NIAGARA STARTS FOUR-GAME HOMESTAND WITH A-STATE TUESDAY THE PURPLE EAGLES' FINAL GAME BEFORE CHRISTMAS BREAK

The Niagara Purple Eagles will host the Arkansas State Red Wolves on Tuesday, Dec. 23 at 7 p.m. to begin their four-game homestand during the holiday season.

Niagara, which is in a midst of a six-game losing streak, will play its next four games on the Frank and Barbara Layden Court at the Gallagher Center. The Purple Eagles will be looking to avoid starting 0-3 at the Gallagher Center since losing four straight to begin their home schedule during the 2006-07 season; that team went on to win the 2007 MAAC Tournament and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

The Purple Eagles and Red Wolves met for the first time last season in Jonesboro, Ark. where the host came away with an 86-61 victory.

Tipoff Tidbits

- Niagara's non-conference schedule is one of the toughest in the nation. The Purple Eagles' non-conference schedule is ranked third by both ESPN Daily RPI and RPI Forecast (Live-RPI) and is eighth by KenPom.com. Niagara's opponents combined record is 53-25.
- Wesley Myers set a career-high in 3-pointers with four triples at Buffalo on Dec. 19. His four 3-pointers are the most by a Purple Eagle this season.
- Freshman Matt Scott led the Purple Eagles in scoring versus Canisius on Dec. 6 with a career-high 13 points while going perfect from the field (5-for-5), behind the 3-point line (2-for-2) and at the free-throw line (1-for-1).
- Redshirt sophomore Emile Blackman led all scorers with 21 points at St. John's on Dec. 2, which are the most by a Purple Eagle this season. Blackman leads the team in scoring with 12.3 ppg.
- Sophomore Ramone Snowden recorded his second double-double of the season with 13 points and a game-high 12 rebounds at St. John's on Dec. 2. Snowden, who has already doubled his total from last season, ranks fourth in the MAAC in double-doubles.
- The Purple Eagles have committed the fewest fouls (165) and the second fewest turnovers (112) in the MAAC.
- According to KenPom.com, Niagara is the **SIXTH** youngest team in the nation. NU has 13 underclassmen on the roster.

Carom Carousel

- Ramone Snowden leads the team and is fifth in the MAAC with 7.5 rebounds per game.
- He is also fourth in the conference and 58th in the nation in defensive rebounds with 5.88 per game.
- Snowden is on pace for the most rebounds in a season since Bilal Benn's 298 (9.9 per game) during the 2009-10 season.
- Snowden has the top two rebounding outputs of the season for Niagara with 12 at St. John's and 11 at Saint Peter's.
- He is one of 18 MAAC players with multiple double-digit rebounds games.

- The Red Wolves have won their last two games entering Tuesday's night contest with wins at Mississippi State and at home versus Marshall.
- Three players are averaging in double figures - Anthon Livingston (16.5 ppg), Cameron Golden (14.8 ppg) and Sean Gardner (13.9 ppg).
- PJ Hardwick is second in the Sun Belt with 5.2 assists per game.
- A-State has committed the fourth fewest fouls (133) in the nation.

Against the Red Wolves (A-State leads 1-0)

- Niagara dropped the first-ever meeting with Arkansas State, 86-61, last season.
- NU trailed 32-12 after 11 minutes before cutting the lead to 60-51 with 8:54 remaining.
- The meeting was the final game of Niagara's six-game road trip.

Strength of Schedule

- Niagara has the toughest non-conference schedule in the MAAC and ranks in the top-10 in the nation according to several metric sites.
- ESPN Daily RPI ranks NU's non-conference strength of schedule **THIRD**, Live-RPI.com ranks it **THIRD** and KenPom.com ranks Niagara **EIGHTH**.
- The Purple Eagles have played teams from the ACC (Pitt), Atlantic-10 (St. Bonaventure and Davidson), and the Big East (St. John's).

