against a Pac-12 opponent against UCLA, averages 6.9 rebounds per game, the most among all freshmen in the Pac-12. Head

coach Adia Barnes' career-high in rebounds was 18 back on Jan. 7, 1995. Reese's 213 total rebounds are the fourth-most for a freshman in Arizona history.

**First Pac-12 Freshman of the Week**

Cate Reese was named Pac-12 Freshman of the week for the third time this season on Jan. 28 after averaging 15.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game on 54% shooting against the L.A. schools while recording her first-career Pac-12 double-double. Reese won her second on Jan. 21, averaging 17 points, five rebounds and two steals on 58% shooting against the Oregon schools, who were both ranked in the top 10 at the time. Reese became Arizona's first Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on Nov. 26 after her 19-point and 16-rebound performance against South Carolina State.

**I'll Have a Double-Double**

Reese has the second-most double-doubles among all freshmen in the Pac-12 with six. After scoring 14 points and grabbing 10 rebounds against UCLA in her first double-double against a Pac-12 opponent, Reese became the first freshman since lfy Ibekwe to have five double-doubles in one season. Additionally, the last player to have five or more double-doubles in a season was Davellyn Whyte in the 2012-13 season.

**Sam I Am**

Defensive versatility is the story of Sam Thomas, who is the only player in the Pac-12 to average at least 1.6 steals and 1.2 blocks per game. Throughout a game, you can find the sophomore guarding the opposing team's point guard or center. There have been eight games this season in which she has recorded at least three steals, including the game against South Carolina State in which she had five blocks and four steals. Of Arizona's 31 games, there have only been nine in which she has not recorded at least one steal. Not only is she an incredible defender, she is also Arizona's third-leading scorer at 9.5 points per game and averaged 10.2 in Pac-12 play, the second-most on the team. Thomas has made at least one three in each of her last 10 games as well as 11 of her last 12.

**Old Man Dominique**

Ask anyone to characterize redshirt junior Dominique McBryde's game and they will all say "old man game." McBryde, who transferred from Purdue after the 2016-17 season has been one of Arizona's most crucial players, especially on the defensive end, after sitting out the 2017-18 season. The junior had her best game of the season as she made a career-high four three-pointers to give her a season-high 20 points in 50 minutes of action, another career-high. McBryde was pivotal against Utah as she held Megan Huff to 1-13 shooting and scored nine points in the fourth quarter to close out the win. While at Purdue, McBryde was named honorable mention All-Big-Ten in 2017, averaging 6.7 points and 6.3 rebounds while making 25 starts.

### Buenos Dias, Lucia

Junior guard Lucia Alonso returns to the court for year three with a ton of experience, playing 1,088 minutes last season to go along with 887 minutes the year before. The only player in Arizona history that played more minutes in their first two years was Arizona Ring of Honor inductee Davellyn Whyte, who played 2,095 in her first two seasons. Known as a knockdown three-point shooter, Alonso has the highest career three-point percentage in school history at 40.8%. She has made at least three three-pointers in six games this season and became the 10th player in school history to make 100 three-pointers after knocking down four alone in the fourth quarter against Washington State on Feb. 9.

### Tee Tee is Back

At the beginning of the season, Tee Tee Starks had made the decision that this would be her final year playing college basketball. On senior day, she announced that she will be returning for her final year of eligibility and will be a fifth-year senior for the 2019-20 season. It's no secret that Starks causes absolute havoc on the defensive end, and the numbers show it. In the 15 games against Pac-12 teams she played at least 10 minutes in, opponents average 64.5 points per game while shooting 40% from the field. In the five Pac-12 games she has either missed or played fewer than 10 minutes due to injury, opponents are averaging 74 points per game and shoot 47% from the field. Starks has become one of Arizona's most trusted shooters as she shoots 47% from three. She has made one in six of her last seven games and knocked down four twice against California and USC in the Pac-12 Tournament, where she scored a career-high 14 points.

