### MEDIA INFORMATION

**FACILITIES:** Media facilities in First National Bank Arena consist of an area at floor level on the east side of the court for reporters, broadcasters and photographers, as well as a television-film booth locate high on the east side of the arena. There is also a Media Room located on the west side open to the press before, during and after games. Admittance to these areas is by special credential issued only by the A-State Athletics Media Relations Office.

CREDENTIALS: Credentials for home games are provided to those members of the media who are covering the game in a full working capacity. Requests with names should be submitted in writing on company letterhead. Passes will be mailed to valid applicants as long as time permits; otherwise, passes may be claimed at the Media Entrance on the east side of the arena (Lower Green Entrance). Spouses, dates, children and non-workers are NOT permitted in the media areas. Passes must be displayed at all times, and A-State reserves the right to revoke passes and privileges at any time due to misrepresentation or misconduct. Requests for road game credentials may be made through the A-State Media Relations Women's Basketball SID (Caleb Garner).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces are available to members of the media on a paved lot adjacent to the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of the arena, Lot "A". Display a parking pass to the working attendant for admittance. Parking is on a first-come, first-serve basis. All parking pass requests should be made to the Athletics Media Relations Office.

**ENTRY:** Media representatives with proper A-State issued credentials will be allowed entrance ONLY at the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of First National Bank Arena. This is also the main entry to the athletics offices and is adjacent to the Media parking area.

GAME SERVICES: Programs, notes, reference guides, statistical packets, and live statistics (Stat Broadcast) are provided. Complimentary light refreshments and food will be available before and throughout the game.

PHOTOGRAPHERS: Photographers are not allowed to shoot from in front of the team benches nor from the catwalk above the floor (for security, insurance and safety reasons). Along the end lines, click on women's basketball. photographers must stay behind the broken line and clear from the free throw lane. Credentials are required to shoot from courtside. Certified photographers of newspapers, magazines, wire services and TV stations must request passes in writing. No credentials will be issued to freelance photographers unless authorized by A-State Media Relations.

INTERVIEWS: Head Coach Matt Daniel will be available in the media room after each game, following a brief team meeting. A-State student-athletes will also be available by request at this time. The A-State women's basketball locker room is CLOSED to the media following games. To arrange for a student-athlete interview

during the week, contact Caleb Garner, Assistant Athletic Media Relations Director at (870) 972-2707. All interviews must be approved by the head coach.

INJURY INFORMATION POLICY: A student-athlete's protected health information is protected by federal regulations under either the Health Information Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) or the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (the Buckley Amendment) and may not be disclosed without either the studentathlete's authorization under HIPAA or their consent under the Buckley Amendment. Authorized/consented injury information pertaining to a student-athlete shall be released to the media through the Athletics Media Relations Department after being authorized by the athletic trainer. It's also appropriate in post-game or weekly press conferences for head coaches to announce team injury updates. It's the policy of the Department of Athletics to provide accurate information on injuries and not withhold injury information from the media. Team physicians may be available to offer explanation on injuries if requested by the athletic trainer. Any sideline or locker room report made to the media shall be made by an athletic trainer, team physician, or a media relations staff representative.

RADIO: Radio broadcasts of Red Wolves men's basketball will be on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and will also be available over the Internet. Keith Merritt is the exuberant "Voice of the Red Wolves". The visiting team's "official" radio station, as designated by the visitors' SID, will be permitted origination privileges. A courtesy line is provided courtside. Any questions regarding broadcasts or the use of facilities should be directed to Caleb Garner. Assistant Athletics Media Relations Director.

### **KNOW THE FOE: GEORGIA SOUTHERN**

- Georgia Southern enters Saturday's game coming off a 58-46 loss at Little Rock that broke a twogame winning streak to open league play. The Eagles are currently 5-9 overall with a 2-1 league mark.
- Two players average double digits for the Eagles, led by Alexis Brown (10.9 pts/g) and Tatum Barber (10.4). Brown leads the Sun Belt Conference with a 94.9 percent free-throw percentage, which also leads the nation.
- Georgia Southern ranks fourth in the league in rebounding (39.9) and third in rebounding margin (+3.7). On the offensive glass, the Eagles rank third in the league at 15.0.
- Arkansas State has played Georgia State nine times since the 2010-11 season, with A-State leading 8-1 overall and 3-1 in Jonesboro. A full breakdown of the series can be found on page 12.

### AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD ...

- Give the Red Wolves their sixth win of the season.
- Hand the Scarlet and Black its fourth home win of the year.
- Mark the third straight win for the Red Wolves
- Improve A-State's lead in the overall series versus Georgia State to 9-1.
- Be better than a loss.

### **"STEAL MY SUNSHINE"**

- Arkansas State ranks first in the Sun Belt Confernece in total steals (143) and steals per game (10.2).
- Morgan Wallace (2nd 30/2.1 per game) and Jireh Washington (T7th 24/1.7) rank in the top 10 in the league in steals and steals per game.
- The Red Wolves have swiped 10 or more steals in nine games, including four straight and six of their last seven games. A-State has tallied 13 or more steals six times this season.

