**A-STATE/MSU SERIES HISTORY**

- A-State holds leads the all-time series 47-51-1 over Murray State.
- A-State has won six straight games in the series, which dates back to the 1948 season.
- The teams have played at least one game in the series every year since 1989.
- The Red Wolves defeated Murray State 27-7 earlier this season. The 27 runs missed the school record for most runs in a game by 1 run.
- Austin Baker set two school records (runs scored with 7 and total bases with 14) and tied the school record for home runs in a game with 3.
- Lucas Feddersen tied the school record for most at-bats in a game with eight.
- Tyler Hardie tied the school record for most walks with four.

SCORING WHEN THE PRESSURE IS ON

- Of the 16 runs that Arkansas State in the series at Georgia State (April 25-27), 10 of them came with two outs.
- In Saturday's 7-6 loss, all six of A-State's runs were scored with two outs.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

- A-State has a 9-1 record on Sunday's this season.
- It's only loss was a 5-4 loss to Creighton on March 9 in the second game of a three-game series.

OWNING THE LAST GAME

- A-State has played 11 weekend series this season and has won the final game in each of those series.
- Nine of those victories have come on Sunday, with one on Saturday (UALR series) and the other was on a Monday (Creighton).

ZUBER GETS FIRST CAREER SAVE

- Freshman pitcher Tyler Zuber picked up his first career save in the Red Wolves' 10-6 victory over Georgia State on April 27.
- He came in with the bases loaded with 2 outs in the bottom of the eighth and struck out SBC home run leader Nic Wilson to get out of the inning and then worked an un-eventful ninth for the save.

HAWKINS DOMINATES BEARS

- Junior LHP Chandler Hawkins had a career night at Central Arkansas on April 22.
- In his first midweek start of the year, Hawkins fanned a career-high 10 in five innings of work.
- Hawkins retired eight in a row at one point and struck out five out looking on the night.
- He is the second A-State pitcher to reach double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (David Owen has struck out 10 twice.)

A-STATE PITCHING STAFF FANS SEASON-HIGH

- The Arkansas State pitching staff struck out a season-high 10 batters against Central Arkansas on April 22.

SWEEPS WEEK

- A-State swept its third weekend opponent of the 2014 season with three victories over Louisiana-Monroe April 18-20.
- The Warhawks are also the second SBC opponent that the Red Wolves have swept this season (UALR was the first during the opening weekend of the conference).
- The Red Wolves also completed a midweek season sweep of Memphis earlier in the week, marking the first-time since 2009 that A-State had defeated the Tigers twice in one season.

FIELDER'S CHOICE WALK-OFF

- A-State completed a comeback from five runs down against ULM on April 20 in the most unusual way with a fielder's choice walk-off.
- The Red Wolves won the game by scoring four runs in the bottom of the ninth inning, included the game winning run on a fielder's choice by Ty Michelotti. The freshman hit a slow ground ball to second and the throw came home and but was too late as Zach Maggio scored the winning run.

WOODHOUSE GETS THE SAVE

- Senior Cody Woodhouse did something he had never done in his four years on the A-State pitching staff, record a save.
- Woodhouse tossed the final three innings in the Red Wolves 11-7 victory over ULM on April 19 for the first save of career.

BURGESS EARNS WEEKLY SBC HONOR

- Sophomore Matt Burgess became the first Arkansas State position player since 2009 to be named the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week when the league revealed the weekly award on April 21.
- The last A-State position player to win the award was Michael Faulkner back in 2011.
- A pair of A-State pitcher (Jacob Lee and Daniel Wright) have been named the SBC Pitcher of the Week since that time.
- Burgess is the 21st position player to win the award in A-State history and the 47th overall (includes hitters and pitchers).
- Sophomore Matt Burgess was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com SBC Player of the Week on April 21.
- He is the second A-State player to be honored by the website this season (David Owen also earned POW honors earlier this season.)

