STORYLINES

- ▶ The 2016-17 campaign marks the program's 89th season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,165-1,116 all-time record (.511) dating back to the inaugural 1926-27 season.
- ▶ In the 30th season at the Convocation Center, the Red Wolves have compiled a 285-115 (.713).
- ▶ Head Coach Grant McCasland, who is in his first season at Arkansas State, claimed his 200th victory as a collegiate coach on Monday. McCasland has a record of 201-45 (.817) in stops at Midland College (2004-09), Midwestern State (2009-11) and A-State (2016-present).
- ▶ With the 78-72 win at Georgetown, A-State earned the sixth non-conference road win in program history against a team from the ACC, Big East, Big 12, Big 10, Pac-12, or SEC.
- ▶ A-State has held all three opponents below 22 percent shooting from 3-point range.
- ▶ Guards are responsible for 71 of the 117 team rebounds (60.7 percent) thus far.
- ▶ Devin Carter had a game-high 25 points at Georgetown, his 16th game in 34 outings with 20 or more points.
- ▶ Donte Thomas is the only returning NCAA Division I player to average at least 10.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists a year ago. This season, Thomas is averaging 10.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 7.3 assists.
- ▶ The Red Wolves have shot at least 63 percent in the first half the last two games.
- ▶ With a win Saturday, A-State will face the winner between Chattanooga and Central Arkansas on Sunday. The teams that falls in each game will face off as well on Sunday. A-State will play at 11 a.m. win or lose.

REGIONAL GAMES OF MAUI JIM MAUI INVITATIONAL

- ▶ What is the Maui Jim Maui Invitational doing in West Point, N.Y.?
- ▶ The four teams in the field for the regional games are Arkansas State, Army, Central Arkansas and Chattanooga. Each of the four regional teams participated in opening games against schools that will compete in the Maui Invitational next week. A-State faced Georgetown, Central Arkansas traveled to Wisconsin and Oklahoma State, Army faced Oregon and Chattanooga played at Tennessee and North Carolina.
- ▶ The winners of Saturday's games -- Arkansas State vs Army and Central Arkansas vs Chattanooga -- will face off Saturday for the regional title. The teams that fall in the opening games on Saturday will square off on Sunday as well, but A-State will play at 11:00 a.m. (CT) win or lose on Saturday.

STATEMENT WIN

- ▶ A-State earned a 78-72 win at Georgetown on Nov. 17, a statement win for the program in just the third game under head coach Grant McCasland.
- ▶ The non-conference road win is the sixth in program history against a team from the higher resource conferences (ACC, Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 and SEC).
- ▶ A-State last picked up a non-conference road win against a higher resource team on Dec. 17, 2014 at Mississippi State (69-55).
- ▶ The other four non-conference road wins against higher resource conference foes are: at Ole Miss (2013 | 74-69), at Stanford in the NIT (1988 | 60-59), at Iowa (66-62 | 1985) and at Ole Miss (1947 | 40-29).
- ▶ The win marked the first against a team from the Big East Conference as well.

RED WOLVES BOUNCE BACK

- ▶ A-State bounced back from a season opening loss at North Dakota State (76-66) with an impressive 100-57 win in the home opener Monday night against Central Baptist.
- ▶ The 100 points scored are the most in a home opener since 2001 when A-State defeated Central Methodist 101-75.
- ▶ The Red Wolves had 13 steals in the game, only the second time since the 2012-13 season that an A-State squad had 13 or more.
- ▶ A-State shot 63.6 percent (21-33) in the first half Monday, the highest percentage in a half since shooting 70.4 percent (19-27) in the second half at South Alabama on Jan. 2, 2016.
- ▶ The Red Wolves held a 56-20 lead at halftime, the largest in box scores available back to the 2004-05 season. In that span, A-State has held a 30-point halftime lead five other times, the most recent coming against Central Baptist on Dec. 28, 2010 (55-22). A-State had not scored 50 or more points in a half since scoring 54 in the second half at South Alabama on Jan. 18, 2016 and it was the most in a half since scoring 57 against Belhaven on Dec. 6, 2014.

SCOUTING REPORT: ARMY

- ▶ Army enters the weekend with a 1-1 record. Oregon topped the Black Knights 91-77 in the season opener, but Army came back and won their home opener in a commanding 91-53 win against Mount Saint Mary (NY).
- ▶ The Black Knights have a plus-12 scoring margin thus far, scoring 84 points a game on 43.7 percent shooting. Army is 38.1 percent from 3-point range and also carries a plus-12 margin on the glass.
- ▶ Kennedy Edwards (12.0 ppg) is one of three players averaging double figures for Army thus far. He's joined by Jordan Fox (10.5) and Luke Morrison (10.5).
- ▶ Mac Hoffman leads the Black Knights on the glass, pulling in 8.0 rebounds per game. He has a team-high seven offensive rebounds as well.

