LEADING OFF: The Arkansas State baseball will try to fight off elimination for a second straight day when it takes on the sixth-seeded Troy Trojans Friday at 6:30 p.m. at the Sun Belt Conference Baseball Championship in Mobile, Ala., on the campus of South Alabama University. The Red Wolves dropped the first game to Troy 4-3 in a SBC record 13 innings on May 21 and then rallied for two runs in the eighth inning on May 22 against South Alabama in an elimination game.

This is the second straight year that the Red Wolves and Trojans have met twice in the SBC Tournament. A-STATE/TROY SERIES HISTORY

- This will be the 35th meeting all-time between the two schools with Troy holding a 26-8 all-time advantage.
- A-State took two of three games from the Trojans May 10-11 after winning the nightcap of a doubleheader 10-7 and then defeated the Trojans 8-5 Sunday afternoon.
- This is the third straight season in which A-State and Troy have squared off at some point in the conference tournament. The Trojans have a 3-1 edge over the Red Wolves during that span.
- Overall this will be the seventh meeting all-time between A-State and Troy in the league to tournament, with Troy holding a 4-2 record over the Red Wolves.
- A-State also played Troy in the opening round of the tournament in 2013 and lost 3-2, but did eliminate the Trojans later in the tournament by a score of 3-2.
- A-State and Troy played each five times in 2013, including twice in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament. The Red Wolves eliminated the Trojans from the tournament with a 3-2 victory.

A-STATE IN THE SBC TOURNEY

- Arkansas State is making its fifth consecutive trip to the SBC Tourney, joining Troy, South Alabama and Western Kentucky as the only teams to have played in five straight tournaments over the same span.
- A-State has won at least two games in the tournament in each of the last four seasons, the only team in this year's field to have accomplished that feat.
- Arkansas State is 21-35 all-time in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament, but the Red Wolves have enjoyed success in the last three years.
- The Red Wolves went 2-1 in pool play in 2012 and reached the championship game against ULM.
- Arkansas State won two games to reach the semifinals following the 2010 season, and went 2-1 in 2011, but did not advance out of pool play.
- Arkansas State has advanced to the championship game of the tournament three times. The Red Wolves defeated Lamar 3-2 to win the tournament in 1994 and advance to the NCAA Central Regional in Austin, Texas. Arkansas State went 2-2 in the regional, losing to host Texas in the opening round 9-4, before defeating Nevada 4-2 and Texas-San Antonio 10-5. Arkansas State was eliminated with a 10-3 loss to eventual national champion Oklahoma.
- A-State was defeated by South Alabama 11-6 in the championship game in 1996.
- In 2012 A-State fell to ULM 4-2 in the championship game.
- Arkansas State is 2-3 in extra inning games in the tournament, defeating Lamar 3-2 in 11 innings and UNO 9-8 in 11 innings, both in 1994. The Red Wolves lost 13-10 in 10 innings to FIU in 2011, 12-8 in 11 innings to Troy in 2010 and to Lamar 4-3 in 13 innings in 1998.

A FAMILIAR FOE

- Friday night's meeting between A-State and Troy will be the 26th meeting since Tommy Raffo took over the A-State baseball program in 2009.
- Troy is the second most opponent the Red Wolves have played in the Tommy Raffo era.
- Raffo is 8-17 against Troy all-time.

WHAT A MARATHON

- A-State and Troy tied for the longest game in Sun Belt Conference Tournament history in their opening round game on March 21.
- The team played 13 innings and with the Trojans defeating the Red Wolves 4-3.
- It was the second time that A-State had played 13 innings in the SBC Tournament. The first was in 1998 against Lamar, a game in which the Red Wolves lost 4-3.
- It was also A-State's first extra inning game in the tournament since 2011.
- The last 13 inning in the SBC Tournament was in 2012 when FAU and ULM went 13 innings.

BULLPEN DOMINANT IN TOURNAMENT

- The A-State bullpen has been tough to score against during the 2014 SBC Tournament. In 11 2/3 innings the bullpen has allowed just two runs.
- Freshman Tyler Zuber has been near perfect. In 4 2/3 innings in Thursday’s opening round game against Troy he surrendered just one run on one hit.

