THE OPENING TIP

- ▶ Arkansas State is looking to continue the feasting post-Thanksgiving, taking their talents to the Sooner State for the second time this season. There, A-State will face a pair of opponents in host Oral Roberts and Abilene Christian at the ORU Thanksgiving Classic in Tulsa, Okla. Both game will be streamed on ORUAthletics.com and can be heard on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network and flagship station 95.3 The Ticket.
- ▶ The 2021-22 campaign marks the program's 48th season, with the Red Wolves amassing a 762-588 all-time record (.564) dating back to the inaugural 1974-75 season. A-State is the winningest program among current Sun Belt Conference members.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES

- ▶ Arkansas State opens the two-game set against host Oral Roberts, which enters the weekend at 0-4 overall and riding a 12-game losing skid dating back to Feb. 5, 2021.
- ▶ Preseason Second Team All-Summit League guard Keni Jo Lippe leads ORU in scoring (11.5 points/game) and shoots 42.9 percent from the field. Her 81.2 percent mark at the free-throw line ranks sixth in the Summit League. She has scored 1,504 points in her career for the Golden Eagles.
- ▶ ORU ranks third in the Summit League in fewest turnovers committed, only allowing 70 this season. The Golden Eagles also rank third in the league in blocked shots per game (3.8) and rebounding (39.0/game).

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Arkansas State started strong and fast early, dispatching in-state Division-III foe University of the Ozarks 95-49 just before Thanksgiving.
- ▶ Lauryn Pendleton registered a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds, while six players scored in double figures on the night. Jade Upshaw led with a career-best 17 points in her first career start to pace an effort that saw all 11 players who saw action factor into the scoring column.

STUFFING... IN SCHEDULING

- ▶ Not the traditional Thanksgiving side dish... (It's dressing if it is on the side. Stuffing is actually IN the turkey. Change my mind.)
- ▶ Arkansas State is packing in a schedule during Thanksgiving Week, playing four games in a seven-day stretch.
- ▶ A-State opened the week with back-to-back wins in back-to-back days, defeating SEMO at Ozarks (Ark.) before this weeken'ds trek to Tulsa, Okla., for the ORU Thanksgiving Classic for games at host Oral Roberts (Saturday) and Abilene Christian (Sunday).

AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD ...

- ▶ Improve Arkansas State's record to 5-2.
- ▶ Move A-State to 2-1 in road contests on the year, and its 69th all-time win in an MTE.
- ▶ Mark a three-game winning streak for the Red Wolves.
- ▶ Be better than a loss.

TRINITEE'S TRANSFORMATION

- ▶ Another story to watch is the continued improvement of Arkansas State forward Trinitee Jackson.
- ▶ The junior was among the most improved players in the conference last season in multiple areas, including upping her minutes played per game from 6.8 in 2019-20 to 15.4 a season ago. Because of that, Jackson went from averaging just 3.0 points and 2.9 rebounds to becoming a key impact performer who averaged 7.9 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting 48.0 percent from the floor.
- ▶ That has continued into this season, where she played career-best minutes in back-to-back games, coincidentally notching back-to-back double-doubles versus Arkansas (11/19) and SEMO (11/22).
- ▶ **With 17 rebounds versus Arkansas Friday and 15 at SEMO on Monday, Jackson is the first A-State player with back-to-back games of 15 boards or more since 2004-05 (Adrienne Davie - 16, 2x, 12/19 vs Western Michigan & 12/21 at SFA).**

A-STATE IN MULTI-TEAM EVENTS/REGULAR-SEASON TOURNAMENTS

- ▶ Arkansas State is not a stranger to regular-season tournaments/multi-team events, playing in 62 total since the first one in 1979-80.
- ▶ A-State owns a 68-66 record in such events, most recently playing a pair of games in Chicago at the Maggie Dixon Classic in 2019, dropping outcomes to host DePaul and North Carolina A&T.
- ▶ Until not playing in one in 2012-13, A-State played in at least one tournament from 1979-80 until 2011-12 - a stretch of 31 consecutive seasons.

SOONER STATE RED WOLVES

- ▶ Freshman Jade Upshaw is the lone Oklahoman on the 2021-22 Arkansas State women's basketball roster, hailing from Sapulpa, just 19 minutes outside of this weekend's destination of Tulsa.
- ▶ Upshaw was a phenom in high school for Kellyville High School, where she scored nearly 1,800 points for the Ponies and was All-World by the *Tulsa World*.

ON THIS DAY - NOVEMBER 27

- ▶ Since the 1991-92 season, Arkansas State has played 10 times on Nov. 27, going 5-5, including three times in tournament action.
- ▶ Most recently, A-State defeated Murray State 74-63 in Jonesboro in 2018.
- ▶ November 27, 1966: The highest-scoring NFL game was played, with the Washington Redskins defeating the New York Football Giants 72-41.

