SERIES HISTORY

A-State leads 8-6

- ▶ In the all-time series versus Austin Peay dating back to 1995, Arkansas State leads 8-6. This weekend's series will mark the 15th, 16th and 17th meetings between A-State and the Governors. In games played in Clarksville, the series is knotted up at 3-3.
- ► Austin Peay won the inaugural meeting, 5-3, in Jonesboro and led 2-1 early in the series before A-State won seven of the next eight.
- ► The teams most recently met for a midweek showdown on March 22, 2017, with Austin Peay coming away with a 9-8 win over the Red Wolves in Clarksville.
- ► Head Coach Tommy Raffo is 2-3 as a head coach versus Austin Peay.

KNOW THE FOE: AUSTIN PEAY

- ► Austin Peay enters the weekend series at 15-24 overall, splitting a pair of midweek contests versus North Alabama (W 16-15) and Southeast Missouri (L 16-3).
- ► Garrett Spain is the team's top hitter, leading in batting average (.333), hits (45), runs (29), home runs (7), RBI (32), slugging (.570) and stolen bases (11). Jack Alexander leads the team with 12 doubles while Gino Avros and TJ Foreman lead the way with three triples.
- ► The Governors are among the top 30 teams in the nation at the plate in walks (29th-179) and sacrifice flies (26th-21), while ranking 35th with an OVC-leading 52 stolen bases. They also lead the OVC in triples (10).
- ▶ On the mound, Austin Peay owns a 6.83 team ERA. Harley Gollert is the team's leader in strikeouts (54), while he and Luke Brown lead the Governors with three wins apiece. The Governors are slated to start Brown on Friday, with Saturday and Sunday starters to be announced.
- ► Austin Peay is one of the nation's best at turning the double play, currently 16th nationally with an OVC-best 32.

LAST 5 GAMES

- ▶ Arkansas State has gone 2-4 in its last five games, with both wins coming in Sunday victories over UT Arlington and Texas State. Ben Klutts leads the way with a .476 clip at the plate (10-for-21) and .619 slugging percentage during that stretch, while Blake McCutchen hit .368 with two doubles, a homer and six RBI. McCutchen also slugged a team-best .632. Tyler Duncan led the way with eight RBI, four coming on a grand slam Sunday at Texas State.
- ▶ On the mound, the Red Wolves own a 4.64 ERA while holding opponents to a .250 batting average. Jack Jumper pitched in three ballgames with a save and five strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings. Carter Holt was A-State's top starter with a 2-0 record and a pair of quality starts versus UTA and Texas State.

ROWDY'S RETURN

- ► Arkansas State pitching coach Rowdy Hardy is making the return to his alma mater this weekend with A-State's trip to Austin Peay. Hardy is a member of the Austin Peay Sports Hall of Fame after his illustrious career with the Governors from 2004-06. In his three seasons in Clarksville, Hardy set the school and Ohio Valley Conference record for career wins (32).
- ▶ In 2004, he was named the league's Rookie of the Year with a school-record 12 wins (7-0 in OVC play) with a 2.90 ERA in leading the Governors to a regular-season league title and finished 10th nationally in wins. Hardy was also named third-team All-America by Louisville Slugger.
- ▶ As a junior, Hardy became the only pitcher in program history to record multiple double-digit win seasons by going 11-6. He posted a 2.63 ERA (2.04 in league play) and was named the OVC Pitcher of the Year, while also helping the Governors to an NCAA Tournament berth. Hardy was selected second-team All-America and started APSU's NCAA opener versus Tennessee and eventual top-pick Luke Hochevar.
- ►As a senior in 2006, Hardy won nine games and posted a career-best 2.58 ERA. After completing his collegiate career, he went on to a successful minor-league career with the Kansas City Royals and Atlanta Braves organizations. He was the 2007 Royals Minor League Pitcher of the Year after compiling a 15-5 record and 2.48 ERA for Wilmington before reaching as high as Triple-A in the Braves system.

*HOLT*ING IT DOWN

- ► Carter Holt has been strong on the mound for Arkansas State on Sundays, tossing back-to-back quality starts versus UT Arlington and at Texas State.
- ▶ In his last five starts, the Red Wolves are 5-0, while Holt owns a 3.12 ERA and a 3-0 record. Holt has pitched 26.0 innings, allowing nine earned runs while striking out 18 and walking eight.

