LEADING OFF

- The 2021 campaign marks the program's 74th season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,344-1,659-10 all-time record dating back to the inaugural 1948
- The Red Wolves are entering the weekend series at Texas State to continue an eight-game road stretch after dropping a 5-3 loss at Central Arkansas on Tuesday. A-State and Texas State are tied for fourth in the Sun Belt West Division at 5-7 in league play.
- Arkansas State owns a 13-9 lead in the overall series versus Texas State - 13-8 under Head Coach Tommy Raffo. MORE ON PAGE 3.
- Ben Klutts is riding a team-best nine-game hitting streak entering the weekend. During that stretch, Klutts is hitting .400 with two doubles and a home run, while slugging .543 with an on-base percentage of .512. MORE ON PAGE 3.
- Jaylon Deshazier has reached base in 19 straight games - a career long for the Pine Bluff native. Deshazier is hitting .300 during that stint, slugging .543 with three doubles, a triple and four homers.
- A-State pitching has tossed two quality starts in the last three weekend games, with Brandon Hudson and Carter Holt doing so this past weekend versus UTA.
- A-State enters the week ranked third in the Sun Belt Conference in on-base percentage (.361) and runs per game (5.8), fourth in hit-by-pitches (41) and fifth in home runs per game (0.93).
- Drew Tipton is rising up the Arkansas State career charts in multiple categories. MORE ON PAGE 5.

The Bears got a run back in the sixth before adding three more in the seventh, aided by a pair of A-State errors, to take the lead. The go-ahead run scored on a two-RBI single by RJ Pearson, making it 5-3 UCA.

SERIES HISTORY

A-State leads 13-9

- ▶ In the all-time series versus Texas State dating back to 2000, Arkansas State leads 13-9. Texas State was originally known as Southwest Texas State at the time of the first meeting in 2000, but went through a name change to Texas State University in 2003.
- ► Texas State won the inaugural meeting early in the 2000 season, defeating Arkansas State 11-8 at the Dallas Baptist Classic in Dallas, Texas. That Bobcats team would go on to win the Southland Conference Tournamsent.
- ► The Bobcats most recently swept the Red Wolves in 2019 in San Marcos, clinching the sweep with a 7-6 10-inning victory. They have won three of the last four meetings.
- ► Head Coach Tommy Raffo is 13-8 as a head coach versus Texas State 6-4 in games played in San Marcos.

KNOW THE FOE: TEXAS STATE

- ► Texas State enters the weekend series at 15-23 overall (5-7 SBC), having dropped six in a row after a 5-1 loss at home to No. 3 Texas.
- ▶ Justin Thompson is the only Bobcat hitting above .300 this season at a .308 clip, leading the team in hits (45), runs (21), home runs (5) and RBI (32). Jose Gonzalez is tied for the league lead in doubles (13 11th NCAA) and is ninth in slugging (.545)
- ► As a team, Texas State hits .252 (7th SBC) but is tied for the league lead in triples (11 17th NCAA), rank second in doubles (67 34th NCAA) and leads the conference (31st NCAA) in walks (161). In conference play, the Bobcats are hitting just .243 with 22 doubles and just one triple.
- ► On the mound, TSU owns a 5.29 team ERA, which is ninth-best in the SBC but leads the conference in runners picked off (7).
- ► The Bobcats are slated to start righties Zachary Leigh (2-5, 5.54 ERA, 51 K) on Friday and Zeke Wood (2-3, 3.60, 41 K) on Saturday.

LAST 5 GAMES

- ► Arkansas State has gone 1-4 in its last five games, with the lone win coming on Sunday versus UT Arlington. Ben Klutts leads the way with a .400 clip at the plate and .550 slugging percentage during that stretch, while Jaylon Deshazier hit .364 with six RBI. Jake Gish led the way with a team-high seven RBI in that stretch with two homers.
- ▶ On the mound, Max Charlton pitched a pair of solid outings, with an ERA of 2.25 in 4.0 innings of relief with seven strikeouts. Carter Holt and Brandon Hudson tossed quality starts on Friday and Sunday versus UTA, with Holt picking up a win.

BEN *KLUTCH*

- ▶ Ben Klutts has been on a tear at the plate for Arkansas State recently, riding a season-long nine-game winning streak entering Friday's contest.
- ► The Poteau, Oklahoma, native is hitting .400 during that stretch, slugging .543 with three extra-base hits and 10 runs scored. His on-base percentage is up over .500 as well, at .512.

DESHAZIER CONTINUES ON-BASE STREAK

- ▶ Jaylon Deshazier is riding a career-long 19-game on-base streak into the weekend series, having reached base at least once in every game since Monday, March 15 at Oklahoma.
- ▶ Deshazier is hitting .300 with 21 hits, four home runs, three doubles and a triple during that stretch, reaching base 31 total times in 80 appearances (.383 OBP).