### It's Her Destiny

Destiny Graham is the lone four-year senior on the team who started her career at Arizona. Not only that, she is the only player on the roster who played for former head coach Niya Butts. She had her best game of the season against Stanford (2/22) as she scored a season-high 11 points with a career-high three three-pointers. It was the first time she made multiple three-pointers in one game. On Jan. 23, it was announced that Graham would be attending the So You Want to be a Coach program in Tampa Bay in April.

### Still Playing

For the first time since 2011, Arizona will play in the postseason after earning an 18-13 record. The Wildcats, who are the lone Pac-12 team in the WNIT, last played in the WNIT back in 2011 when they lost to Utah State in the First Round. In 1996, Adia Barnes and the Arizona Wildcats won the WNIT over Northwestern. Arizona also played in the 2001 edition, but lost at New Mexico in the Second Round.

### A Turnaround for the Ages

After winning just six games last season, the Wildcats have won 18 games this season, tying the record for the largest turnaround from year to year. Here is a look at the largest turnarounds from season to season in school history.

#### Lock it Up

The Arizona defense has been swarming this season allowing just 62.6 points per game, which is fourth in the Pac-12 and are allowing opponents to just 39% shooting, which is the third-best mark in the conference. Against South Carolina State, the Bulldogs shot just 19.6% from the field, which is 0.2% higher than the school record for lowest field goal percentage allowed in one game. So far, Arizona has forced the opponent to shoot below 35% nine times this year as opposed to last year when opponents shot under 35% four times all season. Arizona is averaging 8.2 steals per game on the season which is second the Pac-12.

#### Keeping them at Bay

Of Arizona's 31 games this season, the Wildcats have held their opponents under their scoring average 23 times. UCLA was held under their regular scoring average through four quarters, but the game went to triple overtime, allowing the Bruins to score 98.

#### The Key to Victory

Arizona has won the rebounding battle 13 times this season, and in each of those games, the Wildcats have come out victorious. In the 18 games that Arizona's opponent won the rebounding battle, the Wildcats are just 5-13.

#### Winning Big

All but four of Arizona's victories has come by at least 10 points this year and also have four wins of 30 or more. In every single one of Arizona's wins, they led by at least 10 points at one point in the game.

#### It's Been a While

- Aari McDonald broke Adia Barnes' 21-year single-season scoring record against Cal on Feb. 24. McDonald also broke the school record for points in a conference tournament game (34).

- Arizona has won 17 games and seven conference games for the first time since the 2010-11 season and have guaranteed an above .500 regular season record for the first time since that season.

- McDonald became the first player since Shawntinice Polk ('03-'04) to be named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List and became the first to be named to the Dawn Staley and Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List.

- McDonald joins Kelsey Plum, as the only players in conference history to have 750 points and 130 assists in one season.

- McDonald is the first in school history to score 30 points eight times in one season and was the first in school history to have three-straight 30-point games. She is also the first player since Adia Barnes ('98) to score 600 points in one season.

- McDonald is the first player in school history to score 600 points in the first 24 games of the season and is the first sophomore in the Pac-12 since the 1999-00 season to do so.

- The last time Arizona played in a triple overtime game was during the 2008-09 season and the last time there was a triple overtime game between two Pac-12 teams was back in the 2000-01 season.

- Arizona started the season 12-1 for the first time since the 1999-00 season.

- The Wildcats have beaten two ranked opponents (No. 17 ASU & No. 24 Cal) this season. The last time Arizona won two conference games, as well as back-to-back wins over ranked opponents, was during the 2002-03 season.

- Arizona won 11-straight games for the first time in school history from mid-November to early January.

#### Knocking Down the Trey

Arizona has had four games this season where they have made at least 10 three-pointers. Last year, Arizona made 10 or more three-pointers in just two of their 30 games. Aari McDonald (53), Sam Thomas (42), Lucia Alonso (34) and Tee Tee Starks (22) lead the way for Arizona. Against Washington State on Feb. 9, Arizona shot 60% (9-15) from three, which is the best three-point percentage the Wildcats have shot in a game since Nov. 18, 2015.