### **TURNOVERS, ANYONE?**

- Over the last four games, Araknsas State has forced 18 or more turnovers, including doing so in six of the last seven contests. A-State has forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games this season.
- On the flipside, A-State has taken care of the ball well in its last two games, turning it over 9 times vs. Texas State and 7 vs. Georgia State.

### **SUN BELT CONFERENCE OPENERS**

- Since joining the Sun Belt Conference prior to the 1991-92 season, Arkansas State has amassed a
  19-10 record in league openers. When opening league play at home, A-State is 12-3, while going 7-7 if
  the first game of conference play is on the road.
- In SBC home openers, A-State is 23-6 overall and has won eight in a row after defeating Georgia State on Thursday.
- The Red Wolves entered the season having won seven straight league lid-lifters and eight of their last nine.
- In road openers, A-State is 15-12 and won six straight prior to this season's loss to UT Arlington.

### **#TEAM1STWINS**

- The Red Wolves are among the least selfish teams in the Sun Belt Conference, ranking fifth in the league in assists per game (11.6). Jireh Washington ranks sixth in the league in assists per game (3.3).
- In A-State's five wins, the Red Wolves have posted 82 assists to 123 made baskets for a 66.7% assist percentage.

### ~MO~ KNOWS BASKETBALL

- After starting the season as one of Arkansas State's primary rebounding threats and not so much a scorer, tallying only 16 points through the first three games, Morgan Wallace lit up the stat sheet at the Maggie Dixon Classic en route to All-Tournament honors.
- Wallace scored 37 points in the two games (career-high 21 at DePaul) while bringing down 12 rebounds.
- This season, Wallace leads the team in minutes played per game (34.1) as well as rebounding (8.1), the
  latter which leads all guards in the conference and ranks fourth in the league overall.
- On Jan. 9 vs. Georgia State, Wallace led the charge with a double double at 21 points and 11 boards.
   She has hauled in 7+ rebounds in 10 games. In A-State's five wins, Wallace averages a double-double at 11.8 points per game and 10.0 rebounds.

### "WE'RE THE THREE BEST FRIENDS THAT ANYBODY COULD HAVE"

- So far this season, Arkansas State has had three or more players record double-digit scoring in eight
  of its 14 games.
- A-State had three or more players score in double figures in 19 of the Red Wolves' 30 games last season.

### PROVIDING A SPARK

 After starting the first six games of the year, Payton Tennison has come off the bench for the Red Wolves for four games before starting at LA Tech, but embraced the Sixth Woman role. In her first two games in reserve action, Tennison was one of the team's top scoring threats, combining for 29 points on 10-of-13 from the field, including a stellar 7-of-10 from three-point range.

### "STRING MUSIC!"

- The Red Wolves proved to be lethal from long range to open the season vs. CBC, knocking down 15 treys on 32 attempts. The 15 made tied a program-best while the 32 tries shattered the school record
- Payton Tennison (8-of-11) and Jada Ford (4-of-9) combined for 12 of those 15 scores, with Tennison draining seven straight to open the contest. Kayla Williams (2-of-2) and Hailee Erickson (1-of-6) also contributed to the record night.
- Ford and Tennison continued to be clutch from three at Tulsa, both hitting a pair of late threes to aid in A-State's 18-point comeback.
- In the Red Wolves' five wins, the team has shot 37.8 percent (42-of-111).

### TAKE IT TO THE BANK!

- Arkansas State has amassed a 318-109 (.745) overall mark in 32-plus seasons at First National Bank Arena.
- In home openers, the Red Wolves own a stellar 40-6 mark and have won 18 of their last 19 after defeating Central Baptist in the opener.

### **FORD TOUGH**

- Jada Ford climbed into A-State's top 10 in three-point shooting this season. The senior from Muskogee, Oklahoma, is now sixth all-time and needs one to tie for fifth. This season, Ford has hit a three-pointer in 10 straight games and 12 of 14 games.
- Ford ranks second on the team in double-figure scoring games (34) while leading the pack with 10 20-point outings. In fact, the Red Wolves tend to do well on the scoreboard when Ford scores 20 or more, owning a **9-1** record in those 10 performances.



# **LAST TIME OUT**



### Arkansas State 70, Georgia State 68 January 9, 2020 - Jonesboro, Arkansas

- Four players scored in double figures, including Morgan Wallace (21 points, 11 rebounds) and Jireh Washington (15, 10) with double-doubles to lead Arkansas State to a 70-68 overtime victory over Georgia State.
- The Red Wolves won their second straight game and did so after trailing by as much as 15, including by 12 in the fourth quarter. A-State outscored the Panthers 25-15 in the fourth to force OT.
- A-State shot over 70 percent at the free-throw line for the second straight game while also forcing 19 turnovers.
- The win was A-State's first home game in exactly a month.