DUNCAN AT THE DISH

- ▶ Tyler Duncan has had a strong start to the season at the plate for Arkansas State. The senior ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in five categories and is among the top 100 in the NCAA in RBI (95th 32) and RBI per game (92nd 1.07). A full look at where he ranks in the league and nationally is below.
- ▶ The Sooke, British Columbia, native is on pace to put up career-best numbers that surpass his first two seasons in Jonesboro. His 6 homers has surpassed his previous two years' total, while his 8 doubles is nearing the 12 he tallied in 2019 and 2020. Duncan is also slugging at a .556 clip, while his average (.316) is currently a career best. Pretty good, eh?

"HIT DINGERS"

- ► Tyler Duncan owns the team lead in home runs with six round-trippers so far this season after his insidethe-park homer on Sunday, April 11 at Louisiana, with Jake Gish, Sky-Lar Culver, Jaylon Deshazier and Drew Tipton all tied for second with four.
- ▶ Both Culver (11), Tipton (11) and Duncan (11) are among the top four active leaders in homers on the team, behind Deshazier (15).
- ► A-State has homered in 19 of its 29 games this season. The Red Wolves have homered twice or more in six games.
- ▶ In the first game of A-State's doubleheader at Oklahoma on March 14, A-State belted four dingers for the first time since Feb. 16, 2019 at Stephen F. Austin and just the fifth game with four or more homers since before 2005.

LIAM *STIX*

- ▶ Liam Hicks is back in the Arkansas State lineup after being sidelined for eight games due to injury. He was leading the team in hitting with a .370 clip before going down, but came back in a big way at Illinois State.
- ▶ Hicks hit .500 (6-12), reaching base 10 times in 16 plate appearances in the series in Normal.
- ▶ The Toronto native kept his hot streak going versus Little Rock, hitting a team-best .538 on the series and reaching base in 60 percent of his plate appearances (9 of 15) with three extra-base hits and four RBI.
- ▶ He owns a team-best on-base percentage of .505, reaching base in 37 of 38 games to start his A-State career 31 straight before not reaching on 4/10 at Louisiana.
- ▶ In 13 games returning to the lineup on March 26, Hicks is hitting .382 (21-for-55) with 13 runs scored and nine RBI, slugging .509 with an on-base percentage of .514.
- ▶ On April 14, Hicks was named No. 23 on D1 Baseball's Top 100 Draft-Eligible Hitters using analytics the highest-ranked of four Sun Belt hitters. The list evaluated on a scale of 50-100 hitters' plate discipline (Hicks: 90.01), hit ability (ability to hit/get on base: 88.80) and game power (XBH; power in-game: 77.26).

"THE ELDER STATESMAN"

- ▶ Drew Tipton is the longest-serving active A-State player on the 2021 roster, having been on the team since the 2016 season. He is also rising up the career charts in several categories: games started (8th 184), at-bats (9th 668), runs scored (5th 139), triples (T10th 4), walks (7th 98), hit-by-pitch (4th 35), stole bases (2nd 53) and stolen base attempts (2nd 57). - ► The Bryant, Arkansas, native redshirted in 2016, but has been a member of the program during a stretch that spans three different U.S. Presidents (2016 Obama; 2017-2020 Trump; 2021 Biden).

B-HUD TAKING ADVANTAGE OF STARTING OPPORTUNITY

- ▶ Brandon Hudson earned a victory in his first career start on March 23 versus Murray State, and that performance was good enough for him to earn his first career Sun Belt Conference start on April 1 versus in-state rival Little Rock.
- ▶ Hudson tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start, allowing one hit. The Roland, Arkansas, native struck out three and walked a pair to earn the victory. In his second start, on April 1 versus Little Rock, Hudson delivered another gem. He tossed a careerhigh 6.0 innings and limited the Trojans to two runs on four hits.
- ► In his three Sun Belt Conference starts, Hudson has pitched a pair of quality starts after doing so on Friday versus UT Arlington.

"MY SACRIFICE"

▶ Blake McCutchen is known to lay down the bunt here and there to move runners over. The Cabot, Arkansas, native ranks eighth in the Sun Belt and 91st in the NCAA with four sac bunts. He averages 0.16 sac bunts per game, which ranks fourth in the league and 85th nationally.

"REAL. COMFORTABLE. JEANS."

- ▶ No, we're not talking about Wrangler Jeans. This note pertains to Arkansas State freshman pitcher Tyler Jeans. The Texarkana, Arkansas, product was very sharp to start his career, boasting an 2.03 ERA in his first six relief appearances with a 1-0 record.
- ▶ On April 2 versus Little Rock, he struck out a career-best 7 in 4.0 innings versus Little Rock on April 2 to clinch the series. Jeans took the mound for his first career start on April 13 versus Mississippi State, pitching 4.0 innings but retiring nine in a row after giving up a leadoff solo homer.

