

ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES Arkansas State vs Georgia State | Oct. 15, 2020 | Centennial Bank Stadium

TEAM:

- Redshirt sophomore TW Ayers was an A-State team captain and represented the Red Wolves at midfield for the coin toss.
- A-State now has 17 wins over its last 22 midweek (Tue.-Thur.) games.
- Head Coach Blake Anderson picks up his 50th career win, fourth most in program history and one shy of Bill Davidson (1971-78) for third.

OFFENSE:

- A-State established single game school records in passing yards (551), passing touchdowns (8) and first downs by pass (28). The previous record for passing yards was 520 at ULM in 2017, while the previous record for passing touchdowns was seven against Southeast Missouri in 2018 and most first downs by pass were 25 at Nebraska in 2017.
- The Red Wolves tied the school record for first downs (34). The Red Wolves 40 pass completions ranks second, the 57 pass attempts ranks tied for fourth, the 96 plays ranks fifth in single-game history.
- The eight touchdown passes tie the Sun Belt Conference single-game record set by North Texas against Navy in 2007.
- Arkansas State went over 500 yards total offense for the second time this season. It's the first time the Red Wolves surpassed the 600 yard mark since posting 685 total yards against Southeast Missouri in the 2018 season.
- Junior tight end Reed Tyler posted his first receiving touchdown of the season and third of his career.
- Junior quarterback **Logan Bonner** threw a season-tying three TD passes for the second consecutive game . . . He now has 11 TD throws this season and 23 for his career, giving him the 10th most in school history . . . He now has at least one TD pass in every game this season and in 8-of-9 career starts . . . He has thrown multiple TD pass in seven career games, including the last four in a row.
- Dahu Green recorded a career-long 49-yard touchdown reception, which was his fourth touchdown catch of the season. The gain was also the fourth longest passing play of the season for the Red Wolves . . . He posted his first career 100-yard receiving game (172) tied his career-high for touchdown receptions with two for the second consecutive week.
- Sophomore QB Layne Hatcher tied his career high with four passing touchdowns, giving him 10 for the season and 37 for his career . . . Hatcher has thrown at least one TD pass in in 14 of 16 career games.
- Senior WR Jonathan Adams Jr. tied the single-game school record with 15 receptions (J.D. McKissic at Missouri in 2013) ... Adams posted his sixth and seventh receiving TDs of the season, giving him 16 for his career to tie the third most in school history . . . Adams has caught at least one TD in three games this season, including the last two in a row . . . He has posted multiple

- receptions in 20 consecutive games . . . Adams posted his second consecutive 100-yard receiving game and has now hit the mark in four career outings with a career high 177 yards receiving.
- Senior WR **Brandon Bowling** posted his fourth TD reception of the season, running his career total to six . . . He has at least 1 TD reception in each of the last three games.
- Freshman running back **Lincoln Pare** posted his first career TD reception.

DEFENSE:

- A-State has recorded at least one turnover gained in 67 of its last 82 games dating back to the 2014 season.
- Sophomore cornerback **Samy Johnson** posted four pass break-ups.

SPECIAL TEAMS:

• Junior kicker **Blake Grupe** became Arkansas State's fifth all-time leading scorer, finishing today's game with 11 points to give him 220 for his career, 14 shy of Eric Neihouse (2002-05) for fourth.
