MEDIA INFORMATION

FACILITIES: Media facilities in First National Bank Arena consist of an area at floor level on the east side of the court for reporters, broadcasters and photographers, as well as a television-film booth located high on the east side of the arena. There is also a Media Room located on the west side open to the press before, during and after games. Admittance to these areas is by special credential issued only by the A-State Athletics Media Relations Office.

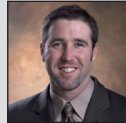
CREDENTIALS: Credentials for home games are provided to those members of the media who are covering the game in a full working capacity. Requests with names should be submitted in writing on company letterhead. Passes will be mailed to valid applicants as long as time permits; otherwise, passes may be claimed at the Media Entrance on the east side of the arena (Lower Green Entrance). Spouses, dates, children and non-workers are NOT permitted in the media areas. Passes must be displayed at all times, and A-State reserves the right to revoke passes and privileges at any time due to misrepresentation or misconduct. Requests for road game credentials may be made through the A-State Media Relations Women's Basketball SID (Caleb Garner).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces are available to members of the media on a paved lot adjacent to the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of the arena, Lot "A". Display a parking pass to the working attendant for admittance. Parking is on a first-come, first-serve basis. All parking pass requests should be made to the Athletics Media Relations Office.

ENTRY: Media representatives with proper A-State issued credentials will be allowed entrance ONLY at the Media Entrance (Lower Green Entrance) on the east side of First National Bank Arena. This is also the main entry to the athletics offices and is adjacent to the Media parking area.

GAME SERVICES: Programs, notes, reference guides, statistical packets, and live statistics (Stat Broadcast) are provided. Complimentary light refreshments and food will be available before and throughout the game.

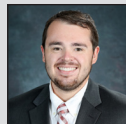

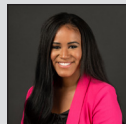

PHOTOGRAPHERS: Photographers are not allowed to shoot from in front of the team benches nor from the catwalk above the floor (for security, insurance and safety reasons). Along the end lines, photographers must stay behind the broken line and clear from the free throw lane. Credentials are required to shoot from courtside. Certified photographers of newspapers, magazines, wire services and TV stations must request passes in writing. No credentials will be issued to freelance photographers unless authorized by A-State Media Relations.

INTERVIEWS: Head Coach Matt Daniel will be available in the media room after each game, following a brief team meeting. A-State student-athletes will also be available by request at this time. The A-State women's basketball locker room is CLOSED to the media following games. To arrange for a student-athlete interview

during the week, contact Caleb Garner, Assistant Athletic Media Relations Director at (870) 972-2707. All interviews must be approved by the head coach.

INJURY INFORMATION POLICY: A student-athlete's protected health information is protected by federal regulations under either the Health Information Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) or the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (the Buckley Amendment) and may not be disclosed without either the student-athlete's authorization under HIPAA or their consent under the Buckley Amendment. Authorized/consented injury information pertaining to a student-athlete shall be released to the media through the Athletics Media Relations Department after being authorized by the athletic trainer. It's also appropriate in post-game or weekly press conferences for head coaches to announce team injury updates. It's the policy of the Department of Athletics to provide accurate information on injuries and not withhold injury information from the media. Team physicians may be available to offer explanation on injuries if requested by the athletic trainer. Any sideline or locker room report made to the media shall be made by an athletic trainer, team physician, or a media relations staff representative.

RADIO: Radio broadcasts of Red Wolves men's basketball will be on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and will also be available over the Internet. Keith Merritt is the exuberant "Voice of the Red Wolves". The visiting team's "official" radio station, as designated by the visitors' SID, will be permitted origination privileges. A courtesy line is provided courtside. Any questions regarding broadcasts or the use of facilities should be directed to Caleb Garner, Assistant Athletics Media Relations Director.

