SOUTH ALABAMA'S LAST GAME

Howard 73, South Alabama 60 • December 23, 2014

MOBILE, Ala. — Howard held the University of South Alabama men's basketball team to a season-low 30.6 percent shooting and **James Daniel III** scored a game-high 22 points in the Bison's 73-60 victory Tuesday night in the Gotham Classic at the Mitchell Center.

The Bison even their record at 7-7 while the Jaguars drop their fifth in row to fall to 2-8.

"I'm obviously really disappointed in our game tonight," USA head coach **Matthew Graves** said. "I thought we came out very slow and got behind, but then we dug in and made some good plays. We kind of played back-and-forth and had a good stretch of about 10 to 12 minutes where we defended really well and did some good things. You go into the half, down three and we're holding steady, but you can just sense that the momentum was beginning to shift. We did not rebound the ball very well in the first half, then it really showed itself in the second half. They were a lot quicker to the ball. They were more physical. The ball meant more to them.

"We didn't get much movement. In the first half we had seven assists on eight field goals, which is outstanding. In the second half, we got really stagnant, stood around a lot and felt sorry for ourselves because shots weren't going in. No. 1, (James) Carlton got hot, and we didn't have an answer for him. That's how you get down 73-60."

Daniel made three 3-pointers and went 5-for-5 at the free-throw line for his 22 points and added four assists. **James Carlton** added 17 points and **Marcel Boyd** grabbed a game-best 14 rebounds.

Freshman **Taishaun Johnson** (Indianapolis, Ind.) paced the Jags with 17 points and new career-highs with three 3-pointers and four steals. Sophomore **Ken Williams** (Houston, Texas) recorded eight of his 11 points from the free-throw line, and tied a season-best with four assists.

The Bison took control midway through the second half with a 15-4 run, almost singlehandedly from Carlton, who contributed 11 of the 15 points.

Meanwhile, the Jaguars missed seven of their eight shots during that 5:25 stretch and fell behind 62-48 with 8:16 to play.

"When you have a really thin bench, your margin for error shrinks," Graves said. "Tonight, we saw that we had no answers, both on the offensive end and defensively. Carlton was able to get a basket anytime. Then when they did miss, we couldn't get the rebound. So you really compound those sort of problems and it makes for a long night."

South Alabama's 15 made field goals were a season low and the team was outscored 32-12 in the paint.

"We got impatient from the perimeter," Graves noted. "Then also, our bigs were really tentative about flashing in there, especially **Abdul** (**Lewis**) tonight. **Dionte** (**Ferguson**) had a rough night, going 1-6. When you're not able to get some production at the rim, 32-12 in the paint is not a very good recipe for us."

The Bison dominated the boards as well, winning the battle 46-32 overall with 23 offensive rebounds, almost double the previous high by an opponent entering the game (12 by Southern Miss and IUPUI). The 23 offensive boards led to 24 second-chance points.

"I think it was an effort thing," said Graves. "I think we weren't making shots on the other end, and we allowed that to affect our energy and effort on the defensive end on the floor."

Howard jumped out to a quick 8-0 lead to start the contest but South Alabama answered with seven unanswered to almost pull even. The Jags were able to hold the lead for nearly the final 12 minutes of the first half, starting at the 12:04 mark, but a 9-4 Bison run right before halftime—on two 3-pointers and a three-point play—gave them the lead for good.

ARKANSAS STATE'S LAST GAME

Arkansas State 74, Niagara 69 • December 23, 2014

NIAGARA UNIVERSITY, N.Y. — Redshirt sophomore point guard **PJ Hardwick** dished out 11 assists with no turnovers as the Arkansas State men's basketball squad rallied from nine points down in the second half to upend Niagara 74-69 in its final non-conference contest of the year Tuesday night at the Gallagher Center in Niagara University, N.Y.

Hardwick also added four points on the night, including a clutch jumper as the shot clock expired to bring A-State (5-4) within one point at 65-64 with a little less than three minutes remaining in the game. Niagara (1-8) missed a three-pointer on its next possession and **Sean Gardner** drilled a fadeaway three-point attempt to give the Red Wolves a 67-65 advantage they wouldn't relinquish.

Cameron Golden connected on a shot beyond the arc to extend A-State's lead to 70-65, but a couple of missed free throws kept Niagara in the game. The Purple Eagles had a chance to tie the game after a turnover with the score 72-69, but missed a potential game-tying three-pointer with eight second remaining. **Anthony Livingston** grabbed the rebound and made two free throws to set the final.