### "I'M NOT USUALLY ONE FOR CHARITY (STRIPE VISITS)..."

- The Red Wolves were among the nation's best at getting to the free-throw line in 2018-19, topping the Sun Belt Conference in both free throw attempts (744) and free throws made (495). Those marks ranked sixth and 15th nationally.
- This season, through 14 games, A-State has seemingly continued that trend of getting to the stripe, ranking fourth in the league (34th nationally) with 304 free-throw attempts. According to HerHoopStats. com, the Red Wolves rank 18th nationally (out of 351 teams) in Free Throw Rate (% of two-point scoring attempts including all free throw trips that result in a free throw trip) with a 21.0 percent clip.
- Additionally, HerHoopStats.com ranks the Red Wolves 24th nationally in percentage of points from free throws (22.4%).
- Peyton Martin ranks fourth in the league at getting to the line, attempting 79 free throws this season.

### MILESTONE WATCH

- Ford eclipsed the 800-point mark for her career vs. Georgia State (1/9), and leads all active A-State players with 800 career points
- Peyton Martin (691) is on pace to reach the 700 (and possibly 800)-point mark
- Starr Taylor played in her 100th game as a Red Wolf on 12/14 at Memphis.
   Taylor has played in all but two games over her three-plus seasons at Arkansas State. Payton Tennison needs three games to reach 100.

### NOT A BAD START . . .

In the season-opening win vs. Central Baptist, Arkansas State brought down a whopping 64 rebounds, which was the fourth-most in a single game in program history and the most since 2009.

### A NEW ERA BEGINS

- Matt Daniel was hired on March 29 following Brian Boyer's 20-year tenure at the helm of the program.
- Daniel, a Jonesboro native, most recently spent five years as head coach at Marshall, where he led the Herd to the postseason for the first time ever.
- Before his stint at Marshall, Daniel pulled off one of the biggest turnarounds in NCAA history at Central Arkansas, improving by 15 games from Year 1 to Year 2.

### #NOTFIGHTINGALONE

 This season, the Arkansas State women's basketball team is wearing special shooting shirts with embroidered "WA" patches in memory of Wendy Anderson, the late wife of A-State football coach Blake Anderson who lost a courageous battle with cancer in August.

### MARTIIIIIIN!

- After earning third-team all-conference honors as a sophomore a year ago, junior forward Peyton Martin was tabbed Third Team All-Sun Belt Conference in the preseason coaches' poll.
- Martin led the Red Wolves in scoring (13.7) and rebounding (6.3) while also leading in blocks (0.6).

### "RIIIISE N' SHIIINE"

 Arkansas State's schedule features five games slated for start times of noon or earlier, including a pair of 11 a.m. tip-offs (at DePaul and at South Alabama). The Red Wolves added the fifth when tip-off at Memphis was moved up to Noon.

### "BACK IN [SCARLET &] BLACK"

- A-State brings back 70 percent or better in minutes (70 percent), rebounding (71 percent), steals (73 percent), scoring (73 percent), assists and blocks (76 percent).
- The Red Wolves return four players who started at least half of the 30 games in 2018-19: Peyton Martin (30 starts), Jireh Washington (26), Morgan Wallace (24) and Payton Tennison (19).

### (NATURAL) STATE OF MIND

- Arkansas State's 2019 roster features six players from the state of Arkansas, including two local products from Jonesboro (Starr Taylor and Mya Love). Maggie Mahan (Center Ridge), Peyton Martin (Pine Bluff), Payton Tennison (Valley Springs) and Morgan Wallace (Little Rock) are the other four Natural State products.
- That total ties Arkansas for the most among the five Division I programs in the state.

### **WE'RE COMIN' TO YOUR CITAYYYY**

- Arkansas State's schedule features 17 games away from the friendly confines of First National Bank Arena, with 12 at home (3 non-SBC, 9 SBC).
- That total is the most since the 2016-17 team played 18 games in the regular season away from Jonesboro.



### Arkansas State 86, Georgia Southern 75 March 2, 2019 - Jonesboro, Arkansas

JONESBORO, Ark. (3/2/19) - The Arkansas State women's basketball team collected an 86-75 win Saturday over Georgia Southern in its regularseason home finale at First National Bank Arena, securing a spot in the Sun Belt Conference Tournament

The Red Wolves improved to 9-5 at home this season, moving its overall record to 11-16 and league mark to 6-10. They could still host a Sun Belt Conference Tournament first-round game if they sweep both their games next week in Louisiana and if South Alabama drops its last two games of the regular season. Georgia Southern now holds a 7-21 overall record, while standing 2-15 in conference action.

Arkansas State was led by three players scoring in double figures, including freshman guard Jireh Washington with a career-high 24 points. Sophomore forward Peyton Martin picked up her fourth double-double of the season with a career-high 13 rebounds and 20 points. Junior guard Payton Tennison added 14 points for the Red Wolves.

Not only did A-State post its fourth most points in a game this year, it also tied its second highest field goal percentage (.484) and made 30 field goals to tie its second most on the season. The Red Wolves also made 20-of-22 free throws, including all 14 of its fourth-period attempts, for a season-high 90.9 percentage.

While Georgia Southern made 47.5 percent of its shots and went 13-of-26 from beyond the arc, A-State held a 37-31 advantage on the boards and outscored the Eagles 46-30 in the paint.
