NOTABLES

- The 2022-23 season is the 118th season of Arizona basketball and the program has an all-time record of 1,887-970 (.660), and ranks 11th in NCAA history in wins. The .660 winning percentage ranks eighth in NCAA history.
- With the win over Utah Tech on Thursday, Arizona improved to 3-0 to start the season for the 13th consecutive season.
- Arizona is 3-0 all-time against Cincinnati, including a 71-64 victory in Honolulu on Dec. 27, 1975 as part of the Rainbow Classic. Complete series history on page 7 of these notes.
- Arizona's **22-game home court winning streak** is tied for the third-longest active streak in the nation, trailing Gonzaga's 68 straight and Texas Tech's 24 in a row.
- In the season opener against Nicholls, Arizona shot a **school-record** 71.7% (35-53) from the floor, surpassing the previous mark of 71.4% set in 1984. Arizona leads the nation in field goal percentage (63.2%).
- Through the first 40 games of Tommy Lloyd's head coaching career, Arizona has shot 50% or better from the floor 25 times.
- After leading the country in assists in 2021-22 and setting a new UA single-season record, the Wildcats got off to a great start in the opener by registering 30 assists. Arizona **leads the country** in assists per game so far this season (26.3).
- In the win over Utah Tech, Arizona set a new program record for most free throws made without a miss in a game, going 22 of 22.
- Through the first 3 games of the season, Arizona has scored 316 points - the most ever by an Arizona team to start a season.
- Second-year head coach **Tommy Lloyd** was named 2022 National Coach of the Year by the USBWA, NABC and Associated Press, becoming the first Arizona coach to receive those honors. He was the **ninth first-time head coach in NCAA history** to win 30 games in year one. The **33 wins** were tied for third-most in program history and one shy of tying Bill Guthridge (UNC) for the most by a first-time head coach in NCAA history.
- Junior forward **Azuolas Tubelis** is on the Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award Preseason Watch Lists along with the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year watch list. He became the first Arizona player since Ivan Radenovic on March 3, 2007 to post at least 23 points, 7 rebounds and 6 assists in a game when he did it against Nicholls. Needs 124 points to join the 1,000 point club at Arizona. Tubelis is the only player in the country averaging 20.0 ppg and shooting 78% from the floor.
- Junior point guard **Kerr Kriisa** added his name to the record books with his second career triple-double (14p/11r/12a) vs. Southern. It was the 11th triple-double in Arizona history and he's the third Wildcat with multiple triple-doubles, joining Andre Iguodala (3) and Loren Woods (2). He was named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Preseason watch list and was a preseason second team all Pac-12 honoree. He set a career-high with 24 points (6-7 3FG) vs. Utah Tech.

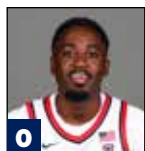

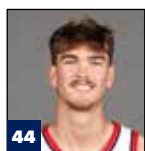

- Junior wing **Pelle Larsson** has been remarkably consistent through the first three games, scoring 16, 17 and 14 while shooting 60% from the floor. He's also averaging 4.0 assists and 5.7 rebounds. Larsson was the Pac-12's Sixth Man of the Year in 2021-22, playing 20 minutes off the bench and averaging 7.2 points, 3.4 rebounds and shooting 36% from the 3-point line. He was named to the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Preseason watch list and second team preseason all Pac-12.
- Redshirt junior center **Oumar Ballo** is a member of the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Preseason watch list and earned honorable mention preseason all Pac-12 accolades from the media. He went 8 of 11 from the free throw line on his way to 18 points, 9 rebounds, four assists (career high) and two steals against Nicholls. The native of Mali registered his third career double-double with 16 points, 11 rebounds (career high). Shooting 72.7% from the floor and ranks in the top 20 in FTA.
- Graduate transfer **Cedric Henderson Jr.** made his third straight start to begin the season and posted 20 points against Utah Tech. It's his 15th career 20-point game. He has scored 1,224 career points.
- Graduate Transfer **Courtney Ramey** was is eligible to play vs. Cincinnati and Coach Lloyd has indicated that he will likely start. He averaged 10.0 points per game in four years at Texas and earn third team All-Big 12 honors.
- Freshman guard **Kylan Boswell** made his Arizona debut at the age of 17 after reclassifying and graduating high school a year early. He finished eight points and five assists in 23 minutes off the bench in the opener and added five more assists against Southern. Boswell does not turn 18 until April 2023.
- After playing 103 minutes over 23 games as a freshman, **Adama Bal** has layed 58 minutes over the first three games as a sophomore. He's averaging 8.7 points and shooting 44.4% from the 3-point line.

