**A-STATE/MEMPHIS SERIES HISTORY**

- Memphis leads the all-time series 90-54-1
- A-State and Memphis split the series last season, with each team winning a game on the road.
- The Red Wolves recorded the second most strikeouts in a game with 18 against the Tigers in 1995.
- A-State had seven doubles against the Tigers in a game in 1991, which is tied for the most in a game in school history.
- Arkansas State drove in 26 runs against the Tigers during a game in 1992, the most ever in a single-game in program history.

A-STATE/MISSOURI STATE SERIES HISTORY

- This will be the 61st meeting all-time between A-State and Missouri State.
- The first meeting occurred during the 1964 season when the Bears were known as Southwest Missouri State.
- Since 1990, the schools have met for at least one game every year except for 1998 and 2004.
- Missouri State leads the all-time series record 36-24.
- A-State won both games against the Bears in 2013 in Jonesboro.

CROFT SOLIDIFIES BULLPEN

- Since permanently moving to the bullpen on March 10, A-State senior pitcher senior Morgan Croft has not allowed a run in his last 11.1 innings.
- Croft has also collected three saves during that time and has given up just two hits and five walks.

WOODHOUSE FINDS ROLE IN THE PEN

- Senior pitcher Cody Woodhouse has been dominant coming out of the bullpen this season for the Red Wolves. He has allowed just five runs in 22.1 innings of work (4 of which came in his outing at UTA on March 23).

STRANGE BUT TRUE FACTS

- A-State is a perfect 9-0 when collecting at least 10 hits in a game this season.
- The 3rd and 7th innings have been A-State inning's to produce this season. A-State has out scored its opponents by a combined 59-8 in those innings.
- When leading after 7 innings the Red Wolves are 13-1 and are a perfect 13-0 when leading after 8 innings.

TWICE AS WILD

- A-State senior Zach Maggio scored all the way from second base on a wild pitch Wednesday night against Ole Miss. The Rebels' catcher couldn't locate the ball when it bounced in the air and it only rolled a few feet away so Maggio rounded third and scored easily without a play at the plate.

STEALING HOME TWICE IN A WEEK

- A-State stole home twice in one week after stealing home just once in all of 2013.
- A-State's Matt Burgess completed a steal of home on March 11 at Murray State, while Dustin Jones stole home on March 14 at Tomlinson Stadium against UALR.
- In both instances, both were the results of double steals.
- A-State also stole home against UALR in 2013 when Kevin Fitzpatrick accomplished the feat in the second to last game of the year.

IRON MAN

- A-State's Dustin Jones ranks 22nd in the nation in consecutive starts in the nation at 124.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Sophomore outfielder Austin Baker set two records and tied another one with his performance against Murray State Tuesday. He finished the day 5-for-6 with seven runs scored, five RBI's, three home runs in three consecutive at-bats, and 14 total bases.
- Baker set the record for runs scored with seven, breaking the previous high of five that had been done three other times in school history, with the last being Isaac Dillon in 2005 vs. UNO. The 14 total bases also set a new record, breaking the previous high of 13, which had been accomplished two other times in school history. Junior Collin Massanelli had 13 total bases last season on March 16, 2013 against UALR.
- Baker's three home runs also tied a school record for home runs with three, tying three other players including teammate Massanelli that had three against UALR on March 16, 2013.
- Junior infielder Lucas Feddersen tied the record for most at-bats in a game with eight, tying Bill Smith's record set in 1960 against St. Louis. Freshman catcher Tyler Hardie also tied a record with four walks against the Thoroughbreds, tying 16 other players in school history.
- A-State's 27 runs was the second-highest total in school history. Arkansas State's record is 28 runs scored against Memphis in 1992.

COOL RUNNINGS

- A-State is second in the Sun Belt Conference with 25 stolen bases thus far.
- The Red Wolves had just 28 stolen bases in all of 2013.
- Austin Baker leads A-State with 8 stolen bases, breaking the team-high for any A-State player in 2013. His total also ranks fifth in SBC play and is the only player among the conference's top five leaders to have not been caught stealing.

SECOND OR BETTER

- The Red Wolves rank first in the Sun Belt Conference in on base pct. at .404 and walks with 79.
- Arkansas State is second in the SBC in runs scored with 114, batting average at .293, hit-by-pitches with 27, and sacrifice flies with 10.
- A-State ranks second in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles with 38, only trailing Georgia State's 45. The Red Wolves are tied with WKU for second with five triples. ULL leads with seven.
- A-State's pitchers rank second in batters struck out looking with 48.

RED WOLVES AMONG SBC LEADERS

- Matt Burgess is second in the Sun Belt Conference with 19 RBIs after the first four weeks of the season. He also ranks 10th in the league with a .345 batting average.
- Lucas Feddersen ranks 8th in the league with a .346 batting average and also leads the team.
- In addition to Austin Baker's ranks among steal leaders, he is first in the conference with three triples, second with 18 runs, fourth in slugging pct. at .613, fourth in total bases with 38, tied for sixth in hits with 21, and tied for seventh in RBIs with 14.
- Catcher Stuart Levy is second in the conference with seven doubles and is tied for second in the SBC with seven runners caught stealing.