KNOW THE FOE: SOUTH ALABAMA

- South Alabama enters the week on a two-game losing streak, having dropped losses to Appalachian State (71-59) and Coastal Carolina (76-73) this past weekend. The Jaguars are currently 12-13 overall with a 7-6 mark in league play, which is sixth in the conference.
- Three Jaguars average double-digit points, led by Shaforia Kines (15.6), who also leads in assists (68/2.72 per game), ranking third in the league in scoring. Savannah Jones averages 14.3 points along with 5.5 rebounds and is the team's top three-point threat at 37.9 percent, which is best in the conference. Preseason SBC Player of the Year Antoinette Lewis averages a double-double at 13.2 points and a conference-leading 10.3 rebounds. Lewis also leads the league with 5.32 offensive rebounds per game and 13 double-doubles.
- As a team, South Alabama leads the Sun Belt in blocked shots (112 - 4.5 per game), ranking 35th nationally in total swats. The Jaguars rank 18th in the nation (third in the league) in free-throw attempts (528) and lead the league in three-point attempts (601), threes made (191) and three-point field goals per game 7.6). USA averages 69 points per game while allowing 67.5 on average.
- Arkansas State has played South Alabama 50 times in the history of the two programs, with the Scarlet and Black leading 38-12 overall and 17-9 in Mobile. The Red Wolves have claimed three straight and 11 of the last 12 meetings. A full breakdown of the series can be found on page 12.

AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD ...

- Give the Red Wolves their 10th win of the season.
- Hand the Scarlet and Black its fourth road win of the year
- Give A-State its seventh Sun Belt win of the year, matching last season's total.
- Mark A-State's fourth straight win in the series over South Alabama, its 12th in the last 13 meetings.
- Give the Red Wolves their third straight win over USA in Mobile.
- Be better than a loss.

COMEBACK KIDS

- Four of Arkansas State's nine wins have come after facing deficits of seven or more. Three of those four were deficits of 10 or greater.
- A-State's biggest deficit overcome this year was a 15-point comeback win over Georgia State. The Red Wolves most recently battled back from an 11-point halftime deficit to oust ULM on 2/1.

GENERAL WASHINGTON LEADING THE 'PACK

- No, this note isn't about the first President of the United States who also happens to grace the \$1 bill. But it is about Arkansas State guard Jireh Washington, who leads the Red Wolves in scoring (13.1/game) and assists (3.8), while also ranking second on the squad in steals per game (1.46), FG percentage (43.4%) and third in rebounding average (5.0).

"STEAL MY SUNSHINE"

- Arkansas State ranks first in the Sun Belt Conference in total steals (224) and steals per game (9.33).
- Morgan Wallace ranks third in the league in steals per game (2.09) and fourth in total steals (48).
- The Red Wolves have swiped **10 or more steals in 14 games**, including nine of their last 14 games. A-State has tallied **13 or more steals seven times** this season.

TURNOVERS, ANYONE?

- Arkansas State has forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games this season, including **at least 15 takeaways 15 times (eight games with 20 or more)**.
- The Red Wolves have turned the ball over 15 times or fewer in 12 games this year, including a season-low seven twice (11/13 vs. SEMO, 1/9 vs. Georgia State) and 10 times or less four times.
- When A-State wins, it averages 14.1 turnovers allowed per game with a turnover margin of +4.8 while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.1.

DO YOU BELIEVE IN [MYA] LOVE?

- Arkansas State rookie Mya Love made the most of her first collegiate start on Jan. 25 vs. Coastal Carolina, helping A-State to a 63-61 win over the Chanticleers with a career-best stat line of 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting (2-of-2 from three), seven rebounds and three steals. She also played a season-high 32 minutes
- Love had scored no more than five points in a game this season prior to that.

#TEAM1STWINS

- The Red Wolves are among the least selfish teams in the Sun Belt Conference, ranking fifth in the league in assists per game (11.92) and seventh in total assists (286). Jireh Washington ranks fifth in the league in assists per game (3.79) and total assists (91).
- In A-State's nine wins, the Red Wolves have posted 146 assists to 218 made baskets for a 67.0% assist percentage.
- When A-State is victorious, five players average in double figures: Jireh Washington (13.4), Peyton Martin (13.4), Morgan Wallace (11.8), Jada Ford (10.3) and Payton Tennison (10.0). Wallace also nearly averages a double-double at 9.9 rebounds per game in those nine wins.
- The Red Wolves have posted an assist percentage greater than 65 percent in six games this season, the highest coming against Appalachian State (79.3 percent), which was the best since posting an 85-percent mark last season vs. ULM. That matches the total from 2013-14 when A-State posted a mark of 70 percent or better three times.

