QUICK HITS

- Louisiana-Lafayette shot 64 percent (14-22) from beyond the arc and 55 percent (32-58) from the field to defeat A-State 96-59 on Thursday.
- PJ Hardwick had a career high 17 points on 7-17 shooting and was the only A-State player to score in double figures. Cameron Golden scored eight points while Nouhoum Bocoum had eight points and Kelvin Downs scored six points off the bench.
- The Red Wolves play 11 games in the month of January, the most since A-State had 11 games in the 1986-87 season.
- The 2014-15 campaign represents the program's 87th season as the Red Wolves have presently amassed a 1,150-1,087 all-time record (.514 win pct.) dating back their inaugural 1926-27 season. A-State has won at least 20 games in a season five times - 1986-87 (21-13), 1987-88 (21-14), 1988-89 (20-10), 1990-91 (23-9) and 1997-98 (20-9) since joining the NCAA-I ranks in 1970-71.
- A-State has amassed a record of 199-196 (.504) since joining the Sun Belt Conference in the 1991-92 season. A-State is now 129-66 (.662) in home SBC games while the road record sits at 70-129 (.352).
- The Red Wolves are 8-1 on the season when pulling down 35-plus rebounds. A-State is 7-3 when attempting fewer three-pointers in the second half compared to the first half and 7-2 when shooting a better field goal percentage than their opposition.
- Saturday's matchup with Troy presents A-State with its sixth opponent and seventh game against a foe riding a losing streak of two or more games. The Red Wolves are 2-4 in the previous six occurrences.

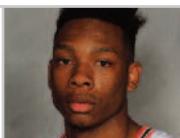

Troy Leads 7-6
A-State streak: W1

- Arkansas State and Troy resume a Sun Belt Conference series that dates back to the 2005-06 season with the Trojans leading 7-6 on the ledger. A-State has won five of the last seven meetings after Troy earned wins in five out of the first six.
- The Red Wolves are 2-3 all-time in games played at Troy, earning an 83-73 victory last season at Trojan Arena. All five previous meetings at Troy have been decided by 10 or fewer points, including an overtime game (1/24/13).
- Last season, A-State and Troy split the season series with the road team picking up the win. A-State defeated the Trojans 83-73 on Feb. 14 at Troy, but the Trojans defeated the Red Wolves 98-84 at the Convocation Center.
- Rakeem Dickerson and Ed Townsel both scored 19 points to lead four A-State players in double figures as the Red Wolves defeated Troy 83-73 on Feb. 1 at Troy. Cameron Golden poured in 18 points off the bench and Melvin Johnson III added 10 points. A-State shot 43.6 percent (24-55) from the floor and 82.8 percent (24-29) at the free throw line. Troy made 46.6 percent (27-58) of its shots from the field and was 57.1 percent (12-21) in free throw efficiency.
- Troy's Tevin Calhoun scored 35 points with seven three-pointers and the Trojans netted a Convocation Center record-tying 14 three-point field goals to hand A-State a 98-84 loss on Jan. 9. Kirk Van Slyke recorded double-figure scoring for a seventh-straight game at the time with 27 points, including 9-of-10 at the free throw stripe. Brandon Reed compiled a season-high 23 points by going 6-for-11 from the field along with eight free throws. Melvin Johnson III tossed in 17 points while six other A-State players combined for 17 points. Troy shot 57.6 percent (19-33) in the first half, including 60 percent (9-15) from beyond the arc. For the game, Troy shot 55.2 percent (32-58) and made 51.9 percent (14-27) from three-point range. A-State ended the evening shooting 49.1 percent (28-57), which included 33.3 percent (8-24) from long range.

