OFF THE TOP

- Arizona is 102-9 (.919) in the last 111 games they have played in the McKale Center. Arizona is also 62-2 in its last 64 non-conference home games.
- According to the NCAA's NET tool, Arizona's strength of schedule is 10th and non-conference SOS is 21th.
- The Wildcats are looking to end a two-game losing streak after dropping games at Oregon and Oregon State last week. Utah has also lost its last two games, dropping contests to Oregon and Colorado.
- Arizona's 48.3 FG% is 16th-best in the country while holding opponents to just 38.1 percent this season, the 25th-best in the country and second in the Pac-12.
- UA is scoring 81.3 points per game this season, the 14th-most in the country this season and tops in the Pac-12. The Wildcats are also outscoring teams by an average of 15.6 points per game, the 9th-best margin in the country.
- The Wildcats average 16.6 assists per game rank 17th nationally and the 1.41-to-1 assist/turnover ratio is 12th in the country. Those marks are also tops in the Pac-12.
- A two-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week, **Zeke Nnaji** is shooting 66.2 percent from the floor this year (7th nationally). He enters tonight's game having posted a double-double in four of his last five games and has six for the season. In the last five games, he is averaging 17.8 points, 12.4 rebounds (4 off. reb/gm) while shooting 58.5 percent from the floor.
- Freshman **Nico Mannion** is second in the Pac-12 and 20th nationally with 100 assists this season. His 6.3 assists per game average ranks 18th in the country and he is the only freshman in the country with three games of 10+ assists this season. He is just the eighth UA freshman to ever register 100 assists in a season and the first since Jerryd Bbayless (2008). The UA freshman single-season assist record is 197 assists (Russell Brown, 1978).
- Freshman **Josh Green** is averaging 13.2 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists over the last five games. He leads the team with 26 steals and has eight games with 2+ steals this season. He ranks T8th in the Pac-12 in steals/game (1.6). He is on pace to finish in the top 10 in steals among all UA freshmen.
- Over the first 16 games, Arizona has scored 578 (36.1/game) points in the paint and has 294 (18.3/game) fast break points.

The 25 assists against Omaha marked the fifth game of the 2019-20 season with at least 20 assists for the Wildcats. The last season UA had five or more games with 20+ assists was 2007-08 (8 games).

Arizona has forced opponents into 239 turnovers this season, the most ever by a Sean Miller coached team through the first 16 games of a season.

The 11 assists for Mannion against Pepperdine were the most by a UA player since Parker Jackson-Cartwright had 11 on Nov. 21, 2016. It's the fifth-most by an Arizona freshman and the last freshman to have 11 or more assists was Mustafa Shakur in 2004. Mannion also had 11 assists against Omaha, joining Mike Bibby and Russell Brown as the only Arizona freshmen to have two or more games of 11+ assists.

Nico Mannion (16p, 11a) and **Zeke Nnaji** (16p, 11r) both registered double-doubles against Pepperdine, the first time a pair of UA teammates posted double-doubles in the same game since Feb. 15, 2018 (Ayton & Ristic).

Memphis and Arizona are the only two schools in the country to have freshmen as their top three leading scorers for the season.

Zeke Nnaji leads the Wildcats in fouls drawn (72), with Josh Green (57) and Chase Jeter (53) close behind.

Nnaji scored 20 points in the season opener against NAU, the most by a freshman in his debut under head coach Sean Miller at Arizona and the most by any UA freshman since Hassan Adams (22 points) in 2002.

The starting lineup for Arizona in the season opener against NAU featured three freshmen - Mannion, Green and Nnaji. It's the first time in program history that the first game of the season saw three freshmen in the starting lineup.

As a team, Arizona committed just seven turnovers in the game against NAU, the fewest in a season opener since committing just five vs. NAU in 2007. The Wildcats committed just six turnovers vs. No. 6 Gonzaga on Dec. 14, the fewest in a game since Nov. 29, 2018 vs. Georgia Southern (6). It was the fewest committed by an Arizona team against a Top 25 opponent since having just six against No. 7 Stanford on Feb. 16, 2008.