GUARDS CRASHING THE BOARDS

- ▶ It's nothing new to A-State fans to see Donte Thomas among the team leaders in rebounding, but he's joined by guard Rashad Lindsey as team leaders in rebounds after the first three games.
- ▶ Thomas led or tied for the team lead in rebounding six times last season and has led or tied for the lead in all three games this season. Lindsey and Thomas each had six rebounds at North Dakota State and Thomas had seven boards against Central Baptist and at Georgetown.
- ▶ Guards are responsible for 71 of the 117 team rebounds (60.7 percent) thus far.
- ▶ Among Sun Belt Conference athletes, Thomas, Lindsey and C.J. Foster are in the top-20 rebounders. Thomas ranks tied for 11th with 6.7 per game while Lindsey and Foster are tied for 19th with 5.0 per game.

THOMAS ENJOYS DC HOMECOMING

- ▶ When the schedule for the 2016-17 season came out, it was easy for Donte Thomas to cricle the game at Georgetown on a calendar.
- ▶ Thomas, a Washington native, returned to his roots and played in front of many family and friends helping A-State to a 78-72 win.
- ▶ Logging 22 minutes, Thomas scored 12 points, had a team high seven rebounds and five assists. Going up against the Hoyas full court press much of the night, Thomas committed just two turnovers and was 3-for-5 from the floor.

RISING TO THE OCCASION

- ▶ The Nov. 17 game at Georgetown marked the fourth over the last two seasons against a higher resources conference foe on the road.
- ▶ Devin Carter has risen to the occasion in all four games, scoring 20 or more points while shooting at least 50 percent from the field.
- ▶ In the four games (at Oregon, at Baylor, at Missouri and at Georgetown), Carter has hit 35-of-64 (54.7 percent) of his field goal attempts while going 14-for-28 (50 percent) from 3-point range.
- ▶ For the four games, he's averaged 22.8 points (91 pts) and 5 rebounds (20 rebs). His 25 points at Georgetown are the most among the four outings while 20 at Baylor are the fewest.

WELCOME BACK

- ▶ C.J. Foster elected to redshirt last season and the move has paid off so far this season.
- ▶ Foster tied his career high with nine points in the season opener at North Dakota State and ranks sixth on the team averaging 7.0 points per game.
- ▶ In the statement win at Georgetown, Foster set a career high with six rebounds. He had a key offensive rebound in the final minute that helped A-State clinch the victory. On the year, Foster has a team-high seven offensive rebounds.

TRENDING UP

- ▶ It's early, but A-State has seen an uptick in shooting percentages over the three games compared to last season.
- ▶ A-State is shooting 50.9 percent (89-1175) from the field, up from 43.4 percent (86-198) at this point last season. From 3-point range, A-State is up from 31.8 percent (14-44) to 41.7 percent (20-48) this year.

ELITE COMPANY

- ▶ Senior guard Donte Thomas was among elite company last season by averaging at least 11 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists. So far this season, he's near those numbers averaging 10.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 7.3 assists.
- ▶ Only four players last season averaged those numbers - Alex Hamilton (Louisiana Tech: 19.9 PPG, 5.7 RPG, 6.2 APG), Denzel Valentine (Michigan State: 19.2 PPG, 7.5 RPG, 7.8 APG), Kyle Collinsworth (BYU: 15.3 PPG, 8.2 RPG, 7.4 APG) and Donte Thomas (Arkansas State: 11.2 PPG, 5.8 RPG, 5.6 APG) - but only Thomas returns this year.

PROVEN WINNERS

- ▶ Head Coach Grant McCasland embarks on his first season as head coach of the Red Wolves with a proven coaching staff full of winners.
- ▶ McCasland compiled a record of 199-45 (.816) in stops at Midland College (NJCAA) and Midwestern State (NCAA D2) and is joined by associate head coach Ross Hodge who posted a 146-24 (.859) record at Pairs JC (NJCAA) and Midwestern State (NCAA D2). Assistant Coach James Miller produced a 77-23 (.770) record at New Mexico JC (NJCAA) and assistant Jareem Dowling was 19-11 (.633) at Scotland Performance Institute (Prep).
- ▶ The staff has produced a record of 443-103 (.811) with 17 seasons of head coaching positions at various levels.

ABOUT THE GAME

Deven Simms, fouled after stealing an inbounds pass, made two free throws with 12 seconds remaining to help Arkansas State hold off a furious Georgetown rally for a 78-72 victory on Thursday night at McDonough Arena.

A-State (2-1) built a lead of 23 points late in the first half before carrying a 48-29 advantage to halftime. Georgetown used a 22-7 run, capped by two free throws from L.J. Peak, to close within 74-72 with 50 seconds remaining.

A free throw by C.J. Foster made it 75-72 before Simms' steal and free throws. A-State got the ball back on a charge then lost it on a steal by Jagan Mosley, but Pryor's rushed 3-pointer with four seconds left missed.

