QUICK HITS

- A-State rallied from a nine point deficit in the second half and outscored Texas State 12-7 in overtime to pick up a 78-73 Sun Belt Conference victory on Saturday at the Convocation Center.
- The Red Wolves play 11 games in the month of January, the most since A-State had 11 games in the 1986-87 season.
- The 2014-15 campaign represents the program's 87th season as the Red Wolves have presently amassed a 1,150-1,085 all-time record (.515 win pct.) dating back their inaugural 1926-27 season. A-State has won at least 20 games in a season five times - 1986-87 (21-13), 1987-88 (21-14), 1988-89 (20-10), 1990-91 (23-9) and 1997-98 (20-9) since joining the NCAA-I ranks in 1970-71.
- A-State has amassed a record of 199-194 (.506) since joining the Sun Belt Conference in the 1991-92 season. With Saturday's win, A-State is now 129-65 (.665) in home SBC games while the road record sits at 70-128 (.354).
- The Red Wolves improved to 8-1 on the season when pulling down 35-plus rebounds as A-State out-rebounded Texas State 41-39 on Saturday. A-State is 7-2 when attempting fewer three-pointers in the second half compared to the first half and 7-2 when shooting a better field goal percentage than their opposition.
- Anthony Livingston posted his seventh double-double as he had a game-high 24 points and 15 rebounds against Texas State. Cameron Golden poured in 22 points, his second-straight game with 20-plus points. Nouhoum Bocoum added 14 points of the bench to tie his career high.

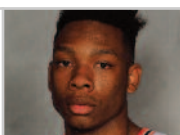

Georgia State leads 4-1
A-State streak: L3

- Arkansas State and Georgia State resume the conference series with the Panthers holding a 4-1 edge in five previous meetings.
- Coming off a four overtime thriller in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament last year, A-State was defeated by Georgia State 72-45 in the last meeting.
- In the Sun Belt Conference semifinal matchup, Kendrick Washington led the Red Wolves with 12 points and 12 boards. Melvin Johnson III scored 10 points to go along with six rebounds.
- Georgia State shot 50 percent (26-52) in the game and the Panthers were 70 percent (14-20) from the charity stripe. A-State finished 32 percent (17-53) from the field and 43 percent (6-14) at the free throw line.
- Georgia State won both regular season meetings last year, including a 79-76 overtime defeat of A-State at the Convocation Center. The Red Wolves held a three-point lead with just over a minute left, but Melvin Johnson III hit a game-tying three-pointer to send the game to overtime. A-State had four players finish in double figures in the contest. Melvin Johnson III led with 19 points while Kirk Van Slyke totaled 18 points. Cameron Golden and Brandon Reed each tallied 13 points.
- The Panthers edged the Red Wolves 73-72 in Atlanta last year. Cameron Golden missed the mark with three seconds left and a layup by Brandon Reed rimmed out as Georgia state held off A-State. Kirk Van Slyke led the Red Wolves with 22 points and 10 rebounds. Kendrick Washington finished with 12 points and nine rebounds while Golden finished with 10 points.
- Georgia State and Arkansas State met 10 days apart in the 1995-96 campaign with the road team winning each matchup. The Panthers took the first meeting (Dec. 9, 1995) by a score of 72-57, but A-State got revenge with a 74-67 win in Atlanta on Dec. 19, 1995.

SCOUTING GEORGIA STATE

- Georgia State, the defending Sun Belt Conference champions, enters Monday's game with an 11-7 overall record and a 4-3 mark in league play. The Panthers suffered a 74-69 setback at Appalachian State on Saturday after defeating UT Arlington 83-62 on their home floor on Thursday night.
- The Panthers are 7-1 on their home floor this season, but just 2-6 on the road including 0-2 in conference play.
- Georgia State has two players, Ryan Harrow (20.4) and R.J. Hunter (20.1), averaging 20-plus points per game. Harrow and Hunter rank second and third, respectively, in league scoring average. The duo combines to average 40.5 PPG, tied for the third-most of any duo in the country. Hunter needs 24 points to break the Panthers career scoring record.
- The Panthers average 73.9 PPG to rank second among Sun Belt Conference teams. Defensively, Georgia State ranks fourth allowing 66.4 PPG. The Panthers lead the league in field goal percentage shooting 49 percent from the field. Georgia State also leads the league in steals, snagging 9.4 per game, and assist to turnover ratio with an average of 14.4 assists and 10.9 turnovers per game.
- Ron Hunter is in his fourth season at Georgia State with an impressive record of 73-44. In 21 seasons as a head coach, Hunter has a 347-263 record. Ron Hunter played collegiately at Miami (Ohio) and helped the Redhawks compile an 81-30 record during his four-year career, including three appearances at the NCAA Tournament.

INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- A-State has hauled in 41 rebounds in the last two games to improve to 8-1 on the season when pulling down 35 or more rebounds. The lone loss in which the Red Wolves reached 35-plus rebounds was a 73-65 setback at Toledo
- The Red Wolves are 7-2 on the season when having fewer three-point attempts in the second half than in the first half. A-State was 1-9 in first half against Texas State on Saturday, but 4-8 in the second half. Further, in the nine games in which A-State has fewer three-point attempts in the second half, the Red Wolves have outscored their opponents 309-258 in the second half alone. In the first half of those games, A-State has been outscored 303-265.
- The Red Wolves are 7-3 when 25 or more of their points are inside the painted area.
- A-State is 7-5 this season when Anthony Livingston attempts 10 or more shots, but 1-3 when he is unable to reach 10 field goal attempts.

EXTRA TIME

- A-State is 2-0 in overtime this season, both wins coming in league play against South Alabama and Texas State. The Red Wolves are 8-9 in overtime games under head coach John Brady.
- The Red Wolves have won three-straight games in overtime dating back to the four overtime thriller against UALR in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament last year. A-State's last overtime loss came at the hands of Georgia State on March 4 at the Convocation Center.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE GAMES

- The Red Wolves are 199-194 (.506) since joining the Sun Belt Conference (SBC) in the 1991-92 season, which includes a season-best 14-4 (.778) mark in the 1997-98 campaign.
- A-State sports a 129-65 (.665) record at home and is 70-128 (.354) on the road in Sun Belt action.
- ASU head coach John Brady has registered a 58-55 (.513) record in Sun Belt Conference contests since his arrival in the 2008-09 season, which consists of a 40-15 (.727) home ledger and a 18-40 (.310) away mark.

@AStateMB Knocks Off Texas State
78-73 In Overtime

- The Arkansas State men's basketball team rallied from nine points down in the second half and outscored Texas State 12-7 in overtime to pick up a 78-73 Sun Belt Conference victory Saturday night at the Convocation Center.
- Sophomore forward Anthony Livingston scored 24 points and hauled in 15 rebounds, both game highs, to lead A-State (8-8, 3-4) to its second straight victory. Junior guard Cameron Golden added 22 points, including 13 in the second half and overtime periods combined, to help the Red Wolves collect their third home win of the season.
- Texas State (10-6, 4-3) scored the first bucket of the second half to take a 35-26 advantage, but the Red Wolves went on a 10-0 run over the next four minutes to take their first lead since the game's opening minutes. The remainder of the second half featured 10 lead changes and six ties as neither team led by more than four points.
- With the score tied 60-60 at the 3:03 mark, the final minutes of regulation were a back-and-forth battle. A-State went up two on a Golden layup, but the Bobcats answered with a three by Wes Davis on their next possession. Livingston followed with a three that put A-State back on top 65-63 with 1:05 left, and he then made 1-of-2 free throws with 21 seconds remaining to make the Red Wolves' lead three. However, Davis made another three with nine seconds left on the clock to tie the game at 66-66. A-State had a couple of opportunities in the final seconds, but a missed layup and short put-back attempt fell off the mark as time expired.
- A-State scored the first six overtime points on a pair of Golden free throws, a Livingston layup and two more free throws by junior forward Charles Waters. Texas State's Emani Gant had the answer as they hit a three on two of their next three possessions to tie the game once again. Livingston put the Red Wolves back on top for good when he made a layup with 36 seconds left. The shot gave A-State a 74-72 lead.

A-STATE IN JANUARY GAMES

- The Red Wolves have started the new calendar year with an 2-4 mark and are in the midst of a tough January slate.
- Dating back to the 2010-11 season, the Red Wolves are 15-7 at home and 4-14 in January road games.
- A-State has a total of 11 games this month, the most in the month of January since the 1986-87 season. The 1982-83 schedule had the most January games, with A-State going 8-5 in 13 games.
- Since the 2000-01 season, the Red Wolves have a record of 63-59 (.516) in January outings. A-State is 43-20 (.694) at home and 20-39 (.339) on the road in that span of January contests.
- Under head coach John Brady, A-State is 31-26 (.544) in January games, 23-8 (.742) at home and 8-18 (.308) on the road.

