QUICK HITS

- A-State had three players scored in double figures and got a double-double from sophomore forward Anthony Livingston, but the Red Wolves dropped a tightly-contested game against Georgia state 60-54 on Monday at the Convocation Center.
- Anthony Livingston posted his eighth double-double as he had 23 points and 13 rebounds against Georgia State. Sean Gardner scored a conference game high 19 points while Cameron Golden added 10 points. PJ Hardwick dished out 17 assists and continues lead SBC in assists (6.5 APG).
- The Red Wolves play 11 games in the month of January, the most since A-State had 11 games in the 1986-87 season.
- The 2014-15 campaign represents the program's 87th season as the Red Wolves have presently amassed a 1,150-1,086 all-time record (.514 win pct.) dating back their inaugural 1926-27 season. A-State has won at least 20 games in a season five times – 1986-87 (21-13), 1987-88 (21-14), 1988-89 (20-10), 1990-91 (23-9) and 1997-98 (20-9) since joining the NCAA-I ranks in 1970-71.
- A-State has amassed a record of 199-195 (.505) since joining the Sun Belt Conference in the 1991-92 season. With Monday's loss, A-State is now 129-66 (.662) in home SBC games while the road record sits at 70-128 (.354).
- The Red Wolves are 8-1 on the season when pulling down 35-plus rebounds. A-State is 7-2 when attempting fewer three-pointers in the second half compared to the first half and 7-2 when shooting a better field goal percentage than their opposition.

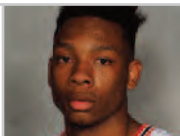

Louisiana leads 46-23
A-State streak: L3

- Arkansas State and Louisiana resume the conference series with the Ragin' Cajuns holding a 46-23 edge. A-State is 4-6 in the last 10 meetings overall and has a current seven-game road losing streak. Eight of the last 10 outings have been decided by nine points or less with A-State sporting a 4-6 record.
- A-State has struggled on the road in the series, carrying a record of 8-26 entering Thursday's matchup. The Red Wolves last win in Lafayette happened on Dec. 17, 2006, 73-63. Five of those seven losses have come by five or fewer points, including an overtime loss in the 2010-11 season. Overall, the Red Wolves have lost nine of the last 10 meetings and 10 of the last 12 dating back to an 82-80 win on Feb. 3, 2001.
- The Ragin' Cajuns have won three-straight in the series, including both meetings in the series a year ago. Melvin Johnson III had a game high 28 points and Ed Townsel added 23 points, but A-State was dealt a 77-76 loss Louisiana in the most previous meeting. In the other meeting of the 2013-14 season, the Ragin' Cajuns snapped a three-game win streak by A-State by defeating the Red Wolves 85-67 at the Cajun Dome. Kendrick Washington and Melvin Johnson III each had 19 points to pace A-State.
- A-State's last win against Louisiana came on Dec. 27, 2012, a decisive 87-70 victory at the Convocation Center. Ed Townsel scored a career-high 31 points while Raeford 'Gator' Worsham had 18 points and Marcus Hooten tossed in 11 points in the win.
- With 69 games played in the series, A-State versus Louisiana ranks as the third-most games against any one opponent.

SCOUTING LOUISIANA

- Louisiana enters Thursday's game riding a three-game losing skid, but the Ragin' Cajuns have lost each of the three games by eight or fewer points. Louisiana shot a season-low 32.7 percent from the field and were just 2-18 (11 percent) from beyond the three-point line in a 57-55 loss to ULM on Monday.
- Prior to a three-game skid, Louisiana had won seven of their last eight games, including a 4-0 start in league play.
- The Ragin' Cajuns feature four players averaging double figures led by forward Shawn Long. The 6-9 post leads the team in scoring (16.2 PPG) and rebounding (9.8 RPG), a rebound total that leads the Sun Belt Conference. Devonta Walker ranks sixth in rebound, pulling down seven a game. Forward Brian Williams is second on the squad, averaging 12.3 PPG.
- Despite three-straight losses, the Ragin' Cajuns are tops in the league in scoring, averaging 80.3 points per game, seven better than No. 2 Georgia Southern (73.3). Defensively, Louisiana ranks 10th, allowing 71.6 points to their opponents. Louisiana is tops in the league in rebounds (40.5), first in assists (15.0), second in field goal percentage (47.4) and third in three-point field goal percentage (34.7). The Ragin' Cajuns average 41.7 points per game in the paint while their bench chips in 26.8 points per game.
- Bob Marlin is in his fifth season at Louisiana sporting a record of 76-71. In a career that spans 22 seasons, Marlin has posted a 424-237 mark, 301-202 at the Division I level.

