LEADING OFF

- The 2021 campaign marks the program's 74th season with the Red Wolves amassing a 1,348-1,662-10 all-time record dating back to the 1948 season.
- The Red Wolves are entering the weekend series having one four of their last five games, most recently dropping a tight 15-12 decision at ninth-ranked Ole Miss on Tuesday.
- Since the series began in 2015 when Georgia Southern joined the Sun Belt Conference, the Eagles hold an 11-5 series lead. **MORE ON PAGE 3.**
- This weekend's series pits two of the hottest offenses in the Sun Belt, with both A-State and Georgia Southern ranking inside the top four in the league in batting average, doubles/game, hit-by-pitch, home runs, home runs per game, on-base percentage, runs, runs per game and slugging percentage.
- Liam Hicks has reached base in 44 of his 45 career games at Arkansas State, and is among the toughest in the nation to strike out (32nd) and ranks ninth on on-base percentage. He enters the weekend inside the top five in the Sun Belt in six offensive categories. **MORE ON PAGE 3.**
- A-State pitching has tossed four quality starts in its last six weekend games, including two apiece by Carter Holt and Will Nash.
- A-State enters the weekend leading the Sun Belt in home runs per game and runs per game, while being second in on-base percentage and runs scored. **MORE ON PAGE 7.**
- Drew Tipton is rising up the Arkansas State career charts in multiple categories. Tipton also ranks inside the top 50 among the NCAA's active career leaders in multiple statistics. **MORE ON PAGE 7.**

- Arkansas State took the nation's ninth-ranked team to the brink on Tuesday night, battling back from an 11-2 deficit to cut it to one with an eight-run sixth, but dropped a 15-12 at No. 9 Ole Miss.

SERIES HISTORY

Georgia Southern leads 11-5

- In the all-time series versus Georgia Southern dating back to 2015 when the Eagles joined the Sun Belt Conference, A-State trails 5-11.
- The Eagles are riding a five-game winning streak entering the weekend, having won six of the last seven and eight of the last 10.
- In games played in Jonesboro, A-State is 2-4 in a pair of series. The Red Wolves' last win over Georgia Southern actually occurred in Jonesboro, taking a 6-5 win in 10 innings on May 11, 2018.

KNOW THE FOE: GEORGIA SOUTHERN

- Georgia Southern enters the weekend series at 27-16 overall and 11-7 in Sun Belt Conference action. The Eagles boast a league most in wins, while sitting a game back of South Alabama for the top spot in the Sun Belt East.
- Mason McWhorter leads the Eagles in hitting (.404), which is just two-thousandths of a point (.4035) behind A-State's Liam Hicks (.4037) at the top of the league. McWhorter either leads or ties for the league-lead in hits (69), hits per game (1.60), doubles (15), home runs (13), runs (40), slugging (.731). His 125 total bases also leads the NCAA, while he is second in the league in RBI behind A-State's Tyler Duncan. Noah Ledford also owns 11 homers, ranking third in the conference.
- As a team, the Eagles lead the Sun Belt in hitting (.297), slugging (.458), on-base percentage (.379), runs scored (272), hits (439), RBI (244), doubles (86) and triples (13), while ranking second in home runs (43).
- On the mound, Georgia Southern boasts one of the top closers in the nation in Nick Jones, who is tied for the NCAA lead with 13 saves. Jones was recently named to the NCBWA Midseason Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- The Eagles rank third in team ERA (4.03) while leading the league in strikeouts (443) as well as strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.10).

LAST 5 GAMES

- Arkansas State has gone 4-1 in its last five games, with four straight wins until dropping an exciting 15-12 decision at No. 9 Ole Miss. The Red Wolves are hitting .345 with 12 homers and 17 doubles for a .619 slugging percentage. Liam Hicks is leading the way with a .524 (11-for-21) average with three home runs and nine runs driven in, along with a 1.095 slugging mark and on-base percentage of .571. Tyler Duncan leads with 10 RBI and a .440 clip while Jake Gish is slugging 1.167 in limited action.
- A-State is averaging over 11 runs in those games on over 13 hits.
- On the mound, the Red Wolves are holding opponents to a .272 average with a 4.70 ERA. Will Nash and Carter Holt own quality starts during that stretch, two by Holt.

LIAM *STIX*

- Liam Hicks is back in the Arkansas State lineup after being sidelined for eight games due to injury. He was leading the team in hitting with a .370 clip before going down, but came back in a big way at Illinois State.
- Hicks hit .500 (6-12), reaching base 10 times in 16 plate appearances in the series in Normal.
- He owns a team and Sun Belt-best on-base percentage of .524, reaching base in 44 of 45 games to start his A-State career - 31 straight before not reaching on 4/10 at Louisiana.
- The Toronto native ranks near the top in several offensive categories in the Sun Belt and is inside the top 20 in on-base percentage (ninth) and hitting (18th), as well as inside the top 40 in hits per game (32nd) and toughest to strike out (32nd - K every 10.9 plate appearances).
- Since April 1 (18 games), Hicks is hitting .400 and slugging .671 with seven doubles and four home runs.
- On April 14, Hicks was named No. 23 on D1 Baseball's Top 100 Draft-Eligible Hitters using analytics - the highest-ranked of four Sun Belt hitters. The list evaluated on a scale of 50-100 hitters' plate discipline (Hicks: 90.01), hit ability (ability to hit/get on base: 88.80) and game power (XBH; power in-game: 77.26).