LOOKING FOR A CHARITY

- A-State averages 13 free throw makes a game this year, shooting 71 percent from the charity stripe (209-294). The Red Wolves sport a 7-4 record when making 12 or more free throws in a game.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- The Red Wolves bench scored 19 points against Texas State, just the ninth time in 16 games that the bench reached double figures.
- The top bench performance of the season came against Belhaven with the reserves scoring 20 points.
- On the season, A-State's bench has been outscored 357-157, an average of 12.5 points per game.
- A-State is 3-1 on the season when the bench is even or outscores the opponent.

ROAD SUCCESS

- The 2014-15 Red Wolves are on the hunt for the single-season record of eight road wins set in the 1973-74 season.
- A-State is 5-4 on the road thus far, picking up a fifth road win on Thursday at Appalachian State.
- Last year, A-State was 7-7 on the road, just shy of tying the mark.
- A-State has the most road wins of any Sun Belt Conference member thus far, one better than Georgia Southern who sports a 4-4 road record.

DURE IS PURE

- Junior guard Frederic Dure made his first appearance with the Red Wolves on Saturday after sitting out the first 15 games due to NCAA rules.
- Dure played seven minutes, all in the second half, and drained his lone shot, a three-pointer from the left wing that gave A-State a 46-45 lead with 11:39 remaining in the game against Texas State.
- Dure was a first-team all-star and All-Region Nine First-Team selection at Sheridan (Wyo.) Junior College in 2013-14 helping lead the Generals to a conference

- He compiled 26 double-digit scoring performances and scored 20 or more points on 10 occasions, including a high of 29 points.
- Averaged 15.1 pts, 4.5 rebs, 1.9 assists, and 1.1 steals per game in the 2013-14 season.
- Averaged 10.6 pts and 3.6 rebounds in the 2012-13 campaign.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE LIVINGSTON

- Sophomore forward Anthony Livingston has posted double-doubles in both games last week and has seven on the year, most among any player in the Sun Belt Conference.
- Livingston is second on the team in scoring (15.6), a total that ranks second in SBC and 159th nationally. Livingston is second in the SBC in rebounding (9.1) and ranks 33rd nationally. His field goal percentage (48.4) ranks 13th in the league and 103rd nationally.

PASSING WITH PJ

- A-State redshirt sophomore point guard PJ Hardwick dished out 15 assists and scored 10 points against Appalachian State on Jan. 3rd for his first double-double of the year. His 15 assists tied the Convocation Center record set by Chico Fletcher and was two shy of Fletcher's single-game record.
- Ohio State's Shannon Scott, who had 16 assists in a game, is the only player this season with more assists.
- Hardwick, who has 91 assists in 14 games, is on pace for 176 assists, a season total that would rank him fifth. Hardwick leads the SBC in assists per game (6.5) and is ninth nationally. His assist to turnover ratio of 2.6 leads the league and is 42nd nationally.

PJ BECOMING A SCORER

- PJ Hardwick has found his touch shooting the ball recently as he has scored double figures in four of the last six games. Hardwick followed a career high of 15 points at ULM with 12 points against Georgia Southern. Hardwick reached double figures for the first time with 10 points against Appalachian State Jan. 3rd and he poured in 11 points in the second meeting with the Mountaineers.
- Hardwick is 18-of-43 (42 percent) from the field in the last four games after starting the season 11-of-34 (32 percent).

THE GOLDEN RULE

- Junior guard Cameron Golden has scored 20 points in back-to-back games and he has found his rhythm shooting the rock. Golden is shooting 43 percent (13-30) from the floor and 33 percent (4-12) from three in the last two games.
- On the season, A-State is 7-3 this year when Golden shoots 33 percent or better from the floor.
- With an average of 15.8 PPG, Golden ranks seventh in the conference and 146th nationally. He is team's leader in steals with a 1.9 SPG mark, a total that ranks seventh in the SBC and 111th nationally.

