LEADING OFF

- The 2021 campaign marks the program's 74th season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,350-1,664-10 all-time record dating back to the 1948 season.
- The Red Wolves are entering the penultimate weekend series having won six of their last nine after taking two from (RV) Georgia Southern over the weekend before dropping a hard-fought midweek contest at No. 1 Arkansas.
- Troy leads the overall series 34-14, but the Red Wolves have claimed the last three meetings. MORE ON PAGE 3.
- Ben Klutts and Will Nash swept this week's Sun Belt Player and Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Liam Hicks was added to the Buster Posey Award Watch List, which awards the top catcher in college baseball. Hicks has reached base in 48 of his 49 career games at Arkansas State, and leads the Sun Belt (16th NCAA) in on-base percentage (.513). He enters the weekend inside the top five in the Sun Belt in six offensive categories. MORE ON PAGE 3.
- A-State pitching has tossed seven quality starts in its last nine weekend games, including three apiece by Carter Holt and Will Nash.



- Arkansas State had the bases loaded with the tying run at the plate in the eighth inning against top-ranked Arkansas, but ultimately fell 8-4 in the first-ever meeting between the in-state foes on Tuesday night in Fayetteville.
- Tyler Jeans posted an admirable start, holding the Hogs hitless through the first four innings before the Razorbacks exploded for five runs in the fifth. A-State got in the board in the seventh, but three more runs in the bottom half of the inning put Arkansas ahead 8-1.
- A-State managed to claw back with a three-run eighth, but the rally was not quite enough to overcome the top-ranked Razorbacks.

SERIES HISTORY

Troy leads 34-14

- ► Arkansas State and Troy are set to square off for the 49th, 50th and 51st time in history this weekend in Troy.
- ► The Trojans lead 34-14 in the all-time series dating back to 2006 11-7 in games played in Troy.
- ► A-State won the last three meetings between the teams, sweeping Troy in the 2019 series at Riddle-Pace Field - 9-3, 10-6, 10-4.
- ► A-State is 14-25 versus Troy under Tommy Raffo.
- ▶ Drew Tipton is .522 in his career versus Troy, going 12-for-23 in six games with eight stolen bases.

KNOW THE FOE: TROY

- ► Troy is entering the weekend at 24-21 overall and 10-8 in Sun Belt play after its midweek contest versus Alabama State was canceled. Last weekend, the Trojans swept Coastal Carolina in Conway.
- ▶ Logan Cerny leads the team in hitting (.348) with a league-leading 14 home runs. He is also second in the conference in RBI (42) and leads the conference in slugging (.726). Drew Frederic is the Division I active career leader in runs scored (203) and is second in at-bats (920), hits (284) and total bases (433). The senior is also third in career stolen bases (84). Rigsby Mosley leads the conference and ranks 18th in the NCAA with 16 doubles.
- ► As a team, the Trojans are one of the top doubles teams in the nation, ranking second in the Sun Belt and 28th in the NCAA with 90 doubles. Their 2.00 doubles per game leads the league and is 38th-best nationally. Troy also hits .276 as a squad, which ranks second in the Sun Belt.
- ▶ On the mound, Troy owns a 4.50 team ERA while holding opposing batters to a .258 average.
- ► The Trojans are slated to start righties **Garrett Gainous** (7-4, 4.22 ERA, 67 K) Friday, **Orlando Ortiz** (5-4, 4.89, 74 K) on Saturday and **Bay Witcher** (5-2, 4.06, 39 K) on Sunday. **Marquez Oates** is the team's primary closer, owning a 1.93 ERA with six saves.

LAST 5 GAMES

- ▶ Arkansas State has gone 2-3 in its last five games, taking a series over (RV) Georgia Southern in the middle of that stint. Two Red Wolves hit above .400 in the five games, led by Ben Klutts (.474) and Liam Hicks (.400). Klutts slugged a team-best .842 with a double and two homers, while Tyler Duncan drove in a team-high seven runs with two doubles. A-State averaged .263 as a team, powering 10 doubles and seven home runs.
- ▶ On the mound, the Red Wolves limited opponents to a .253 average with a 4.19 ERA. Three of the five starters notched quality starts.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