Perfect Scott

- Freshman Matt Scott led the Purple Eagles in scoring versus Canisius on Dec. 6 with a career-high 13 points while going perfect from the field (5-for-5), behind the 3-point line (2-for-2) and at the free-throw line (1-for-1).
- Scott became the first Purple Eagle to go perfect from the field, with a minimum of five field goal attempts, since Eric Williams went 5-for-5 at Central Connecticut State on Dec. 19, 2010.

Gallagher Center Court Named For Frank and Barbara Layden

- Niagara University officially unveiled the naming of the Gallagher Center court after Frank and Barbara Layden on Dec. 6.
- Layden played for Niagara from 1951-55 under John "Taps" Gallagher and coached Niagara for eight seasons while leading the Purple Eagles to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance in 1970.
- Layden coached in the NBA as an assistant coach for the Atlanta Hawks (1976-79) and then was the general manager (1979-87), head coach (1981-89) and president (1989-99) for the Jazz organization.
- Layden was named the 1983-84 NBA Coach of the Year and Executive of the Year, and was the recipient of the NBA's J. Walter Kennedy Citizenship Award, which is annually given to a player or coach who shows outstanding service and dedication to the community.

Niagara In December

- The Purple Eagles are 29-33 in December since the 2006-07 season.
- Six times Niagara had a record over .500 with the last time coming during the 2009-10 season (5-2).

Little 3 Business

- The Purple Eagles have dominated the Little 3 in recent seasons, owning a 26-11 record in the last 37 games against Canisius and St. Bonaventure.
- Niagara is 18-7 versus the Golden Griffins ns since Feb. 12, 2003 and is 8-4 against St. Bonaventure.
- However, NU has dropped the last eight meetings to Canisius and St. Bonaventure.

Rare MAAC November Game

- The Nov. 20 game between Niagara and Saint Peter's as the Purple Eagles' third-ever MAAC game played in November.
- Niagara defeated Saint Peter's, 61-59, to improve to 1-2 all-time in November MAAC games.
- The Purple Eagles fell at Iona, 83-72, on Nov. 28, 2012 and to Canisius on Nov. 30 2002, 89-69.
- The game was Niagara's earliest MAAC game in history.

MAAC Opening Win

- Niagara held off Saint Peter's for a 61-59 win in its MAAC opener on Nov. 20 for its first MAAC opening win since the 2009-10 season.
- Niagara improved to 14-12 all-time in MAAC openers.
- NU is 6-5 all-time when opening its MAAC schedule on the road. The Purple Eagles are 11-15 all-time in MAAC road openers.

Season Openers

- NU dropped its season opener to Pitt on Nov. 14 and is now 10-12 in its last 22 season openers, including 5-5 in season openers on the road.
- The Purple Eagles' last road win to begin the season was at Binghamton (71-56) on Nov. 18, 2005.
- Niagara has lost its last four road season openers at Pitt in 2014, Seton Hall in 2013, Oregon State in 2012 and Auburn in 2009.

New Look Purple Eagles

- Head coach Chris Casey begins his second season on Monteagle Ridge.
- In his first season at the helm, Casey picked up the program's first win against Big 4 rival Buffalo since 2008 and a victory over two-time defending SoCon champions Davidson.
- The 2014-15 Purple Eagles will be one of the youngest teams in the nation with 13 underclassmen (five freshmen, two redshirt freshmen, three sophomores, and three redshirt sophomores) on the roster.

- Snowden is the team's leading returner in points and rebounds. He played in all 33 games last season, including 30 starts.
- Myers is the team's leading returner in assists (1.2 per game). He played in all 33 games last season and started the final 14 games.
- Harris saw action in all 33 games last season while making three starts. Harris, a redshirt junior, is the only upperclassman on the team.
- Fowler played in 30 games last season and started in the first nine games of the season.