"We made some big baskets tonight," A-State men's basketball coach **John Brady** said. "PJ made one at the shot clock buzzer, Sean made a big three, Cameron had a big three, and Anthony made a couple of clutch free throws. It was a gutty win for us. PJ was outstanding tonight and when you think about it he probably accounted for close

OPENING TIP

- Tuesday marks the second straight year South Alabama opens Sun Belt Conference play at home, but it's
 only the second time in the last five seasons it has happened.
- The Jaquars are 2-4 in their last six Sun Belt openers, and 3-3 in their last six home SBC openers.
- Arkansas State's last five wins in the series have come by an average of 13.5 points, with all but one by at least 12 points. ASU's 85-61 win in Mobile last year was the Red Wolves' second-biggest victory against the Jaquars and largest on the road.
- USA went 6-for-14 from 3-point land in the first half vs. Howard, but made just one in eight attempts after halftime.
- The Jags have not hit the 70-point plateau and are averaging 62.8 points in their current five-game skid.
- Despite leading the league in defensive rebound percentage going in to the Howard game, South Alabama gave up a season-high 23 offensive rebounds—almost double the previous season high, against 20 defensive rebounds for the Jaguars—leading to 24 second-chance points, twice as many as previously allowed this year.
- USA went 23-for-29 from the free-throw line its last time out, setting a new season high for free throws
 made and free throw percentage (79.2, min. 10 FTM) and putting up the second-most attempts on the
 year. The 29 attempts are the most in a South Alabama loss, as the team was averaging just 15.9 attempts
 in defeats, and had only 19 attempts total in its last two outings.
- Sophomore Ken Williams converted 8 of 10 at the charity stripe, new career highs in both categories, and ties the most makes and is a new high for any Jaguar in a game this season. He entered the contest 7-for-8 at the line for the year.
- Freshman Taishaun Johnson went 6-for-6 at the line vs. Howard—tying the best percentage by a USA
 player this season—and put up a team-high 17 points and four steals. He also nailed three 3-pointers, a
 new career high. Johnson is averaging 17.5 points in his last two games.
- Johnson has two six-assist games in his last five outings, but has one assist and 12 turnovers in the other three.
- Arkansas State had to replace all five starters from 2013-14 and returned just three letterwinners.
- The Red Wolves' Anthony Livingston ranks fourth in the league in scoring at 16.4 ppg, Cameron Golden
 is eighth (15.3 ppg) and Sean Gardner is ninth (14.9 ppg). ASU is the only school in the conference with
 three players in the top nine.

to 30 points between his four points and the assists."

A-State outshot Niagara 47.3 percent (26-55) to 45 percent (27-60) for the game, but Niagara shot 63 percent (17-27) in the first half to A-State's 40 percent (12-30) to earn the early edge. The Red Wolves outrebounded Niagara 35-34 and shot 71.4 percent (15-21) from the charity stripe, while the host team could only muster a 52.6 percent (10-19) mark.

Gardner led all scorers in the game with 23 points, while Golden poured in 20 of his own. Livingston added 16 points and had 10 rebounds for his second double-double in as many games. Niagara had five scorers in double figures and was led by **Rayvon Harris** (13) and **Ramone Snowden** (12). **Emile Blackman** had 11, while **Wesley Myers** and **Dominique Reid** each had 11 points off the bench.

"Niagara started out uncharacteristic of what they have done, so you have to give them credit," Brady added. "We weren't as good defensively as we had been and tonight they made some baskets, including some guys that hadn't done that this year for them. They played extremely well the first half, but we got them back to who they are in the second half because we played like we are capable of playing, particularly on the defensive side of the ball."

The Purple Eagles raced out to a 10-2 advantage in the first half, but two consecutive three pointers from Gardner capped an 11-2 run to give A-State a 13-12 lead early. However, Niagara regained the edge 17-14 on a **Karonn Davis** three-pointer and wouldn't relinquish the lead the rest of the half. A-State got within 36-34 on two Golden free throws with just under two minutes remaining, but couldn't get any closer as Niagara took a 41-36 edge to the locker room.