"I WANNA GO FAST!"

- ▶ Just like racing legend Ricky Bobby, Arkansas State wants to go fast. They have played a fast brand of basketball early on this season, and it's showing both on the scoreboard and in the advanced metrics.
- ▶ According to HerHoopStats.com, the Red Wolves rank 11th nationally (out of 356 teams) in possessions per 40 minutes ("Pace"), averaging 80.0 possessions per 40 minutes in their four games versus Division-I foes. A-State's 82.3 points per game against D1 opposition is 20th in HHS's rankings.

SPLASH SISTERS

- ▶ A pair of freshmen have been key contributors early on this season for Arkansas State, as **Lauryn Pendleton** and **Jade Upshaw** have each posted at least four games of 10-plus points in six games to start the season. A-State is the only team in the Sun Belt with two freshmen averaging double figures.
- ▶ Upshaw scored 10-plus in the first four games to begin her career, the first since Jireh Washington did so in four straight to open her tenure in 2018-19. A freshman (true or redshirt) has not scored 10 or more in five straight since before the 2001-02 season.
- ▶ If you look to see when the last time A-State had more than one freshman score 10 or more in the first three games to start a career, it goes back quite a while, as it hasn't happened since at least prior to 1990.

THREE'S A CROWD, FOUR'S A PARTY

- ▶ In two-plus seasons under Matt Daniel, Arkansas State has had three or more players record double-digit scoring in 29 of 59 games - including 13 times last year and all six games this season.
- ▶ Dating back to the the 2012-13 season, A-State is 104-58 (.642) when three or more players score 10 or more points.

PATTON POWER

- ▶ Arkansas State newcomer Keya Patton has provided an instant impact in the lineup.
- ▶ The Auburn transfer is A-State's leading scorer (13.8) while adding help in rebounding (4.0) and assists (2.0). Her 50.0 percent shooting ranks fourth in the Sun Belt.
- ▶ Patton has scored 10 or more points in five consecutive games entering Saturday, including back-to-back games of a career-high 17 points versus Arkansas (11/19) and at Southeast Missouri (11/22).

RECOVERING FROM THE TRYPTOPHAN COMA

- ▶ Dating back to the 1991-92 season, Arkansas State has played in 28 games the Friday or Saturday after Thanksgiving. In those contests, A-State owns a 15-13 overall ledger.
- ▶ Prior to not playing in a game immediately following the holiday in 2020, the Red Wolves played in at least one game the Friday or Saturday after Thanksgiving from 2013-2019.

"NOVEMBER RAIN"

- ▶ Arkansas State has traditionally opened the season strong in the month of November, amassing a record of 78-74 since the 1991-92 season.
- ▶ A-State has 21 seasons of .500 or better in November dating back to 1991-92, including a 4-2 mark this season. With two games left in November, the Red Wolves are assured of that 21st .500 mark or better in November.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- ▶ Arkansas State is the nation's best at getting the free-throw line early on this season, ranking first nationally with 159 free-throw attempts. The Red Wolves have been good on 113 of those tries at the stripe, which is the most in the nation as of Thursday's games.
- ▶ Individually, Trinitee Jackson tops the nation with 43 free-throw attempts, while Morgan Wallace is sixth with 36. Wallace has connected on 30 of those tries, which is fourth-most nationally and leads the Sun Belt.
- ▶ Much of Wallace's attempts came in her tremendous 15-of-16 day at the charity stripe on Nov. 12 at Oklahoma, which was the most by an A-State player since Adrienne Davie on Nov. 30, 2006, versus South Dakota State. Those 15 makes is the most by a Division I player this season in a single game.

TAKE IT TO THE BANK!

- ▶ Arkansas State is entering its 35th season inside First National Bank Arena, formerly the Convocation Center (aka "The Convo"), owning a 333-119 (.737) ledger.
- ▶ A-State has posted four straight seasons above .500 at "The Bank," and just two sub-.500 marks in 34 seasons.

"A LITTLE HELP FROM MY FRIENDS"

- ▶ Arkansas State played incredibly unselfish basketball in its season-opening win over Central Baptist College, handing out 18 assists to 26 made field goals for a ~nice~ 69.2 assist percentage. A-State then recorded a 61.5 percent assist percentage (24 assists/39 field goals) versus McNeese on 11/15.
- ▶ Last year, the Red Wolves recorded an assist percentage of 60.0 percent or better six times, with a high of 70.3 percent.
- ▶ In its win over McNeese on 11/15, A-State handed out 24 assists - tied for the fourth most in a single game in school history and the most since dishing out the same number of dimes versus Troy on Feb. 2, 2015.
- ▶ Arkansas State has handed out 15 or more assists in three games so far this season, already half as many as in all of last season (6). In 2019-20, Daniel's first season, the Red Wolves had 10 games of 15-plus assists.