"DOUBLE VISION"

- ► Tyler Duncan is tied for 12th in the conference with eight doubles this season. Drew Tipton is the active career leader with 31.
- ► Arkansas State enters Friday's outing ranked sixth in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles per game, averaging 1.63.

"WALK THE LINE"

- ► The late, great Arkansas native Johnny Cash's hit song has played often after Drew Tipton trots 90 feet to first after four balls this season. The senior has drawn 21 walks so far this season, which ranks tied for fourth in the conference.
- ▶ The Bryant, Arkansas, native enters the weekend eighth in program history in career bases on balls (98).

"DON'T RUB IT!"

▶ While we're on the subject of free passes drawn, Ben Klutts and Tipton are among the nation's leaders in hit-by-pitches. Klutts leads the team, having been hit 12 times which ties for the lead in the Sun Belt and stands 17th nationally. Tipton has been plunked 10 times, which is fifth in the conference and is 50th in the NCAA. He is also tied for fifth all-time with 35 HBPs.

"STONE COLD"

- ▶ No, not Steve Austin. This note's about Arkansas State senior closer Kollin Stone.
- ▶ The former Riverside Rebel from Lake City, Arkansas, is rising atop the charts in career saves after perfect inning versus UTA. Stone is currently tied for third in career saves in program history, matching Tim Egart (2006-07) and Blake Ring (2003-05) with 11. He needs one to tie current Major Leaguer Tyler Zuber for second all-time with 12. FULL LIST ON PAGE 5

- ▶ A-State freshman Jake Algee has posted a solid start to his collegiate career.
- ► The Brookland, Arkansas, native did not allow a run in his first four appearances, striking out five and allowing just three hits in 5.1 innings of work.

- ▶ The Red Wolves pitching staff only features one lefty in Walker Williams.
- Williams tossed 4.0 innings of relief in A-State's 15-14 win over Oklahoma on March 14, surrending two runs on four hits with three strikeouts and no walks. The southpaw would earn his first career win in the effort.

- ► The Red Wolves are entering the weekend series after taking a game at Oklahoma (who knocked off top-ranked Arkansas a couple of days later), defeating the Sooners on the road 15-14 by way of four homers.
- A-State has defeated at least one opponent from a Power 5 conference in three of the last five seasons.

"HOMEGROWN"

- ► Arkansas State's baseball team is full of homegrown talent from the state of Arkansas, with a handful hailing from the Northeast Arkansas region.
- ▶ A total of 21 Red Wolves come from the Natural State, with three being Craighead County natives: Sam Fagan (Jonesboro), Kollin Stone (Lake City) and Jake Algee (Brookland).

O CANADA!

- ▶ Three Arkansas State players call Canada their home and native land, as Tyler Duncan (Sooke, British Columbia), Andrew Leggo (Waterloo, Ontario) and Liam Hicks (Toronto, Ontario) all hail from the Great White North.
- ▶ ULM ties the Red Wolves for the league lead with three Canadians, while Louisiana and Little Rock have one on their rosters.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- ► Arkansas State faces a pretty tough schedule, especially in non-conference play for the 2021 season.
- ▶ After opening at then-No. 1 Ole Miss, A-State faced perennial Missouri Valley Conference contender Missouri State before traveling to Norman, Oklahoma, to face the Sooners.
- ▶ The Red Wolves faced most recently faced off against four-straight top-50 RPI ballclubs in Louisiana (36) and Mississippi State (11), picking up a much-needed win over the Ragin' Cajuns on Sunday.
- ▶ Later this season, the Red Wolves will make another trip to Oxford, as well as a program-first showdown at Arkansas.

WEATHERING THE STORM

- ▶ All but three of A-State's contest to this point have been altered in some form or fashion due to the weather.
- ► The Red Wolves' original season opener versus Missouri State was postponed to March 9-10 due to a winter snow storm throughout the Southern U.S.
- ► The squad then had to alter its contest at Ole Miss to a day later, due to unplayable field conditions at Swayze Field in Oxford, Miss.
- ► A-State had to cancel its Friday contest versus UT Martin (Feb. 26) because of heavy fog. The teams were then forced to play a doubleheader Saturday, Feb. 27. Game two of the twinbill was called after five innings due to heavy rain in Jonesboro.
- ▶ The Red Wolves flipped its contest with Murray State to Johnny Reagan Field due to the threat of inclement weather and unplayable field conditions at Tomlinson Stadium.
- ► A-State's series at Oklahoma has also been altered by weather, as forecasted rain on Friday and Saturday changed the schedule to a Sunday double header and Monday contest.


