## BOBCAT BITS

### TEXAS STATE EYES FIRST HOME WIN OVER ARKANSAS STATE

The Texas State baseball team will play host to Arkansas State in a three-game Sun Belt Conference series March 31-April 2 at Bobcat Ballpark. A-State leads the all-time series 9-4 and has never lost to Texas State in San Marcos (4-0). The Red Wolves ended TXST's season last year in the SBC Championship (hosted by the Bobcats) and swept a three-game series in 2015.

The Bobcats (16-9, 5-1 SBC) have won four consecutive weekend series and are 11-1 in weekend outings over the past month. They own sweeps over Richmond, Alabama A&M and Appalachian State, while taking two out of three from defending national champion Coastal Carolina. They also lead the Sun Belt in wins both overall and in league play.

Arkansas State (12-12, 2-4 SBC) used a 4-3 10-inning triumph March 28 to snap a four-game losing skid. The Red Wolves took a series off ULM to open league play before being swept by the Chanticleers this past weekend. They are tied for fifth in the West Division through two weekends of play.

### BOBCATS ONE WIN SHY OF HISTORY

Texas State enters the final day of March sporting a 13-3 record over the past 30 days. The 13 victories are already the second-most in the month of March in school history and are the most since 2012. A triumph over Arkansas State on March 31 would tie the school record for most wins in March. The only other time a Texas State club reached 14 victories in March was 1992 (14-7). The current win percentage this month of .813 is the best in March in school history. Texas State has also suffered just three losses since the end of February. If the Bobcats close out with a triumph over the Red Wolves, than that mark will tie for the second-fewest losses in any calendar month in school history (minimum 10 games). The only months in school history where TXST lost just two games was February 1990 (13-2) and April 2009 (14-2). ### TXST WELCOMED INTO NATIONAL DISCUSSION

The Bobcats received votes in the latest NCBWA rankings released March 27. TXST used a 15-game stretch where the club went 13-2 to enter the national picture. This was the first time in 2017 that Texas State received votes in any of the national polls. The NCBWA does not list how many votes a team receives.

### TEXAS STATE HELPS RAISE COLON CANCER AWARENESS

The Texas State and Texas A&M baseball programs wore blue laces in their matchup March 28 at Bobcat Ballpark to help raise awareness for colon cancer and to help benefit Kiel Colon Cancer. The mission of the organization is to decrease the number of preventable deaths caused by colon cancer through education and awareness initiative, encouraging healthy lifestyle choices and supporting colon cancer research. ## 'CATS SHATTER ATTENDANCE MARK, TOPPLE UT 11-10 IN EXTRAS

Texas State defeated Texas 11-10 in 10 innings on March 11 inside Bobcat Ballpark. The win was the first all-time for the Bobcats at home against UT, and it also set a new all-time attendance mark of 3,017 fans. After battling back to tie the game on four different occasions, the Bobcats were finally able to take their first lead in dramatic fashion in the bottom of the 10th. The game-winning hit came off the bat of Luke Sherley, who's single to shallow right center drove in sophomore Ryan Newman and set the record crowd into a frenzy. This was the fourth walkoff hit of the season for TXST (Purdue, Feb. 18 / Richmond, March 5 / Coastal Carolina, March 17). Sherley went 4-for-5 to tie for a career-high in hits. He recorded hits in the eighth, ninth and 10th innings. He also drove in a career-high four runs and scored in both the eighth and ninth frames. Jaylen Hubbard registered a career-high in hits (4-for-5), and Jacob Almendarez went 3-for-4 with two RBIs and a run scored. Theodore Hoffman went 2-for-6 with two runs scored, and Newman scored three times. Blake Walden (5-0) earned the win on the mound and is now tied for the nation's lead in that category. He threw the final 2.2 frames and gave up just one run on two hits, while striking out two. Junior Cam Baird started the contest and logged the first 4.0 frames. He

conceded three runs (two earned) on five hits, while striking out three. Senior Brandon Courville, sophomore Anthony Pagano and true freshmen Zachary Leigh and Shane Daughety also saw time on the mound.