SEEM FAMILIAR?

- Louisiana is the fifth A-State opponent and presents the sixth game in which the Red Wolves face a foe riding a losing streak of two or more games. Appalachian State (2), South Alabama, ULM and UT Arlington all entered their matchup with A-State with losing streaks.

STAT TRENDS

- A-State has is 8-1 this season when grabbing 35 or more rebounds. The lone loss was a 73-65 loss at Toledo.
- The Red Wolves are 7-2 on the season when having fewer three-point attempts in the second half than in the first half. Further, in the nine games in which A-State has fewer three-point attempts in the second half, the Red Wolves have outscored their opponents 309-258 in the second half alone. In the first half of those games, A-State has been outscored 303-265.
- The Red Wolves are 7-3 when 25 or more of their points are inside the painted area.
- A-State 7-3 this season when opponents score 30 or fewer points in the paint. Georgia State had 24 points in the paint, but A-State lost the matchup.
- The Red Wolves are 5-1 this season when earning a trip to the free throw line more than their opponents.
- A-State is 6-3 this season when Anthony Livingston sinks three or more free throws. The third loss came Monday when Livingston knocked down 13 of his 14 attempts from the charity stripe.

Georgia State Holds Off
@AStateMB 60-54

- A-State had three players score in double figures and got a double-double from Anthony Livingston, but dropped a tightly-contested game against Georgia State Monday night at the Convocation Center by a 60-54 score.
- Posting a 29 percent field-goal percentage, the Red Wolves (8-9, 3-5) fought through a sluggish shooting performance to put themselves in position to win late in the contest. A-State had to play from behind most of the night, claiming its only lead when Sean Gardner hit a three that made the score 34-33 with 14:36 left in the second half.
- The Red Wolves capitalized at the free throw line by hitting 19-of-23 attempts while also limiting Georgia State (12-7, 5-3) to season low 36 percent field-goal percentage. Following Gardner's three-point shot, the Panthers retook the lead on their next possession with a tip-in by Markus Crider. Crider's rebound and put-back started an 11-1 run by Georgia State that wasn't stopped until Livingston, who was responsible for a team-best 20 points and game-high 13 rebounds, hit a pair of free throws that cut A-State's deficit to 44-37.
- Gardner hit a jumper with 4:34 left in the game that pulled Arkansas State within 47-45. Most of the final four minutes were a one-possession game with Georgia State holding anywhere from a one-to-three-point lead. Still down just 57-54 with 29 seconds remaining, A-State missed a three and was forced to foul Crider, who then hit 1-of-2 free throws to make it a two-possession game.
- The Red Wolves missed a three on their next possession and R.J. Hunter set the final score with a pair of free throws. Hunter was instrumental in the victory, scoring 14 of their final 15 points to end the night with a game-high 23 points.
- Livingston posted his eighth double-double of the season to lead the Red Wolves. He was joined in double figures by Gardner with 19 points and Golden with 10. P.J. Hardwick dished out a game-high seven assists to add to his Sun Belt Conference-leading total.

EXTRA TIME

- A-State is 2-0 in overtime this season, both wins coming in league play against South Alabama and Texas State. The Red Wolves are 8-9 in overtime games under head coach John Brady.
- The Red Wolves have won three-straight games in overtime dating back to the four overtime thriller against UALR in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament last year. A-State's last overtime loss came at the hands of Georgia State on March 4 at the Convocation Center.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE GAMES

- The Red Wolves are 199-195 (.505) since joining the Sun Belt Conference (SBC) in the 1991-92 season, which includes a season-best 14-4 (.778) mark in the 1997-98 campaign.
- A-State sports a 129-66 (.662) record at home and is 70-128 (.354) on the road in Sun Belt action.
- A-State head coach John Brady has registered a 58-56 (.509) record in Sun Belt Conference contests since his arrival in the 2008-09 season, which consists of a 40-16 (.714) home ledger and a 18-40 (.310) away mark.