LIAM *STIX*

- ▶ Liam Hicks is back in the Arkansas State lineup after being sidelined for eight games due to injury. He was leading the team in hitting with a .370 clip before going down, but came back in a big way at Illinois State. Hicks hit .500 (6-12), reaching base 10 times in 16 plate appearances in the series in Normal.
- ▶ He owns a Sun Belt-best on-base percentage of .534, reaching base in 47 of 48 games to start his A-State career 31 straight before not reaching on 4/10 at Louisiana. His batting average of .390 also ranks second in the league, while he has reached base in 17 straight games.
- ▶ The Toronto native ranks near the top in several offensive categories in the Sun Belt and is inside the top 30 nationally in on-base percentage (16th) and hitting (30th).
- ▶ Since April 1 (22 games), Hicks is hitting .381 and slugging .607 with seven doubles and four home runs.
- ▶ On April 14, Hicks was named No. 23 on D1 Baseball's Top 100 Draft-Eligible Hitters using analytics the highest-ranked of four Sun Belt hitters. The list evaluated on a scale of 50-100 hitters' plate discipline (Hicks: 90.01), hit ability (ability to hit/get on base: 88.80) and game power (XBH; power in-game: 77.26).

HICKS ADDED TO POSEY WATCH LIST

- ▶ While we're on the topic of Liam Hicks, the catcher was added to the watch list for the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award presented by the Kamerion Wimbley Foundation.
- ▶ Hicks was one of nine catchers most recently added, with semifinalists being named on May 20 and finalists slated to be announced on June 7. The award was previously known as the Johnny Bench Award.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS!

- ► Arkansas State swept this week's Sun Belt Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week honors, with **Ben Klutts** (Player) and **Will Nash** (Pitcher) earning the honors.
- ▶ Klutts became the first A-State hitter since Alex Howard (May 22, 2017) to earn the honor, tallying multiple hits in all four games on the week, going 8-for-16 (.500) with five RBI.
- ▶ Nash was the first Red Wolves pitcher to be tabbed since Nate Alberius (March 26, 2019) after tossing six shutout innings in a 4-0 series-clinching win over Georgia Southern on Saturday.

DUNCAN AT THE DISH

- ▶ Tyler Duncan has had a breakout season at the plate for Arkansas State. The senior ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in seven categories and is among the top 40 in the NCAA in RBI (32nd 47) and RBI per game (37th 1.18). A full look at where he ranks in the league and nationally is below.
- ▶ The Sooke, British Columbia, native is on pace to put up career-best numbers that surpass his first two seasons in Jonesboro. Duncan's 49 RBI is the best by an A-State hitter since Kyle MacDonald's 50 in 2018. His nine homers has surpassed his previous two years' total, while his 11 doubles is one away from the 12 he tallied in 2019 and 2020. Duncan is also slugging at a .559 clip, while his average (.317) is currently a career best. Pretty good, eh?

"HIT DINGERS"

- ► Tyler Duncan owns the team lead in home runs with nine homers so far this season, with Drew Tipton second on the squad with seven dingers.
- ▶ Both Tipton (14) and Duncan (14) are among the top active career leaders in homers on the team, behind Deshazier (16).
- ► A-State has homered in 27 of its 41 games this season. The Red Wolves have homered twice or more in 11 games. The Red Wolves belted four homers for the second time this season on Tuesday at Ole Miss, and just the sixth game with four or more homers since before 2005.

"THE ELDER STATESMAN"

- ▶ Drew Tipton is the longest-serving active A-State player on the 2021 roster, having been on the team since the 2016 season. He is also rising up the career charts in several categories: games played (6th 208), games started (6th* 201), at-bats (7th 736), runs scored (2nd 162), walks (5th 111), hit-by-pitch (T4th 40), stolen bases (5th 58). - ➤ Tipton is among the top 50 among the NCAA Division active career leaders in six categories entering Friday runs scored (13th 162), stolen bases (22nd 58), hit-by-pitch (24th 40), walks (25th 111), games played (46th 208) and at-bats (46th-736).
- ► The Bryant, Arkansas, native redshirted in 2016, but has been a member of the program during a stretch that spans three different U.S. Presidents (2016 Obama; 2017-2020 Trump; 2021 Biden).

BEN *KLUTCH*

- ▶ Ben Klutts has been on a tear at the plate since April 1, after starting the season with a .227 average through the team's first 18 games.
- ► Since April 1 (22 games), Klutts is hitting a team-best .404 with a team-high 36 hits, eight doubles, three homers, 14 RBI and a slugging percentage of .596.
- ▶ The Poteau, Oklahoma, native is riding a team-best eight-game hitting streak in which he has recorded multiple hits in seven of eight games entering the weekend.