DESHAZIER CONTINUES ON-BASE STREAK

- ▶ Jaylon Deshazier is riding a career-long 22-game on-base streak into the weekend series, having reached base at least once in every game since Monday, March 15 at Oklahoma.
- ▶ Deshazier is hitting .293 with 24 hits, four home runs, three doubles and a triple during that stretch, reaching base 36 total times in 94 appearances (.379 OBP).

DUNCAN AT THE DISH

- ► Tyler Duncan has had a strong start to the season at the plate for Arkansas State. The senior ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in six categories and is among the top 50 in the NCAA in RBI (47th 38) and RBI per game (37th 1.15). A full look at where he ranks in the league and nationally is below.
- ▶ The Sooke, British Columbia, native is on pace to put up career-best numbers that surpass his first two seasons in Jonesboro. His 7 homers has surpassed his previous two years' total, while his 8 doubles is nearing the 12 he tallied in 2019 and 2020. Duncan is also slugging at a .558 clip, while his average (.310) is currently a career best. Pretty good, eh?

"HIT DINGERS"

- ► Tyler Duncan owns the team lead in home runs with seven round-trippers so far this season after his grand slam Sunday at Texas State, with Drew Tipton second on the squad with five dingers.
- ▶ Both Tipton (12) and Duncan (12) are among the top active leaders in homers on the team, behind Deshazier (15).
- ► A-State has homered in 21 of its 33 games this season. The Red Wolves have homered twice or more in seven games.
- ▶ In the first game of A-State's doubleheader at Oklahoma on March 14, A-State belted four dingers for the first time since Feb. 16, 2019 at Stephen F. Austin and just the fifth game with four or more homers since before 2005.

LIAM *STIX*

- ▶ Liam Hicks is back in the Arkansas State lineup after being sidelined for eight games due to injury. He was leading the team in hitting with a .370 clip before going down, but came back in a big way at Illinois State.
- ► Hicks hit .500 (6-12), reaching base 10 times in 16 plate appearances in the series in Normal.
- ▶ He owns a team-best on-base percentage of .508, reaching base in 40 of 41 games to start his A-State career 31 straight before not reaching on 4/10 at Louisiana.
- ▶ The Toronto native ranks near the top in several offensive categories in the Sun Belt, including the best in on-base percentage (.508) and is one of the toughest hitters in the nation to strike out. He ranks 22nd nationally in on-base percentage.
- ▶ On April 14, Hicks was named No. 23 on D1 Baseball's Top 100 Draft-Eligible Hitters using analytics the highest-ranked of four Sun Belt hitters. The list evaluated on a scale of 50-100 hitters' plate discipline (Hicks: 90.01), hit ability (ability to hit/get on base: 88.80) and game power (XBH; power in-game: 77.26).

- ▶ Drew Tipton is the longest-serving active A-State player on the 2021 roster, having been on the team since the 2016 season. He is also rising up the career charts in several categories: games started (8th* 187), at-bats (10th 678), runs scored (5th 143), walks (8th 100), hit-by-pitch (5th 36), stolen bases (5th 53). - ▶ The Bryant, Arkansas, native redshirted in 2016, but has been a member of the program during a stretch that spans three different U.S. Presidents (2016 Obama; 2017-2020 Trump; 2021 Biden).

B-HUD TAKING ADVANTAGE OF STARTING OPPORTUNITY

- ▶ Brandon Hudson earned a victory in his first career start on March 23 versus Murray State, and that performance was good enough for him to earn his first career Sun Belt Conference start on April 1 versus in-state rival Little Rock.
- ▶ Hudson tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start, allowing one hit. The Roland, Arkansas, native struck out three and walked a pair to earn the victory. In his second start, on April 1 versus Little Rock, Hudson delivered another gem. He tossed a careerhigh 6.0 innings and limited the Trojans to two runs on four hits.
- ▶ In his four Sun Belt Conference starts, Hudson has pitched a pair of quality starts after doing so on April 16 versus UT Arlington.