DOUBLING UP

- A-State has had at least three players score in double figures in 14 of its 16 games this season, with the only exceptions being road games at Purdue and UT Arlington.
- A-State has had two games in which four players scored double figures. The Red Wolves are 0-2 in those games, losses against Toledo and Appalachian State (Jan 3). Cameron Golden (18), Nohoum Bocoum (13), Sean Gardner (12) and Anthony Livingston had double figures against Toledo Dec. 13th. Livingston (21), Gardner (17), Golden (11) and Hardwick (10) each reached double figures against Appalachian State Jan. 3rd.

TOUGH SLATE

- The Red Wolves have five games against SBC opponents after they come off a bye date in conference play, the most in the conference.
- Appalachian State had a bye on the first conference date before their game with A-State (Jan. 3) and ULM (Jan. 5/Feb. 21) has byes before both of its matchups with the Red Wolves. Georgia Southern (Jan. 8) was the third-straight opponent coming off a bye to take on A-State. The Red Wolves also take on South Alabama in Jonesboro on March 5th after the Jaguars have February 28th off.
- Louisiana-Lafayette also has five opponents on their league schedule after the foe has a bye week. The Ragin' Cajuns play all five of their opponents coming off a bye in consecutive games.
- The Red Wolves are in the midst of a stretch of three games against teams in the top four of the conference. Texas State was second in the league standings entering Saturday's game and A-State plays third-place Georgia State on Monday before travelling to face UL Lafayette who is tied for second.

LOGGING BIG MINUTES

- Cameron Golden, Anthony Livingston, and Sean Gardner are all in the top-five in minutes played in the Sun Belt Conference and top-75 in the nation.
- Golden is second in the SBC averaging 36.4 minutes per game and 27th nationally. Livingston, who played 44 of 45 minutes on Saturday, ranks fourth (35.7) in the SBC and 45th nationally while Gardner is fifth (35.1) in the SBC and 66th nationally.

NUMBER 100

- Arkansas State head coach John Brady recorded his 100th win as A-State's head coach with the 67-49 victory over UCA on December 1.
- He became the fifth coach to register at least 100 wins at Arkansas State joining John Rauth, Nelson Catalina, Dickey Nutt, and Marvin Adams. Adams is the coach above Brady with 111 wins that he tallied from 1976-84.

DID YOU KNOW

- Sophomore guard Dajion Macklien played football at NCAA Division II North Alabama in the 2012 season
- Sean Gardner and junior forward Charles Waters are stepbrothers
- Nohoum Bocoum wears size 18 shoes
- Cameron Golden has switched his jersey number to one for this upcoming season after wearing zero this past 2013-14 campaign.
- A-State has gone 572 games since losing a game in which it scored 90 or more points. The loss came in the 1995-96 campaign, a 101-93 loss at Jacksonville on January 22, 1996.

CLOSE TIES

- Guard Josh Pierre's father, Butch, will embark on his seventh season as the associate men's basketball head coach at Oklahoma State University.
- Butch spent 11 seasons (1997-08) at LSU as a member of current A-State head coach John Brady's staff, including six as an associate head coach.
- Josh has a twin brother, Joseph III. Pierre doubled his point production last season by tallying 12 points in eight games after netting six points in four appearances for the 2012-13 campaign.

HEAD COACH JOHN BRADY



A proven winner in the collegiate coaching ranks, John Brady's vision of taking the Arkansas State men's basketball program to the highest competitive level nationally has made the two entities a perfect match.

Brady has certainly become accustomed to success throughout his distinguished coaching career as evidenced by a Final Four appearance and 380 career

victories.

The past two seasons (2012-13 and 2013-14) clearly illustrate Brady's success as A-State has compiled back-to-back 19-win seasons to represent the Red Wolves' most single-season victories since 1997-98 campaign. The 2012-13 team posted a 19-12 overall mark and claimed a Sun Belt Conference (SBC) West Division Championship title while the 2013-14 squad registered a 19-13 overall record.

A new era in A-State men's basketball history began on March 19, 2008 when Brady was announced as the Red Wolves' 15th head coach in the program's history.

Brady has wasted little time making a positive impact on the A-State program as in his initial three years at the helm, he turned the Red Wolves into a success story on the court by capturing a share of the Sun Belt Conference's Western Division Championship title in 2010-11 along with compiling double-digit SBC wins back-to-back for the first time in nearly 20 years and going 13-0 at home.