"MY SACRIFICE"

▶ Blake McCutchen is known to lay down the bunt here and there to move runners over. The Cabot native ranks seventh in the Sun Belt and 61st in the NCAA with six sac bunts. He averages 0.17 sac bunts per game, which ranks eighth in the league.

"DOUBLE VISION"

- ▶ Ben Klutts is tied for third in the Sun Belt with 14 doubles on the year second with 0.34 doubles per game. Drew Tipton is the team's active career leader with 38.
- ► Arkansas State enters Tuesday's outing fourth in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles per game, averaging 1.80.

"WALK THE LINE"

- ► The late, great Arkansas native Johnny Cash's hit song has played often after **Drew Tipton** trots 90 feet to first after four balls this season. The senior has drawn 31 walks so far this season, which leads the Sun Belt Conference.
- ► The Bryant, Arkansas, native enters the week fifth in program history in career bases on balls (111).

"DON'T RUB IT!"

▶ While we're on the subject of free passes drawn, Klutts and Tipton are among the league's leaders in hit-by-pitches. Klutts leads the team, having been hit 13 times which ranks third in the Sun Belt and stands 37th nationally. Tipton has been plunked 12 times, which is fourth in the conference. He is also tied for fourth all-time at A-State with 40 HBPs.

PITCHING NOTES

B-HUD TAKING ADVANTAGE OF STARTING OPPORTUNITY

- ▶ Brandon Hudson earned a victory in his first career start on March 23 versus Murray State, and that performance was good enough for him to earn his first career Sun Belt Conference start on April 1 versus in-state rival Little Rock.
- ▶ Hudson tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start, allowing one hit. The Roland, Arkansas, native struck out three and walked a pair to earn the victory. In his second start, on April 1 versus Little Rock, Hudson delivered another gem. He tossed a careerhigh 6.0 innings and limited the Trojans to two runs on four hits.
- ▶ In his five Sun Belt Conference starts, Hudson has pitched three quality outings.

*HOLT*ING IT DOWN

- ► Carter Holt has been strong on the mound for Arkansas State on Sundays, tossing four straight quality starts for the Red Wolves.
- ▶ In his last seven starts, the Red Wolves are 6-1, while Holt owns a 3.08 ERA and a 3-1 record. Holt has pitched 38.0 innings, allowing 13 earned runs while striking out 24 and walking 10 during that span.

HIGH-QUALITY H,0

- ▶ No, not Bobby Boucher's water... this note refers to the run of quality starts for the Arkansas State pitching staff.
- ► Since solidifying the weekend rotation before the Little Rock series on April 1, A-State has registered 10 quality starts (Carter Holt [4], Will Nash [3], Brandon Hudson [3]).

O CANADA!

- ► Three Arkansas State players call Canada their home and native land, as Tyler Duncan (Sooke, British Columbia), Andrew Leggo (Waterloo, Ontario) and Liam Hicks (Toronto, Ontario) all hail from the Great White North.
- ▶ ULM ties the Red Wolves for the league lead with three Canadians, while Louisiana and Little Rock have one on their rosters.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ► Arkansas State has been on the road more than a lot of college baseball teams this season.
- ▶ Out of the 41 total games played, 27 so far have been true road games 65.9 percent of games. Only 13 of the 293 teams that are playing Division I baseball this season have a similar or higher percentage. The only team further south than A-State is Texas Southern at 70 percent. North Dakota State has the highest percentage at 82.5 percent.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- ► Arkansas State faces a pretty tough schedule, especially in non-conference play for the 2021 season.
- ▶ After opening at then-No. 1 Ole Miss, A-State faced perennial Missouri Valley Conference contender Missouri State before traveling to Norman, Oklahoma, to face the Sooners
- ► The Red Wolves faced off against four-straight top-50 RPI ballclubs in Louisiana (36) and Mississippi State (11), picking up a much-needed win over the Ragin' Cajuns in Sunday's contest.
- ► Tuesday's contest in Fayetteville marked the second time this season the Red Wolves will face the RPI No. 1 team.

- ► The Red Wolves flipped its contest with Murray State to Johnny Reagan Field due to the threat of inclement weather and unplayable field conditions at Tomlinson Stadium
- ► A-State's series at Oklahoma has also been altered by weather, as forecasted rain on Friday and Saturday changed the schedule to a Sunday double header and Monday contest.

- ▶ Tyler Zuber is currently on the active roster with the Kansas City Royals.




