LEADING OFF

- The 2021 campaign marks the program's 74th season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,343-1,655-10 all-time record dating back to the inaugural 1948 season.
- The Red Wolves are entering the midweek contest after taking one in a three-game series at Louisiana over the weekend (3-10, 0-9, 16-11). A-State avoided the series sweep by defeating the Ragin' Cajuns in a slugfest on Sunday.
- Mississippi State leads the all-time series versus A-State 42-10. Tommy Raffo is making his first trip back to his alma mater as head coach of the Red Wolves since serving 15 years as an assistant at MSU. MORE ON PAGE 3.
- Tyler Jeans is slated to draw his first career start after making seven relief appearances to begin his A-State
- A-State enters the midweek contest ranked third in the Sun Belt Conference in home runs per game (1.00) (as of games played through 4/11), as well as in onbase percentage (.366) and runs per game (5.9). The Red Wolves rank seventh overall in the league with 25 round-trippers. A-State also ranks fourth in doubles per game in the conference (1.76).
- Tyler Duncan ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in seven offensive categories.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Red Wolves claimed the third game of a three-game series on Sunday, avoiding the sweep at Louisiana with a 16-11 win.
- Louisiana took 10-3 and 9-0 decisions in the first two games, but A-State brought the bats for Game 3.
- A-State picked up a pair of homers in the seventh and ninth innings as insurance, taking the win despite the Ragin' Cajuns belting seven homers - six solo shots.
- The Red Wolves got a three-run inside-the-park homer by Tyler Duncan and a three-run shot by Jake Gish in the late innings, while Kollin Stone held off a Cajuns ninth-inning rally to earn his third save of the year.

SERIES HISTORY

Mississippi State leads 42-10

- ▶ In the all-time series dating back to 1954, Arkansas State trails Mississippi State 42-10, with the Bulldogs winning five straight and eight of the last nine meetings
- ► The teams last met in 2006 for a three-game series in Starkville, with MSU taking the sweep. A-State's last win came in 1984 (8-7).
- ▶ Head Coach Tommy Raffo is facing his alma mater for the first time as head coach of the Red Wolves. Raffo lettered for the Bulldogs from 1987-90 and served 15 years as an assistant under legendary head coach Ron Polk.

KNOW THE FOE: MISSISSIPPI STATE

- ▶ Mississippi State enters the weekend series at 24-7 overall (8-4 SEC) after earning its second straight series sweep this past weekend in Auburn. The Bulldogs have won seven straight, with a win over Southern sandwiched by sweeps over Kentucky and Auburn.
- ► Tanner Allen leads the Bulldogs at the plate with a .333 average, 5 home runs and 34 RBI. Reigning SEC Newcomer of the Week Kamren James and Luke Hancock are tied for the team lead with 7 long balls. Rowdey Jordan has been hit 12 times, which is 11th most in the nation and first in the SEC. The Bulldogs hit .278 as a team and are 20th nationally in bases on balls (149).
- ▶ On the mound, the Bulldogs are slated to start RHP Carlisle Koestler. The seventh-year veteran owns a 3-0 record in seven appearances (1 start) with a 3.21 ERA in 14.0 innings pitched. As a team, the Bulldogs hold opposing batters to a .194 average with a 3.01 ERA. MSU's pitching staff is among the nation's best, leading the country in strikeouts per 9 innings (13.1) and sixth in K-to-BB ratio (3.62)

RAFFO'S RETURN

- ► Arkansas State head coach Tommy Raffo is making his first trip back to Starkville as head coach of the Red Wolves since he was hired after the 2008 season. Tuesday will mark the first meeting versus his alma mater.
- ▶ Raffo served as an assistant for the Bulldogs under legendary head coach Ron Polk (1994-97, 2002-08) as well as Pat McMahon (1998-2001) after playing four seasons at first base for the Diamond Dawgs from 1987 to 1990. As a player, he was a two-time All-American and All-SEC honoree, also earning a pair of All-SEC Tournament laurels.
- ▶ He holds at least one spot in MSU's single-season top 10 in hits (4th-102 & 9th-97), home runs (6th-22), total bases (4th-185), RBI (7th-80) and games played (9th-70, 10th-68). In his storied career, Raffo ranks fourth on MSU's all-time list in career batting average (.366), RBI (207) and on-base percentage (.458), fifth in slugging (.628) and total bases (477), eighth in hits (278), doubles (52), home runs (45)
- ▶ A volunteer assistant from 1994-97, then an assistant for McMahon and Polk from 1998-2008, Raffo was part of three trips to the College World Series (1997, 1998, 2007), 11 NCAA Regionals (1996-01, 2003-07), three NCAA Super Regionals (2000, 2001, 2007), six 40-plus win seasons and two SEC Tournament championships (2001, 2005).