During his first season with the Red Wolves, Brady helped lead A-State to one of the best starts in program history and achieved the No. 22 ranking on Collegeinsider.com's Top 25 poll.

Brady would take the Red Wolves a step further in his second season (2009-10), improving their record to 17-14 while making a Sun Belt Conference Tournament Semifinal appearance and finishing second in the SBC's West Division. For his efforts, Brady was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year and the District VII Coach of the Year by the USBWA.

For the 2009-10 season, A-State registered an 11-7 SBC record which signified its best conference mark since the 2006-07 campaign when A-State achieved an identical league mark. A-State's 11 wins represented the seventh time in which the Red Wolves compiled a double-digit league victories total since joining the Sun Belt. A-State would then duplicate its SBC wins in the 2010-11 season by finishing with an 11-5 conference ledger.

Prior to Arkansas State, Brady spent 10-plus seasons serving as LSU's head coach. During his tenure at the school, Brady guided the Tigers to six post-season berths, two Southeastern Conference (SEC) Championship crowns and three SEC Western Division titles. With his success, Brady was tabbed as the SEC Coach of the Year twice (1999-00 and 2005-06).

Brady's 16-year tenure as a head coach at both LSU and Samford in Birmingham, Alabama, has been decorated with achievements. He has coached a combined 25 All-TAAC and SEC selections, 48 academic all-conference choices, posted 11 winning seasons and collected five division championships. Brady compiled up the third most wins in LSU history with 192 and left Samford after the 1996-97 season as the Bulldog's all-time leader in coaching victories (89) as well.

Brady quickly turned around an LSU's men's basketball program that had suffered four consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, leading the Tigers to a 28-6 record, an SEC Championship and an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in just his third season (1999-00) at the helm. Under Brady's direction, the Tigers recorded six consecutive winning seasons from 2001-02 to 2006-07 while making three trips to the NCAA Tournament and two more to the NIT. The 2005-06 campaign saw LSU post a 27-9 overall record and advance to the Final Four for the first time in 20 years.

Not only did Brady coach the Tigers to 23 wins versus ranked opponents, he also led them to victories over two teams ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll (Arizona in 2002-03 and Duke in 2005-06).

Additionally, he orchestrated a 19-game home winning streak over SEC opponents, the third longest stretch in LSU history.

While at LSU, Brady coached two NBA Lottery picks and six current NBA players. The Tigers signed nine Parade All-Americans and four McDonald All-Americans under Brady, who also coached three SEC Players of the Year, four players named SEC Freshman of the Year, one SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and 17 All-SEC selections.

Prior to taking over the reigns at LSU, Brady served as Samford's head coach from 1991-92 through 1996-97. He quickly turned around a Samford program, which was coming off six straight losing seasons, by guiding the Bulldogs to a 17-10 overall record in just his second season. Brady went on to lead Samford to three consecutive winning seasons (1995-97) for the first time since 1982-84, culminating in a 19-9 overall record and division crown in 1997. SU placed first in the Trans America Athletic Conference's (TAAC) West Division in each of Brady's final two seasons for the first time in program history.

Brady's four winning seasons at Samford represented the first for any coach at the school. He directed SU to an 89-77 record after the Bulldogs went 27-83 the four seasons prior to his initial year. Brady coached eight All-TAAC and 14 Academic All-TAAC student-athletes over six seasons at Samford.

A native of McComb, Miss., native, Brady earned his bachelor's degree from Belhaven College in 1976. He was a three-year starter at BC and scored over 1,000 career points. Brady, a two-time All-Southern States Conference selection, was inducted into his alma mater's Hall of Fame.

Brady began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for the Mississippi State men's basketball program where he earned his master's degree from 1976-77. Brady took his first head coaching position in 1977 at Louisiana's Crowley High School and led the basketball squad to a 129-49 (.725) overall record in five seasons. He was honored as the 1981 Louisiana Sports Writers Association Class 3-A Coach of the Year.

Brady returned to the college coaching ranks in 1982 as an assistant coach at Mississippi State. He spent eight years with the Bulldogs, the first four seasons under coach Bob Hoyt and the proceeding four as a chief recruiter for coach Richard Williams. Following his tenure at MSU, Brady returned to Louisiana to serve as an assistant coach at the University of New Orleans. Brady helped lead UNO to a NCAA Tournament berth in his only season with the Privateers.