GRAND SALAMI ON RYE

- Sophomore Matt Burgess has continued his assault on opposing pitcher through the season's first two week's.
- He hit the Red Wolves first Grand Slam since 2011 on Feb. 23 against Illinois State with a bases loaded shot over the fence in right-centerfield in the bottom of the third inning.
- He was the first A-State player to hit a grand slam since Jordan Castaldo did it on May 25, 2011 against FIU.

OWEN HONORED BY COLLEGESPORTSMADNESS.COM

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week after his performance at UAB on March 2.
- Owen struck out a career-high 10 against the Blazers to lead A-State to a 5-3 victory.
- He became the first Red Wolves pitcher to strikeout 10 in a game since Bradley Wallace and Daniel Wright each did it in 2013.

BAKER STEALS THE WEEKEND

- Austin Baker went 4-for-4 in stolen bases in A-State's opening weekend series against Miami (OH), including two in the opening game.
- This is the second straight season in which Baker has had an impressive start to the season. As a freshman in 2013 he hit a home run in his first collegiate at-bat.

STRINGING TOGETHER EXTRA BASE HITS

- Arkansas State had seven straight extra base hits in its 13-3 victory over Miami (OH) Sunday Feb. 16.
- For the weekend the Red Wolves had 14 extra base hits, including 13 doubles.

OPENING SERIES SWEEP TWICE AS NICE

- The Arkansas State baseball team opened the 2014 season with a three-game sweep of Miami (Ohio), marking the second year in a row the squad has opened the season with a three-game series sweep.
- Prior to 2013 sweep, the only other it had happened was during the 1971 season.

PRESEASON SBC ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

- Redshirt junior infielder Zach George was named to the 2014 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference team, the first such honor of his career.
- George hit .333 a season ago but played just nine games before suffering a season-ending knee injury at Sam Houston State before the start of conference play. Despite the injury, George managed to hit one home run and drive in five runs and stole one base.
- In 2012, the Paragould, Ark., native finished the year with a .270 batting average and started in 52 of the Red Wolves' 57 games. He added six home runs and was second on the team with 41 RBIs. His 86 total bases and .430 slugging percentage each ranked as the third best on the team.

WALLACE RECOGNIZED AS TOP SENIOR

- A-State senior pitcher Bradley Wallace was named as the top 100 seniors in the class of 2014 by Perfect Game USA.
- Wallace was selected as the 28th best senior baseball player in the class of 2014 and the 16th best right-handed pitcher in the class. He was one of just two players from the Sun Belt Conference on the list with Louisiana-Lafayette first basemen Chase Compton ranking 61st.

COLLEGESPORTSMADNESS.COM HONORS WALLACE

- Arkansas State senior pitcher Bradley Wallace was as a Preseason Second Team All-Conference selection by CollegeSportsMaddness.com
- Wallace finished the 2013 season with a 5-2 record and a 4.33 ERA and was the Red Wolves' No. 2 starter on a pitching staff that set the school record for most strikeouts in season. He had 78 punch outs in 70.2 innings of work and had the second most wins of any pitcher on the team.

GOING TO THE SHOW

- Senior right-hander Daniel Wright became A-State's second highest draft pick in the modern draft era after he was selected in the 10th round by the Cincinnati Reds last season.
- Fellow senior Logan Uxa was also selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 32nd round.

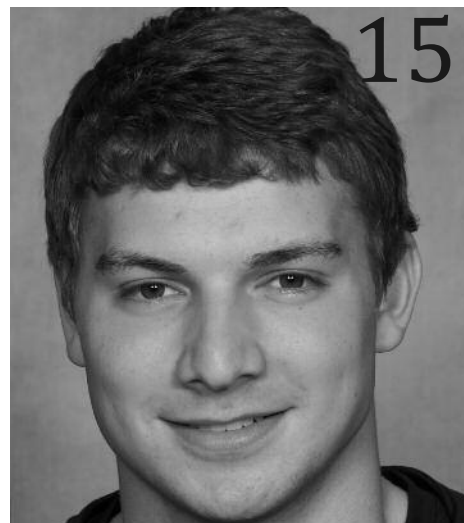

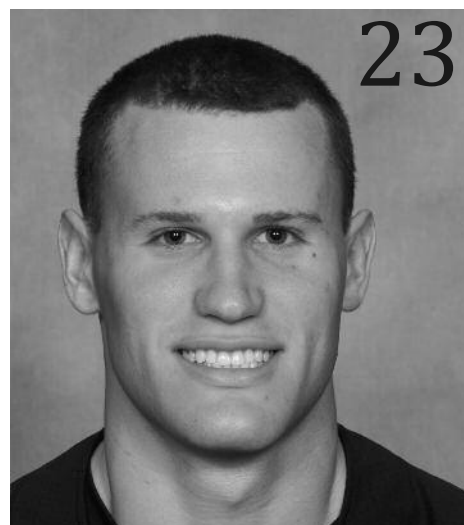