The 15 steals against Long Beach State were the most by Arizona since having 15 vs. Gonzaga in the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Since the year 2000, Arizona is 16-2 against Utah but the Utes won the most recent meeting between the two teams in Salt Lake City last year, 83-76

NOTING NNAJI

Freshman Zeke Nnaji ranks SEVENTH in the country in field goal percentage (66.2) and is a two-time Pac-12 Freshman of the Week honoree. He has scored in double figures in all but two games and is sixth in the Pac-12 in rebounding (8.5) while also joining a group of seven players in the country to have five games of 11+ rebounds this season. He is also connecting at a 79.8 percent clip from the free throw line this season. The Minneapolis native has six double-doubles on the year, most recently an 11-point, 14-rebound effort at Oregon. He followed that up with 21 points and nine rebounds at Oregon State. Against No. 6 Gonzaga, Nnaji tallied 16 points and 17 rebounds and then added 24 points and 11 rebounds against St. John's to close out conference play. In Pac-12 play, his numbers have stayed remarkably consistent, posting 16.3 points and 11.3 rebounds per contest while continuing to shoot a high percentage (54.5) from the floor. His talent also extends off the court, as he is a classically trained pianist and played the "Star Spangled Banner" prior to the team's Red-Blue Game on Sept. 27.

MANNION THE POINT GUARD

Highly touted point guard Nico Mannion, who was born in Italy and holds dual citizenship in Italy and the United States, has made an impact from the start with the Wildcats. He was named to multiple preseason award watch lists (Wooden, Naismith), earned First Team Preseason All-Pac-12 accolades and was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on Dec. 2. He has handed out 100 assists through the first 16 games of the season, a total which ranks eighth all-time among Arizona freshmen. He has made at least one 3-point field goal in all but one game this season and has an active streak of 20 consecutive made free throws. He posted his first collegiate double-double with 16 points, 11 assists against Pepperdine at the Wooden Legacy, while also driving the length of the court to hit the game-winning driving layup with less than three seconds left. The next night against Penn, he went off for 24 points on 11-of-14 shooting, while also adding four assists (zero turnovers) and two steals on his way to being named to the Wooden Legacy All-Tournament team. He recorded his fourth 20-point game of the season at Oregon and then posted nine points and nine assists at Oregon State.

GOING GREEN

Freshman Josh Green, who grew up in Sydney, Australia and moved to the United States for high school, has shown the ability to get it done at both ends of the court. He leads the team in steals (26), has four games with at least three steals and has at least one steal in every game but one. He is averaging 5.1 rebounds in addition to 13.0 points per game. He has also connected on four 3-point field goals in a game twice this season (Illinois, Pepperdine). In Pac-12 play, he is shooting 50.0 percent while averaging 12.7 points and 5.0 rebounds. Prior to the start of the season, he was named Second Team Preseason All-Pac-12 and is also on the watch list for the Julius Erving Award (Top SF). He has scored in double figures in each of the last four games while also averaging six rebounds.

NOT CHASING ANYONE

Chase Jeter arrived at Arizona prior to the 2017-18 season after transferring from Duke, but had to sit out the season per NCAA rules. In his first season on the court as a Wildcat, Jeter was a presence in the paint and a threat down low. Jeter averaged 10.9 points per game and 6.6 rebounds a contest with five double-doubles. Jeter shot .574 from the floor, having connected on 128 of 223 shot attempts. He scored in double figures in 19 of the 30 games he played. This season, he is second on the team lead in rebounding (5.3) and has six games scoring in double figures to his credit, three of which came at the Wooden Legacy to propel him onto the All-Tournament team after posting averages of 15.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and shooting 76.9 percent from the floor (20-26). He is on the preseason watch list for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award, given to the top center in the country.