#### Taking Care of the Ball

Turnovers were an issue in the first two games of the season as the Wildcats averaged 20.5 turnovers. Coach Adia Barnes made a point to her team to take care of the ball and since then, the Wildcats average under 14 turnovers per game in the last 29 games, including just four against Oregon State both times they played them, which tied the record set last year at Oregon State and six against California which is tied for the second-fewest in school history. The Wildcats have the third-best turnover margin in the Pac-12 with a margin of +2.7 as they force the third-most turnovers per game in the Pac-12 (15.9).

#### A Big Win vs. the Rival

It's no secret that Dec. 30th's game against No. 17 Arizona State was a huge win for the program. It broke a four-game losing streak against the Sun Devils and it was the first time in two seasons the Wildcats beat a ranked team. It was the fewest points ASU had scored against Arizona since the 1975-76 season as UA held the Devils to 23% shooting from the field and 17% from downtown.

#### Cats Dominate the Bank of Hawaii Classic

Arizona took the long flight to Honolulu for the Bank of Hawaii Classic on Nov. 16 and 18 against Seattle U and Portland, and came home with two convincing wins. In the two games, Arizona won by a combined 52 points and shot a combined 51.2% from the field while averaging 88 points per game. Aari McDonald and Cate Reese were named to the Bank of Hawaii Classic All-Tournament Team, with McDonald being named the MVP.

#### An Exceptional Trio of Transfers

It had been over a year since either Dominique McBryde, Aari McDonald or Tee Tee Starks played in a game after transferring from their respective schools, but now they are eligible to play and are ready to make an immediate impact. Before they came to Arizona, the trio played in a combined 135 games, made 66 starts, scored 868 points and played in seven NCAA Tournament games.

#### An Additional Hurdle for Reese

Freshman Cate Reese is getting a ton of attention for being Arizona's first McDonald's All-American in school history. But her journey to becoming a McDonald's All-American and a Naismith Trophy honorable mention All-American hasn't been the easiest of tasks as she was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes, the same disease that her sister Ali has dealt with, on April 4, 2016.

### No Longer a Walk-On

After two years of trying out to make the team, Lindsey Malecha finally earned a walk-on spot on the team before the 2017-18 season and found herself on the court a decent amount last season. She scored a total of 31 points in 118 minutes and played in 23 of Arizona's 30 games. On July 20, 2018, Malecha was awarded a scholarship and the video of Adia Barnes presenting her with the scholarship went viral. Barnes consistently sings the praises for Malecha's perennial hard work and good leadership. Not only does she work her tail off on the court, she is also a 4.0 Pre-Med student studying Biology with the goal of becoming a surgeon one day.

### Ibekwe Enters the Arizona Ring of Honor

Ify Ibekwe will go down as one of the best players in school history, and on Friday, November 23rd, she was forever enshrined in McKale Center as her name was hung from a banner in the Arizona Ring of Honor during the game against South Carolina State. She finds her name next to the likes of Davellyn Whyte, Dee Dee Wheeler, Shawntinice Polk and current head basketball coach Adia Barnes. After four seasons in Tucson, Ibekwe is now the all-time leader in rebounds (1,194) and double-doubles (55), and is also second in blocks (166), fourth in points (1,653 points) and fifth in steals (228). She has three of the top five rebounding totals in a single season, including the top spot, and has the second and third spot in double-doubles. She left as a two-time All-American, a three-time All-Pac-10 honoree, a Pac-10 All-Freshman honoree and was the 2011 Pac-10 Defensive Player of the Year.

### Arizona Signs Four in Class of 2019

Head women's basketball coach Adia Barnes and her coaching staff signed four future Wildcats on National Signing Day on Wednesday. Birna Benonysdottir, Sewal Gul, Tara Manumaleuga and Mara Mote will be the four making their way from overseas to the Old Pueblo.