*HOLT*ING IT DOWN

- Carter Holt has been strong on the mound for Arkansas State on Sundays, tossing three straight quality starts for the Red Wolves.
- In his last six starts, the Red Wolves are 6-0, while Holt owns a 3.38 ERA and a 3-0 record. Holt has pitched 32.0 innings, allowing 12 earned runs while striking out 20 and walking nine.

DUNCAN AT THE DISH

- Tyler Duncan has had a strong start to the season at the plate for Arkansas State. The senior ranks inside the top 10 in the Sun Belt Conference in six categories and is among the top 50 in the NCAA in RBI (44th - 42) and RBI per game (36th - 1.17). **A full look at where he ranks in the league and nationally is below.**
- The Sooke, British Columbia, native is on pace to put up career-best numbers that surpass his first two seasons in Jonesboro. His 8 homers has surpassed his previous two years' total, while his 10 doubles is nearing the 12 he tallied in 2019 and 2020. Duncan is also slugging at a .567 clip, while his average (.327) is currently a career best. Pretty good, eh?

"HIT DINGERS"

- Tyler Duncan owns the team lead in home runs with eight round-trippers so far this season after his homer at Austin Peay last Saturday, with Drew Tipton second on the squad with seven dingers.
- Both Tipton (14) and Duncan (13) are among the top active leaders in homers on the team, behind Deshazier (16).
- A-State has homered in 25 of its 37 games this season. The Red Wolves have homered twice or more in 10 games.
- A-State belted four homers for the second time this season on Tuesday at Ole Miss, and just the sixth game with four or more homers since before 2005.
- The Red Wolves are averaging over a home run per game and are well on-pace to surpass its 2019 total of 47.

"THE ELDER STATESMAN"

► Drew Tipton is the longest-serving active A-State player on the 2021 roster, having been on the team since the 2016 season. He is also rising up the career charts in several categories: games started (6th* - 197), at-bats (7th - 719), runs scored (2nd - 159), walks (5th - 110), hit-by-pitch (T4th - 40), stolen bases (5th - 57). **FULL LIST OF TIPTON'S CAREER RANKS ON PAGE 7.**

► Tipton is among the top 50 in the NCAA's active career leaders in five categories entering Friday - **runs scored (12th - 159), stolen bases (22nd - 57), hit-by-pitch (22nd - 40), walks (25th - 110), games played (47th - 204) and hits (105th-185).**

► The Bryant, Arkansas, native redshirted in 2016, but has been a member of the program during a stretch that spans three different U.S. Presidents (2016 - Obama; 2017-2020 - Trump; 2021 - Biden).

B-HUD TAKING ADVANTAGE OF STARTING OPPORTUNITY

► Brandon Hudson earned a victory in his first career start on March 23 versus Murray State, and that performance was good enough for him to earn his first career Sun Belt Conference start on April 1 versus in-state rival Little Rock.

► Hudson tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start, allowing one hit. The Roland, Arkansas, native struck out three and walked a pair to earn the victory. In his second start, on April 1 versus Little Rock, Hudson delivered another gem. He tossed a career-high 6.0 innings and limited the Trojans to two runs on four hits.

► In his four Sun Belt Conference starts, Hudson has pitched a pair of quality starts after doing so on April 16 versus UT Arlington.

BEN *KLUTCH*

► Ben Klutts has been on a tear at the plate since April 1, after starting the season with a .227 average through the team's first 18 games.

► Since April 1 (18 games), Klutts is hitting .392 with a team-high 29 hits, two homers, 11 RBI and a slugging percentage of .568. He's also tied with Liam Hicks for the team lead in doubles with 7 during that stretch.

"MY SACRIFICE"

► Blake McCutchen is known to lay down the bunt here and there to move runners over. The Cabot, Arkansas, native ranks sixth in the Sun Belt and 44th in the NCAA with six sac bunts. He averages 0.19 sac bunts per game, which ranks sixth in the league and 50th nationally.

"DOUBLE VISION"

► Ben Klutts ranks tied for sixth in the Sun Belt with 13 doubles on the year - second with 0.35 doubles per game. Drew Tipton is the team's active career leader with 38.

► Arkansas State enters Tuesday's outing ranked third in the Sun Belt Conference in doubles per game, averaging 1.89.

