- Give the Red Wolves their first 7-3 start to a season since 1997-98
 - Make the Red Wolves 7-3 through their first 10 games for the sixth time in their history.
 - Make A-State 14-11 all-time in SBC openers.
 - Give the Red Wolves their fourth straight victory in an SBC opener.
 - Give Arkansas State its 31st SBC victory over the last three years.
 - Give the Red Wolves their 53rd victory over the last three years.
 - Give A-State head coach Brian Boyer his 279th career win.

- ATTEMPTS AT HISTORY**
- Arkansas State attempted 30, 3-point shots at Nebraska on Dec. 21, tying the school record for most attempts in a game.
 - The other instance took place against Missouri State on Dec. 20, 2011.
 - The Red Wolves also attempted 83 field goals, nearly equaling the school record of 89 against Arkansas College in 1974-75.

- TOUGH ONES TO TAKE**
- In each of A-State's three losses this season the Red Wolves have led their opponents in the fourth quarters.
 - The combined record Chattanooga, Florida and Nebraska (the 3 losses) is 28-7 and all three are ranked in the top-100 RPI.
 - A-State total margin of loss has been just 13 points in its three setbacks.

- TAKING CARE OF THE BASKETBALL**
- Arkansas State has committed the seventh fewest turnovers in the nation through non-conference play.
 - A-State has turned the ball over just 124 times on the year and is one of just 12 teams with less than 130 turnovers on the year.
 - Troy ranks 144th in the nation with 174 turnovers on the year.

- A CLASSIC GAMBLE PERFORMANCE**
- Aundrea Gamble turned in perhaps her best performance of the season in the Red Wolves' most recent outing against Nebraska (Dec. 21).
 - The senior recorded her seventh career double-double with 27 points and 11 rebounds in the eight point loss to the Huskers.
 - It was just the second time in Gamble's career that A-State has lost when she recorded a double-double. The last time was against UTEP in the WNIT in 2014.

- THE MORE ANALYTICAL THE BETTER**
- A-State is averaging 99.4 points per 100 possessions, meaning A-State is scoring on nearly half of it's trips on the offensive end.
 - The ORTg (offensive team rating) number ranks second during the Brian Boyer era. The 2014-15 team had a rating 101.7.
 - Last year's is the only two team with a number in the 100s. The previous high was during the 2004-05 season when the team had a number of 93.0.
 - Traditionally Boyer's team have averaged an ORTg somewhere between 86-88.

- IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS**
- Khadija Brown-Haywood has had an impressive start to the 2015-16 season and has put up a slew of eye-popping numbers.
 - She leads the Sun Belt Conference in rebounding with 8.7 boards per contest.
 - She also ranks in the top-10 in scoring with 14.1 points per night.
 - She is the only player in the conference to rank in the top-10 in points, rebounds and steals per game.

- Arkansas State has three players on its roster that were McDonald's High School All-America nominees.

- The player efficiency rating (PER) is John Hollinger's all-in-one basketball rating, which attempts to boil down all of a player's contributions into one number. Using a detailed formula, Hollinger developed a system that rates every player's statistical performance
- The top average PER for a player's career with held by Michael Jordan at 27.91. LeBron James is second at 27.66.
- In comparison to the WNBA, Cynthia Cooper had the top career PER at 28.72, followed by Lauren Jackson at 27.96.
- Only 20 players in WNBA history have averaged a career PER at 20 or above.
- Lauren Jackson had the highest single season PER average at 35.04 in 2007.

THE BOYER FILE

One of the most recognizable names and faces in the Sun Belt Conference and women's college basketball, Brian Boyer has built an illustrious career highlighted by countless milestones, including becoming the all-time wins leader in the SBC.

In his 16 years on the sidelines, Boyer was the primary architect in transforming the Arkansas State women's program into a model of consistency since taking over in 1999 and guiding the team to an appearance in the Women's National Invitation Tournament. He has coached the Red Wolves to six appearances in the WNIT and two SBC regular-season championships including the outright regular season crown in 2013-14.

An ambassador for both Arkansas State and the sport of college basketball, Boyer has enjoyed an unprecedented level of success through an energetic and positive approach to the game. A three-time Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year (2003-04, 2004-05 & 2013-14), Boyer has compiled an impressive 272-223 (.549) record over his 16-year career.

Boyer possesses the most conference wins by a coach in Sun Belt Conference in both the men's and women's game. He is the longest tenured basketball active coach in the conference and has also coached more games than any basketball coach (men's or women's) in Arkansas State history.

A-State has an unprecedented run of success over the last two years and has compiled 46 wins from the 2013-14 through the 2014-15 season, the third most in school history over any two-year span. Boyer helped guide the team to back-to-back Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship appearances and led his squad to back-to-back WNIT berths for the first time in a decade.

The 2014-15 season saw numerous records fall in what could be considered Arkansas State's most successful run in school history. The Red Wolves tied a school record with 21 regular season victories and fell just one win shy of tying the all-time mark of wins in a single year at 25. The squad participated in the Preseason WNIT and Postseason WNIT, one of just two teams in the country to do that, and narrowly missed garnering the program's first NCAA Tournament berth with an RPI of 44 at season's end. The Red Wolves had the highest RPI of any team in the country to not make the NCAA Tournament.

Boyer and the Red Wolves also made the Convocation Center one of the toughest places to play in the league, compiling a perfect 10-0 record in league play and winning a total of 14 games in Jonesboro, tying the school record (men's and women's) for most home in a single year. In addition, A-State has won 16 straight games at home during conference play, the second longest streak in the SBC.

Under Boyer's tutelage, Aundrea Gamble collected her second straight Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year honor after winning the league's scoring title and setting the school record for most assists in a single season. She was also named a CollegeSportsMadness.com Mid-Major First-Team All-American and earned Sun Belt Conference All-Tournament Team honors. In addition, Jasmine Hunt and Khadija Brown-Haywood also earned Third-Team All-Conference honors and finished second and third on the team respectfully in scoring.

The 2013-14 campaign was perhaps the best of Boyer's historic career at A-State. The Red Wolves finished with a 22-12 overall record and a 14-4 mark in the Sun Belt Conference (SBC). The squad captured the outright regular-season Sun Belt Conference title for the first time in school history. A-State entered the SBC Tournament as the No. 1 seed and advanced to the championship game for the second time in program history.

It was also a historic year for Boyer, who surpassed former Louisiana Tech coach Leon Barmore and Florida International coach Cindy Russo for the most league wins in Sun Belt Conference at 136 on March 5, 2014 and won his third career SBC Coach of the Year award at the end of the season. Boyer currently stands at 153 career league wins.

Boyer has coached 25 players to All-Conference status during his tenure, but his team's success is not limited to just on the court. The program won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference Team Academic honors in 2012-13 and 2013-14 with team GPAs that were over the 3.0 mark.
