## TIP-OFF TIDBITS

- This is the 47th season of women's basketball at Arkansas State.
- Arkansas State is hosting three games to close its non-conference slate - two versus Champion Christian and one versus Grambling State.
- The Red Wolves are facing Champion Christian for the first time in program history, while taking on Grambling State for the fourth time ever - the first time since 2017 (W 76-56 in Jonesboro).
- In her last two games, Jada Stinson is 17-23 from the field (73.9%), 9-14 from three (64.3%) and averaging 22.5 points per game. She became the first player to record back-to-back 20-point games since 2018-19.
- 14 different players scored in A-State's 96-46 win over Williams Baptist on Friday.

## MEDIA INFORMATION

**FACILITIES:** Media facilities in First National Bank Arena consist of an area at floor level on the east side of the court for reporters, broadcasters and photographers, as well as a television-film booth located high on the east side of the arena. There is also a Media Room located on the west side open to the press before, during and after games. Admittance to these areas is by special credential issued only by the A-State Athletics Media Relations Office.

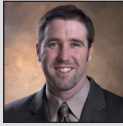
**CREDENTIALS:** Credentials for home games are provided to those members of the media who are covering the game in a full working capacity. Requests with names should be submitted in writing on company letterhead. Passes will be mailed to valid applicants as long as time permits; otherwise, passes may be claimed at the Media Entrance on the east side of the arena (Lower Green Entrance). Spouses, dates, children and non-workers are NOT permitted in the media areas. Passes must be displayed at all times, and A-State reserves the right to revoke passes and privileges at any time due to misrepresentation or misconduct. Requests for road game credentials may be made through the A-State Media Relations Women's Basketball SID (Caleb Garner).

**PARKING:** A limited number of parking spaces are available to members of the media on a paved lot adjacent to the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of the arena, Lot "A". Display a parking pass to the working attendant for admittance. Parking is on a first-come, first-serve basis. All parking pass requests should be made to the Athletics Media Relations Office.

**ENTRY:** Media representatives with proper A-State issued credentials will be allowed entrance ONLY at the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of First National Bank Arena. This is also the main entry to the athletics offices and is adjacent to the Media parking area. Upon entry, a temperature screening will be done in accordance with Sun Belt Conference COVID-19 policy.

**PHOTOGRAPHERS:** In accordance with Sun Belt COVID-19 policy, no photographers or videographers, with the exception of two (2) per game determined by the A-State

Media Relations staff, will be allowed to shoot courtside this season. Court access credentials are required to shoot from courtside. All other photographers will be asked to shoot from the mezzanine level. Certified photographers of newspapers, magazines, wire services and TV stations must request passes in writing. No credentials will be issued to freelance photographers unless authorized by A-State Media Relations.

**INTERVIEWS:** Head Coach Matt Daniel will be available in the Hames Conference Room in First National Bank Arena after each game, following his radio interview. A-State student-athletes will also be available by request at this time. In accordance with Sun Belt policy, appropriate social distancing must be observed and masks must be worn. The A-State women's basketball locker room is CLOSED to the media following games. To arrange for a student-

athlete interview during the week, contact Caleb Garner, Assistant Athletic Media Relations Director at (870) 972-2707. All interviews must be approved by a member of the coaching staff.

**INJURY INFORMATION POLICY:** A student-athlete's protected health information is protected by federal regulations under either the Health Information Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) or the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (the Buckley Amendment) and may not be disclosed without either the student-athlete's authorization under HIPAA or their consent under the Buckley Amendment. Authorized/consented injury information pertaining to a student-athlete shall be released to the media through the Athletics Media Relations Department after being authorized by the athletic trainer. It's also appropriate in post-game or weekly press conferences for head coaches to announce team injury updates. It's the policy of the Department of Athletics to provide accurate information on injuries and not withhold injury information from the media. Team physicians may be available to offer explanation on injuries if requested by the athletic trainer. Any sideline or locker room report made to the media shall be made by an athletic trainer, team physician, or a media relations staff representative.