Key Newcomers (Backcourt)

- Redshirt sophomore Emile Blackman, redshirt freshman Karonn Davis, and freshmen Matt Scott, Anders Skou Hansen and Julian Richardson will be key additions in the backcourt.
- Blackman is a transfer from LIU Post where he played under Chris Casey. He averaged 6.5 points per game and 2.5 rebounds per game during the 2012-13 season. He sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Davis was a part of a winning program at Friend's Central High School in Philadelphia where he won a pair of Pennsylvania Independent Schools state titles. Davis redshirted last season and looks to be an influential member on the team.
- Scott was a three-year member at Brooklyn Law and Tech where he helped it to the program's first-ever Public School Athletic League (PSAL) Class A semifinal appearance. He earned New York State Sportswriters Association (NYSSWA) Class A Second Team honors for the 2013-14 season.
- Skou Hansen brings international experience to the roster, having played for Hoersholm 79ers in his hometown of Broendby, Denmark. He also played for the Denmark national team at the youth level.
- Richardson was a three-time all-league first team, three-time all-city first team, and a two-time all-state first team selection playing at El Camino Real High School in Woodland Hills, Calif.

Key Newcomers (Frontcourt)

- Redshirt freshman forward Dominique Reid, freshmen James Suber, and DayJar "DayDay" Dickson will look to make an immediate impact in the front court.
- Reid, who redshirted last season to rehabilitate a knee injury he suffered in high school, will look to make an immediate impact. His 6-foot-8, 200-lb frame adds size to the front court.
- Suber averaged 11.5 points per game during his senior season at Philadelphia Electrical & Technology as he helped the Chargers advance to the Philadelphia Public School and Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) Class AAA semifinals. Suber was named to the Daily News All-City Third Team and All-Public Second Team at the end of the season.
- Dickson played on a successful high school full of Division I talent. He helped Potomac High School in Oxon Hill, Md. To the 2014 Maryland 2A state title. He averaged 7.0 points per game, five rebounds per game and 10.2 rebounds per game. At 6-foot-9, he is the tallest player on the roster.

- Ramone Snowden and Wesley Myers were named to the Preseason All-Big 4 Second Team.
- The All-Big 4 Teams consists of players from Niagara, Buffalo, Canisius and St. Bonaventure.
- Dominique Reid was tabbed as MAAC Rookie/Freshman of The Year by College Sports Madness and by The Sporting News.

Purple Eagles Roll In Exhibition Win

- Niagara defeated NCAA Division II Roberts Wesleyan 84-66 in an exhibition game on Nov. 3.
- 13 Purple Eagles saw action, including eight for the first time. Redshirt freshman Karonn Davis led all scorers with 21 points on 8-for-10 shooting from the field in 24 minutes. Redshirt sophomore Emile Blackman added 11 points and five rebounds in his first action as a Purple Eagle. Freshman Matt Scott was perfect from the field (4-for-4), from behind the 3-point line (2-for-2) and at the free-throw line (3-for-3) for 13 points.
- Returners Ramone Snowden, Rayvon Harris, Cameron Fowler and Wesley Myers all had solid games. Snowden scored 14 points, including a game-best seven made free throws. Harris scored eight points and grabbed four boards. Myers led the game with four assists and Fowler scored five points and had four rebounds and two assists.

Second Season At Niagara

Eighth Season Overall

Chris Casey, who arrived with 27 years of coaching experience at the Division I and II and III levels, was named the 21st head coach of the Niagara University men's basketball program on April 22, 2013.

Casey has had successful stints as a Division I assistant coach at St. John's, Central Connecticut State and Saint Peter's, and as a Division II head coach at LIU Post and a Division III head coach at Rutgers-Newark.

In his first season at the helm, Casey picked up wins against Big 4 rival Buffalo, which was the program's first since 2008, and a victory over two-time defending SoCon champions Davidson. Casey also coached Antoine Mason who led the nation in scoring for three months and finished second in the nation, behind national player of the year Doug McDermott from Creighton, with 25.6 points per game.

Casey came to Niagara after three seasons at LIU Post in Brookville, N.Y. where he posted a 62-25 record and went 44-11 in the East Coast Conference. Casey led the Pioneers to back-to-back 20-win seasons, two East Coast Conference Championships and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

LIU Post concluded the 2012-13 season with an 18-9 record and finished tied for second in the conference with a 13-5 ECC record. Casey coached three Pioneers to all-conference teams, led by senior guard Tobin Carberry who was name ECC Player of the Year, Regional Player of the Year, All-Met Co-Player Player and earned a spot on the Daktronics All-American Third Team.

