RED WOLVES FIRST IN A LINE OF SUN BELT OPPONENTS

Geographically, the Southland and Sun Belt conferences share plenty of overlapping areas. Both leagues feature member schools in Louisiana, Arkansas and Texas.

As such, Northwestern State will see plenty of Sun Belt opponents this season. Beginning with this weekend's series against Arkansas State, the Demons will face four Sun Belt foes this season in a total of seven games.

NSU's next four games come against members of the Sun Belt, including its first midweek game of the season against UL Lafayette on Feb. 28.

The Demons have a home-and-home series with UL Monroe on April 4-5 and will travel to Little Rock on May 9 to face former Demons pitching coach Chris Curry's Trojans.

THE HISTORY WITH ARKANSAS STATE

Northwestern State and Arkansas State meet for the second straight season in a three-game, non-conference season. A season ago, the Demons went to Jonesboro, Arkansas, and took two of three games.

It marked the first time NSU traveled to northeast Arkansas since 2003 when it also won two of three games. This weekend marks the first time since 2004 Arkansas State has played the Demons in Natchitoches.

Northwestern State won two of three games against the Red Wolves in that season-opening series.

PEN AUTHORS STRONG START TO OPENING WEEKEND

With pitch counts shortening Demons starters' outings in a series win against Cincinnati, the Northwestern State bullpen more than picked up the slack.

Six relievers went to the mound during the three-game series and combined to allow 10 hits and two earned runs in 13 2-3 innings while striking out 17.

A NEW CAJUN CANNON AT NSU?

One of Northwestern State's most notable athletic alums is quarterback Bobby Hebert, who earned the nickname the "Cajun Cannon" during his college and pro careers in both the USFL and the NFL.

It remains to be seen if catcher **Kelsey Richard**, a native of Jennings in southwest Louisiana, will have an Hebert-esque career, but the redshirt junior enjoyed a strong opening weekend defensively.

Richard, who threw out six of 31 runners as a sophomore, cut down two of three would-be base stealers during the Demons' series with Cincinnati.

NEW MAN ATOP THE DEMONS' CHAIN

Former Northwestern State All-Southland Conference first baseman and Academic All-American **Bobby Barbier** is in his first season as the Demons head coach.

Barbier has spent the past six seasons as an assistant at Alabama and at NSU. He was the Demons' pitching coach for the past two seasons, helping guide Northwestern State to a combined ERA of 3.28 across 986 1-3 innings.

Barbier oversaw the development of Adam Oller, who was named a second-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball magazine and a third-teamer by the American Baseball Coaches Association. In Barbier's first season, he helped current graduate manager **Brandon Smith** tie the school season saves record (10).

Barbier is the first former Demon baseball player to coach the team since Johnnie Emmons concluded his three-year run in 1989.

FRY TABBED PRESEASON ALL-SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE

For the second straight season, junior **David Fry** was named to the Preseason All-Southland Conference Team.

Fry was chosen as the second-team second baseman for the second straight season. Southeastern Louisiana's Carson Crites was the first-team selection.

In his two seasons, Fry has been named the second-team second baseman (sophomore) and the third-team second baseman (freshman) on the postseason All-Southland Conference Team.

As a sophomore, Fry led Northwestern State with seven home runs while hitting .264.

Fry enters the season as the Demons' active career leader in at-bats (403), runs (63), hits (107), doubles (27), home runs (9), RBIs (57) and total bases (163).

NO PRESSURE ON NEW NO. 35

Junior right-hander **John Carter Sanner**, a transfer from Pearl River Community College, is slated to make his Northwestern State debut in Saturday's game against Cincinnati.

Gauging by his choice of jersey number, Sanner likes high expectations.

Two Northwestern State pitchers have earned All-American honors in the past 23 seasons - right-handers **Reggie Gatewood** (1994) and **Adam Oller** (2016).

Both Gatewood and Oller wore No. 35, which happens to be the jersey number of Sanner's favorite professional pitcher, Detroit right-hander Justin Verlander.

In two seasons at Pearl River (Mississippi) Community College, Sanner went 8-7 and was a Mississippi junior college all-state selection as a freshman.

Sanner acquitted himself well in his first Division I start, tossing four innings of one-run ball against Cincinnati before hitting his early-season pitch count limit. Sanner did not issue a walk and struck out five Bearcats on Feb. 18.