**RADIO:** Radio broadcasts of Red Wolves men's basketball will be on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and will also be available over the Internet. Keith Merritt is the longtime "Voice of the Red Wolves". The visiting team's "official" radio station, as designated by the visitors' SID, will be permitted origination privileges. A courtesy line is provided courtside. Any questions regarding broadcasts or the use of facilities should be directed to Caleb Garner, Assistant Athletics Media Relations Director.

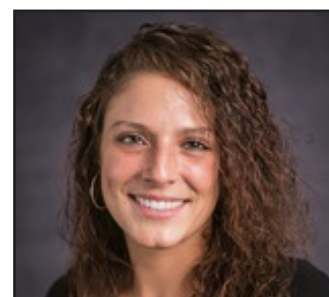

**KNOW THE FOE: CHAMPION CHRISTIAN**

- Champion Christian enters the week with a 2-1 record, having most recently dropped an exhibition contest at Tarleton State, 95-27. The Hot Springs, Ark.,-based Tigers are set to take on Ecclesia College on Monday before battling Arkansas State on Tuesday and Thursday in exhibitions for CCC.
- Destiny Gonzalez leads the Tigers in scoring (19.7) and rebounding (7.7) while Tamarina Manning is the team's top assist-giver at 7.7 dimes per game. Manning also averages 12 points per game and is second on the squad in rebounding at 6.0 per contest. T'Kira Fuller averages 13 points while Sckiya Banister chips in 11.7 points per outing.

**KNOW THE FOE: GRAMBLING STATE**

- Grambling State marks the second SWAC foe of the season for Arkansas State, taking on the Lady Tigers for the first time in exactly three seasons. A-State claimed a 76-56 triumph on Dec. 16, 2017, in Jonesboro. GSU enters the week with a 1-3 ledger after dropping a 70-62 road contest at UAB. Grambling's lone win of the year came against a Sun Belt foe, defeating ULM 66-42 in Monroe.
- The Lady Tigers are led in scoring by Alexis Holt (12.3), who also leads the team with 2.0 assists per game. DeAndre'a Alexander is the team's top rebounder, averaging 5.5 per contest. Grambling leads the SWAC with 40 total steals, which ranks 80th nationally, ranking 65th in steals per game (10.0). The Lady Tigers also average 20.0 turnovers forced, which leads the SWAC and is 57th-best in the nation.

**AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD ...**

- On Tuesday vs Champion Christian: improve Arkansas State to 3-1 on the season
- On Wednesday vs Grambling State: move A-State to 3-1 all-time versus GSU and mark its second straight win in the series.
- Be better than a loss.

**STINSON SCORES 20-PIECE [TWICE!]**

- Jada Stinson has made a statement in her last two games, shooting 73.9 percent (17-23) from the field and 64.3 percent from three (9-14), averaging 22.5 points. The junior transfer tallied 21 points versus Williams Baptist, giving her 20 points in back-to-back games, making her the first A-State player to do so since Peyton Martin in 2018-19.
- Stinson was ON FIRE from the field in A-State's win over SIU Edwardsville on Dec. 2, starting 7 of 7 from the field (5 of 5 from three) en route to a career-high 24 points on 8 of 9 from the field (6 of 6 from three). Her 3-point FG percentage of 85.7 percent is a single-game high for a Sun Belt player this season.

**"WASHINGTON ON YOUR SIDE"**

- While that may be a catchy song from "Hamilton," this note is about Arkansas State guard Jireh Washington, who is A-State's returning leader in scoring (13.0/game) and assists (3.9), while also ranking second on the squad in steals per game (1.5), FG percentage (43.3%) and third in rebounding average (4.3).
- The Third-Team All-Sun Belt Conference honoree scored in double figures in 22 games last season, while dishing out five or more assists 12 times.
- Washington has also shown to be a strong distributor with over 200 assists in her two seasons. The Memphis native needs 69 dimes to crack the A-State Career Top 10 in assists.
- Washington opened this season with three-straight games of 10 or more points giving her double-digit scoring for the seven straight games and the 13 of the last 14 dating back to last season.
- She is also one of the league's top defenders thus far in the season, tied for the league lead with 4.0 steals per game, which ranks 11th nationally.

