A-STATE/UTA SERIES HISTORY

- Saturday's game will be the 70th meeting all-time between A-State and UT Arlington.
- The Red Wolves are 34-35 all-time against the Mavericks.
- A-State and UT Arlington were former Southland Conference foes from 1969 to 1986 with the Red Wolves taking the first six meetings from the Mavericks from 1969-1971.
- The Red Wolves took two of three games from the Mavericks in Arlington earlier this year.
- This will be just the second time that A-State and UTA have met in a postseason tournament. The teams met in the 1981 Southland Conference Tournament with the Mavericks winning 5-2.
- Geoff Desmond had the most putouts in an A-State game in 2005 vs UTA.

A-STATE IN THE SBC TOURNEY

- Arkansas State is making its fifth consecutive trip to the SBC Tourney, joining Troy, South Alabama and Western Kentucky as the only teams to have played in five straight tournaments over the same span.
- A-State has won at least two games in the tournament in each of the last four seasons, the only team in this year's field to have accomplished that feat.
- Arkansas State is 22-35 all-time in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament, but the Red Wolves have enjoyed success in the last three years.
- The Red Wolves went 2-1 in pool play in 2012 and reached the championship game against ULM.
- Arkansas State won two games to reach the semifinals following the 2010 season, and went 2-1 in 2011, but did not advance out of pool play.
- Arkansas State has advanced to the championship game of the tournament three times. The Red Wolves defeated Lamar 3-2 to win the tournament in 1994 and advance to the NCAA Central Regional in Austin, Texas. Arkansas State went 2-2 in the regional, losing to host Texas in the opening round 9-4, before defeating Nevada 4-2 and Texas-San Antonio 10-5. Arkansas State was eliminated with a 10-3 loss to eventual national champion Oklahoma.
- A-State was defeated by South Alabama 11-6 in the championship game in 1996.
- In 2012 A-State fell to ULM 4-2 in the championship game.
- Arkansas State is 2-3 in extra inning games in the tournament, defeating Lamar 3-2 in 11 innings and UNO 9-8 in 11 innings, both in 1994. The Red Wolves lost 13-10 in 10 innings to FIU in 2011, 12-8 in 11 innings to Troy in 2010 and to Lamar 4-3 in 13 innings in 1998.

GREAT TIME FOR A SHUTOUT

- Arkansas State's 12-0 victory over Troy Friday night was the first shutout in victory in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament since 2011 when A-State defeated ULL 3-0.
- It was the first run-ruled shutout game in the tournament since 2008 when New Orleans defeated ULL 10-0.

IRON MAN IS SO CLUTCH

- Dustin Jones hit the third home run of his career Friday, May 23 against Troy in elimination game in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.
- Jones hit the home run on the same night he tied the A-State record for most games played in a career at 227.
- Two of his three career home runs have come in the SBC Tournament. His first came as a freshman in 2011 against South Alabama.

IN THE SEMIS AGAIN

- A-State has made it to the "Semifinals" of the Sun Belt Conference Championship Tournament in each of the last two seasons.
- In 2013 the team advanced to Saturday as the No. 8 seed and this season the team has advanced through as the No. 3 seed.

I'LL TAKE A #12

- A-State has scored 12 runs (includes a game scoring 13) five times in the SBC Tournament and is a perfect 5-0 in those games.
- Four of those times have happened since 2010. The Red Wolves scored 12 runs twice in 2012 and once each in 2011 and 2010 in the SBC Tournament.

WHAT A GEM

- Junior lefty Chandler Hawkins turned in one of his best performances of the season in the Red Wolves 12-0 victory over Troy Friday night.
- Hawkins went just three batter over the minimum and gave three hits and two walks but got two double play balls in 7-inning complete game shutout.
- He also needed just 66 pitches to get through the game and became the first A-State pitcher to throw a complete game this season.

WHAT A MARATHON

- A-State and Troy tied for the longest game in Sun Belt Conference Tournament history in their opening round game on March 21.
- The team played 13 innings and with the Trojans defeating the Red Wolves 4-3.
- It was the second time that A-State had played 13 innings in the SBC Tournament. The first was in 1998 against Lamar, a game in which the Red Wolves lost 4-3.
- It was also A-State's first extra inning game in the tournament since 2011.
- The last 13 inning in the SBC Tournament was in 2012 when FAU and ULM went 13 innings.