### Birna Benonysdottir

Benonysdottir, a native of Keflavik, Iceland, averaged 17 points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and one block for the U18 Iceland Team in the 2017 European Championships. She also competed on the U16 Iceland Team at the 2016 European Championships and averaged 18 points and seven rebounds. Last year while playing for Keflavik, a club in Iceland, she averaged nine points and four rebounds last year for Keflavik.

### Sewal Gul

Gul, a native of Istanbul, Turkey, currently plays for Ferenhbace, one of the best clubs in all of Europe along with Kelsey Plum, the NCAA record holder for career points scored. She has some international experience as well for the Turkish National Team. She averaged 11 points and nine rebounds for the U18 team at the 2018 European Championships and played on the U16 team in the 2015 European Championships.

### Tara Manumaleuga

Manumaleuga, a native of Sydney, Australia and the cousin of former Arizona tight end Brandon Manumaleuga, graduated high school in November and arrived on campus in January. She is now eligible to play, but intends to use the rest of the season as a redshirt year in preparation for the 2019-20 season. She was a bronze medalist at the 2017 U17 Australian High School Championships and was a silver medalist at the Championship Basketball School of Queensland QLD State Schools at Hillcrest Christian College. She played for QLD South in both the U16 and U17 Australian Junior Basketball Championships and competed for the New Zealand U17 Team at the 2018 FIBA World Cup where she averaged 12 points per game, leading New Zealand to an 11th-place finish. Manumaleuga has been competing internationally since she was 12 years old.

### Mara Mote

The fourth and final signee comes from Cesis, Latvia. Mote, who has been a member of the Junior Latvian National Team played in the 2016 U16 European Championships and averaged 12 points per game and also played in the 2017 U19 FIBA World Cup where she scored nine points per game. She was the MVP of the most recent Baltic Cup and currently plays for TTT Riga in Latvia.

## Adia BARNES

### HEAD COACH

THIRD YEAR | ARIZONA, '98

**Adia Barnes** was introduced as Arizona's head women's basketball coach on April 4, 2016. The leading scorer in Arizona women's basketball history and a WNBA Champion, Barnes came to Tucson after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Washington for five seasons.

In her second year as head coach, Barnes signed the highest ranked recruiting class in Arizona history as ProspectsNation.com ranked the class at the fifth-best in the country. The class of 2018 was highlighted by five-star prospect Cate Reese, who became Arizona's first McDonald's All-American in program history. Reese was also named an honorable mention All-American by the Naismith Trophy.

Barnes and co. brought in four other signees, who include Bryce Nixon, Semaj Smith, Shalyse Smith and Valeria Trucco. Semaj Smith and Trucco were also rated as five-star post players, Shalyse Smith was rated as a four-star forward and Nixon was rated as a three-star guard. Barnes and the rest of the coaching staff secured National Letters of Intent from prospects in Arizona, California, Italy, Texas and Washington.

Under her guidance, Sam Thomas was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team and JaLea Bennett was named honorable mention All-Pac-12. Thomas finished the season with the fourth-most rebounds for a freshman in Arizona history (209) and scored the 10th-most points for a freshman (306) while leading all freshmen in the Pac-12 in rebounding, steals, blocks and minutes. Additionally, all three returners from the 2016-17 season (Bennett, Lucia Alonso and Destiny Graham) all set career-highs in points and rebounds.

Barnes led the Wildcats to a 14-16 record in her first year at the helm with a 5-13 Pac-12 record. 14 wins is the most since the 2011-12 season and five conference wins is the most in the Pac-12 era for the Wildcats.

Under her direction, five Wildcats averaged their career-high in scoring, including LaBrittney Jones, who was named All-Pac-12 by averaging 15.6 points, 6.8 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game. Jones is the first Wildcat to be named to the All-Pac-12 team since Davellyn Whyte made the 2013 team.