GRAB THE BROOMS!

- ▶ Arkansas State swept in-state rival Little Rock two weekends ago, shutting down one of the hottest teams in the Sun Belt at the time. A-State held the hot-hitting Trojans to a .192 average and outscored them 24-8 in three contests.
- ▶ Most notably, A-State held Little Rock scoreless through 23 1/3 innings Saturday through the first four innings on Sunday. The Trojans were held to just 4 for 24 (.167) with runners in scoring position, 0 for 12 through the first two games.

DUNCAN AT THE DISH

- ▶ Tyler Duncan has had a strong start to the season at the plate for Arkansas State. The senior ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in seven categories and is among the top 100 in the NCAA in three of those. A full look at where he ranks in the league and nationally is below.
- ▶ The Sooke, British Columbia, native is on pace to put up career-best numbers that surpass his first two seasons in Jonesboro. His 6 homers has surpassed his previous two years' total, while his 8 doubles is nearing the 12 he tallied in 2019 and 2020. Duncan is also slugging at a .612 clip, while his average is currently a career best. Pretty good, eh?

"HIT DINGERS"

- ▶ Tyler Duncan owns the team lead in home runs with six round-trippers so far this season after his insidethe-park homer on Sunday at Louisiana, with Sky-Lar Culver, Jaylon Deshazier and Drew Tipton tied for second with four.
- ▶ Both Culver (11), Tipton (11) and Duncan (11) are among the top four active leaders in homers on the team, behind Deshazier (15).
- \blacktriangleright A-State has homered in 17 of its 25 games this season.
- ▶ In the first game of A-State's doubleheader at Oklahoma on March 14, A-State belted four dingers for the first time since Feb. 16, 2019 at Stephen F. Austin and just the fifth game with four or more homers since before 2005.

LIAM *STIX*

- ▶ Liam Hicks is back in the Arkansas State lineup after being sidelined for eight games due to injury. He was leading the team in hitting with a .370 clip before going down, but came back in a big way at Illinois State.
- ▶ Hicks hit .500 (6-12), reaching base 10 times in 16 plate appearances in the series in Normal.
- ▶ The Toronto native kept his hot streak going versus Little Rock, hitting a team-best .538 on the series and reaching base in 60 percent of his plate appearances (9 of 15) with three extra-base hits and four RBI.
- ▶ He currently leads the Sun Belt Conference with a .413 batting average among all players with a minimum of 60 at-bats, while also reaching base in 32 of 33 games to start his A-State career 31 straight before not reaching on Saturday at Louisiana.
- ▶ In nine games returning to the lineup on March 26, Hicks is hitting .444 (16 for 36) with 9 runs scored and 8 RBI, slugging .611 with an on-base percentage of .556.

"MY SACRIFICE"

▶ Blake McCutchen is known to lay down the bunt here and there to move runners over, doing so twice this past weekend versus Little Rock. The Cabot, Arkansas, native ranks sixth in the Sun Belt and 62nd in the NCAA with four sac bunts. He averages 0.20 sac bunts per game, which ranks third in the league and 42nd nationally.

"REAL. COMFORTABLE. JEANS."

- ▶ No, we're not talking about Wrangler Jeans. This note pertains to Arkansas State freshman pitcher Tyler Jeans. The Texarkana, Arkansas, product has been incredibly sharp as of late, boasting a team-best 2.03 ERA in six relief appearances with a 1-0 record.
- ▶ In his last three appearances, Jeans has not allowed just two runs, both unearned, in 9 1/3 innings. In that stretch, he's struck out 12 batters, including a career-best 7 in 4.0 innings versus Little Rock on April 2 to clinch the series.

B-HUD TAKING ADVANTAGE OF STARTING OPPORTUNITY

- ▶ Brandon Hudson earned a victory in his first career start on March 23 versus Murray State, and that performance was good enough for him to earn his first career Sun Belt Conference start on April 1 versus in-state rival Little Rock.
- ▶ Hudson tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start, allowing one hit. The Roland, Arkansas, native struck out three and walked a pair to earn the victory. In his second start, on April 1 versus Little Rock, Hudson delivered another gem. He tossed a careerhigh 6.0 innings and limited the Trojans to two runs on four hits.