A-STATE IN JANUARY GAMES

- The Red Wolves have started the new calendar year with an 2-5 mark and are in the midst of a tough January slate.
- Dating back to the 2010-11 season, the Red Wolves are 15-7 at home and 4-14 in January road games.
- A-State has a total of 11 games this month, the most in the month of January since the 1986-87 season. The 1982-83 schedule had the most January games, with A-State going 8-5 in 13 games.
- Since the 2000-01 season, the Red Wolves have a record of 63-60 (.512) in January outings. A-State is 43-21 (.672) at home and 20-39 (.339) on the road in that span of January contests.
- Under head coach John Brady, A-State is 31-27 (.534) in January games, 23-9 (.719) at home and 8-18 (.308) on the road.

LOOKING FOR A CHARITY

- A-State averages 13 free throw makes a game this year, shooting 71 percent from the charity stripe (228-317). The Red Wolves sport a 7-5 record when making 12 or more free throws in a game.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- The Red Wolves bench scored 19 points against Texas State, just the ninth time in 16 games that the bench reached double figures.
- The top bench performance of the season came against Belhaven with the reserves scoring 20 points.
- On the season, A-State's bench has been outscored 368-160, an average of 12.2 points per game.

ROAD SUCCESS

• The 2014-15 Red Wolves are on the hunt for the single-season record of eight road wins set in the 1973-74 season.

• A-State is 5-4 on the road thus far, picking up a fifth road win on Thursday at Appalachian State.

• Last year, A-State was 7-7 on the road, just shy of tying the mark.

• A-State has the most road wins of any Sun Belt Conference member thus far, one better than Georgia Southern and ULM who sport 4-4 marks on the road.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE LIVINGSTON

• Sophomore forward Anthony Livingston has posted three-straight double-doubles and earned Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week honors for his performances against Appalachian State and Texas State.

• Livingston has topped 20 points six times, including the last two outings and grabbed 15-plus rebounds in two games this year.

• In his last three games, Livingston has shot 42 percent (16-38) from the floor, 40 percent (4-10) from beyond the arc and 84 percent (21-25) from the charity stripe while pulling down 40 rebounds and playing 121 of a possible 125 minutes. In those three games, Livingston averages 19.0 points and 13.3 rebounds.

• Livingston leads the team in scoring (15.8), a total that ranks seventh in SBC and 144th nationally. Livingston is second in the SBC in rebounding (9.5) and ranks 29th nationally. His field goal percentage (47.1) ranks 14th in the league and 123rd nationally.

PASSING WITH PJ

• A-State redshirt sophomore point guard PJ Hardwick dished out 15 assists and scored 10 points against Appalachian State on Jan. 3rd for his first double-double of the year. His 15 assists tied the Convocation Center record set by Chico Fletcher and was two shy of Fletcher's single-game record.

• Ohio State's Shannon Scott, who had 16 assists in a game, is the only player this season with more assists.

• Hardwick, who has 98 assists in 15 games, is on pace for 182 assists, a season total that would rank him fifth. Hardwick leads the SBC in assists per game (6.5) and is ninth nationally. His assist to turnover ratio of 2.6 leads the league and is 42nd nationally.

THE GOLDEN RULE

• On the season, A-State is 7-3 this year when guard Cameron Golden shoots 33 percent or better from the floor.

• With an average of 15.5 PPG, Golden ranks eighth in the conference and 167th nationally. He is team's leader in steals with a 1.9 SPG mark, a total that ranks seventh in the SBC and 109th nationally.

DOUBLING UP

• A-State has had at least three players score in double figures in 15 of its 17 games this season, with the only exceptions being road games at Purdue and UT Arlington.

• A-State has had two games in which four players scored double figures. The Red Wolves are 0-2 in those games, losses against Toledo and Appalachian State (Jan. 3). Cameron Golden (18), Nohoum Bocoum (13), Sean Gardner (12) and Anthony Livingston had double figures against Toledo Dec. 13th. Livingston (21), Gardner (17), Golden (11) and Hardwick (10) each reached double figures against Appalachian State Jan. 3rd.