CARDIAC KIDS

- A-State has had a flare for the dramatic during the SBC Tournament. The Red Wolves rallied from two runs on May 21 to force extra-innings against Troy before eventually falling in the 13th inning.
- In its elimination game on May 22 against South Alabama. the Red Wolves scored two runs in the eighth inning to take the lead and held to a one run advantage in the ninth to close out the win.

HISTORY ON A-STATE’S SIDE

- The Sun Belt Conference Tournament has been kind to Arkansas State in its history in Mobile, with A-State holding a 7-11 record all-time in the tourney in Mobile.
- The last time Arkansas State won the SBC Tournament was in 1994 in Mobile. The Red Wolves also entered as the No. 3 seed that season.

CLOSING IN ON RECORDS

- Several players on this year’s squad are approaching single season records. Below is a list of where they stand:
 - Doubles: Stuart Levy - 19 (Third Most in a Single Season - Record 23, Josh Yates, 2006)
 - Appearances: Colton Kibler - 30 (Tied Third Most in Single Season - Record 32, 2007)
 - Pitching Strikeouts: 419 - Currently Ranks third in a single season (Record is 487 set in 2013)
 - Team Fielding Percentage: .973 - Tied Highest (.973 in 2012)

A-STATE BULLPEN SHUTS DOWN UALR

- In 19 1/3 innings against the Trojans this season, the Arkansas State bullpen has given up just five runs and struck out 15.

CAN’T BE SWEEP UNDER THE RUG

- For just the fifth time (and first since 2012) in school history, Arkansas State avoided being swept (3-game series) for an entire year.
- On the flip side, the Red Wolves swept three series this season, also the most since 2012.

OWEN NAMED TO OLSON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named to the Gregg Olson “Breakout Player of the Year” watch list.
- Owen is the first Arkansas State player to be named to the award watch list.
- He is one of five Sun Belt players on the list and also just one of 80 players overall.

WHAT A CROWD

- A crowd of 1,143 was on hand on May 13 at Tomlinson Stadium to watch A-State take on No. 11 Ole Miss and set a new record for the largest crowd ever to watch a game at the stadium.
- The previous high was 1,019 in 2008 against Memphis.

RED WOLVES “WEARING” PITCHES

- The Red Wolves have been hit by 82 pitches for this season surpassing last year’s total of 52.
- This year, A-State had a stretch of 12 straight games with a hit by pitch and has had 18 games where it has had multiple HBP.
- The team ranks second in the Sun Belt in total HPB.

A ZUBER STAR

- Freshman Tyler Zuber recorded two saves against Troy to bring his season total to four since taking over the backend duties in the bullpen.
- Zuber has been fantastic in Sun Belt Conference play, sporting a 1.35 ERA in 13.1 innings in allowing just two runs.

SINGLED OUT

- A-State had 12 hits, all singles, in its 8-5 victory over Troy to clinch the series on May 11.
- It was the seventh time this season that A-State has had everyone one of hits in a game be singles.
- It was also the secone time this season that A-State had 12 hits in a game and have them all be singles. A-State also had 12 singles against UALR on March 15 in a victory in that series finale.

TAKING DOWN NO. 2

- A-State defeated No.2 Louisiana-Lafayette 6-4 on May 4. The Ragin' Cajuns were the highest ranked team to ever play at Tomlinson Stadium and the highest ranked team that A-State has ever defeated in Jonesboro.
- The highest ranked team A-State had defeated was No. 2 Ole Miss in 2008. A-State defeated the Rebels 7-5 in Oxford.
- Since 2003, A-State is 9-19 against ranked opponents at Tomlinson Stadium. Prior to this year's victory the last home victory over a ranked opponent was during the 2012 season in a 10-5 victory over No. 22 Ole Miss.

WALLACE TIES CAREER-HIGH

- Senior right-hander Bradley Wallace tied a career-high with 12 strikeouts against No. 2 ULL on May 3.
- Wallace also struck out 12 against Western Kentucky in 2013.
- He is the third A-State pitcher to reach double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (David Owen and Chandler Hawkins have also equaled the feat.)
- Wallace and Cody Woodhouse combined to strikeout 17 in the game, the highest mark for team strikeouts in a single-game this season for A-State.