Casey led the 2011-12 team to a 23-6 record as the Pioneers won the ECC title for their fourth championship in five seasons and made their third NCAA appearance in four seasons. Casey was named ECC Coach of the Year and the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II Coach of the Year. Under Casey's tutelage, the Pioneers saw three players named to the ECC First Team and one to the Second Team, as well as ECC Player of the Year Stefan Bonneau who earned All-Region, All-Met and two All-America accolades, and ECC Rookie of the Year Tyuan Williams.

Casey's first season at LIU Post was a successful one as he led the Pioneers to an East Coast Conference Championship and an appearance in the NCAA East Regional. Four of Casey's players were selected to All-ECC teams, and Bonneau earned ECC Player of the Year and NABC All-Region First Team. Casey's LIU teams were extremely active in the local community during his tenure and volunteered at organizations such as St. John's Bread and Life and the Miracle League of Long Island.

Prior to being named head coach at LIU, Casey was an instrumental member of the St. John's coaching staff under former head coach Norm Roberts. He spent six seasons on the staff, serving as the Director of Operations for two seasons before being promoted to Assistant Coach. During his tenure at St. John's, Casey played a large role on Roberts' staff as he was responsible for recruiting, opponent scouting, player development, on-court instruction and practice and game preparation.

Casey's first season as an assistant coach proved to be one of significance for the Red Storm. St. John's made a return to the BIG EAST Championship Tournament for the first time since 2003, posted its first winning record (16-15) since that season and compiled its best conference record (7-9) since 2003 as well.

In 2008-09, Casey's guidance helped the Red Storm equal that win total, propelling the squad to its first BIG EAST Tournament victory in six years and a postseason appearance in the CBI. 2010 was also a high-water mark for the Casey with the Red Storm, as they made the NIT tournament that season.

Casey came to St. John's from Central Connecticut State University, where he spent three seasons as the Blue Devils' top assistant coach and recruiting coordinator. He was also responsible for game preparation, player development and on-the-floor coaching at CCSU.

During his tenure with the Blue Devils, the team won the 2002 Northeast Conference Championship and earned a berth in the 2002 NCAA Tournament. In 2003, Casey was named an AFLAC National Assistant Coach of the Year.

In his three years with Central Connecticut State, the team averaged nearly 19 wins per season. The team's league record during those years was 40-16, and the Blue Devils advanced to two NEC Championship games.

At CCSU, Casey worked with forward Corsley Edwards, who was selected by the Sacramento Kings in the second round of the 2003 National Basketball Association Draft, the first-ever selection for a Blue Devil player. In addition, two student-athletes, Edwards and Ron Robinson, were named the league's player of the year during his tenure.

Casey joined the staff at Central Connecticut State after serving as the head coach at Rutgers University-Newark for three seasons, from 1998-99 to 2000-01. In his third year with the Scarlet Raiders, he led the team to its second postseason appearance since 1985. The team matched the school record for victories in the regular season and the Raiders qualified for the ECAC Postseason Tournament. For his efforts, Casey was named the New Jersey Athletic Conference Coach of the Year.

Prior to his time at Rutgers, Casey was an assistant basketball coach at St. Peter's University for eight years. He served as the team's recruiting coordinator and helped land seven all-conference players with two players being named the conference's Rookie of the Year. St. Peter's qualified for the NCAA Tournament twice during his tenure, 1991 and 1995.

Casey has also made coaching stops at his alma mater, Western Connecticut State, and St. Francis (N.Y.). In 1988-89, Western Connecticut finished the season 25-3 and made a trip to the Division III Elite Eight in the NCAA Tournament.

Casey is a 1986 graduate of Western Connecticut State University with a B.S. in business administration. He earned his master's in education administration from Central Connecticut State in 1993. He played basketball for four seasons at Western and was a two-time team captain. His team made an appearance in the ECAC Tournament in his senior season.

Casey and his wife, Hope, have two daughters, Lauren and Jordan.