SCOUTING TROY

- Troy enters Saturday's matchup riding a two-game losing skid and the Trojans have lost seven of their last 10 games overall. Thursday, UALR defeated Troy 73-65 to drop Troy to 7-10 overall and 2-6 in league play.
- Troy has two players averaging double figures and four more above seven points per game. The Trojans have limited their rotation to nine players in league play. Musa Abdul-Aleem paces the squad in scoring with an average of 15.9. Wesley Person averages 14.8 points and Kevin Thomas has an average of 7.2 rebounds per game while averaging 9.4 points.
- The Trojans have shot 43 percent from the floor and 35 percent from three. In their eight conference games, Troy is shooting 41 percent from the floor and 37 percent from beyond the arc. Troy averages 9.9 assists per game, but has turned the ball over at a 14.6 clip thus far.
- Phil Cunningham is in his second season at the helm of Troy. He's posted a record of 18-30 entering Saturday's game.

SEEM FAMILIAR?

- Troy is the sixth A-State opponent and presents the seventh game in which the Red Wolves face a foe riding a losing streak of two or more games. Appalachian State (2), South Alabama, ULM, UT Arlington and Louisiana-Lafayette all entered their matchup with A-State with losing streaks.

STAT TRENDS

- A-State has is 8-1 this season when grabbing 35 or more rebounds. The lone loss was a 73-65 loss at Toledo.
- The Red Wolves are 7-3 on the season when having fewer three-point attempts in the second half than in the first half. Further, in the 10 games in which A-State has fewer three-point attempts in the second half, the Red Wolves have outscored their opponents 340-303 in the second half alone. In the first half of those games, A-State has been outscored 354-293.
- The Red Wolves are 7-3 when 25 or more of their points are inside the painted area.
- A-State is 7-3 this season when opponents score 30 or fewer points in the paint. Georgia State had 24 points in the paint, but A-State lost the matchup.
- The Red Wolves are 5-1 this season when earning a trip to the free throw line more than their opponents.
- A-State is 6-3 this season when Anthony Livingston sinks three or more free throws. The third loss came Monday when Livingston knocked down 13 of his 14 attempts from the charity stripe.

EXTRA TIME

- A-State is 2-0 in overtime this season, both wins coming in league play against South Alabama and Texas State. The Red Wolves are 8-9 in overtime games under head coach John Brady.
- The Red Wolves have won three-straight games in overtime dating back to the four overtime thriller against UALR in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament last year. A-State's last overtime loss came at the hands of Georgia State on March 4 at the Convocation Center.

Louisiana-Lafayette Shoots Past
@AStateMB 96-59

- Louisiana-Lafayette shot 64 percent (14-22) from beyond the arc and 55 percent (32-58) from the field to defeat A-State 96-59 on Thursday at the Cajundome.
- PJ Hardwick scored a career-high 17 points, 11 of which came in the first half, on 41 percent (7-17) shooting from the field. Nouhoum Bocoum and Cameron Golden each added eight points for the Red Wolves.
- ULL forward Shawn Long was 10-11 (91 percent) from the field, including a perfect 5-of-5 from three to lead all scorers with 27 points. Hayward Register added 19 points for the Ragin' Cajuns in 14 points off the bench.
- A-State shot 40 percent (12-30) from the field in the first half, but Louisiana-Lafayette shot 52 percent (16-31) and added 15 points from the free throw line to hold a 51-28 lead at the half.
- After Charles Waters opened the scoring for A-State, ULL went on a 13-2 run to lead the Red Wolves 13-4. A-State traded buckets with the Ragin' Cajuns, but ULL used a 10-0 run to take an 18-point lead by a score of 33-15.
- The Ragin' Cajuns knocked down 10-of-11 (91 percent) of their three-point attempts in the second half to outscore A-State 45-31 for the period. Bocoum scored all eight of his points in the second half, including sinking his first career three-pointer. Bocoum was 3-for-3 at the charity stripe and pulled down four rebounds.
- A-State finished the night shooting 38 percent (22-58) from the field, but just 21 percent (3-14) from beyond the arc. The Red Wolves earned 19 trips to the free throw line, but only hit 12 free throws to shoot 63 percent.
- The Red Wolves were out-rebounded 41-29 in the game with the Ragin' Cajuns controlling the defensive glass 29-18. A-State was outscored in the paint 34-24 and ULL's bench held a 50-21 advantage over the Red Wolves.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE GAMES

