FOR STARTERS ...

- This season is the 45th year of volleyball at Arkansas State, owning an all-time mark of 1,065-547-5 (.661).
- Entering the 2020 season, Arkansas State has the 20th most wins in Division I history.
- Arkansas State has met UT Arlington 22 times entering the week, dating back to 1982. The series is deadlocked at 11 wins apiece, although UTA owns a 7-5 lead when the match is played in Arlington. A-State owns a two-match winning streak, with both victories occurring in 2019.
- A-State ranks second in the Sun Belt Conference in opponent hitting percentage (.093) and is first in blocks per set (2.89).
- Arkansas State has held all its opponents to a hitting percentage of .200 or less in all five matches, including three sub-.100 marks. Dating back to last season, A-State has held its foes to under .200 in eight of the last nine matches.
- Josie Stanford's 28 kills on 10/3 vs. Little Rock was the most in a match by a Sun Belt Conference player this season and the highest total for an A-State player since 2018 (Carlisa May, 29). It also is tied for the most by a player in a match in the NCAA and is the most for a fourset match this season (as of Oct. 11).
- A-State is 41-1 since the 2017 season when taking the first two sets 2-0 in 2020.

Arkansas State went 2-3 in its first five matches in 2019, winning two
against Texas State and UT Arlington while dropping contests to South
Alabama, Troy and Appalachian State.

KNOW THE FOE: UT ARLINGTON

- UT Arlington enters the weekend 3-0 after taking all three matches at Little Rock last weekend (3-1, 3-0, 3-2). The Mavericks have had multiple matches postponed or canceled, including Sept. 25-26 versus A-State.
- UTA is led by reigning Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week **Brooke Townsend**, who leads the team in several statistical categories including kills (48), points (53.0) and attack percentage (.349). **Kylee Kapp** leads the Mavericks in assists (79) and aces (9) while **Briana Brown** is the reigning SBC Freshman of the Week after tallying 40 kills over the weekend (including 26 in the series finale). **Michaela Wright** leads UTA at the net with 19 total blocks, and reigning SBC Defensive Player of the Week **Alli Wells** leads in digs (81).
- A-State evened up its series versus UTA to 11-11 with two victories 3-0 in Jonesboro and a 3-2 thriller in Arlington. In Arlington, the Mavericks own a 5-7 advantage. The series began in 1982 when both teams were members of the Southland Conference, and UTA claimed seven straight before A-State earned a win. A breakdown of last season's matches is found on page 6.

ROAD TRIP!

- Arkansas State opened its 2020 season with five consecutive home matches the first time A-State had opened a season at home since 2010 and the most consecutive home matches since 2018 (5).
- As a result of numerous schedule adjustments due to the COVID-19 pandemic, A-State is hitting the road for the first time in 2020, and will stay on the road until November. After traveling to Arlington, the Red Wolves face road tests at Louisiana (Oct. 23-24) and at Little Rock (Oct. 31).

"YOU'VE BEEN BLOCKED"

- No, not on Facebook or Twitter ... This is referring to the standout blocking Arkansas State has.
- This season through five matches, A-State leads the Sun Belt Conference in blocks per set (2.89). The Red Wolves have recorded 10.0 blocks in four of its five matches, including a season-high 14.0 on 10/9 vs. ULM. In 2019, A-State reached 10 or more blocks eight times in 29 matches.
- In 2019, Arkansas State finished fourth in total blocks and return 99.7 percent of their blocks from last year.
- Last season, A-State finished third in the conference in solo blocks (78) and fifth in block assists (324).
- Arkansas State was one of four squads in the conference to have four or more players with 50 or more blocks in 2019.

DAVENPORT NAMED DPOTW

- On Tuesday, Kendahl Davenport was named Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a strong opening weekend.
- Davenport tallied 13 total blocks in two matches, averaging 1.63 blocks per set, which leads the league entering this weekend.
- The Conway, Arkansas, native was the first weekly honoree for A-State since Carlisa May (Oct. 15, 2018) and the first DPOW since Tatum Ticknor in August 2018.

"JOSIE'S ON A VACATION FAR AWAY..."

- While that may be the first line of The Outfield's hit song "Your Love," it's
 actually in reference to the tremendous day that Josie Stanford had
 versus Little Rock on Oct. 3.
- In A-State's 3-1 win over the Trojans, Stanford shattered her previous career high in kills and attacks, tallying 28 kills on 58 attempts. The junior also hit at a .293 clip from the right side after spending the last two seasons at middle blocker.
- Her 28 kills were the most by an A-State player since Carlisa May's 29 in 2018 and also third-most since before 2007. Her total was also the best by a Sun Belt Conference player so far this season.

RED WOLVES CONTINUE DOMINANCE VS ULM

- Last weekend, A-State took three straight matches against ULM, only dropping one set to improve to 4-1 on the year.
- On Thursday, A-State picked up its first of two sweeps on the weekend.
- Friday's doubleheader began with ULM taking a tight second set in the
 first match to even things up early, but the Red Wolves went on to take
 the third and fourth to win. In the nightcap, A-State played one of its best
 matches to date en route to a quick sweep over the Warhawks.