Throughout the season, the Wildcats showed that they never gave up, which is a trait that Barnes instilled in the team. A perfect example was at the end of the season when the Wildcats were on a seven-game losing streak, but were able to finish off the season 3-3.

On Feb. 17, 2017, the Wildcats broke a four-game losing streak to rival Arizona State as they beat the Sun Devils by a score of 62-58. It was also special because at the time, Barnes had never lost to Arizona State as a player or coach at the time.

Known as a stellar recruiter, Barnes brought in five recruits for the 2017 class, which was ranked 30th in the country. Those five include Kiana Barkhoff, Sam Fatkin, Marlee Kyles, Sam Thomas and Mallory Vaughn. Of those five signees, four of them were rated three stars by ESPN.com and Thomas was rated four stars. Four of the five signees were named Player of the Year in their respective states.

Prior to bringing on five 2017 signees, Barnes had to work quickly as she brought in guards Lucia Alonso and Bria Rice to the team in 2016. Alonso started 27 games at the point guard position and shot 43% from three, which is the second-highest single-season three-point percentage in school history.

Additionally to her success on the court and in recruiting in 2017, Barnes made it a point to get better in the classroom and in the community. The Wildcats had their best academic semester in a decade and also led the athletic department in community service hours.

Barnes joined the staff at Washington in 2011 and helped boost the Huskies profile in the Pac-12 and nationally, culminating in a trip to the Final Four this year. After three seasons on staff, Barnes was promoted to recruiting coordinator, where she handled all aspects of recruiting including budget, compliance and planning, in addition to her role in player development.

Prior to Barnes arrival for the 2011-12 season, Washington hadn't posted a 20-win season in six years. Since then, the Huskies have posted five straight, including a 26-win season this year.

While at Washington, Barnes coached Kelsey Plum, who was Washington's first ever WBCA All-American in the 2015-16 season. She led the conference and was fourth in the nation as she scored 25.9 points per game during the 2015-16 season and led the country in free throws made with 266. Plum became the fastest player in the Pac-12 and the seventh-fastest player in NCAA history to reach 2,000 points. As a sophomore, she was named a Wooden Top-15 Nominee as she averaged 22.6 points per game and set a Washington school record as she scored 45 points on Nov. 14, 2015. Plum set the Washington single-season and Pac-12 record for points with 712 and was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

Barnes also coached Chantel Osahor, who became a star in the 2016 NCAA Tournament. As a junior, she started every game and averaged a double-double with 10.1 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. She broke the Washington single-season record with 417 boards in 2015-16. Osahor was named the NCAA Lexington Region MVP as she averaged 14.5 points and 15 rebounds per game. She dominated in the Regional Final as she scored 24 points and grabbed 18 boards.

A three-time all-conference selection and '98 graduate of Arizona, Barnes was voted USBWA first-team All-American and Pac-10 player of the year in 1997-98. Her 2,237 career points currently rank ninth on the Pac-12's all-time scoring list. Following her collegiate career, Barnes played professionally for 12 seasons in the WNBA and overseas. She won a WNBA Championship with the Seattle Storm in 2004, was named to the Storm's All-Decade Team, and also played for Cleveland, Minnesota and Sacramento. Her overseas career included stops in the Ukraine, Israel, Turkey, Russia and Italy.

In addition to her playing and coaching career, Barnes has been extremely active in the community through the Adia Barnes Foundation, which mentors underserved youth and conducts charitable events and community service projects such as school supply drives. Barnes spent 10 years as the Seattle Storm's TV analyst for NBA TV and FOX Sports Northwest and also spent time as the color commentator for Storm radio broadcasts.

A native of San Diego, Calif., Barnes is married to Salvo Coppa, who coached for 14 seasons, including 10 professionally in Italy and with three separate national teams. She is also the mother of one son, Matteo.