**MARTIN PROVIDES SPARK OFF THE BENCH VERSUS SIUE**

- Peyton Martin came off the bench in the first two games of the season, averaging 17.0 points per game, including a career-high 28 and eight rebounds versus SIU Edwardsville on Dec. 2.
- She is fifth in the Sun Belt Conference in field goal percentage, shooting at a 53.3 percent clip.

**DYNAMIC DUO**

- The tandem of Jireh Washington and Peyton Martin returns as the second-highest returning scoring pair in the Sun Belt, averaging 25.5 points per game - two points behind South Alabama's Savannah Jones and Antoinette Lewis (27.5).
- This season, Washington and Martin combine for 28 points per game through the Red Wolves' first two outings.

## "BACK TO DECEMBER"

- Since the start of the 1991 season, Arkansas State has totaled a 105-88 record in the month of December. This season has five scheduled December matchups, concluding 2020 with three straight home games on Dec. 11, 15, 16 and 17.

## ON THIS DATE (DEC. 15, 16 &amp; 17)

- Since 1991, Arkansas State is 6-2 on Dec. 15, most recently dropping an 83-60 decision at Missouri State in 2012. On Dec. 16, A-State is a perfect 4-0 with its most recent outcome being a 76-56 home win over Grambling State. In games played on Dec. 17, A-State is 5-4, most recently taking a 59-44 win at Kent State.
- Off the court, December 15 is known as the date in which the Bill of Rights was ratified (1791). "Gone With The Wind" premiered in Atlanta in 1939. In 1955, Johnny Cash released his hit single "Folsom Prison Blues".
- On December 16, 2019, Mariah Carey's "All I Want For Christmas Is You" reached No. 1, 25 years after its release.
- On December 17 in history, the Wright brothers made the first sustained motorized aircraft flight in Kitty Hawk, N.C. (1903).

## YOUTHFUL RED WOLVES

- Of the 15 players on Arkansas State's roster, 12 of them have played two or fewer seasons at the Division I level. The Red Wolves are one of 13 teams with 12 or more players with two years or less experience.

## NICE TO MEET YA!

- Seven players made their debuts for Arkansas State in the season opener versus Arkansas-Pine Bluff – Hilani Cantone, Jordyn Brown, Jada Stinson, Mattie Hatcher, Talia Roldan, Seynabou Thiam and Karolina Szydlowska. Four of those players – Stinson (8), Hatcher (3), Roldan (2) and Szydlowska (10) scored for the Red Wolves.



## TAKE IT TO THE BANK!

- Arkansas State has amassed a 325-113 (.742) overall mark in 33-plus seasons at First National Bank Arena.
- The Red Wolves did an impressive job of defending homecourt last season, owning an 8-4 mark in the friendly confines. Three of those four losses have come to teams with 18 or more wins (UT Arlington, Troy and SEMO).
- This season, A-State has 14 home contests scheduled at "The Bank," tied for the most since the 2014-15 season boasted 15 home outings. The Red Wolves have entertained 14 home crowds three of the last five seasons.

## UNIQUE SCHEDULE

- We all know 2020 is not a "normal" year, and that carried over into the schedule. This season, due to the late start date, teams are allowed 25 total regular-season games.
- The Red Wolves will face a different conference schedule than in years' past, taking on only teams from the Sun Belt's West Division - Little Rock (2 games), Louisiana (4), Texas State (4), ULM (4) and UT Arlington (4).

## "WHO ARE YOU?"

- While Arkansas State returns several players from last season, fans will also see several new faces grace the floor this season, as A-State brought in six newcomers to go along with redshirt transfers Jada Stinson and Talia Roldan.
- A-State dipped into the JUCO ranks for three players, nabbing international talent in 6-6 post player Seynabou Thiam (Senegal) and 6-0 forward (Poland). California native Jordyn Brown also looks to factor into the Red Wolves' backcourt, providing a capable deep threat.
- The Red Wolves' 2020-21 roster also features three rookies in Hilani Cantone, Vic Dames and Mattie Hatcher.

