## **STORYLINES**

The 2020-21 campaign marks the program's 93rd season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,223-1,183 all-time record (.509) dating back to the inaugural 1926-27 season ... Marquis Eaton (Second Team) and Caleb Fields (Third Team) were named Preseason All-Sun Belt giving A-State two preseason honorees for the first time since 2013-14 ... Marquis Eaton is 20 points shy of becoming the 29th player in program history to reach 1,000 points ... Marquis Eaton is 36 assists shy of entering the top-10 ranks in program history ... Marquis Eaton is four games played shy of becoming the 19th player in program history to play 100 or more games ... The Red Wolves are among 24 Division I teams to have players from 12 or more states and/or countries ... A-State is 44-48 all-time in season openers and opens on the road for the fifth time in the last seven seasons ... Freshman forward Norchad Omier is the first Nicaraguan-born player to sign a Division I basketball scholarship.

### **SERIES HISTORY**

### A-State leads 3-0

- ► A-State and Marshall square off for the fourth time with the Red Wolves having won each of the first three meetings between the two sides, but all three games have been decided by nine or fewer points.
- ▶ The Red Wolves first met Marshall in 1988 (81-73) before the two teams played a home-and-home series in 2013 (83-82) and 2014 (67-58).
- ► A-State has played in Huntington just once, back on December 21, 2013 coming away with the 83-82 win. Brandon Reed hit a 3-pointer with 24.5 seconds left to break a 79-all tie and A-State held on for the win.
- ► The Red Wolves hosted Marshall in Dan D'Antoni's first season with the Herd and came away with a 67-58 victory. Anthony Livingston scored 20 points and grabbed 20 rebounds to lead A-State.
- ► The Red Wolves are 121-140 against the current membership of Conference USA. This is the first contest against a C-USA member since facing FAU on December 14, 2019 (75-71°).

### THE OPENING TIP

- ▶ Basketball is back and the Arkansas State men's basketball team opens the 2020-21 season Friday at Marshall. Friday's game is streamed on C-USA.TV with a day pass available for \$6.95. The game will be broadcast on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and flagship station 107.9 KFIN.
- ► The 2020-21 campaign marks the program's 93rd season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,223-1,183 all-time record (.509) dating back to the inaugural 1926-27 season.

### "COME BACK"

- ► A-State opens the season with just four returning letterwinners and two returning starters. Eight newcomers and two redshirt players round out the roster.
- ► The Red Wolves return two starters in Marquis Eaton and Caleb Fields, but Christian Willis (15) and Antwon Jackson (1) also earned the starting nod last season.
- ▶ A-State returns 45.8 percent (1036 of 2262) of its scoring with Eaton (425) and Fields (344) being the top two scorers last year. The Red Wolves have just 32.5 percent (327 of 1007) rebounds and 18.8 percent (16 of 85) blocks returning having lost the top four players in rebounds and blocks. More than 50 percent of assists and steals return, with 59.1 percent (261 of 442) assists back and 51.8 percent (114 of 220) steals returning.

### "LITTLE HELP FROM MY FRIENDS"

- Last season, A-State averaged 13.8 assists per game, up from 11.3 assists per game in the prior campaign.
   A-State had 17 games (13-4 record) with 14 or more assists, ninth most in NCAA, after posting a combined 13 the previous two seasons.
- ► The Red Wolves had 442 assists on 750 field goals, good for an assist percentage of 58.5 percent. The 1987-88 team has the highest assist percentage in program history at 61.6 percent (570/925). Per Ken-Pom.com, A-State ranked 22nd nationally in assist percentage (A/FGM).

### "AROUND THE WORLD"

- ► The A-State roster this season features eight states and four countries. The Red Wolves are among 24 Division I teams this season with players from 12 or more states/countries.
- ➤ Two players reside from Arkansas (Marquis Eaton and Avery Felts) and Tennessee (Caleb Fields and Caleb London) with Alabama (Markise Davis), Florida (Malcolm Farrington), Illinois (Christian Willis), New Jersey (Keyon Wesley), Nevada (Antwon Jackson) and Texas (Tim Holland Jr.) making up the eight states.
- ► The four countries represented are Croatia (Mario Fantina), Nicaragua (Norchad Omier), Senegal (Cheikh Ndour) and Serbia (Lazar Grbovic).
- ▶ A native of Bluefields, Nicaragua, Norchad Omier is the first player from Nicaragua to sign a Division I scholarship. Omier prepped last season at Miami Prep and averaged a double-double of 26.7 points and 20.3 rebounds per game. He scored 40 points and pulled in 17 rebounds against IMG Academy.

### "THE FINAL COUNTDOWN"

- Marquis Eaton enters the season 20 points shy of 1,000 for his career.
- ► With 20 more points scored, Eaton would become the 29th player in program history to reach the 1,000 point plateau.
- ► If Eaton reaches 1,000 points, he would be the first to do so for A-State since Ty Cockfield during the 2018-19 season.