LOGGING BIG MINUTES

• Cameron Golden, Anthony Livingston, and Sean Gardner are all in the top-five in minutes played in the Sun Belt Conference and top-75 in the nation.

• Golden is second in the SBC averaging 36.3 minutes

per game and 28th nationally. Livingston, who played has played 121 of 125 possible minutes in the last three games, ranks third (35.7) in the SBC and 40th nationally while Gardner is fifth (35.1) in the SBC and 67th nationally.

TOUGH SLATE

• The Red Wolves have five games against SBC opponents after they come off a bye date in conference play, the most in the conference.

• Appalachian State had a bye on the first conference date before their game with A-State (Jan. 3) and ULM (Jan. 5/Feb. 21) has byes before both of its matchups with the Red Wolves. Georgia Southern (Jan. 8) was the third-straight opponent coming off a bye to take on A-State. The Red Wolves also take on South Alabama in Jonesboro on March 5th after the Jaguars have February 28th off.

• Louisiana also has five opponents on their league schedule after the foe has a bye week. The Ragin' Cajuns play all five of their opponents coming off a bye in consecutive games.

• The Red Wolves are in the midst of a stretch of three games against teams in the top four of the conference. Texas State was second in the league standings entering Saturday's game and A-State played third-place Georgia State on Monday before travelling to face the Ragin' Cajuns who are tied for fourth.

BUT IT GETS BETTER

• After completing the two-game road swing with games at Louisiana and Troy, A-State will have wrapped a grueling stretch of 10 out of 15 games on the road dating back to Dec. 10 at Purdue. Following Saturday's game at Troy, the Red Wolves will play six of their final 10 regular season games at home, including four of the final five games.

NUMBER 100

• Arkansas State head coach John Brady recorded his 100th win as A-State's head coach with the 67-49 victory over UCA on December 1.

• He became the fifth coach to register at least 100 wins at Arkansas State joining John Rauth, Nelson Catalina, Dickey Nutt, and Marvin Adams. Adams is the coach above Brady with 111 wins that he tallied from 1976-84.

• Sophomore guard Dajion Macklien played football at NCAA Division II North Alabama in the 2012 season

• Sean Gardner and junior forward Charles Waters are stepbrothers

• Nohoum Bocoum wears size 18 shoes

• Cameron Golden has switched his jersey number to one for this upcoming season after wearing zero this past 2013-14 campaign.

• A-State has gone 572 games since losing a game in which it scored 90 or more points. The loss came in the 1995-96 campaign, a 101-93 loss at Jacksonville on January 22, 1996.

CLOSE TIES

• Guard Josh Pierre's father, Butch, will embark on his seventh season as the associate men's basketball head coach at Oklahoma State University.

• Butch spent 11 seasons (1997-08) at LSU as a member of current A-State head coach John Brady's staff, including six as an associate head coach.

• Josh has a twin brother, Joseph III. Pierre doubled his point production last season by tallying 12 points in eight games after netting six points in four appearances for the 2012-13 campaign.

HEAD COACH JOHN BRADY



A proven winner in the collegiate coaching ranks, John Brady's vision of taking the Arkansas State men's basketball program to the highest competitive level nationally has made the two entities a perfect match.

Brady has certainly become accustomed to success throughout his distinguished coaching career as evidenced by a Final Four appearance and 380 career

victories.

The past two seasons (2012-13 and 2013-14) clearly illustrate Brady's success as A-State has compiled back-to-back 19-win seasons to represent the Red Wolves' most single-season victories since 1997-98 campaign. The 2012-13 team posted a 19-12 overall mark and claimed a Sun Belt Conference (SBC) West Division Championship title while the 2013-14 squad registered a 19-13 overall record.

A new era in A-State men's basketball history began on March 19, 2008 when Brady was announced as the Red Wolves' 15th head coach in the program's history.

Brady has wasted little time making a positive impact on the A-State program as in his initial three years at the helm, he turned the Red Wolves into a success story on the court by capturing a share of the Sun Belt Conference's Western Division Championship title in 2010-11 along with compiling double-digit SBC wins back-to-back for the first time in nearly 20 years and going 13-0 at home.

During his first season with the Red Wolves, Brady helped lead A-State to one of the best starts in program history and achieved the No. 22 ranking on Collegeinsider.com's Top 25 poll.