### BOBCATS VANQUISH REIGNING NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

Texas State won two out of three games against Coastal Carolina to open Sun Belt Conference action March 17-19. The Chanticleers were ranked No. 20 in the nation at the time and are the reigning NCAA champions. The Bobcats won the first game 5-4 in 14 innings thanks in large part to a walkoff home run from sophomore Ryan Newman. CCU was narrowly able to even the series with a 4-3 victory March 18, but Texas State used a five-run seventh inning in the series finale to win 10-7 and snatch the series from the visitors. Newman and junior Luke Sherley both had six hits against Coastal Carolina, and they combined to score seven times. Junior Blake Walden threw 3.0 innings of relief to earn the victory on the mound in the opener, and sophomore Brayden Theriot tossed the final 3.2 frames to collect the win in the finale. The two relievers combined to allow no runs on two hits, while striking out three each. This was the first time Texas State ever hosted the defending national champions.

### TXST ENDS DROUGHT AGAINST RICE

Texas State defeated Rice 13-4 on March 15 at Bobcat Ballpark. The Bobcats picked up their first midweek victory of the season and also snapped an eight-game losing streak to the Owls that dated back to the 2012 season. Texas State plated solo tallies in each of the first two innings, and the visitors tied the game at 2-2 with runs of their own in the top of the third and fourth frames. The maroon and gold busted the game open with a seven-spot in the home half of the fourth and added another four runs the rest of the way to secure the nine-run triumph. The runs in the fourth inning were the most scored in a single frame this season. TXST outhit Rice 14-9 and also did not commit an error in the field. Sophomore Jacob Almendarez led the Bobcats at the plate with a 3-for-5 effort. He scored once and tied his career high with two runs driven in. Juniors Luke Sherley and Derek Scheible, along with sophomores Ryan Newman and Jaylen Hubbard all had two hits. Junior Cam Baird earned the starting nod on the mound and left after allowing just two runs on five hits in 3.2 frames. He struck out four and walked two. True freshman Broc Bosse (1-0) earned the first win of his career after sitting down both batters he faced in relief.

### ORTEGA NAMED SUN BELT PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jonathan Ortega was selected as the Sun Belt Conference Community Coffee Player of the Week, the league announced on March 7. The sophomore infielder from Victoria, Texas, helped lead the Bobcats to a 3-1 record in games played from Feb. 27-March 5, which included a weekend sweep of Richmond. He had at least two hits in every game and finished with a .611 (11-for-18) average. He recorded clutch home runs in the first two games of the series with the Spiders, which marked the first time in his career he hit homers in back-to-back contests. In the second game with TXST trailing 4-2 in the eighth, he registered a two-out, full-count home run to give the Bobcats the lead in a game they would later win in extra innings. Ortega scored twice in every outing against Richmond and also added a run against Sam Houston State in the midweek contest. In the first game against the Spiders, he posted career highs in hits (5), RBIs (7) and doubles (2). He also stole a base in all four games and never struck out all week, while drawing three walks. This was the first weekly honor for a TXST player this season. Ortega picked up the second SBC accolade of his career (March 15, 2016), making him the first Texas State player to be selected as the league's top hitter on more than one occasion. The other two award winners have been former great Tanner Hill (March 19, 2015) and junior Luke Sherley (March 1, 2016). Ortega also earned College Sports Madness SBC Player of the Week honors, which does not have separate awards for hitters and pitchers.

### TXST SITS DOWN NATIONALLY-RANKED Foe

Texas State earned a hard-fought 12-11 upset victory over No. 22 Oklahoma State on Feb. 25 at Allie P. Reynolds Stadium. The Bobcats never trailed in the game but had to fend off three separate Cowboy comebacks. Junior Blake Walden (2-0) earned the win on the mound after throwing the final 1.2 innings. He allowed one run on two hits. Sophomore Wes Engle took the ball first and left after 4.0 frames. He struck out five, walked four and gave up three runs on two hits. Pearson, sophomore Brandon Lewis and true freshman Zachary Leigh all logged time on the mound between Engle and Walden. Junior Derek Scheible went 4-for-5 at the plate and tied the school record by scoring five times. He also registered a career-high four runs batted in to go along with a career high in hits. Junior Dylan Paul went 3-for-5 with three RBI and one run scored, and sophomore Jonathan Ortega finished 3-for-6 with an RBI. Sophomore Jacob Almendarez went 2-for-5 with two RBI and two runs scored. Overall, Texas State outhit Oklahoma State 17-11.