LANGDON SHINES IN DEBUT

Junior transfer **Cole Langdon** (Copiah-Lincoln CC) enjoyed a white-knuckle introduction to Division I baseball.

Langdon started the eighth inning of Northwestern State's 3-2 win against Cincinnati on Feb. 18 with the Demons clinging to a one-run lead.

All Langdon did was collect a two-inning save without allowing a hit and striking out four.

Langdon's six-out save was one of two multi-inning saves Northwestern State recorded against Cincinnati as freshman right-hander **Evan Daigle** closed the Demons' 6-2 win on Feb. 19 with three scoreless innings.

BEAR A MODEL OF EFFICIENCY

Senior left-hander **Devin Bear** held his momentum across the offseason.

After sharing the team lead with 21 appearances in 2016, Bear was the lone Demons pitcher to appear in two games during the season-opening weekend.

Bear needed just nine pitches to strike out a pair of Cincinnati hitters and earn the win on Feb. 18. A day later, he needed just one pitch to retire the lone batter he faced.

KAUFMAN PROVES HE HAS WHEELS

As a fifth-year senior, designated hitter/infielder **Regan Kaufman** has seen plenty during his time at Northwestern State.

In his first at-bat of his senior season, Kaufman showed the 1,478 in attendance at Brown-Stroud Field something they had never seen - Kaufman hitting a triple.

Kaufman, a Natchitoches native, ripped the first pitch he saw in 2017 into the right-center field gap and beat a relay throw to third for his first triple in 336 career plate appearances.

ALUMNUS BARBIER IN GOOD COMPANY

First-year head coach **Bobby Barbier** will continue what has been a bit of a tradition among Northwestern State baseball coaches.

Although Barbier is the first former Demon player to coach his alma mater's team since Johnnie Emmons ended a three-year run in 1987-89, he is far from the first NSU alum to do so.

Two of the top three coaches on Northwestern State's all-time wins list - Herbie Smith (327 wins from 1969-86) and Jim Wells (192 wins from 1990-94) - are NSU alumni. Wells' .683 winning percentage (192-89) ranks as the best in school history and his 192 wins sit third behind Smith and Mitch Gaspard's 2010 wins from 2002-07.

NEW FACES ACROSS THE NSU ROSTER

In addition a new head coach, Northwestern State welcomes 16 newcomers to the roster this season as well as a new pitching coach (**Chris Bertrand**) and new hitting coach (**Taylor Dugas**).

The 16 newcomers include 11 freshmen - **Evan Daigle** (Port Allen, La./Brusly HS), **Peyton Davis** (Bossier City, La./Airline HS), **Chaney Dodge** (Carencro, La./Teurlings Catholic HS), **Hudson LaBorde** (Lafayette, La./Lafayette HS), **Emile Lege** (Lafayette, La./Lafayette HS), **Donovan Ohnoutka** (Natchitoches, La./St. Mary's HS), **Caleb Ricca** (Prairieville, La./Dutchtown HS), **Jake Rice** (Montgomery, Texas/Montgomery HS), **Tyler Smith** (Franklinton, La./Covington HS), **Payton Stafford** (Prairieville, La./Dutchtown HS) and **Cameron**

Taylor (Bossier City, La./Airline HS).

Five junior college transfers round out the new faces. They are **Carter Hankins** (Purvis, Miss./Pearl River CC), **Dan Hlad** (Midlothian, Ill./Black Hawk College), **Cole Langdon** (Ventress, La./Copiah-Lincoln CC), **John Carter Sanner** (Hattiesburg, Miss./Pearl River CC) and **Hunter Uzzle** (Orange, Texas/Eastern Oklahoma JC). All five are juniors.

Four freshmen - Daigle, Lege, Ricca and Smith - and three transfers - Hlad, Langdon and Sanner - all made their debuts during the season's opening weekend.

NEW FACES NOT LIMITED TO PLAYERS

The 16 newcomers are not the only newcomers to the Demons program.

With **Bobby Barbier**'s ascension to the head coaching position, it opened up a spot on the staff as the Demons' pitching coach. That role now belongs to **Chris Bertrand**, who comes to Natchitoches after four seasons as the head coach at Texas-Tyler.