"WALK THE LINE"

► The late, great Arkansas native Johnny Cash's hit song has played often after Drew Tipton trots 90 feet to first after four balls this season. The senior has drawn 30 walks so far this season, which leads the conference and is inside the top 60 nationally.

► The Bryant, Arkansas, native enters the weekend fifth in program history in career bases on balls (110).

"DON'T RUB IT!"

► While we're on the subject of free passes drawn, Ben Klutts and Tipton are among the nation's leaders in hit-by-pitches. Klutts leads the team, having been hit 13 times which ranks second in the Sun Belt and stands 26th nationally. Tipton has been plunked 12 times, which is fourth in the conference and is 38th in the NCAA. He is also tied for fourth all-time with 40 HBPs.

► Liam Hicks has also jumped into the top 10 in the league in HBP per game, ranking seventh (0.28).

"STONE COLD"

► No, not Steve Austin. This note's about Arkansas State senior closer Kollin Stone.

► The former Riverside Rebel from Lake City, Arkansas, is rising atop the charts in career saves after perfect inning versus UTA. Stone is currently tied for third in career saves in program history, matching Tim Egart (2006-07) and Blake Ring (2003-05) with 11. He needs one to tie current Major Leaguer Tyler Zuber for second all-time with 12. **FULL LIST ON PAGE 5**

- ▶ Arkansas State's baseball team is full of homegrown talent from the state of Arkansas, with a handful hailing from the Northeast Arkansas region.
- ▶ A total of 21 Red Wolves come from the Natural State, with three being Craighead County natives: Sam Fagan (Jonesboro), Kollin Stone (Lake City) and Jake Algee (Brookland).

0 CANADA!

- ▶ Three Arkansas State players call Canada their home and native land, as Tyler Duncan (Sooke, British Columbia), Andrew Leggo (Waterloo, Ontario) and Liam Hicks (Toronto, Ontario) all hail from the Great White North.
- ▶ ULM ties the Red Wolves for the league lead with three Canadians, while Louisiana and Little Rock have one on their rosters.

ROAD WARRIORS

- ▶ Arkansas State has been on the road more than a lot of college baseball teams this season.
- ▶ Out of the 37 total games played, 26 so far have been true road games - 70.2 percent of games. Only 13 of the 293 teams that are playing Division I baseball this season have a similar higher percentage. The only team further south than A-State is Texas Southern at 70 percent. North Dakota State has the highest percentage at 82.5 percent.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

- ▶ Arkansas State faces a pretty tough schedule, especially in non-conference play for the 2021 season.
- ▶ After opening at then-No. 1 Ole Miss, A-State faced perennial Missouri Valley Conference contender Missouri State before traveling to Norman, Oklahoma, to face the Sooners.
- ▶ The Red Wolves faced most recently faced off against four-straight top-50 RPI ballclubs in Louisiana (36) and Mississippi State (11), picking up a much-needed win over the Ragin' Cajuns on Sunday.
- ▶ Later this season, the Red Wolves will make another trip to Oxford, as well as a program-first showdown at Arkansas.

WEATHERING THE STORM

- ▶ All but three of A-State's contest to this point have been altered in some form or fashion due to the weather.
- ▶ The Red Wolves' original season opener versus Missouri State was postponed to March 9-10 due to a winter snow storm throughout the Southern U.S.
- ▶ The squad then had to alter its contest at Ole Miss to a day later, due to unplayable field conditions at Swayze Field in Oxford, Miss.
- ▶ A-State had to cancel its Friday contest versus UT Martin (Feb. 26) because of heavy fog. The teams were then forced to play a doubleheader Saturday, Feb. 27. Game two of the twinbill was called after five innings due to heavy rain in Jonesboro.
- ▶ The Red Wolves flipped its contest with Murray State to Johnny Reagan Field due to the threat of inclement weather and unplayable field conditions at Tomlinson Stadium.
- ▶ A-State's series at Oklahoma has also been altered by weather, as forecasted rain on Friday and Saturday changed the schedule to a Sunday double header and Monday contest.

STATE TO THE SHOW

- ▶ A handful of former Arkansas State baseball players are playing in professional baseball currently.
- ▶ Tyler Zuber is currently on the active roster with the Kansas City Royals.
- ▶ The minor league season is set to start Tuesday, with Kyle MacDonald set to open his 2021 season with the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades in the Yankees' farm system.
- ▶ A-State volunteer assistant Zach George is preparing to continue his career, having most recently left Jonesboro for Fargo, North Dakota. There, he'll resume play with the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks of the American Association of Professional Baseball.

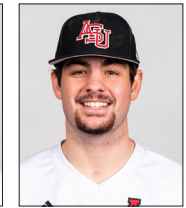

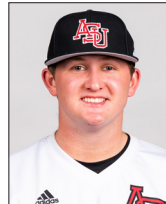