LLOYD SUPERLATIVES

The last time a first-time head coach like Tommy Lloyd won Pac-12 coach of the year was Tony Bennett at WSU in 2007. It's the fifth time overall it's happened in the Pac-12.

Lloyd set a new Pac-12 record for conference wins and overall wins in his first season in the conference.

Tommy Lloyd is the only first-year Pac-12 head coach to ever start 15-1 or better through his first 16 games in the conference.

Lloyd joined Bill Guthridge (UNC in 1998) and Bill Hodges (Indiana State in 1979) as the only head coaches to earn a No. 1 seed in their first season as head coach.

RECORD SETTING GPA

In the Fall 2021 semester, the men's basketball team posted a team GPA of 3.04, which was the best team GPA for a semester in the history of the

program. 11 players had a 3.0 or better, including 4 with a 4.0. Then in the Spring 2022 semester they topped that, earning a 3.10 team GPA. This accomplishment is even more remarkable considering the long tournament runs at the Pac-12 Tournament and NCAA Tournament.

DOMINATING WITHOUT THE SHOTS?

In 2021-22, Arizona took a total of 2,269 shots for the season while their opponents took exactly 2,400. According to the Twitter account (@Hoop_Power), the Wildcats' 33 wins last year were the most by a team while taking less shot attempts than their opponents since Gonzaga in 2019.

BOSWELL RECLASSIFIES

Freshman guard Kylan Boswell announced over the summer that he would graduate high school a year early and enroll at the University of Arizona for the 2022-23 season. Boswell also had surgery on his right foot over the summer and returned to practice in late October.

NBA RUNS IN THE FAMILY

Cedric Henderson Jr. is the son of NBA veteran Cedric Henderson, who played in the NBA for five seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (1997-01) and Golden State Warriors (2001-02). The elder Henderson appeared in 260 NBA games and averaged 7.3 ppg.

NATIONAL TEAM PRIDE

Kerr Kriisa (Estonia) and Pelle Larsson (Sweden) both spent time over the summer playing for their senior national teams. Both played in FIBA World Cup qualifiers while Kriisa also played in Eurobasket.

ARIZONA SIGNS TOP 50 RECRUIT

Head coach Tommy Lloyd announced that KJ Lewis has signed his national letter of intent and will join the Wildcats for the 2023-24 season. The 6-4, 195 guard currently plays at Duncanville High School near Dallas, but spent part of his high school career at Chapin High School in El Paso. Lewis grew up in Tucson and attended elementary school in nearby Vail, Ariz. through fifth grade. As a junior at Chapin, he averaged 20.4 points, 5.2 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.5 steals per game and was a finalist for Mr. Texas Basketball Player of the Year.

"From the first moments when we got involved with him, I was really impressed. Not only is he a really talented player that has really trended up the last six months, he's an amazing person. Incredibly high character. I'm not big on comparisons, but I think a reasonable comparison is Marcus Smart. He's a great two-way player that really, really impacts the game at both ends." - Tommy Lloyd on KJ Lewis

Tommy Lloyd was named head coach at the University of Arizona on April 14, 2021 after serving as an assistant coach at Gonzaga the previous 22 seasons, where he developed 19 All-Americans and 15 conference players of the year and contributed to five straight 30-win seasons and two appearances in the national championship game.