For the first time since 2014, the Demons have a new volunteer assistant as former New York Yankee and Alabama standout and multiple school record holder **Taylor Dugas** takes over in that role.

Both Bertrand (Abbeville) and Dugas (Lafayette) are Louisiana natives who make their return to the Pelican State.

TEAMING UP AGAIN

Natchitoches has become a popular spot for high school reunions of sorts.

The 2017 Demons roster features teammates from Brusly High School (**Kwan Adkins**, **Evan Daigle**, **Austin Reich**), Bossier City-Airline (**Peyton Davis**, **Cameron Taylor**), Geismar-Dutchtown (**Caleb Ricca**, **Payton Stafford**), Lafayette High School (**Hudson LaBorde**, **Emile Lege**), Montgomery (Texas) High School (**Jake Rice**, **Kyle Swanson**), Shreveport-Evangeline (**Brooks Bryan**, **Spencer Goodwin**, **Miller Parker**) and Shreveport-Loyola College Prep (**Nathan Jones**, **Austin Townsend**).

Additionally, both fifth-year senior **Regan Kaufman** and freshman **Donovan Ohnoutka** are products of St. Mary's School in Natchitoches.

The teammates don't stop at the high school level.

First baseman **Carter Hankins** and pitcher **John Carter Sanner** were teammates at Pearl River Community College. Sanner was a high school teammate of 2015 Southland Conference Hitter of the Year **Cort Brinson**, who finished his Northwestern State career in 2016.

TIDWELL, FRY COULD FIND THEMSELVES IN RECORD BOOKS

Senior right-handed pitcher **Evan Tidwell** has handled several roles during his first three seasons. After settling into the weekend rotation for the first time in his career, Tidwell will open his senior year as the Sunday starter.

Through three seasons, Tidwell has appeared in 47 games, giving him a chance to crack the program's top-10 list in career appearances. Tidwell, a Zachary High School product, needs 15 appearances to tie Casey Johnson (2000-03) and Dennis Choate (1972-75) for ninth all-time with 62 appearances.

In each of the past two seasons at least one Demons starter has made 15 starts.

Junior infielder **David Fry** is in a similar situation as Tidwell.

After doubling in a Feb. 18 win against Cincinnati, Fry has 28 career doubles, five shy of tying head coach **Bobby Barbier** and Curtis Ardoyn for 10th on the school's all-time list.

Fry blasted a team-best seven home runs as a junior, five more than in his freshman season. Fry needs 11 home runs to tie David Bailey for 10th on NSU's career list.

He also needs 9 hit by pitches to tie Tigger Lyles for seventh in school history after being tagged twice during the opening weekend.

D1BASEBALL HIGH ON DEMONS' DRAFT PROSPECTS

In its annual conference previews, D1Baseball.com thought highly of veteran and new Demons alike.

Three NSU juniors - outfielder **Kwan Adkins** (5), infielder **David Fry** (18) and right-handed pitcher **Cole Langdon** (20) - ranked among the publication's top 20 Southland Conference 2017 draft prospects.

A pair of sophomore right-handers - **Nathan Jones** (3) and **Austin Reich** (4) - were among the top 10 draft prospects for the 2018 event.

Finally, D1Baseball.com tagged freshman shortstop **Caleb Ricca**

as the top choice on its list of 10 impact freshmen in the Southland Conference. Ricca also was named the Southland Conference Preseason Freshman of the Year by Perfect Game USA.

SCHEDULE FEATURES TOP 25 CHALLENGES

As has been customary, the Demons face a challenging schedule both in the Southland Conference, which placed three teams in the top 51 of the 2016 final RPI, and outside of conference play.

Northwestern State will face three teams who earned national top-25 rankings in preseason polls.

The Demons will face UL Lafayette on Feb. 28. The Ragin' Cajuns are ranked 13th by both Baseball America and D1Baseball.com, 14th by Collegiate Baseball, 15th by the National College Baseball Writers Association and 16th by the USA Today Coaches Poll.

From March 17-19, the Demons will travel to Oklahoma State, which is the NCBWA's and USA Today's No. 22 preseason team.

A visit to LSU on May 16 concludes NSU's run against preseason ranked teams. The Tigers are Collegiate Baseball's preseason No. 2, the NCBWA's and USA Today's No. 3 team, Baseball America's No. 4 squad and D1Baseball's No. 5 pick.