BULLPEN DOMINANT IN TOURNAMENT

- The A-State bullpen has been tough to score against during the 2014 SBC Tournament. In 11 2/3 innings the bullpen has allowed just two runs.
- Freshman Tyler Zuber has been near perfect. In 4 2/3 innings in Thursday's opening round game against Troy he surrendered just one run on one hit.

CARDIAC KIDS

- A-State has had a flare for the dramatic during the SBC Tournament. The Red Wolves rallied from two runs on May 21 to force extra-innings against Troy before eventually falling in the 13th inning.
- In its elimination game on May 22 against South Alabama. the Red Wolves scored two runs in the eighth inning to take the lead and held to a one run advantage in the ninth to close out the win.

HISTORY ON A-STATE'S SIDE

- The Sun Belt Conference Tournament has been kind to Arkansas State in its history in Mobile, with A-State holding a 9-12 record all-time in the tourney in Mobile.
- The last time Arkansas State won the SBC Tournament was in 1994 in Mobile. The Red Wolves also entered as the No. 3 seed that season.

CAN'T BE SWEEPED UNDER THE RUG

- For just the fifth time (and first since 2012) in school history, Arkansas State avoided being swept (3-game series) for an entire year.
- On the flip side, the Red Wolves swept three series this season, also the most since 2012.

OWEN NAMED TO OLSON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named to the Gregg Olson "Breakout Player of the Year" watch list.
- Owen is the first Arkansas State player to be named to the award watch list.
- He is one of five Sun Belt players on the list and also just one of 80 players overall.

WHAT A CROWD

- A crowd of 1,143 was on hand on May 13 at Tomlinson Stadium to watch A-State take on No. 11 Ole Miss and set a new record for the largest crowd ever to watch a game at the stadium.
- The previous high was 1,019 in 2008 against Memphis.

RED WOLVES "WEARING" PITCHES

- The Red Wolves have been hit by 82 pitches for this season surpassing last year's total of 52.
- This year, A-State had a stretch of 12 straight games with a hit by pitch and has had 18 games where it has had multiple HBP.
- The team ranks second in the Sun Belt in total HPB.

A ZUBER STAR

- Freshman Tyler Zuber recorded two saves against Troy to bring his season total to four since taking over the backend duties in the bullpen.
- Zuber has been fantastic in Sun Belt Conference play, sporting a 1.35 ERA in 13.1 innings in allowing just two runs.

SINGLED OUT

- A-State had 12 hits, all singles, in its 8-5 victory over Troy to clinch the series on May 11.
- It was the seventh time this season that A-State has had everyone one of hits in a game be singles.
- It was also the second time this season that A-State had 12 hits in a game and have them all be singles. A-State also had 12 singles against UALR on March 15 in a victory in that series finale.

TAKING DOWN NO. 2

- A-State defeated No.2 Louisiana-Lafayette 6-4 on May 4. The Ragin' Cajuns were the highest ranked team to ever play at Tomlinson Stadium and the highest ranked team that A-State has ever defeated in Jonesboro.
- The highest ranked team A-State had defeated was No. 2 Ole Miss in 2008. A-State defeated the Rebels 7-5 in Oxford.
- Since 2003, A-State is 9-19 against ranked opponents at Tomlinson Stadium. Prior to this year's victory the last home victory over a ranked opponent was during the 2012 season in a 10-5 victory over No. 22 Ole Miss.

WALLACE TIES CAREER-HIGH

- Senior right-hander Bradley Wallace tied a career-high with 12 strikeouts against No. 2 ULL on May 3.
- Wallace also struck out 12 against Western Kentucky in 2013.
- He is the third A-State pitcher to reach double-digit strikeouts in a game this season (David Owen and Chandler Hawkins have also equaled the feat.)
- Wallace and Cody Woodhouse combined to strikeout 17 in the game, the highest mark for team strikeouts in a single-game this season for A-State.

BAKER RUNS WILD ON THOROUGHBREDS

- In two games against Murray State this season, Austin Baker has a tremendous amount of success.
- He has totaled eight RBIs, seven hits and 18 total bases in those two games and set school records for total bases in a single home and tied the school record for home runs in a single game with 3.