BAKER RUNS WILD ON THOROUGHBREDS

- In two games against Murray State this season, Austin Baker has a tremendous amount of success.
- He has totaled eight RBIs, seven hits and 18 total bases in those two games and set school records for total bases in a single home and tied the school record for home runs in a single game with 3.

ANY BATTER AT ANY TIME

- Through 57 games this season all 13 of 17 Red Wolves with an at-bat this season have at least two RBIs in a single game and all 17 have at least one RBI on the year.
- In addition, 13 of 17 Red Wolves with an AB this season have recorded multiple hits in a game.

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME

- A-State head coach Tommy Raffo has gone 38-42-1 in the month of May since arriving at the school.
- The Red Wolves went 11-4 in th month in 2011-12 and advanced to the finals of the SBC Tournament.

NUMBERS NEVER LIE

- A-State is having one of its best seasons at the plate in recent memory by averaging 9.07 hits per game, the most since the 2011 season when the team averaged 9.49 per game.
- The team’s 1.91 doubles per outing are also the most since 2010 (1.90).
- The Red Wolves are also scoring more runs and are averaging right at 5.82 runs per game, the most since 2010 when scored 6.50 runs per game.

NO PLACE LIKE THE TOM

- A-State has made Tomlinson Stadium one of the toughest places to play in the SBC this season.
- The Red Wolves are 20-9 are home this season and 11-4 in conference play when playing on Kell Field. (Two games were played in Millington, Tenn., due to a rain/snow in Jonesboro. They were not included.)

SACRIFICING HIMSELF

- Dustin Jones ranks 19th among active NCAA players with 35 career sacrifice bunts in his career.
- Jones recently passed Michael Faulkner for the career record for total sacrifices (bunts and flies) with 40. Michael Faulkner held the preveious record with 33.

JONES EYES GAMES PLAYED RECORD

- Senior Dustin Jones is approaching the A-State record for most games played in a career.
- He has played in 226 games in his Red Wolves career.
- The record is 227 games by Chris Floyd from 1992-95.
- Jones also ranks 12th in the nation among active in players in career games played.

IRON MAN

- A-State’s Dustin Jones ranks 15th in the nation in consecutive starts in the nation at 159.
- His last non-start was on March 9, 2012 against Dayton, the only game in which he did not start that season.

- A-State is 21-4 when collecting at least 10 hits in a game this season.
- The 3rd and 7th innings have been A-State inning’s to produce this season. A-State has out scored its opponents by a combined 108-55 in those innings (51-34 in the 3rd and 57-21 in 7th)
- When leading after 7 innings the Red Wolves are 26-1 and are 28-1 when leading after 8 innings.

State Zone offers fans live audio and video coverage of select games, including 30-plus baseball games, along with unlimited access to the largest A-State sports video library. Other packages offered by State Zone include a one-month deal for the price of \$8.95, four months for \$29.95, or one year for \$79.95.

UNDER PRESSURE

- Of the 16 runs that Arkansas State in the series at Georgia State (April 25-27), 10 of them came with two outs.
- In Saturday's 7-6 loss, all six of A-State's runs were scored with two outs.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

- A-State has a 11-1 record on Sunday's this season.
- It's only loss was a 5-4 loss to Creighton on March 9 in the second game of a three-game series.

OWNING THE LAST GAME

- A-State has played 14 weekend series this season and has won the final game in each of those series.
- Eleven of those victories have come on Sunday, with two on Saturday (UALR series) and the other was on a Monday (Creighton).

HAWKINS DOMINATES BEARS

- Junior LHP Chandler Hawkins had a career night at Central Arkansas on April 22.
- In his first midweek start of the year, Hawkins fanned a career-high 10 in five innings of work.
- Hawkins retired eight in a row at one point and struck out five out looking on the night.
- He is the second A-State pitcher to reach double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (David Owen has struck out 10 twice.)