JEMARL GETS TO BALL

Redshirt sophomore guard **Jemarl Baker Jr.** (pronounced "Jamal") has 39 assists to just 10 turnovers this season while also shooting 43.1 percent from the 3-point line (22-of-51). He received a waiver from the NCAA and is eligible to play immediately for the Wildcats after transferring to Tucson from the University of Kentucky. He spent two years at UK, redshirting during the 2017-18 season and then playing 28 games as a redshirt freshman in 2018-19. He will have three years of eligibility with the Wildcats. In his first official game at Arizona, he set a then-career highs with nine points and three steals off the bench. In the game against New Mexico State, he set a new career-high with 16 points - including 4-of-6 from long distance - in just 16 minutes of game action. On Sunday, he broke out of a bit of a shooting slump, going 3-of-4 at Oregon State on his way to 10 points.

GETTINGS BUCKETS

Grad transfer Stone Gettings, who joined the Wildcats after spending three years at Cornell, scored five points and added five boards against Arizona State, his first game back after missing five games with a concussion/facial fracture. He got his Arizona career off to a rousing start by scoring 13 points off the bench against Northern Arizona. He was 3-of-4 from the 3-point line and added three rebounds while accumulating a +17 plus-minus in just 18 minutes of action. At Oregon, he played a season-high 22 minutes, including the final minutes of regulation and overtime. He now has 941 points in his career between Cornell and Arizona.

SMITH STARTING STRONG

The pride of Mobile, Alabama, redshirt junior Dylan Smith earned his first career "Gold Jersey" just prior to the start of the regular season for his play in practice and games and making winning plays. He has been in the starting lineup every game this season. He reached double figures in the scoring column in all three games at the Wooden Legacy, tallying 16 points vs. Pepperdine and then chipping in 10 points against Penn. He capped off the weekend with 20 points against Wake Forest, his best scoring output as a Wildcat, as he was named to the Wooden Legacy All-Tournament Team. Against Omaha, he went 4-of-6 from the 3-point line on his way to 14 points and four rebounds. It marked his third game this season with four 3-pointers made. He has scored in double figures in eight games and seven of the last 10 while also connecting from the 3-point line at a 41.9 percent clip, which would easily be the best single-season percentage of his career.

NO HAZZARD WITH MAX

Max Hazzard came to Arizona after an outstanding career at UC Irvine, where he led the Anteaters to the NCAA Tournament and a first round win. He was the MVP of Big West Tournament and finished his UCI career with 170 made 3-point field goals, connecting a 36.6 percent clip. In his first game with the Wildcats, he was just 1-of-5 from long range but he contributed five assists and just one turnover. He went 2-of-3 from long distance in game two vs. Illinois and finished with 10 points. Known for his shooting, he has 21 assists and just 10 turnovers through 16 games, highlighted by a season-high four assists vs. LBSU. Also against LBSU, he connected on four triples in six attempts for 14 points. After going through a shooting slump, he went 3-of-4 from behind the arc against Gonzaga. His triple with less than two minutes to go against St. John's game the Wildcats a one-point lead. He is closing in on 1,000 career points, sitting at 992 entering today's game.

ILEE PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF

Arizona saw a rise in production from junior forward Ira Lee in Pac-12 play over his first two seasons in Tucson. Lee averaged 7.8 points per game, 4.4 rebounds a contest and had 17 blocks in the 18 Pac-12 games as a sophomore. The 6-foot-7-inch power forward was 57-of-91 from the floor. For the 2018-19 season, Lee had 126 rebounds while he compiled just 62 as a freshman. He began his junior season with a flurry, dropping 10 points and corralling 14 rebounds in the exhibition win over Chico State. He is averaging 12 minutes per game off the bench and chipping in 3.3 points, 4.0 rebounds and shooting 53.8 percent from the field. He had a season-high 12 points and six rebounds against Omaha.