Niagara began the second half strong as they took a 51-42 lead on a bucket from **Cameron Fowler** with 16:36 showing on the clock, but A-State used an 8-0 run, capped by a Gardner layup, to set the score at 51-50. The Purple Eagles stretched their advantage out to 56-50 with just under 11 minutes remaining, but a 7-0 run, capped by a Golden three, gave A-State its first edge since the first half. Niagara quickly regained the lead, but would lose it on Gardner's three-pointer with 1:53 left to go.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

Arkansas State 85, South Alabama 61 • February 13, 2014

MOBILE, Ala. — Down 10-2 early in the contest, Arkansas State went on a 20-2 run—including 18 unanswered points—to walk away with an 85-61 win over the University of South Alabama men's basketball team Thursday night at the Mitchell Center.

The Red Wolves win their third straight game to improve to 14-8 and 7-4 in the Sun Belt Conference. The Jaguars drop their sixth straight contest to fall to 7-17 and 1-10.

Arkansas State went on spurts of 12-3 and 15-3 in the second half to hand South Alabama its worst home loss since 2008-09.

"We knew going into the game that it was going to be tough," USA head coach **Matthew Graves** said. "They're a very good team and they were playing at a high level, coming off a good win. I thought we got off to a great start. We shared the ball, we moved the basketball and we got some post touches. During that stretch we missed a couple of shots that were good shots and we were playing in a good rhythm. Then we hit a spell where it was an 18-0 run and we just didn't get enough stops.

"In the second half, I felt like we traded some baskets and then they took off on us again. At one point they were shooting 81 percent from the floor and when a team, I think they were 13 of 16 at the time, there's something wrong there. It's not just on the players; we have to do a better job of figuring out ways that we can guard people. Right now we're struggling on the defensive end of the floor and it shows up. I felt like offensively, we scored enough to win the game, but you can't give up 85 points and expect to win."

The Red Wolves shot 52.8 percent for the game and 64.3 percent in the second half. ASU made 13 of its first 16 shots after halftime, including runs of six and seven conversions in a row.

Melvin Johnson III scored 18 of his game-high 24 points in the second half, all within a six-minute stretch where he accounted for 18 of the team's 22 points.

"They are the second-best offensive team in the league, statistically," Graves noted. "You go 18-for-18 from the line and you shoot almost 50 percent from the '3.' Let's face it, there were three or four of those shots from three that they don't normally make, but the problem is it was the three or four baskets or the couple of free throws that allowed their guys to really get in rhythm and do some things. When you're in a nice rhythm offensively that allows shots that you might not normally make, they go in because you're feeling really good about yourself."

The 18-0 run started with a 3-pointer from Johnson, and after three straight misses from the Jags, a layup from **Kendrick Washington** gave the Red Wolves their first lead of the contest at 14-12. USA turned the ball over on five of its next six possessions and **Brandon Reed** knocked home two free throws at the 9:24 mark to take a 22-12 lead.

The Jaguars responded with an 11-4 rally to cut the deficit to three after an **Isaiah Maston** (Birmingham, Ala.) triple, but the Red Wolves outscored USA 9-5 to end the half and led 35-28 at the break.

South Alabama got as close as five early in the second half but Johnson single-handedly increased the margin to 16 with seven unanswered points and a 15-3 run in just over five minutes gave ASU its largest lead of the contest at 28.

"We really played well the whole game," Red Wolves head coach **John Brady** said. "Defensively, we were good throughout, and then in the second half, offensively, we were really good. We haven't shot the ball like this at home, but we shoot it on the road. We really played well, and I was really proud of our guys and how they continued to defend the whole game."

Senior **Augustine Rubit** (Houston, Texas) poured in a team-best 23 points and senior **Antoine Allen** (Baltimore, Md.) was the only other Jaguar in double-digits with 10. Junior **Mychal Ammons** (Vicksburg, Miss.) grabbed seven rebounds and sophomore **Barrington Stevens III** (Allen, Texas) tied his career high with six assists.

JAGUARS LOOKING TO REPLACE SCORING AND REBOUNDING

South Alabama not only loses three starters and eight letterwinners, but those three starters accounted for 53.8 percent of its scoring and 53.1 percent of its rebounding... Departing senior **Augustine Rubit** led the team with 17.0 points and 9.4 rebounds per game and was voted Second Team All-Sun Belt... **Mychal Ammons**, who left to pursue a professional career, was second on the team behind Rubit in rebounding (7.2 rpg) and third in scoring (9.3)... **Antoine Allen** averaged 10.7 ppg, second on the team, and knocked down a team-best 66 3-pointers.