- The Red Wolves are 199-196 (.504) since joining the Sun Belt Conference (SBC) in the 1991-92 season, which includes a season-best 14-4 (.778) mark in the 1997-98 campaign.
- A-State sports a 129-66 (.662) record at home and is 70-129 (.352) on the road in Sun Belt action.
- A-State head coach John Brady has registered a 58-57 (.504) record in Sun Belt Conference contests since his arrival in the 2008-09 season, which consists of a 40-16 (.714) home ledger and a 18-41 (.305) away mark.

A-STATE IN JANUARY GAMES

- The Red Wolves have started the new calendar year with an 2-6 mark and are in the midst of a tough January slate.
- Dating back to the 2010-11 season, the Red Wolves are 15-7 at home and 4-15 in January road games.
- A-State has a total of 11 games this month, the most in the month of January since the 1986-87 season. The 1982-83 schedule had the most January games, with A-State going 8-5 in 13 games.
- Since the 2000-01 season, the Red Wolves have a record of 63-61 (.508) in January outings. A-State is 43-21 (.672) at home and 20-40 (.333) on the road in that span of January contests.
- Under head coach John Brady, A-State is 31-28 (.525) in January games, 23-9 (.719) at home and 8-19 (.296) on the road.

BENCH PRODUCTION

- The Red Wolves bench scored 21 points against Louisiana-Lafayette, just the 10 time in 18 games that the bench reached double figures.
- The 21-point bench performance at ULL is the most that A-State has scored this season and the second time to top 20 points (Belhaven).
- On the season, A-State's bench has been outscored 418-181, an average of 13.2 points per game.
- A-State is 3-1 on the season when the bench is even or outscored the opponent.

ROAD SUCCESS

- The 2014-15 Red Wolves are on the hunt for the single-season record of eight road wins set in the 1973-74 season.
- A-State is 5-5 on the road thus far, picking up a fifth road win last Thursday at Appalachian State.
- Last year, A-State was 7-7 on the road, just shy of tying the mark.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE LIVINGSTON

- Sophomore forward Anthony Livingston has posted three double-doubles in the last four games and earned Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week honors for his performances against Appalachian State and Texas State.
- Livingston has topped 20 points six times, including two of the last three outings and grabbed 15-plus rebounds in two games this year.

PASSING WITH PJ

- A-State redshirt sophomore point guard PJ Hardwick dished out 15 assists and scored 10 points against Appalachian State on Jan. 3rd for his first double-double of the year. His 15 assists tied the Convocation Center record set by Chico Fletcher and was two shy of Fletcher's single-game record.
- Ohio State's Shannon Scott, who had 16 assists in a game, is the only player this season with more assists.
- Hardwick, who has 99 assists in 16 games, is on pace for 173 assists, a season total that would rank him fifth. Hardwick leads the SBC in assists per game (6.5) and is ninth nationally. His assist to turnover ratio of 2.4 leads the league and is 42nd nationally.

DOUBLING UP

- A-State has had at least three players score in double figures in 15 of its 18 games this season, with the only exceptions being road games at Purdue, UT Arlington and Louisiana-Lafayette.
- A-State has had two games in which four players scored double figures. The Red Wolves are 0-2 in those games, losses against Toledo and Appalachian State (Jan 3). Cameron Golden (18), Nohoum Bocoum (13), Sean Gardner (12) and Anthony Livingston had double figures against Toledo Dec. 13th. Livingston (21), Gardner (17), Golden (11) and Hardwick (10) each reached double figures against Appalachian State Jan. 3rd.