Brady would take the Red Wolves a step further in his second season (2009-10), improving their record to 17-14 while making a Sun Belt Conference Tournament Semifinal appearance and finishing second in the SBC's West Division. For his efforts, Brady was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year and the District VII Coach of the Year by the USBWA.

For the 2009-10 season, A-State registered an 11-7 SBC record which signified its best conference mark since the 2006-07 campaign when A-State achieved an identical league mark. A-State's 11 wins represented the seventh time in which the Red Wolves compiled a double-digit league victories total since joining the Sun Belt. A-State would then duplicate its SBC wins in the 2010-11 season by finishing with an 11-5 conference ledger.

Prior to Arkansas State, Brady spent 10-plus seasons serving as LSU's head coach. During his tenure at the school, Brady guided the Tigers to six post-season berths, two Southeastern Conference (SEC) Championship crowns and three SEC Western Division titles. With his success, Brady was tabbed as the SEC Coach of the Year twice (1999-00 and 2005-06).

Brady's 16-year tenure as a head coach at both LSU and Samford in Birmingham, Alabama, has been decorated with achievements. He has coached a combined 25 All-TAAC and SEC selections, 48 academic all-conference choices, posted 11 winning seasons and collected five division championships. Brady compiled up the third most wins in LSU history with 192 and left Samford after the 1996-97 season as the Bulldog's all-time leader in coaching victories (89) as well.

Brady quickly turned around an LSU's men's basketball program that had suffered four consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, leading the Tigers to a 28-6 record, an SEC Championship and an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in just his third season (1999-00) at the helm. Under Brady's direction, the Tigers recorded six consecutive winning seasons from 2001-02 to 2006-07 while making three trips to the NCAA Tournament and two more to the NIT. The 2005-06 campaign saw LSU post a 27-9 overall record and advance to the Final Four for the first time in 20 years.

Not only did Brady coach the Tigers to 23 wins versus ranked opponents, he also led them to victories over two teams ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll (Arizona in 2002-03 and Duke in 2005-06).

Additionally, he orchestrated a 19-game home winning streak over SEC opponents, the third longest stretch in LSU history.

While at LSU, Brady coached two NBA Lottery picks and six current NBA players. The Tigers signed nine Parade All-Americans and four McDonald All-Americans under Brady, who also coached three SEC Players of the Year, four players named SEC Freshman of the Year, one SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and 17 All-SEC selections.

Prior to taking over the reigns at LSU, Brady served as Samford's head coach from 1991-92 through 1996-97. He quickly turned around a Samford program, which was coming off six straight losing seasons, by guiding the Bulldogs to a 17-10 overall record in just his second season. Brady went on to lead Samford to three consecutive winning seasons (1995-97) for the first time since 1982-84, culminating in a 19-9 overall record and division crown in 1997. SU placed first in the Trans America Athletic Conference's (TAAC) West Division in each of Brady's final two seasons for the first time in program history.

Brady's four winning seasons at Samford represented the first for any coach at the school. He directed SU to an 89-77 record after the Bulldogs went 27-83 the four seasons prior to his initial year. Brady coached eight All-TAAC and 14 Academic All-TAAC student-athletes over six seasons at Samford.

A native of McComb, Miss., native, Brady earned his bachelor's degree from Belhaven College in 1976. He was a three-year starter at BC and scored over 1,000 career points. Brady, a two-time All-Southern States Conference selection, was inducted into his alma mater's Hall of Fame.

Brady began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for the Mississippi State men's basketball program where he earned his master's degree from 1976-77. Brady took his first head coaching position in 1977 at Louisiana's Crowley High School and led the basketball squad to a 129-49 (.725) overall record in five seasons. He was honored as the 1981 Louisiana Sports Writers Association Class 3-A Coach of the Year.

Brady returned to the college coaching ranks in 1982 as an assistant coach at Mississippi State. He spent eight years with the Bulldogs, the first four seasons under coach Bob Hoyt and the proceeding four as a chief recruiter for coach Richard Williams. Following his tenure at MSU, Brady returned to Louisiana to serve as an assistant coach at the University of New Orleans. Brady helped lead UNO to a NCAA Tournament berth in his only season with the Privateers.