**THE SEASON OPENER**

Texas State was the only Sun Belt school to schedule an opponent from a Power 5 Conference (ACC, Big 12, Big Ten, Pac-12, SEC) in the opening weekend of the season. The Bobcats split a four-game set with Purdue out of the Big Ten, which included a come-from-behind 13-11 triumph in the second game of a doubleheader on Feb. 18. TXST fell behind 10-5, but scored eight runs in the final two innings - including a walkoff homer from Derek Scheible - to earn the first win of the season. The Bobcats then blew past the Boilermakers 14-5 in the series finale. Texas State hosted 6,725 fans (1,681/game), which included 2,068 in the opener. The figure was the second-highest for an opening night game and the then-11th highest attendance figure in stadium history.

**BOBCATS BOAST TOP ATTENDANCE NUMBERS**

Since the NCAA began tracking attendance figures in 2014, Texas State has boasted the second-best attendance in the Sun Belt Conference. From 2014-16, the Bobcats welcomed 120,802 (1,328/game) patrons to Bobcat Ballpark. During the first 19 home games of this season, TXST has an average attendance of 1,637, which is good for 31st in the nation. The Bobcats have also welcomed the two largest crowds in school history this year, with the record of 3,017 coming in a victory over Texas on March 21. There were also 2,952 who entered Bobcat Ballpark to watch Texas State take on Texas A&M March 28. Adding in games against Purdue (2,068) and Baylor (2,002), Texas State has already welcomed a school record four separate crowds of 2,000 or more fans this season. The previous school record of three 2K+ crowds was set in 2014.

**THE 2017 SCHEDULE**

The Bobcats are in the midst of a treacherous 2017 slate that features numerous dangerous opponents and allows Texas State fans plenty of opportunities to see some of the best college baseball teams in the nation. TXST is playing 23 road games and 33 contests in the friendly confines of Bobcat Ballpark. Of those 22 different opponents, seven received preseason national top-25 rankings from at least one of the five accredited ranking organizations (Coastal Carolina, Louisiana, Oklahoma State, Rice, Sam Houston State, Texas, Texas A&M). Also on the docket are seven programs that competed in the NCAA Championship last year (CCU, OSU, Rice, TAMU, SHSU, Louisiana, South Alabama), two College World Series participants (CCU, OSU) and the defending national champions (CCU). Of the first 30 games this season, 24 are scheduled to be played at home. Of the final 26 games, 17 will be played on the road.

**A NEW FORMAT THIS YEAR**

Beginning with the 2017 season, the Sun Belt Conference will conduct its baseball regular season with divisional play. Two divisions will be comprised of six teams each, and divisional champions will be awarded at the end of the year based on the winning percentage against all teams, regardless of division. The 2017 Sun Belt Conference Baseball Championship will be seeded with the division winners as the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds, with the No. 1 seed being awarded to the divisional winner with the best conference winning percentage. The number of teams playing in the conference championship will increase from eight to 10. This would cause two additional games to be played. The first round games will include the No. 8 seed vs. No. 9 seed and the No. 7 seed vs. the No. 10 seed, with both contests conducted as single-elimination games on Tuesday of tournament week. The conference tournament is set for May 23-28 at J.I. Clements Stadium on the campus of Georgia Southern.

### BOBCATS SELECTED FOURTH IN SBC WEST DIVISION

Texas State was selected to finish fourth in the West Division of the 2017 Sun Belt Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll, the league announced Feb. 8. The Bobcats collected 44 points to land one point shy of Little Rock, while Louisiana sat atop the division with 72 points. The Ragin' Cajuns also earned all 12 first-place votes. UTA was slotted second with 50 points, while Arkansas State (27 points) and ULM (14 points) were fifth and sixth, respectively. Coastal Carolina, the defending national champions, were projected as the favorites in the SBC East Division with 70 points and 10 first-place votes. South Alabama earned a first-place vote and was tabbed second with 56 points, while Georgia Southern picked up the final first-place vote and landed in third with 48 points. Troy (39 points), Georgia State (23 points) and Appalachian State (15 points) rounded out the bottom half of the East Division.