"Georgetown has a tremendous team and they are going to be great, but for us as a team we've got great guys that have competed since day one," said A-State head coach Grant McCasland. "Our seniors (Donte Thomas and Devin Carter) told me they wanted to win and they brought it tonight. That's why we won and I'm fortunate to coach this team. I'm proud of the steps we've taken to this point and I'm excited about where we will go from here."

Devin Carter had a game-high 25 points, 19 of which came in the first half. The Red Wolves had four others finish in double figures with Simms posting 13 points off the bench. Donte Thomas had 12 points, seven rebounds and five assists while Rashad Lindsey added 12 points and three rebounds. Jessie Govan led the Hoyas with 20 points while Peak had 18.

A-State, which shot 65.4 percent (17-26) in the first half, finished 55 percent (28-51) from the floor and 50 percent (6-12) from 3-point range. Georgetown finished 41 percent (23-56) from the field, but just 15 percent (3-20) from 3-point range.

A-STATE'S 15TH HEAD COACH

- ▶ Head Coach Grant McCasland was named the 15th head coach in program history back in March.
- ▶ McCasland begins his first season with five returning letter winners on the squad, including two starters, with nine newcomers added to the roster.
- ▶ McCasland is one of 50 new NCAA Division I coaches at their respective school this season and one of 29 in their first Division I head coaching role. Two of the 29 new head coaches in their first Division I experience have NBA head coaching experience: Terry Porter (Portland) and Mike Dunleavy Sr. (Tulane).
- ▶ McCasland has a tie to one of the 29 new Division I head coaches as Northern Colorado head coach Jeff Linder was an assistant coach on McCasland's staff at Midland College for two seasons.
- ▶ First year head coaches at A-State have averaged a record of 11-11. Marvin Speight (16-9), John Rauth (16-8) and Jack Dale (16-9) have the most wins among A-State first year head coaches.
- ▶ The Red Wolves face four opponents this year that feature new head coaches: Army, Little Rock, TCU and UT Martin.

DEFENDING THE TREY

- ▶ All three opponents thus far have shot 22 percent or less from 3-point range against the Red Wolves.
- ▶ North Dakota State was just 1-for-11 (9.1 percent) in the season opener and Central Baptist was 6-for-27 (22.2 percent) beyond the arc. A-State held Georgetown without a 3-point field goal in the first half (0-6) on Nov. 17 before the Hoyas finished 3-for-20 (15 percent).
- ▶ After three games, opponents are shooting 17.2 percent (10-58) from long range. A-State ranks seventh in the most recent NCAA Division I statistical rankings and is second among Sun Belt peers (South Alabama - 3rd | 13.9 percent).

QUICK STARTS

- ▶ The Red Wolves have held large halftime leads in each of the last two games and shot 60 percent or better in the first half of each game.
- ▶ A-State built a 56-20 advantage against Central Baptist back on Nov. 14 and shot 63.6 percent (21-33) from the field. The Red Wolves followed with a 48-29 lead at Georgetown and shot 65.4 percent (17-26) from the floor.
- ▶ In the three games this year, A-State has outscored opponents 138-89 in the first half, an average of 16.3 points per game. In the first half alone, the Red Wolves are shooting 59.5 percent (50-84) overall and 56 percent (14-25) beyond the arc.

NUMBER CHANGES

- ▶ Donte Thomas, C.J. Foster and Connor Kern have each changed numbers since last season.
- ▶ Donte Thomas has switched from No. 24 to No. 0 while C.J. Foster swapped No. 13 to No. 5. Connor Kern traded No. 2 for No. 12.

30TH SEASON AT THE CONVOCAATION CENTER

- ▶ The 2016-17 season marks the 30th for A-State with the Convocation Center as the home court.
- ▶ A crowd of 10,766 watched the first A-State men's basketball game at the Convo on December 5, 1987 against Memphis.
- ▶ A-State has a home record of 285-115 (.713) inside the Convocation Center.

ARKANSAS STATE BASKETBALL

HEAD COACH GRANT McCASLAND

Grant McCasland was named the 15th head coach in Arkansas State's history on March 16, 2016.

A 17-year coaching veteran, McCasland holds a 199-44 (.819) record as a head coach at the junior college and NCAA Division II levels.

McCasland spent the last five seasons as an assistant coach at Baylor, helping lead the Bears to NCAA Tournament appearances in 2012, 2014, 2015 and 2016. Prior to Baylor, he spent two seasons as the head coach at Midwestern State and led the program to back-to-back Elite Eight appearances in the NCAA Division II Tournament. McCasland also has head coaching experience at the junior college level, leading Midland College to the 2007 NJCAA national championship.

Working on head coach Scott Drew's staff at Baylor, McCasland has helped the Bears average 26 wins per year, posting a 125-55 record, including a 10-3 postseason mark. The Irving, Texas native helped Baylor rise to national prominence with five 20-win seasons, five postseason appearances, the Big 12's first NIT championship and Baylor's first postseason tournament title in its 107-year history.