TOUGH SLATE

- The Red Wolves have five games against SBC opponents after they come off a bye date in conference play, the most in the conference.
- Appalachian State had a bye on the first conference date before their game with A-State (Jan. 3) and ULM (Jan. 5/Feb. 21) has byes before both of its matchups with the Red Wolves. Georgia Southern (Jan. 8) was the third-straight opponent coming off a bye to take on A-State. The Red Wolves also take on South Alabama in Jonesboro on March 5th after the Jaguars have February 28th off.
- Louisiana also has five opponents on their league schedule after the foe has a bye week. The Ragin' Cajuns play all five of their opponents coming off a bye in consecutive games.

BUT IT GETS BETTER

- After completing this two-game road swing with games at Louisiana and Troy, A-State will have wrapped a grueling stretch of 10 out of 15 games on the road dating back to Dec. 10 at Purdue. Following Saturday's game at Troy, the Red Wolves will play six of their final 10 regular season games at home, including four of the final five games.

NUMBER 100

- Arkansas State head coach John Brady recorded his 100th win as A-State's head coach with the 67-49 victory over UCA on December 1.
- He became the fifth coach to register at least 100 wins at Arkansas State joining John Rauth, Nelson Catalina, Dickey Nutt, and Marvin Adams. Adams is the coach above Brady with 111 wins that he tallied from 1976-84.

DID YOU KNOW

- Sophomore guard Dajion Macklien played football at NCAA Division II North Alabama in the 2012 season
- Sean Gardner and junior forward Charles Waters are stepbrothers
- Nohoum Bocoum wears size 18 shoes
- Cameron Golden has switched his jersey number to one for this upcoming season after wearing zero this past 2013-14 campaign.
- The Red Wolves have gone 117-straight games hitting a three-pointer. The last time A-State didn't hit a shot from behind the arc was Feb. 24, 2011 when North Texas held the Red Wolves 0-8 from three at the Convocation Center. A-State would win the game without needing a three-point make, 63-47.
- A-State has gone 574 games since losing a game in which it scored 90 or more points. The loss came in the 1995-96 campaign, a 101-93 loss at Jacksonville on January 22, 1996.

CLOSE TIES

- Guard Josh Pierre's father, Butch, will embark on his seventh season as the associate men's basketball head coach at Oklahoma State University.
- Butch spent 11 seasons (1997-08) at LSU as a member of current A-State head coach John Brady's staff, including six as an associate head coach.
- Josh has a twin brother, Joseph III. Pierre doubled his point production last season by tallying 12 points in eight games after netting six points in four appearances for the 2012-13 campaign.

HEAD COACH JOHN BRADY



A proven winner in the collegiate coaching ranks, John Brady's vision of taking the Arkansas State men's basketball program to the highest competitive level nationally has made the two entities a perfect match.

Brady has certainly become accustomed to success throughout his distinguished coaching career as evidenced by a Final Four appearance and 380 career

victories.

The past two seasons (2012-13 and 2013-14) clearly illustrate Brady's success as A-State has compiled back-to-back 19-win seasons to represent the Red Wolves' most single-season victories since 1997-98 campaign. The 2012-13 team posted a 19-12 overall mark and claimed a Sun Belt Conference (SBC) West Division Championship title while the 2013-14 squad registered a 19-13 overall record.

A new era in A-State men's basketball history began on March 19, 2008 when Brady was announced as the Red Wolves' 15th head coach in the program's history.

Brady has wasted little time making a positive impact on the A-State program as in his initial three years at the helm, he turned the Red Wolves into a success story on the court by capturing a share of the Sun Belt Conference's Western Division Championship title in 2010-11 along with compiling double-digit SBC wins back-to-back for the first time in nearly 20 years and going 13-0 at home.

During his first season with the Red Wolves, Brady helped lead A-State to one of the best starts in program history and achieved the No. 22 ranking on Collegeinsider.com's Top 25 poll.

Brady would take the Red Wolves a step further in his second season (2009-10), improving their record to 17-14 while making a Sun Belt Conference Tournament Semifinal appearance and finishing second in the SBC's West Division. For his efforts, Brady was named Sun Belt Coach of the Year and the District VII Coach of the Year by the USBWA.