QUITE THE DEBUT

John Brown wasted little time in making an impact for the Jaguars, scoring 22 points in his USA debut against Carroll... Brown went 4-for-6 from 3-point land and 6-for-6 from the foul line... Fourteen of those points came after halftime and he made all four of his 3-point attempts in the second half... He led the team in scoring his second time out at Southern Miss with 14 points of 7 of 12 shooting.

QUADRUPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Over a four-game stretch in November and December, the Jaguars had a different player record a double-double in each game... It was the first career double-double for each player and they also set new career highs in both categories in the process... Freshman **Taishaun Johnson** had the first in the run, a 15-point, 10-rebound performance in a 66-53 loss at Detroit... He also led the team in assists (3) and steals (2) against the Titans... Senior **Dionte Ferguson** had 12 points and 14 rebounds at Miami, tying the most rebounds by a USA player since February 2013... Nine of his 14 boards on the night came on the offensive end... Sophomore **Georgi Boyanov** posted gamehigh totals of 14 points and 10 rebounds in USA's win over Spring Hill, shooting 5 of 7 from the floor and 3 of 3 from the free-throw line... Freshman **Abdul Lewis** came off the bench to score 17 points with 12 rebounds vs. Middle Tennessee, shooting 7-for-11 from the field.

FRESHMAN LONG-DISTANCE RECORD SET

Ken Williams set a freshman class 3-point record with 55 last year, obliterating the previous mark of 41 set by **Emmett Thomas** in the 2000-01 season... Williams was second on the team in triples last season, and ranked 10th in the Sun Belt with 1.8 per game... He led the team with a .342 long-range percentage and hit a career-high five in a game twice... Williams averaged 1.9 treys and shot 35.7 percent from the floor in conference games... He leads the team with 24 triples—including a career-best six at IUPUI (12/20)—in 2014-15, tied for sixth in the Sun Belt.

JAGUARS PICKED NINTH IN PRESEASON POLL

In a poll of the league's coaches, the Jaguars were voted to finish in a tie for ninth with Georgia Southern with 38 points... Defending champion Georgia State earned all 11 first-place votes and received 121 points... Louisiana-Lafayette, the reigning SBC Tournament title holders, was second with 110 points... Arkansas-Little Rock (94), Texas-Arlington (75) and Arkansas State (73) rounded out the top five, and Louisiana-Monroe (69) was voted sixth... Texas State (43) was seventh, Troy (42) finished eighth and SBC newcomer Appalachian State was 11th (23).

HOME OPENING SUCCESS

In the 45 years of the program, the Jaguars have a history of successful home openers... USA sports a 39-8 record in its home opening contests and has won 23 in a row... The last loss was 81-75 to Southern Miss in 1991... The streak was extended on Nov. 8 with a 74-58 win over Detroit... Spring Hill is the most frequent victim during the streak, losing three times... The Jaguars have defeated Abilene Christian, Alabama State, Alcorn State and Prairie View A&M twice each in season lid-lifters.

ACCURACY IS THE KEY TO SUCCESS

South Alabama is 80-17 when compiling a higher shooting percentage than its opponent since the start of the 2008-09 campaign (47-13 vs. SBC schools) but 15-80 (7-47 vs. Sun Belt teams) when being outshot... In 2012-13 the Jags posted a 13-1 record (11-1 vs. Sun Belt) when outshooting their opponent... In 2010-11, the Jaguars were 11-2 with the shooting advantage and 1-14 without it... South Alabama was 14-3 in 2011-12 when outshooting its opponent and 3-9 when outshot by its opponent.

THAT 70s SHOW

When scoring 70 or more, the Jaguars are 84-24 since the start of the 2007-08 season... The Jags went 12-3 (9-0 in Sun Belt play) in 2012-13... USA opened the 2009-10 season with 10 straight wins when hitting at least 70 before dropping an 86-78 decision at North Texas (1/21), and did not reach 70 the rest of the season... The Jags were 10-2 in 2011-12, with one of those losses coming in overtime.

AT HOME IN THE MITCHELL CENTER

Since the facility opened in 1999, the Jaguars have established a winning tradition on their home floor, the Mitchell Center... In 15 seasons, South Alabama has a 156-66 (.703) record and has eight seasons of 10 or more wins... In 2007-08 the Jags posted a 17-1 slate in front of their home fans (17-0 in the regular season), the second-most home wins in school history (19, 1973-74).