THE TIGER SLAYER

- Tyler Zuber has had two of his best performances against Memphis this season.
- The freshman has combined to throw 10 innings of shutout baseball in two games against the Tigers.
- Those outings include a combined four hits (2 each game), nine strikeouts and no runs.
- He earned the first win of his collegiate career April 15 after tossing five innings and striking out a career-high six in the game.

SACRIFICING HIMSELF

- Dustin Jones ranks 11th among active NCAA players with 34 career sacrifice bunts in his career.
- Michael Faulkner holds the A-State career record for sac bunts with 37.

- Arkansas State capped off an impressive weekend in the city of Mobile by winning its first ever series against South Alabama in the state of Alabama.
- It was just the fifth series win for the Red Wolves out of the 25 series that the two teams have been played.

GAINES SHINES IN EXTRA INNINGS

- Tanner Gaines tossed 6.1 innings of scoreless baseball in A-State's 7-6 victory in extra-innings April 12 at South Alabama.
- Gaines entered the game with two outs in the seventh inning and proceeded to hold the Jaguars to just two hits and no ones to earn the win.

CRAFTY CROFT

- A-State closer Morgan Croft recorded three saves April 9-13 including a 5-pitch save against Central Arkansas on April 9.
- He finished out the week with back-to-back saves against USA April 12-13.

EXTRA, EXTRA!

- Since being inserted into the starting lineup on March 29th against Texas State, freshman Eric Wilcoxson has had 19 hits, nine of which have gone for extra bases.
- He has hit two home runs and five doubles during the span.

TWO OUT RBIs

- A-State has had 88 RBIs come with two outs in an inning so far this far.
- Matt Burgess, the team-leader in RBIs with 45, has driven in 17 runs with outs this season.

A TABLE-SETTER

- Zach Maggio tied career-highs in hits and runs scored in A-State's 7-5 victory over Western Kentucky on April 6.
- Maggio was a perfect 4-for-4 from the plate and reached base all five times he came up to bat in the game.
- He also scored four times during, tying a career high in that category.

THE RBI MACHINE

- Sophomore first baseman Matt Burgess tied a career-high with four RBIs in A-State's 7-5 victory over WKU on April 6.
- Burgess drove in three of his runs without the benefit of a hit. Two of his came on sacrifice fly

JONES EYES GAMES PLAYED RECORD

- Senior Dustin Jones is approaching the A-State record for most games played in a career.
- He has played in 213 games in his Red Wolves career.
- The record is 227 games by Chris Floyd from 1992-95.
- Jones also ranks 11th in the nation among active in players in career games played.

A POWER SURGE

- A-State hit three home runs in the March 25-30 to raise its season total to eight on the year.
- Austin Baker began the week with an inside-the-park home run, while Eric Wilcoxson hit his first career home run on March 29.
- Matt Burgess followed with a 2-run home run on March 30 to complete three home run week for the Red Wolves.

NO FENCE NO PROBLEM

- Austin Baker hit an inside the park home run against Memphis on March 25 with one runner on base.
- The last inside the park home run was by Todd Baumgartner on March 23, 2011 against Lyon College.

STRANGE BUT TRUE FACTS

- A-State is 17-3 when collecting at least 10 hits in a game this season.
- The 3rd and 7th innings have been A-State inning's to produce this season. A-State has out scored its opponents by a combined 92-39 in those innings (44-23 in the 3rd and 48-16 in 7th)
- When leading after 7 innings the Red Wolves are 21-1 and are a perfect 22-0 when leading after 8 innings.

IRON MAN

- A-State's Dustin Jones ranks 15th in the nation in consecutive starts in the nation at 149.
- His last non-start was on March 9, 2012 against Dayton, the only game in which he did not start that season.

TWICE AS WILD

- A-State senior Zach Maggio scored all the way from second base on a wild pitch Wednesday night against Ole Miss. The Rebels' catcher couldn't locate the ball when it bounced in the air and it only rolled a few feet away so Maggio rounded third and scored easily without a play at the plate.