~MO~ KNOWS BASKETBALL

- After starting the season as one of Arkansas State's primary rebounding threats and not so much a scorer, tallying only 16 points through the first three games, Morgan Wallace lit up the stat sheet at the Maggie Dixon Classic en route to All-Tournament honors.
- Wallace scored 37 points in the two games (career-high 21 at DePaul) while bringing down 12 rebounds.
- This season, Wallace leads the team in minutes played per game (33.72) as well as rebounding (8.0), the latter which leads all guards in the conference and ranks fifth in the league overall. Wallace also ranks third in the league in steals per game (2.09) and fourth in total steals (48). In minutes played per game, Wallace ranks fourth in the conference entering Saturday's game, while her 137 defensive rebounds ranks second in the conference (5.96 per game).
- On Jan. 9 vs. Georgia State, Wallace led the charge with a double double at 21 points and 11 boards. She has hauled in 7+ rebounds in 15 games, including six games with 10 or more. In A-State's nine wins, Wallace nearly averages a double-double at 11.8 points per game and 9.9 rebounds. Wallace posted another double-double the next week vs. Appalachian State (13 points, 10 rebounds).

SUN BELT CONFERENCE OPENERS

- Since joining the Sun Belt Conference prior to the 1991-92 season, Arkansas State has amassed a 19-10 record in league openers. When opening league play at home, A-State is 12-3, while going 7-7 if the first game of conference play is on the road.
- In SBC home openers, A-State is 23-6 overall and has won eight in a row after defeating Georgia State on Thursday.
- The Red Wolves entered the season having won seven straight league lid-lifters and eight of their last nine.
- In road openers, A-State is 15-12 and won six straight prior to this season's loss to UT Arlington.

"WE'RE THE THREE BEST FRIENDS THAT ANYBODY COULD HAVE"

- So far this season, Arkansas State has had three or more players record double-digit scoring in 14 of its 24 games.
- A-State had three or more players score in double figures in 19 of the Red Wolves' 30 games last season.
- Since the 2012-13 season, Arkansas State is 92-44 (.676) when three or more players score in double figures.

PROVIDING A SPARK

- After starting the first six games of the year, Payton Tennison has come off the bench for the Red Wolves for four games before starting at LA Tech, but embraced the Sixth Woman role. In her first two games in reserve action, Tennison was one of the team's top scoring threats, combining for 29 points on 10-of-13 from the field, including a stellar 7-of-10 from three-point range.
- On Feb. 6 at Georgia State, Tennison posted 18 points off the bench on six three-pointers.

- Peyton Martin reached the 700-point mark with 17 vs. Georgia Southern (1/11) and then reached 800 points on Feb. 13 vs. UT Arlington.
- Starr Taylor played in her 100th game as a Red Wolf on 12/14 at Memphis. Taylor has played in all but two games over her three-plus seasons at Arkansas State. Payton Tennison also reached the century mark at Little Rock on 1/18.

- In the season-opening win vs. Central Baptist, Arkansas State brought down a whopping 64 rebounds, which was the fourth-most in a single game in program history and the most since 2009.

A NEW ERA BEGINS

- Matt Daniel was hired on March 29 following Brian Boyer's 20-year tenure at the helm of the program.
- Daniel, a Jonesboro native, most recently spent five years as head coach at Marshall, where he led the Herd to the postseason for the first time ever.
- Before his stint at Marshall, Daniel pulled off one of the biggest turnarounds in NCAA history at Central Arkansas, improving by 15 games from Year 1 to Year 2.

- Arkansas State's schedule features 17 games away from the friendly confines of First National Bank Arena, with 12 at home (3 non-SBC, 9 SBC).

JONESBORO, Ark. (2/7/19) - Five Arkansas State players scored in double figures to lead the Red Wolves to a 69-58 victory over South Alabama Thursday night at First National Bank Arena in a Sun Belt Conference women's basketball game.

A-State now stands 9-12 on the season and 4-6 in league play, while South Alabama had its five-game winning streak snapped and now holds a 17-4 overall record and 6-4 Sun Belt mark. Arkansas State completed a regular-season sweep of USA, also winning 77-64 in Mobile in January.

The Red Wolves were led by Jireh Washington with a team-high 14 points, while Peyton Martin scored 12 and Morgan Wallace, Payton Tennison, and Akasha Westbrook each added 11. The game marked the second time this season A-State had five players reach double digits in the scoring column, also doing so against UT Martin in its third contest of the year.

A-State finished the outing with a 42.9 shooting percentage in comparison to USA's 35.1, and it also held a 36-34 advantage on the boards. The Red Wolves connected on 5-of-8 three-pointers and 22-of-31 free throws. Their defense limited the Jaguars to a 26.9 three-point percentage, and South Alabama was 11-of-14 from the foul line.

South Alabama held its largest lead of the game at 14-10 with 2:44 left in the first quarter, but the Red Wolves closed the period out with a 6-0 run to retake a lead they wouldn't relinquish the rest of the night.