In his first season as a head coach in 2021-22, he was named National Coach of the Year by the NABC, USBWA and the Associated Press, becoming the first Arizona men's basketball head coach to win any of those awards. He led Arizona to a 33-4 overall record and a 18-2 mark in Pac-12 play to claim the conference's regular season title by three games over UCLA. The Kelso, Washington native set the Pac-12 record for most wins in his first season as head coach and the Wildcats became the first Pac-12 team to ever win 18 regular season conference games. The 33 wins are the second-most in NCAA history for a head coach in his first-ever season as a head coach, falling one short of UNC's Bill Guthridge mark of 34 in 1998.

Under his guidance in 2021-22, sophomore Bennedict Mathurin was named a consensus All-American as well as the Pac-12 Player of the Year and Most Outstanding Player of the Pac-12 Tournament, as he scored 655 points on the season, the ninth-most in Arizona history. Junior center Christian Koloko was named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year in addition to Pac-12 Most Improved Player of the Year and tied the Arizona single-season record for blocked shots (102) while also increasing his scoring output from 5.3 points per game as a sophomore to 12.6 as a junior and shooting 63.5% from the floor. Sophomore forward Azuolas Tubelis averaged 13.9 points per game and was named First Team All Pac-12 while Dalen Terry was honorable mention all-conference and ranked 12th nationally with a 2.84 assist-to-turnover ratio. Rounding out the award winners from the season was sophomore Pelle Larsson, who shot 47.8% from the floor and averaged 7.2 points and 3.4 rebounds to earn Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year accolades.

As a team in 2021-22, Arizona led the country and set a new Arizona single-season record with 726 assists. The Wildcats also set a new program record with 210 blocked shots, a total that ranked second nationally. The fast-paced offensive attack led to Arizona averaging 84.0 points per game - third nationally - and the most by an Arizona team since 2003-04.

The Wildcats were also champions in the classroom during Lloyd's first season, recording a then-record setting 3.04 team GPA in the Fall 2021 semester with four players posting a perfect 4.0 GPA. Then in the Spring 2022 semester, the team GPA improved to an all-time program best 3.14 with eight players posting a 3.5 or higher GPA. Arizona also earned NABC Team Academic Excellence award in 2021-22 for having a team GPA of 3.00 or higher, marking the first time that Wildcats had received the honor since the award began in 2012-13 season.

Lloyd, 48, served as an administrative assistant at Gonzaga for Few during the 2000-01 season before being promoted to assistant coach prior to the 2001-02 season. In his 20 seasons in Spokane, the Zags posted a record of 578-109 (.841) and reached the NCAA Tournament every year, going as far as the title game twice, the Elite Eight twice and the Sweet 16 four times. Gonzaga was also ranked No. 1 in the country for the first time in program history in 2012-13 and then again ascended to the top spot in 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

During his tenure, Lloyd and the Zags won 19 West Coast Conference regular season titles and 15 WCC Tournament championships with the help of 87 all-WCC honorees, including nine newcomers of the year and six defenders of the year.

Coach Lloyd was instrumental in the Zags signing and developing NBA players, including two-time NBA All-Star Domantas Sabonis, Rui Hachimura, Kelly Olynyk, Zach Collins, Adam Morrison, Brandon Clarke, Kyle Wiltjer, Austin Daye, Robert Sacre, Ronny Turiaf, Jeremy Pargo and Elias Harris.

The Zags have had one of the most potent offenses in the nation over the last 20 years, joining North Carolina and Duke as the only three schools in the country to average more than 80 points per game. Gonzaga also led the country in overall field goal percentage (49.6%) and three-point field goal percentage (37.9%) in that span.

A 1993 graduate of Kelso High School in Washington, Lloyd went on to attend Walla Walla Community College for two seasons and was an All-Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges All-East Region selection in 1995. Following his graduation from WWCC, he finished his career at Whitman College, earning his degree in biology and a secondary teaching credential. He played professionally in Brisbane, Australia in 1997 and Dusseldorf, Germany in 1999.

Lloyd's contract at Arizona runs through the 2026-27 season. Lloyd and his wife, Chanelle, have three children - Liam, Sofia Marie and Maria Alexis. Liam plays basketball at Northern Arizona.