ANY BATTER AT ANY TIME

- Through 57 games this season all 13 of 17 Red Wolves with an at-bat this season have at least two RBIs in a single game and all 17 have at least one RBI on the year.
- In addition, 13 of 17 Red Wolves with an AB this season have recorded multiple hits in a game.

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME

- A-State head coach Tommy Raffo has gone 39-42-1 in the month of May since arriving at the school.
- The Red Wolves went 11-4 in th month in 2011-12 and advanced to the finals of the SBC Tournament.

NO PLACE LIKE THE TOM

- A-State has made Tomlinson Stadium one of the toughest places to play in the SBC this season.
- The Red Wolves are 20-9 are home this season and 11-4 in conference play when playing on Kell Field. (Two games were played in Millington, Tenn., due to a rain/snow in Jonesboro. They were not included.)

SACRIFICING HIMSELF

- Dustin Jones ranks 19th among active NCAA players with 35 career sacrifice bunts in his career.
- Jones recently passed Michael Faulkner for the career record for total sacrifices (bunts and flies) with 40. Michael Faulkner held the preveious record with 33.

JONES EYES GAMES PLAYED RECORD

- Senior Dustin Jones is tied for the A-State record for most games played in a career.

STEALING HOME TWICE IN A WEEK

- A-State stole home twice in one week after stealing home just once in all of 2013.
- A-State's Matt Burgess completed a steal of home on March 11 at Murray State, while Dustin Jones stole home on March 14 at Tomlinson Stadium against UALR.
- In both instances, both were the results of double steals.
- A-State also stole home against UALR in 2013 when Kevin Fitzpatrick accomplished the feat in the second to last game of the year.

REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

- Sophomore outfielder Austin Baker set two records and tied another one with his performance against Murray State Tuesday. He finished the day 5-for-6 with seven runs scored, five RBI's, three home runs in three consecutive at-bats, and 14 total bases.
- Baker set the record for runs scored with seven, breaking the previous high of five that had been done three other times in school history, with the last being Isaac Dillon in 2005 vs. UNO. The 14 total bases also set a new record, breaking the previous high of 13, which had been accomplished two other times in school history. Junior Collin Massanelli had 13 total bases last season on March 16, 2013 against UALR.

- Junior infielder Lucas Feddersen tied the record for most at-bats in a game with eight, tying Bill Smith's record set in 1960 against St. Louis. Freshman catcher Tyler Hardie also tied a record with four walks against the Thoroughbreds, tying 16 other players in school history.
- A-State's 27 runs was the second-highest total in school history. Arkansas State's record is 28 runs scored against Memphis in 1992.

OWEN HONORED BY COLLEGESPORTSMADNESS.COM

- Sophomore pitcher David Owen was named the CollegeSportsMadness.com Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week after his performance at UAB on March 2.
- Owen struck out a career-high 10 against the Blazers to lead A-State to a 5-3 victory.
- He became the first Red Wolves pitcher to strikeout 10 in a game since Bradley Wallace and Daniel Wright each did it in 2013.

WALLACE RECOGNIZED AS TOP SENIOR

- A-State senior pitcher Bradley Wallace was named as the top 100 seniors in the class of 2014 by Perfect Game USA.
- Wallace was selected as the 28th best senior baseball player in the class of 2014 and the 16th best right-handed pitcher in the class. He was one of just two players from the Sun Belt Conference on the list with Louisiana-Lafayette first basemen Chase Compton ranking 61st.

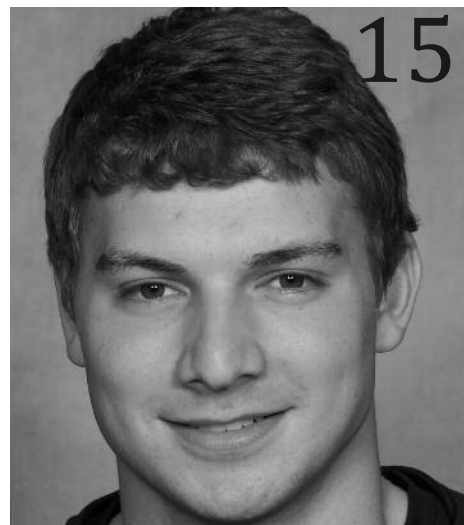