### ORTEGA EARNS PRESEASON ACCOLADE

Jonathan Ortega was named to the 2017 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference Team. The sophomore member of the Texas State baseball program started all 59 games during his rookie campaign. He finished with a .286 (72-for-252) batting average, while also compiling 14 doubles, three triples, four home runs, 35 RBI's and 33 runs scored. The speedy infielder tied for the team lead with seven stolen bases and also finished third in the SBC with 166 assists. He ranked eighth in the conference in double plays turned (32) and ninth in total hits.

### HARRINGTON ADDS 6 FOR 2018

The Texas State baseball team and head coach Ty Harrington have announced that six high school seniors have been added to the program during the early signing period. The newest Bobcats all come from Texas and are set to join the team in the 2018 season. The class include two pitcher/infielders, two infielders, one outfielder and one pitcher. The newest Bobcats will be Matthew Charles (SS/RHP, 5-10, 155, Houston, Texas), Tyler Clark-Chiapparelli (SS/RHP, 6-0, 175, Austin, Texas), Wesley Faison (IF, 6-3, 225, Richmond, Texas), Matthew Nicholas (RHP, 6-0, 185, San Marcos, Texas), Dalton Shuffield (SS, 5-9, 150, San Antonio, Texas) and John Wutrich (OF, 5-11, 175, Midland, Texas).

### RECORD-TYING 5 BOBCATS CHOSEN IN 2016 MLB DRAFT

Texas State had five players selected in the 2016 Major League Baseball Draft. Jonathan Hennigan, Granger Studdard, Tanner Hill and Pasquale Mazzoccoli joined Lucas Humpal to tie the school record for TXST, joining the classes of 2011 and 2012. Humpal was the first Bobcat off the board, when the Baltimore Orioles picked him up with the 15th selection of the ninth round. Hennigan was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies with the first pick of the 21st round, while Studdard was picked by the Boston Red Sox with the 12th pick of the 22nd round. Hill was selected by the Arizona Diamondbacks with the 13th pick of the 26th round. The Diamondbacks have another Bobcat great in their starting lineup in MLB All-Star Paul Goldschmidt. Pasquale Mazzoccoli was drafted with the 29th position in the 35th round by the Pittsburgh Pirates. Texas State has had multiple players selected in seven consecutive drafts and in 13 since TXST coach Ty Harrington took over the program in 2000. Hennigan, Studdard, Hill and Mazzoccoli are the 40th, 41st, 42nd and 43rd players selected in the MLB Draft since Harrington began coaching at Texas State.

### TEXAS STATE BASEBALL PASSES 1,000 WINS

Texas State earned the program's 1,000th victory against Incarnate Word on March 4, 2016. The Bobcats did it in style with a 4-0 shutout and a complete-game, 11-strikeout performance from former Bobcat Lucas Humpal. Head coach Ty Harrington has won the lion's share, as he entered the 2017 campaign with 562 career victories. Other coaches who have earned victories at Texas State include Steve Prentice (222 from 1987-93), Howard Bushong (181 from 1994-99) and Jay Jeffrey (60 from 1985-86).

## TEXAS STATE COACH TY HARRINGTON

"(Texas A&M) pieced together some good at-bats. We couldn't get the out we needed with two outs in that sixth inning. They were able to get the two out hit, and that's probably what separated the game at that point and time. That's baseball sometimes. If we get out of that inning, then it's a tie game. But you have to make pitches when you need them, and they were able to land a ball right in between three guys when they needed it. We needed to rebound offensively and on the mound, but they were able to keep offensive pressure on us. They had great at-bats in the last six to nine outs of the game. Every once in awhile you get punched in the stomach. When you do that, it's what you do the next day. What you do in the next moment is almost as critical or important not only in growth, but also in who you are and what you want to become individually and as a team. When they walk into the gates tomorrow (for practice), they need to be ready."