LOKO FOR KOLOKO

When Stone Gettings missed five games due to injury in December, freshman Christian Koloko was looked upon to help fill the void. The Cameroon native acquitted himself nicely in his time on the court, averaging seven minutes of action over the five games and scoring 1.8 points, grabbing 2.2 rebounds and blocking a total of four shots and impacting countless others around the rim. He best performance came against Omaha when he scored five points, grabbed 10 rebounds (4 offensive) and was 3-of-4 at the free throw line. Most recently, he scored eight points and grabbed six rebounds in 11 minutes against Arizona State and added two points and four rebounds in 10 minutes against Oregon. His 10 blocked shots are tied for second on the team, and he's only played 91 minutes.

ADDING AKINJO

Over the holiday break, the Wildcats added to their roster when James Akinjo decided to transfer to Tucson from Georgetown. Originally from Oakland, California, Akinjo was the 2019 BIG EAST Freshman of the Year after averaging 13.4 points, 5.2 assists and shooting 39.1 percent from the 3-point line. He played in 7 games for the Hoyas in 2019-20 before entering the transfer portal. He is not eligible to play for the Wildcats during the 2019-20 season.

ROSTER MAKEUP

Grad transfers **Stone Gettings** (Cornell) and **Max Hazzard** (UC Irvine) are eligible to play right away along with redshirt sophomore **Jemarl Baker Jr.** (Kentucky), who received a waiver from the NCAA on Oct. 31 and is eligible to play immediately. The fourth transfer is **Jordan Brown** (Nevada), who will sit out the 2019-20 season and have three years of eligibility remaining starting with the 2020-21 season.

The Wildcats return just one of their top five scorers from the 2018-19 season, with redshirt senior **Chase Jeter** anchoring the middle after averaging 10.9 points last season. Sophomore **Brandon Williams** was second on the team in scoring a season ago (11.4 ppg) but will miss the entire 2019-20 season after undergoing offseason knee surgery.

Miller and the Wildcats signed the No. 6 recruiting class in the country in 2019, highlighted by McDonald's All-Americans **Nico Mannion** and **Josh Green**. Other members of the 4-person class include **Zeke Nnaji**, a Top 50 recruit nationally, and **Christian Koloko**, a three-star recruit from Sierra Canyon High School. All four won a state or national title during the senior seasons.

HEAD COACH » 11TH SEASON (PITTSBURGH '92)

MILLER AMONG ELITE FEW WITH NO LOSING SEASONS AS A HEAD COACH

In 15 seasons as a Division I head coach, Sean Miller has yet to suffer through a losing season, making him one of just seven current Division I head coaches with at least 10 years of experience who can make that claim. He is the only Pac-12 head coach on the list.

A HISTORY OF GOLD MEDALS WITH TEAM USA AS A PLAYER AND A COACH

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach. The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

CLOSING IN ON 400 CAREER WINS

As he enters his 11th season at Arizona, and his 16th season overall as a collegiate head coach, Sean Miller is closing in on 400 career victories. His overall record of 395-139 has him on pace to join some of the elite head coaches in NCAA history to reach 400 wins in the fewest number of games.

WINNING PEDIGREE

In his 15 seasons as a head coach, Sean Miller has led his team to the NCAA postseason 11 times. In those trips to March Madness, Miller's teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 on seven occasions and four Elite Eights. Arizona is averaging 26.4 wins per seasons under Miller's guidance, best in program history for a coach with at least four years at the school. The Wildcats have reached the 20-win mark in eight of Miller's 10 seasons at the helm, including four 30-win campaigns. The Arizona Basketball program has recorded 30 or more wins in seven different seasons with four of those coming with Miller at the helm. Overall, Miller has been a part of 17 NCAA Tournament teams as a player, assistant coach and head coach.

LEADER OF THE PAC

Arizona head coach Sean Miller is entering his 11th season leading the Wildcats in 2019-20. He has accumulated eight conference titles - five regular season and three tournament - and a Pac-12 winning percentage that ranks third in conference history behind only John Wooden and Lute Olson. His eight titles are more than all other active Pac-12 men's basketball coaches combined.