## "DON'T STOP BELIEVING"

- Five of Arkansas State's wins last season came after facing deficits of seven or more. Four of those five were deficits of 10 or greater.
- Before coming back from down 21 to defeat South Alabama on March 5 (the largest deficit overcome in school history), A-State's biggest deficit overcome last year was a 15-point comeback win over Georgia State. The Red Wolves also battled back from an 11-point halftime deficit to oust ULM on 2/1.

## "STEAL MY SUNSHINE"

- Arkansas State has swiped 28 steals in its two straight wins (15 vs SIUE, 13 vs WBU), 34 total in three contests. The Red Wolves rank second in the Sun Belt (12/14) in steals per game (11.3), which ranks 33rd nationally.
- Jireh Washington has provided 12 of those steals (7 vs SIUE). Through two games, A-State has notched a steal rate of 11.5 percent (steal rate=Pct. of opp. offensive plays where the ball was stolen). Washington ranks third in the league with 12 steals and is tied for the league lead with 4.0 steals per game, which ranks 11th in Division I.
- The Red Wolves swiped **10 or more steals in 17 games**. A-State tallied **13 or more steals eight times** last season.

## "TAKE IT AWAY"


- Arkansas State forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games in 2019-20, including **at least 15 takeaways 19 times (nine games with 20 or more)**. This season, A-State has forced 16 or more turnovers in all three games, including 20 or more in the last two.
- When A-State was victorious in 2019-20, it averaged 13.5 turnovers allowed per game with a turnover margin of +4.8 while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.2.

## NATURAL STATE SHOWDOWNS

- Arkansas State likes to face in-state foes when it can, with this season's schedule featuring six contests against Arkansas-based opponents (2 vs UAPB, 2 vs Little Rock, vs Williams Baptist [Walnut Ridge] and 2 vs Champion Christian [Hot Springs]). Matchups against Williams Baptist and Champion Christian are the first regular-season tilts for A-State in program history.
- In the summer, A-State and Arkansas announced that the two teams will meet for a home-and-home series beginning in 2021 in Jonesboro - the first meeting since A-State's win in the 2005 WNIT. The Red Wolves are slated to make the return trip to Fayetteville in 2022.

- A-State freshman guard **Mattie Hatcher** is one of several in her family to play college athletics and is the second in her family to compete at Arkansas State. Her brother, Layne, is a quarterback on the A-State football team and was a standout in his rookie season.
- An accomplished equestrian who competed at the Junior Olympic Games, Hatcher comes to A-State with four years of eligibility remaining after spending her freshman year of college as a student at Samford University, training with her horses. She was also a standout on the soccer pitch at Pulaski Academy, owning the career goals scored record for the state of Arkansas.
- Hatcher's father, Greg, was a three-sport athlete at Alma College, lettering in soccer, baseball and wrestling and was a 2017 inductee into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. Her sisters Kelsey (Arkansas women's basketball), Haley (Ouachita Baptist soccer) and Larkin (Harding soccer) also competed collegiately.

## MELTING POT

- Arkansas State's 2020-21 roster boasts players from eight different states and two different countries outside of the United States.
- Karolina Szydłowska (Poland) and Seynabou Thiam (Senegal) are the first players from their respective countries to compete for A-State in women's basketball.

## "57 CHANNELS (AND NOTHIN' ON)"

- All but one of Arkansas State's 2020-21 games will be broadcasted live on ESPN+. The only exception is A-State's Dec. 10 showdown at Arkansas-Pine Bluff, which will be carried on UAPBLionsRoar.com.

## "WE'RE THE THREE BEST FRIENDS THAT ANYBODY COULD HAVE"

- Last season, Arkansas State had three or more players record double-digit scoring in 20 of its 30 games. This year, A-State has done so in both games.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Arkansas State is 96-50 (.658) when three or more players score in double figures.
- "...and we'll never ever ever ever ever leave each other." (If you get the reference, you get a gold star.)