For the 2009-10 season, A-State registered an 11-7 SBC record which signified its best conference mark since the 2006-07 campaign when A-State achieved an identical league mark. A-State's 11 wins represented the seventh time in which the Red Wolves compiled a double-digit league victories total since joining the Sun Belt. A-State would then duplicate its SBC wins in the 2010-11 season by finishing with an 11-5 conference ledger.

Prior to Arkansas State, Brady spent 10-plus seasons serving as LSU's head coach. During his tenure at the school, Brady guided the Tigers to six post-season berths, two Southeastern Conference (SEC) Championship crowns and three SEC Western Division titles. With his success, Brady was tabbed as the SEC Coach of the Year twice (1999-00 and 2005-06).

Brady's 16-year tenure as a head coach at both LSU and Samford in Birmingham, Alabama, has been decorated with achievements. He has coached a combined 25 All-TAAC and SEC selections, 48 academic all-conference choices, posted 11 winning seasons and collected five division championships. Brady compiled up the third most wins in LSU history with 192 and left Samford after the 1996-97 season as the Bulldog's all-time leader in coaching victories (89) as well.

Brady quickly turned around an LSU's men's basketball program that had suffered four consecutive losing seasons prior to his arrival, leading the Tigers to a 28-6 record, an SEC Championship and an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in just his third season (1999-00) at the helm. Under Brady's direction, the Tigers recorded six consecutive winning seasons from 2001-02 to 2006-07 while making three trips to the NCAA Tournament and two more to the NIT. The 2005-06 campaign saw LSU post a 27-9 overall record and advance to the Final Four for the first time in 20 years.

Not only did Brady coach the Tigers to 23 wins versus ranked opponents, he also led them to victories over two teams ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll (Arizona in 2002-03 and Duke in 2005-06).

Additionally, he orchestrated a 19-game home winning streak over SEC opponents, the third longest stretch in LSU history.

While at LSU, Brady coached two NBA Lottery picks and six current NBA players. The Tigers signed nine Parade All-Americans and four McDonald All-Americans under Brady, who also coached three SEC Players of the Year, four players named SEC Freshman of the Year, one SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and 17 All-SEC selections.

Prior to taking over the reigns at LSU, Brady served as Samford's head coach from 1991-92 through 1996-97. He quickly turned around a Samford program, which was coming off six straight losing seasons, by guiding the Bulldogs to a 17-10 overall record in just his second season. Brady went on to lead Samford to three consecutive winning seasons (1995-97) for the first time since 1982-84, culminating in a 19-9 overall record and division crown in 1997. SU placed first in the Trans America Athletic Conference's (TAAC) West Division in each of Brady's final two seasons for the first time in program history.

Brady's four winning seasons at Samford represented the first for any coach at the school. He directed SU to an 89-77 record after the Bulldogs went 27-83 the four seasons prior to his initial year. Brady coached eight All-TAAC and 14 Academic All-TAAC student-athletes over six seasons at Samford.

A native of McComb, Miss., native, Brady earned his bachelor's degree from Belhaven College in 1976. He was a three-year starter at BC and scored over 1,000 career points. Brady, a two-time All-Southern States Conference selection, was inducted into his alma mater's Hall of Fame.

Brady began his coaching career as a graduate assistant for the Mississippi State men's basketball program where he earned his master's degree from 1976-77. Brady took his first head coaching position in 1977 at Louisiana's Crowley High School and led the basketball squad to a 129-49 (.725) overall record in five seasons. He was honored as the 1981 Louisiana Sports Writers Association Class 3-A Coach of the Year.

Brady returned to the college coaching ranks in 1982 as an assistant coach at Mississippi State. He spent eight years with the Bulldogs, the first four seasons under coach Bob Hoyt and the proceeding four as a chief recruiter for coach Richard Williams. Following his tenure at MSU, Brady returned to Louisiana to serve as an assistant coach at the University of New Orleans. Brady helped lead UNO to a NCAA Tournament berth in his only season with the Privateers.