## "NOTHING AS IT SEEMS"

- ▶ This section of the game notes is reserved for useless information.
- ► A-State has scored in 2,406 consecutive games.
- ► The Red Wolves have hit a 3-pointer in 286 consecutive games. A-State has one 3-point make in three of those 278 games; at Louisiana (March 3, 2018), at North Texas (Feb. 28, 2013) and at Louisville (Nov. 11, 2011)
- ► A-State is unbeaten when scoring more points than its opponent.
- ► The Guinness Book of Records states that the greatest dressed weight recorded for a turkey is 39.09 kg (86 lbs), at the annual "heaviest turkey" competition held in London, England on December 12, 1989.
- ▶ West Virginia is located within a day's drive from 75 percent of the U.S. population.

### **HEAD COACH MIKE BALADO**

Arkansas State University Director of Athletics Terry Mohajir announced the appointment of Mike Balado as the 16th head coach of the A-State men's basketball program on March 20, 2017.

Balado came to Arkansas State after spending more than 15 seasons as an assistant coach, his last stop covering four seasons at the University of Louisville. In his first three seasons at the helm, Balado has led the Red Wolves to a 40-56 record. With an up-tempo style of offense, A-State has top-five marks in single-season 3-pointers made, three throws made and free throw attempts. Last season, A-State earned road wins at Colorado State and Tulsa and finished with six or more road wins for just the 13th time in the last 50 seasons. The Red Wolves were resilient with six comeback wins despit trailing by double-digits in the second half. The 2019-20 season saw A-State finish the regular season with 16 or more wins for the 18th time in 50 seasons at the Division I level (since 1970-71).

His first signing class, consisting of Ty Cockfield, Tristin Walley and Grantham Gillard, played a vital role on the floor. Cockfield set the single-season program record for scoring (716) and free throws made (173) and was a second team all-conference pick. Last season, freshman Caleb Fields became the third freshman in program history with 100-plus assists and one of five freshmen nationally to average at least 11 points, three rebounds and three assists with fewer than two turnovers per game.

During Balado's four seasons working at Louisville, the Cardinals posted a 106-32 overall record for a .768 winning percentage. In the 2016-17 campaign, he helped lead Louisville to a 25-9 record and a No. 2 seed in the Midwest Regional of the NCAA Tournament

Prior to joining the Louisville staff, Balado was an assistant coach for Richard Pitino at Florida International University. During that 2012-13 season, he helped the Panthers to an 18-14 record, their first winning season in 13 years and fourth-highest win total in school history.

### "CHANGES"

- ▶ This section of the game notes is reserved for changes to the schedule this season.
- ► A-State is scheduled to open the season at Marshall, but the Thundering Herd are the third different season-opening opponent on the scheduled due to the changes.
- ► The Red Wolves were originally scheduled to open against Jackson State (Nov. 25) and then Coppin State (Nov. 26).
- ► The schedule changes have seen two dates feature two different opponents. Originally, A-State was to face Central Arkansas and Coppin State on Nov. 26 before being canceled and Ole Miss on Nov. 27 before it was canceled.

### "PRESENT TENSE"

- ▶ Antwon Jackson has changed from No. 32 to No. 50. Avery Felts, though he redshirted last season, has changed to No. 2 on the roster from No. 21.
- ► This is the first season since 2013-14 that no player will wear No. 11, but Keyon Wesley is the first player to wear No. 22 since Chano Rashiduddin in 2011. Caleb London (No. 24) and Antwon Jackson (No. 50) are the first to wear their numbers since Donte Thomas and Anthony Livingston, respectively, in 2015-16.

### "FREE FALLIN"

- Per KenPom.com, A-State led the country in free throw rate last season at 48.1. Free throw rate is the
  ratio of foul shots to field goal attempts, expressed as FTA/FGA. The Red Wolves led the nation in free
  throw makes (578) and were third in free throw attempts (814) behind Hampton (821) and Auburn (818).
- ► The Red Wolves established program records for free throws made, passing the previous mark of 562 in 2015-16 and free throws attempted, passing the previous high of 771 in 1971-72.

### "FOREVER YOUNG"

- ► Redshirt-senior Christian Willis is the elder statesman on the A-State roster having been on the team since the 2016-17 season.
- ▶ Willis was recruited to A-State by assistant coach Mike Sctuero on staff for John Brady and Willis then played in 10 games during the 2016-17 season before an injury his freshman campaign under coach Grant McCasland.
- Willis appeared in one game during the 2017-18 season in head coach Mike Balado's first season, before sitting out the remainder of the season as a redshirt season. He started six of his 25 games played in 2018-19 and last season made 15 starts while playing in every game.
- ► Showing steady improvement, Willis reached double-figure scoring totals in six games, including a career-best 17 in a home win over South Alabama. In 36 games played from 2016-19, Willis was 10-of-38 (.263) from 3-point range, but in the 32 games last season he was 25-of-62 (.403) beyond the arc.

### "CALL AND ANSWER"

- Marquis Eaton has answered the call since setting foot on campus in the 2017-18 season.
- ► Eaton has played in 96 games entering the 2020-21 season and is four games shy of becoming the 19th player to play in 100 or more games at A-State.