## GOING TO THE LINE

- Arkansas State has consistently ranked near the top half of the Sun Belt Conference in getting to the free-throw line.
- In 2018-19, A-State ranked atop the league in both free-throw attempts (744) and free throws made (495), which ranked sixth and 15th nationally.
- Last season, the Red Wolves ranked fifth in both categories, going 395 for 593 at the line. They ranked inside the top 100 in the NCAA in both statistics.

## #TEAM1STWINS

- This season through three games, Arkansas State ranks sixth in the Sun Belt in assists and second in assists per game (14th nationally). In the Red Wolves' win over SIU Edwardsville, the team posted an assist percentage of 69.0 percent (20 assists to 29 made baskets). A-State's assist percentage increased to 70.3 percent (26-37) in its win over Williams Baptist.
- In three games, A-State has compiled an assist percentage of 65.6 percent (59 assists to 90 field goals).
- The Red Wolves posted an assist percentage greater than 65 percent in seven games last season (70+ percent three times), the highest coming against Appalachian State (79.3 percent), which was the best since posting an 85-percent mark in 2019 vs. ULM. That matched the total from 2013-14 when A-State posted a mark of 70 percent or better three times.

## ~MO- KNOWS BASKETBALL

- Bo Jackson may know basketball, but so does Arkansas State senior guard Morgan Wallace.
- The senior enters Tuesday's game needing just 35 rebounds to reach 500 for her career and 316 points to reach 1,000. Last season, Wallace led A-State in steals and rebounding, including a team-high five double-doubles and nine games with double-digit rebounds.
- Wallace has also been a steady presence on the floor, leading the team in minutes played last season (34.4/game) and second this season (34.5). She has also started in 35 consecutive games.

## "THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER"

- Arkansas State was active beyond the three-point line in Matt Daniel's first season, attempting a school-record 649 treys. The Red Wolves connected on 186 of those - the most by an A-State team since the 2015-16 season (217).
- In A-State's season opener against UAPB, the Red Wolves fired 30 from beyond the arc. Since the start of the Daniel era last season, Arkansas State owns seven of the top 11 single-game three-point attempt marks in school history.
- Jada Stinson caught fire from deep in A-State's win over SIUE (12/2), making her first five three-point attempts. She finished with a career-high 24 points on 8 of 9 shooting (6-7 from three). Her 85.7 percent clip is a Sun Belt single-game high so far this season.
- Stinson currently leads the Sun Belt with 3.0 three-point field goals per game and is third with a 42.9 percentage.

## "NOTHING ELSE MATTERS"

- Sure, that is a legendary Metallica song, but this section of the game notes is reserved for random, possibly useless, information. Occasionally it will be a space in which the author of these game notes will drop some knowledge. Feel free to share what you've learned in your broadcast!
- Arkansas State has scored in 1,326 consecutive games.
- The Red Wolves are undefeated when outscoring their opponent.
- In presidential election years, Arkansas State is 176-141 overall. When a Democrat wins the election, A-State is 88-53 (.624) while going 88-88 (.500) when a Republican has won. Additionally, when the winner wins Arkansas, A-State is 145-112. When the winner loses the Natural State (2008 and 2012), A-State is 31-29. Since Jimmy Carter was elected in 1976, the winner has only lost Arkansas twice (2008 and 2012).
- Creedence Clearwater Revival has the most No. 2 Billboard hits - without ever hitting No. 1. No other act has topped this dubious honor.
- Water makes different pouring sounds depending on its temperature. If you listen very closely, hot water and cold water sound slightly different when being poured. The heat changes the thickness, or viscosity, of the water, which changes the pitch of the sound it makes when it's poured. What we feel as heat comes from the molecules of the water moving faster. 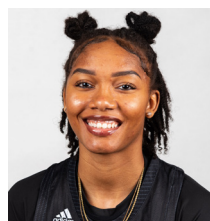