DEFENSE! (CLAP CLAP) DEFENSE! (CLAP CLAP)

- Defense has been a staple of Arkansas State's success in recent years.
- This season through five matches, A-State has held its opponent to a sub-.200 mark in every match. Arkansas State enters the weekend ranking second in the conference in opponent hitting percentage (.093). The Red Wolves also rank inside the top 3 in blocks per set (2.89) and digs per set (18.17).
- Against ULM (10/8-9), A-State held its foes to under a .100 mark for all three outings, including -.117 in the series finale.
- In 2019, A-State boasted the No. 2 opponent hitting percentage in the conference, allowing teams to hit just .175 against them. The Red Wolves owned a 14-4 mark when holding opponents to a percentage of .200 or less, while going 5-0 when that mark is .100 or less.
- Arkansas State also held two opponents to negative attack percentages in 2019, with Arkansas-Pine Bluff hitting -.022 on Sept. 14 and Little Rock hitting -.048 on Nov. 5. Both matches resulted in 3-0 sweeps for the Scarlet and Black.

DOUBLE VISION

- Last season, Arkansas State players totaled 41 double-doubles the most by an A-State team since before 2010.
- Macey Putt (9) is the returning leader in that category. Putt has tallied 17 career double-double matches in her two seasons.
- Julianna Cramer and Peyton Uhlenhake each recorded 8 doubledoubles last season.
- Lauren Musante recorded the team's first double-double of the year on Oct. 3 versus Little Rock, her 11th of her career. She added two more versus ULM to give her three of A-State's five total this season.

FIRST SET IS KEY, SECOND SET ALSO HELPS

- Winning the first set is always a great start to a Red Wolves victory. This season, Arkansas State is 3-0 when taking the first set.
- Last season, Arkansas State was 13-3 when going up 1-0 in the match. In 2018, A-State was nearly unbeatable after taking the first set, going 16-3.
- Over the past three-plus seasons, the Red Wolves are 48-9 when going up 1-0 in the match.
- If you extend that trend into the second set, A-State went 11-1 in 2019 when going up two sets to none. In 2018, the Red Wolves went 14-0 when it took the first two sets, and an impressive 41-1 dating back to 2017.
- This season, A-State is 2-0 when taking a 2-0 lead in a match.

CH-CH-CH CHANGES

- Arkansas State opened its 2020 season on October 2 versus Little Rock, which is much later than an A-State team had started previously.
- The Red Wolves were originally slated to start the season on Sept. 12 at Central Arkansas, but UCA postponed that match and the following day in Jonesboro.
- Then, another postponement struck, as UT Arlington was forced to move the matches on Sept. 25-26 to Oct. 16-17.

A-STATE PICKED 4TH IN SBC WEST IN PRESEASON POLL

- The Sun Belt Conference preseason coaches poll saw Arkansas State projected by the league's coaches to finish fourth in the West Division, which is where A-State finished in the division a year ago.
- A-State has not finished lower than fourth in the division since 2007, when it placed fifth in the division.

RED WOLVES LOOKING TO CONTINUE WINNING WAYS

- Arkansas State has consistently been one of the more successful programs in the Sun Belt Conference, finishing with a winning record 11 of the last 12 years and 6 years in a row.
- A-State has won at least one match in the SBC Tournament in eight straight seasons, making the quarterfinals in 2019.
- The Red Wolves have also reached the postseason three of the last five seasons, including the program's first NCAA Tournament berth in 15 years in 2014.

YEAR 2 OF RESTREPO ERA

- Arkansas State is entering the second year of the Santiago Restrepo era.
 While Year 3 at his stops have been the most successful at two of his stops
- While Year 3 at his stops have been the most successful at two of his stop (27-6 in 2003 at Southern Miss, 28-6 in 2006 at Oklahoma), Restrepo led East Stroudsburg to a 32-2 ledger in 1996 in his second year at the helm.
- In 22 years as a head coach, Restrepo's teams have recorded 15 winning seasons, 14 of them with 17 wins or more.
- Restrepo was hired in April 2019, after an impressive 31-6 season at Oklahoma City University (NAIA).
- Prior to his year at OCU, Restrepo led Oklahoma (2004-17) to its best era in program history that included 8 NCAA Tournament berths
- Restrepo's coaching stops also include Southern Miss (2001-03) and East Stroudsburg (1994-97), with an assistant coach stop at Saint Louis from 1998-2000.

#OWNTHESTATE

- The state of Arkansas is represented by four of A-State's 16 players Sara Betts (Marion), Madison Brown (Cabot), Julianna Cramer (Harrison) and Kendahl Davenport (Conway) are all native Arkansans.
- Against Division-I opponents from the Natural State, the Red Wolves have been quite successful. A breakdown of series records vs. Arkansas counterparts is below:

ACED IT!

- Arkansas State was one of the best teams in the Sun Belt Conference when serving, tallying 163 aces last season, which ranked fifth in the league. Defensively, A-State only allowed 112 aces, which ranked first in the league.
- This season, the Red Wolves have served 25 aces one more than it did through five conference matches a season ago.

"I'M YELLING 'TIMBER'!"

- After an injury-shortened sophomore season that garnered a medical hardship, redshirt sophomore **Timber Terrell** put together an impressive comeback season that included a positional switch in 2019, moving from the middle to the right side.
- That move seemed to have paid off, with Terrell earning Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors.

HOME, SWEET HOME

- The 2020 season marks the 33rd season Arkansas State has played volleyball at First National Bank Arena, formerly known as The Convocation Center.
- Over the last 32-plus seasons (with the 2011 season being played at the HPESS building), A-State has racked up a solid 299-88 ledger (.773) and has claimed eight or more home victories in five of the last six seasons.
- The Red Wolves went 6-7 in the 2019 season and has had undefeated home seasons six times, most recently in 2015 (8-0).

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- In the offseason, Arkansas State added four newcomers to the fold, including three freshmen
- Most notably was the addition of transfer Lauren Musante, who was a two-year standout setter at Illinois-Chicago and amassed nearly 1,000 assists in her two seasons.