BEN *KLUTCH*

- ▶ Ben Klutts has been on a tear at the plate for Arkansas State recently, despite an 11-game hitting streak ending on Sunday at Texas State.
- ▶ The Poteau, Oklahoma, native hit .465 (20-for-43) during that 11-game stretch, slugging .651 with six extra-base hits (5 2B, 1 HR) and 10 runs scored. His on-base percentage is up over .500 as well, at .539.

"MY SACRIFICE"

▶ Blake McCutchen is known to lay down the bunt here and there to move runners over. The Cabot, Arkansas, native ranks eighth in the Sun Belt and 64th in the NCAA with five sac bunts. He averages 0.18 sac bunts per game, which ranks fifth in the league and 58th nationally.

"DOUBLE VISION"

- ▶ Ben Klutts ranks tied for sixth in the Sun Belt with 11 doubles on the year third with 0.33 doubles per game. Drew Tipton is the active career leader with 31.
- ▶ Arkansas State enters Friday's outing ranked fifth in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles per game, averaging 1.73.

"WALK THE LINE"

- ► The late, great Arkansas native Johnny Cash's hit song has played often after Drew Tipton trots 90 feet to first after four balls this season. The senior has drawn 23 walks so far this season, which ranks fifth in the conference.
- ► The Bryant, Arkansas, native enters the weekend eighth in program history in career bases on balls (100).

Tipton has been plunked 11 times, which is fifth in the conference and is 49th in the NCAA. He is also fifth all-time with 36 HBPs.

"STONE COLD"

- ▶ No, not Steve Austin. This note's about Arkansas State senior closer Kollin Stone.
- ▶ The former Riverside Rebel from Lake City, Arkansas, is rising atop the charts in career saves after perfect inning versus UTA. Stone is currently tied for third in career saves in program history, matching Tim Egart (2006-07) and Blake Ring (2003-05) with 11. He needs one to tie current Major Leaguer Tyler Zuber for second all-time with 12. FULL LIST ON PAGE 5

"HOMEGROWN"

- ► Arkansas State's baseball team is full of homegrown talent from the state of Arkansas, with a handful hailing from the Northeast Arkansas region.
- ▶ A total of 21 Red Wolves come from the Natural State, with three being Craighead County natives: Sam Fagan (Jonesboro), Kollin Stone (Lake City) and Jake Algee (Brookland).

O CANADA!

- ► Three Arkansas State players call Canada their home and native land, as Tyler Duncan (Sooke, British Columbia), Andrew Leggo (Waterloo, Ontario) and Liam Hicks (Toronto, Ontario) all hail from the Great White North.
- ▶ ULM ties the Red Wolves for the league lead with three Canadians, while Louisiana and Little Rock have one on their rosters.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- ► Arkansas State faces a pretty tough schedule, especially in non-conference play for the 2021 season.
- ▶ After opening at then-No. 1 Ole Miss, A-State faced perennial Missouri Valley Conference contender Missouri State before traveling to Norman, Oklahoma, to face the Sooners.
- ▶ The Red Wolves faced most recently faced off against four-straight top-50 RPI ballclubs in Louisiana (36) and Mississippi State (11), picking up a much-needed win over the Ragin' Cajuns on Sunday.
- ▶ Later this season, the Red Wolves will make another trip to Oxford, as well as a program-first showdown at Arkansas.

WEATHERING THE STORM

- ▶ All but three of A-State's contest to this point have been altered in some form or fashion due to the weather.
- ► The Red Wolves' original season opener versus Missouri State was postponed to March 9-10 due to a winter snow storm throughout the Southern U.S.
- ► The squad then had to alter its contest at Ole Miss to a day later, due to unplayable field conditions at Swayze Field in Oxford, Miss.
- ► A-State had to cancel its Friday contest versus UT Martin (Feb. 26) because of heavy fog. The teams were then forced to play a doubleheader Saturday, Feb. 27. Game two of the twinbill was called after five innings due to heavy rain in Jonesboro.
- ► The Red Wolves flipped its contest with Murray State to Johnny Reagan Field due to the threat of inclement weather and unplayable field conditions at Tomlinson Stadium
- ► A-State's series at Oklahoma has also been altered by weather, as forecasted rain on Friday and Saturday changed the schedule to a Sunday double header and Monday contest.