"DOUBLE VISION"

- ► Tyler Duncan is tied for sixth in the conference with eight doubles this season. Drew Tipton is the clubhouse career leader with 31.
- ► Arkansas State enters Tuesday's outing ranked fourth in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles per game, averaging 1.76.

"WALK THE LINE"

- ▶ The late, great Arkansas native Johnny Cash's hit song has played often after Drew Tipton trots 90 feet to first after four balls this season. The senior has drawn 19 walks so far this season, which ranks fifth in the conference. He is also second in the league with 0.76 walks per game.
- ▶ The Bryant, Arkansas, native enters the weekend eighth in program history in career bases on balls (96).

"DON'T RUB IT!"

▶ While we're on the subject of free passes drawn, Ben Klutts and Tipton are among the nation's leaders in hit-by-pitches. Klutts leads the team, having been hit 10 times which leads the Sun Belt and stands 32nd nationally. Tipton has been plunked 9 times, which is fourth in the conference and is inside the top 50 in the NCAA.

STONE COLD

- ▶ No, not Steve Austin. This note's about Arkansas State senior closer Kollin Stone.
- ▶ The former Riverside Rebel from Lake City, Arkansas, is rising atop the charts in career saves after a six-out save on Sunday at Louisiana. Stone is currently tied for fifth in career saves in program history, matching Mark Dobson (1995-98) with 10. He needs one to tie Tim Egart (2006-07) and Blake Ring (2003-05) with 11.

ALGEE'S STRONG START

- ► A-State freshman Jake Algee has posted a solid start to his collegiate career.
- ► The Brookland, Arkansas, native did not allow a run in his first four appearances, striking out five and allowing just three hits in 5.1 innings of work.

"LUCKY LEFTY"

- ▶ The Red Wolves pitching staff only features one lefty in Walker Williams.
- Williams tossed 4.0 innings of relief in A-State's 15-14 win over Oklahoma on March 14, surrending two runs on four hits with three strikeouts and no walks. The southpaw would earn his first career win in the effort.
- ► He picked up his second win on March 28 at Illinois State, tossing 2.0 shutout innings of relief.

A-STATE CAPTURES ANOTHER POWER-5 WIN AT OU

- ► The Red Wolves are entering the weekend series after taking a game at Oklahoma (who knocked off top-ranked Arkansas a couple of days later), defeating the Sooners on the road 15-14 by way of four homers.
- A-State has defeated at least one opponent from a Power 5 conference in three of the last five seasons.

"HOMEGROWN"

- ► Arkansas State's baseball team is full of homegrown talent from the state of Arkansas, with a handful hailing from the Northeast Arkansas region.
- ▶ A total of 21 Red Wolves come from the Natural State, with three being Craighead County natives: Sam Fagan (Jonesboro), Kollin Stone (Lake City) and Jake Algee (Brookland).

O CANADA!

- ▶ Three Arkansas State players call Canada their home and native land, as Tyler Duncan (Sooke, British Columbia), Andrew Leggo (Waterloo, Ontario) and Liam Hicks (Toronto, Ontario) all hail from the Great White North.
- ▶ ULM ties the Red Wolves for the league lead with three Canadians, while Louisiana and Little Rock have one on their rosters.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- ► Arkansas State faces a pretty tough schedule, especially in non-conference play for the 2021 season.
- ▶ After opening at then-No. 1 Ole Miss, A-State faced perennial Missouri Valley Conference contender Missouri State before traveling to Norman, Oklahoma, to face the Sooners.
- ▶ Later this season, the Red Wolves will make another trip to Oxford, as well as a visit to Mississippi State and a program-first showdown at Arkansas.

WEATHERING THE STORM

- ▶ All but three of A-State's contest to this point have been altered in some form or fashion due to the weather.
- ► The Red Wolves' original season opener versus Missouri State was postponed to March 9-10 due to a winter snow storm throughout the Southern U.S.
- ► The squad then had to alter its contest at Ole Miss to a day later, due to unplayable field conditions at Swayze Field in Oxford, Miss.
- ▶ A-State had to cancel its Friday contest versus UT Martin (Feb. 26) because of heavy fog. The teams were then forced to play a doubleheader Saturday, Feb. 27. Game two of the twinbill was called after five innings due to heavy rain in Jonesboro.
- ► The Red Wolves flipped its contest with Murray State to Johnny Reagan Field due to the threat of inclement weather and unplayable field conditions at Tomlinson Stadium
- ► A-State's series at Oklahoma has also been altered by weather, as forecasted rain on Friday and Saturday changed the schedule to a Sunday double header and Monday contest.