IN-STATE BATTLES

- ▶ This season's slate features six contests against foes from the Natural State, including a pair against conference rival Little Rock.
- ▶ Including A-State's season opener versus Central Baptist College (Conway) and home outings against Arkansas and University of the Ozarks, the Red Wolves faced three of those in-state foes in the month of November.

CENTURY MARK

- ▶ Arkansas State's Morgan Wallace is on track to surpass 100 career games played. The Little Rock native is currently at 99.
- ▶ Trinitee Jackson is second on the team with 85 games played.

CHASING 1K

- ▶ A pair of Arkansas State guards have a chance to join the 1,000-point club this season in Jireh Washington and Morgan Wallace.
- ▶ Wallace is the team's active career leader in scoring with 877 points, needing 123 points, while Washington is close behind at 850 points - just 150 points shy. There are 24 players in program history who have scored 1,000 points or more.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

- ▶ ... find out what it means to me ...
- ▶ Arkansas State junior guard Jireh Washington received some preseason hype from the Sun Belt Conference coaches, being tabbed a preseason Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference member.
- ▶ The Memphis native received Third Team honors after a strong 2019-20 season and was on track to another award-winning season before her year was cut short to injury after 11 games.

RED WOLVES PICKED 10TH IN PRESEASON

- ▶ In the preseason coaches poll, however, the Red Wolves did not receive as much hype, being picked to finish 10th in the Sun Belt Conference.
- ▶ The league moved back to a 1-12 standings format after being in a divisional-only schedule in 2020-21 due to COVID-19. Teams will play a similar schedule this season, facing "division" foes twice and cross-divisional opponents once.

TAKE IT AWAY

- ▶ Last season, A-State forced 16 or more turnovers in 11 games, including 20 or more in five games. The Red Wolves forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games.
- ▶ A-State got off to a strong start this season, forcing 15 or more takeaways in five of its first six outings, including 20 or more three times. In Tuesday's win over Ozarks, the Red Wolves forced 31 turnovers - the most by an A-State team since Nov. 12, 2010 (32 vs Texas A&M-Corpus Christi).
- ▶ Going back to Matt Daniel's first year at the helm, Arkansas State has forced double-digit turnovers in all but four games including 17 games with 20 or more.

GRAND THEFT BASKETBALL

- ▶ Thievery is not tolerated, but on the basketball court, it's encouraged.
- ▶ A-State swiped 25 steals in Tuesday's win over the University of the Ozarks, the second most in school history. It was just the sixth time ever the Red Wolves had recorded 20 or more steals in a contest and the second time over 25. The last time that happened? Nov. 21, 1991, when the Scarlet and Black swiped a program-record 28 at Northeast Louisiana.
- ▶ Going back to Matt Daniel's first year at the helm, Arkansas State has amassed 10 or more steals in 27 of 57 games, including seven contests of 15 or more.

- ▶ In August, he hired former Arkansas-Pine Bluff forward Erin Campbell as Director of Operations while tabbing Connor McNelis as an assistant coach in October. McNelis is the son of longtime Southern Miss head coach Joye-Lee McNelis and comes to A-State after a two-year stint at Nicholls State.

"YOU MUST BE NEW HERE"

- ▶ Fans will have several new faces to learn for this season, with the 2021-22 edition of the Arkansas State women's basketball roster featuring seven newcomers.
- ▶ One transfer acquisition, Keya Patton (Auburn), signed in the spring to join six November signees - Jade Upshaw, Leilani Augmon, Maily Wilkerson, Jada Williams, Lauryn Pendleton and Kiayra Ellis. Patton averaged 20 minutes per game for Auburn, averaging 6 points per outing.
- ▶ Newcomers are responsible for 54.0 percent of Arkansas State's scoring so far this season (274 of 507 points) and 62.1 percent of assists (54 of 87).

NEW VOICE ON THE MIC

- ▶ Fans will hear a new voice on the radio when Arkansas State takes the court this season, as Cade Carlton begins his first season as the play-by-play announce for the Red Wolves women's basketball team.
- ▶ Carlton, a 2021 A-State alumnus, takes over for longtime voice Keith Merritt.

"I JUST HAVEN'T MET YOU YET"

- ▶ Arkansas State faces five first-time opponents this season: Hendrix, Northwestern State, Oral Roberts, University of the Ozarks and Utah State.
- ▶ Matt Daniel has faced three of the five, dating back to his tenure at Central Arkansas, facing Hendrix and Oral Roberts as well as former Southland Conference counterpart Northwestern State.