SWEEPS WEEK

- A-State swept its third weekend opponent of the 2014 season with three victories over Louisiana-Monroe April 18-20.
- The Warhawks are also the second SBC opponent that the Red Wolves have swept this season (UALR was the first during the opening weekend of the conference).
- The Red Wolves also completed a midweek season sweep of Memphis earlier in the week, marking the first-time since 2009 that A-State had defeated the Tigers twice in one season.

FIELDER'S CHOICE WALK-OFF

- A-State completed a comeback from five runs down against ULM on April 20 in the most unusual way with a fielder's choice walk-off.
- The Red Wolves won the game by scoring four runs in the bottom of the ninth inning, included the game winning run on a fielder's choice by Ty Michelotti. The freshman hit a slow ground ball to second and the throw came home and but was too late as Zach Maggio scored the winning run.

BURGESS EARNS WEEKLY SBC HONOR

- Sophomore Matt Burgess became the first Arkansas State position player since 2009 to be named the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week when the league revealed the weekly award on April 21.
- The last A-State position player to win the award was Michael Faulkner back in 2011.
- A pair of A-State pitcher (Jacob Lee and Daniel Wright) have been named the SBC Pitcher of the Week since that time.
- Burgess is the 21st position player to win the award in A-State history and the 47th overall (includes hitters and pitchers).
- Sophomore Matt Burgess was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com SBC Player of the Week on April 21.
- He is the second A-State player to be honored by the website this season (David Owen also earned POW honors earlier this season.)

THE TIGER SLAYER

- Tyler Zuber has had two of his best performances against Memphis this season.
- The freshman has combined to throw 10 innings of shutout baseball in two games against the Tigers.
- Those outings include a combined four hits (2 each game), nine strikeouts and no runs.
- He earned the first win of his collegiate career April 15 after tossing five innings and striking out a career-high six in the game.

NO FENCE NO PROBLEM

- Austin Baker hit an inside the park home run against Memphis on March 25 with one runner on base.
- The last inside the park home run was by Todd Baumgartner on March 23, 2011 against Lyon College.

STEALING HOME TWICE IN A WEEK

- A-State stole home twice in one week after stealing home just once in all of 2013.
- A-State's Matt Burgess completed a steal of home on March 11 at Murray State, while Dustin Jones stole home on March 14 at Tomlinson Stadium against UALR.
- In both instances, both were the results of double steals.
- A-State also stole home against UALR in 2013 when Kevin Fitzpatrick accomplished the feat in the second to last game of the year.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Sophomore outfielder Austin Baker set two records and tied another one with his performance against Murray State Tuesday. He finished the day 5-for-6 with seven runs scored, five RBI's, three home runs in three consecutive at-bats, and 14 total bases.
- Baker set the record for runs scored with seven, breaking the previous high of five that had been done three other times in school history, with the last being Isaac Dillon in 2005 vs. UNO. The 14 total bases also set a new record, breaking the previous high of 13, which had been accomplished two other times in school history. Junior Collin Massanelli had 13 total bases last season on March 16, 2013 against UALR.
- Baker's three home runs also tied a school record for home runs with three, tying three other players including teammate Massanelli that had three against UALR on March 16, 2013.
- Junior infielder Lucas Feddersen tied the record for most at-bats in a game with eight, tying Bill Smith's record set in 1960 against St. Louis. Freshman catcher Tyler Hardie also tied a record with four walks against the Thoroughbreds, tying 16 other players in school history.
- A-State's 27 runs was the second-highest total in school history. Arkansas State's record is 28 runs scored against Memphis in 1992.

OWEN HONORED BY COLLEGESPORTSMADNESS.COM

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week after his performance at UAB on March 2.
- Owen struck out a career-high 10 against the Blazers to lead A-State to a 5-3 victory.
- He became the first Red Wolves pitcher to strikeout 10 in a game since Bradley Wallace and Daniel Wright each did it in 2013.

WALLACE RECOGNIZED AS TOP SENIOR

- A-State senior pitcher Bradley Wallace was named as the top 100 seniors in the class of 2014 by Perfect Game USA.
- Wallace was selected as the 28th best senior baseball player in the class of 2014 and the 16th best right-handed pitcher in the class. He was one of just two players from the Sun Belt Conference on the list with Louisiana-Lafayette first basemen Chase Compton ranking 61st.