SPANNING THE COUNTRY

Nine different states and three countries are represented on the USA roster... There are three players from Alabama, two players each from Indiana, Texas and Alabama, and one each from Tennessee, North Carolina, New Jersey and California... Sophomore **Georgi Boyanov** is from Lovech, Bulgaria, and freshman **Luka Andjusic** is a native of Belgrade, Serbia.

Matthew Graves Head Coach Butler, 1998 2nd Season

From the moment he was hired in March 2013, University of South Alabama men's basketball head coach Matthew Graves made it a top priority to "change the culture" at South Alabama.

After spending 17 years at Butler University as both a student-athlete and coach, Graves set out to take the Butler philosophy and install that in the Jaguar men's basketball program.

Entering his second season, Graves is laying the foundation for success.

From revamping academics and a greater involvement in community service activities, to restructuring off-season workouts and practices to emphasize skill development, to the style of play during games, every aspect of the program has been evaluated and fine-tuned to Graves' standards.

The process aims to establish long-term prosperity both on and off the court, contending for championships while graduating student-athletes year in, and year out.

Overhauling the academic program resulted in the team's highest GPA in over five years, and both seniors, Antoine Allen and Augustine Rubit earned their degrees.

On the court, his first year in charge resulted in an 11-20 record with a roster that included 10 first- or second-year players, with inexperience rearing its ugly head in the 11 times the Jags let a second-half lead slip away. However, Rubit set both school and conference records for rebounds and became the first Jaguar to earn All-Sun Belt recognition four times.

Rubit finished in the top 10 in five different individual categories and ranked third in the league in rebounding (9.4 rpg) and sixth in scoring (17.0 ppg).

Graves' style of play and work on the court helped Barrington Stevens III go from a 0.7 assist-turnover ratio his freshman campaign to a 2.0 as a sophomore, the best ratio by a South Alabama player since 1988-89.

Graves spent the previous 10 seasons as an assistant on the staff at Butler, where his efforts helped the Bulldogs advance to back-to-back NCAA Tournament

championship games and appear in the event in six of the last seven years.

During his tenure at Butler, Graves helped the program to an overall record of 244-98 (71.3%), a berth in national postseason tournaments each of the last eight seasons and eight straight years with 20-plus victories. Following the 2009-10 campaign that saw the Bulldogs finish 33-5 after falling to Duke 61-59 in the national title contest, he was promoted to associate head coach; in his first year in that role, Butler returned to the NCAA Tournament championship game after defeating Pittsburgh, Florida and Wisconsin — the first, second and fourth seeds — in the Southeast Region while going on to post a 28-10 record.

In 2012-13, the Bulldogs' first in the Atlantic 10 Conference, they went 27-9 including an 11-5 mark in league action. In addition to advancing to the third round of the NCAA Tournament, Butler defeated two of the four No. 1 seeds in the event — Indiana and Gonzaga — during the regular season.

Graves first helped lead Butler back to postseason play in 2005-06, when the school went 20-13 after earning a first-round win in the National Invitation Tournament. The following year, the Bulldogs won the NIT Season Tip-Off and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament before falling to eventual champion Florida en route to a final record of 29-7. Butler finished 30-4 after claiming the Horizon League Tournament title and a first-round NCAA win in 2007-08, advancing to the NCAA Tournament again the next season while posting a 26-6 mark.

While on the Butler staff, Graves was listed No. 2 on CollegeInsider.com's ranking of top 25 mid-major assistants in 2009 while the previous year FoxSports.com recognized him as one of the top 10 mid-major assistants in the country.

Graves started as an assistant coach at North Central and Ben Davis High Schools in Indianapolis, joining the Bulldog staff as coordinator of men's basketball operations in 2001. During his first two seasons at Butler, the Bulldogs won 53 games and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the 2003 NCAA Tournament.

As a player, Graves lettered four years at Butler and was part of a program that posted a 95-54 (63.8%) mark while he was in school. He was team captain each of his final two seasons, when the Bulldogs went 23-10 and 22-11, respectively, after winning the Midwestern Collegiate Conference Tournament title and advancing to the NCAA Tournament. Graves was the third-leading scorer on the team in 1996-97 when Butler made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 35 years, while as a senior he was chosen the squad's most valuable player and was named to the MCC all-tournament team after recording 18 points in the championship contest.