STEALING HOME TWICE IN A WEEK

- A-State stole home twice in one week after stealing home just once in all of 2013.
- A-State's Matt Burgess completed a steal of home on March 11 at Murray State, while Dustin Jones stole home on March 14 at Tomlinson Stadium against UALR.
- In both instances, both were the results of double steals.
- A-State also stole home against UALR in 2013 when Kevin Fitzpatrick accomplished the feat in the second to last game of the year.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Sophomore outfielder Austin Baker set two records and tied another one with his performance against Murray State Tuesday. He finished the day 5-for-6 with seven runs scored, five RBI's, three home runs in three consecutive at-bats, and 14 total bases.
- Baker set the record for runs scored with seven, breaking the previous high of five that had been done three other times in school history, with the last being Isaac Dillon in 2005 vs. UNO.

WATCH IN THE STATE ZONE

Arkansas State University Athletics is pleased to announce that fans can now purchase a 24-Hour Pass to State Zone, the official audio and video portal of AStateRedWolves.com. With a one-time payment of \$4.95, fans can watch live video broadcasts of A-State athletic events for 24 straight hours from the time of the purchase.

State Zone offers fans live audio and video coverage of select games, including 30-plus baseball games, along with unlimited access to the largest A-State sports video library. Other packages offered by State Zone include a one-month deal for the price of \$8.95, four months for \$29.95, or one year for \$79.95.

The 14 total bases also set a new record, breaking the previous high of 13, which had been accomplished two other times in school history. Junior Collin Massanelli had 13 total bases last season on March 16, 2013 against UALR.

- Baker's three home runs also tied a school record for home runs with three, tying three other players including teammate Massanelli that had three against UALR on March 16, 2013.
- Junior infielder Lucas Feddersen tied the record for most at-bats in a game with eight, tying Bill Smith's record set in 1960 against St. Louis. Freshman catcher Tyler Hardie also tied a record with four walks against the Thoroughbreds, tying 16 other players in school history.
- A-State's 27 runs was the second-highest total in school history. Arkansas State's record is 28 runs scored against Memphis in 1992.

GRAND SALAMI ON RYE

- Sophomore Matt Burgess has continued his assault on opposing pitcher through the season's first two week's.
- He hit the Red Wolves first Grand Slam since 2011 on Feb. 23 against Illinois State with a bases loaded shot over the fence in right-centerfield in the bottom of the third inning.
- He was the first A-State player to hit a grand slam since Jordan Castaldo did it on May 25, 2011 against FIU.

OWEN HONORED BY COLLEGESPORTSMADNESS.COM

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week after his performance at UAB on March 2.
- Owen struck out a career-high 10 against the Blazers to lead A-State to a 5-3 victory.
- He became the first Red Wolves pitcher to strikeout 10 in a game since Bradley Wallace and Daniel Wright each did it in 2013.

PRESEASON SBC ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

- Redshirt junior infielder Zach George was named to the 2014 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference team, the first such honor of his career.
- George hit .333 a season ago but played just nine games before suffering a season-ending knee injury at Sam Houston State before the start of conference play. Despite the injury, George managed to hit one home run and drive in five runs and stole one base.

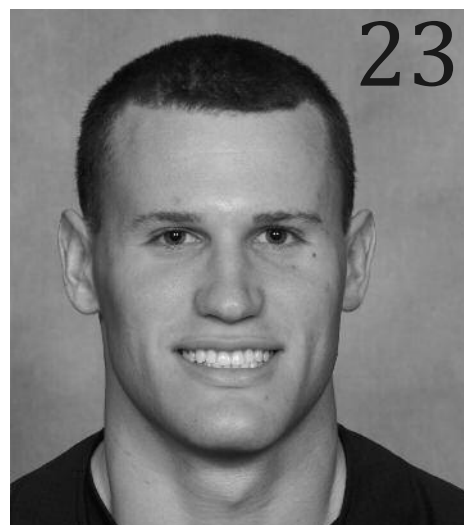
