

# ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES Arkansas State vs Louisiana | Nov. 21, 2020 | Bobcat Stadium

### TEAM:

• Senior linebacker **Justin Rice** was an A-State team captain and represented the Red Wolves at midfield for the coin toss.

#### **OFFENSE:**

- Arkansas State produced a season-high 654 yards total offense that ranks as the eighth most in school history for a single game.
- With four passing touchdowns, Arkansas State increased its season total to 29 for the third most in school history for a single season.
- The Red Wolves scored over 30 points in a game for the fourth time this season and 75th time over their last 115 regular-season games dating back to the 2011 season.
- Junior QB **Logan Bonner** posted two passing touchdowns, giving him 13 this season and 25 for his career . . . His 25 career passing scores ties the eighth most in school history . . . He threw at least one TD pass in a game for the fifth time this season and ninth time of his career as a starter . . . Today marked his 8th career outing with multiple TD passes.
- Soph. QB **Layne Hatcher** threw two touchdown passes, giving him 14 for the season and 41 for his career . . . He became the sixth player in school history to record at least 40 TD passes.
- Senior RB **Jamal Jones** posted his first career 100-yard rushing game finishing with 106 yards . . . It marked the second time this season A-State has had a player post 100 yards in a game . . . Jones recorded his third rushing TD of the season and sixth of his career.
- Senior WR **Jonathan Adams Jr.** posted a pair of receiving TDs, giving him 10 on the season and 19 for his career . . . His 10 single-season TD receptions ties the third most in school history, while the 19 for his career match the second most ever by an A-State player . . . Adams went over 100 yards receiving for the fourth time this season, tying the fourth most in school history.
- Soph. WR Jefferson Foreman posted the two longest receptions of his career, one covering 84 yards and the other 56 . . . He also scored his first career TD on the 84-yard catch, which was also the longest play of the season for the Red Wolves . . . He posted his first career 100-yard receiving game and posted new career highs for receiving yards (148) on just three catches.
- Junior RB Marcel Murray posted his first rushing TD of the season, but the 15th of his career.
- A-State's scoring drive starting at 13:50 in the 4th QTR took 13 plays and 5:57 seconds, covering 96 yards . . . the time of possession consumed and yards were both the longest of the season for A-State, while the 13 plays tied the most.
- Senior TE **Giles Amos** posted his second receiving TD of the season.

## **DEFENSE:**

• Senior LB **Justin Rice** recorded his team-leading 7th sack of the season . . . He entered the game leading the nation in tackles for loss and finished today's game with 1.5 tackles behind the line of scrimmage.

• Junior CB **Booker Ficklin** recorded a team-high seven tackles, which were only one shy of his career-high 8 total against Troy earlier this season.

# **SPECIAL TEAMS:**

• Junior kicker **Blake Grupe** posted his eighth field goal of the season . . . He took over sole possession of the third most career field goals made in school history, now with 41 to his credit.
