

- ▶ Arkansas State and Troy meet for the 27th time in program history on Saturday, with the Red Wolves owning a slight 14-12 lead in the series. However, the Trojans have won nine straight, dating back to March 11, 2016.
- ▶ The teams met twice in 2019-20, with Troy taking both contests - 79-64 in Troy and 91-81 in Jonesboro.

THE OPENING TIP

- ▶ Arkansas State looks to return to winning form on Saturday, closing out its Alabama road swing at reigning conference champion Troy. The game will be broadcasted live on ESPN+ and can be heard on the EAB Red Wolves Sports Network flagship station KNEA 95.3/96.9 The Ticket/970 AM. The 2021-22 campaign marks the 31st season in the Sun Belt Conference for Arkansas State.
- ▶ The 2021-22 campaign marks the program's 48th season, with the Red Wolves amassing a 768-594 all-time record (.564) dating back to the inaugural 1974-75 season. A-State is the active winningest program among current Sun Belt Conference members.

ABOUT THE TROJANS

- ▶ Troy enters Saturday's contest at 13-7 overall (4-2 SBC) after dropping a 68-66 decision to the Sun Belt's original Trojans from the Natural State (which had the nickname Trojans since before WWII). The Trojans were led by **Jasmine Robinson's** 16 points, while **Felmas Koranga** had 12 points and 9 rebounds. Little Rock forced Troy into 20 turnovers.
- ▶ The Trojans enter Saturday as the nation's top team in several categories, including free throws attempted (475), free throws made (375), offensive rebounds per game (18.1) and total rebounds (990). Troy also sits fourth in the nation in steals (215) and defensive rebounds per game (31.4), while being second in rebounds per game (49.50).
- ▶ **Jhileiya Dunlap** tops the Sun Belt Conference in blocked shots (43), ranking eighth nationally. **Felmas Koranga**, a preseason All-Sun Belt selection, leads the league with seven double-doubles. Koranga is also the conference's top rebounder (192), ranking 10th in the NCAA. **Tiyah Johnson**, another preseason All-SBC pick, leads the conference in 3-pointers attempted (92) and made (35).

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Arkansas State's three-game winning streak came to a halt on Thursday, as the Red Wolves dropped a 73-65 decision at South Alabama. Playing without leading scorer **Keya Patton**, A-State struggled from deep, making just one trey on 16 attempts, but managed to cut a double-digit deficit down to one score late.
- ▶ **Jireh Washington** led the way with a career-tying 25 points, while **Morgan Wallace** joined the 1,000-Point Club with 11 points and 14 rebounds. **Trinitee Jackson** also recorded a double-double, grabbing 14 boards to go along with 10 points on the night.

AN ARKANSAS STATE WIN WOULD . . .

- ▶ Improve Arkansas State's record to 11-8 and match 2019-20's win total.
- ▶ Move A-State to 4-2 in Sun Belt Conference play and match last season's conference win total.
- ▶ Halt a nine-game losing streak to Troy.
- ▶ Be better than a loss.

PATTON POWER

- ▶ Arkansas State newcomer **Keya Patton** has provided an instant impact in the lineup.
- ▶ The Indianapolis, Ind., native most recently stole the show with 30 points in the first half (!) against ULM on Saturday and rightly being named the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week on Jan. 11. She is the only player in Division I to score 30 or more points in a single half and one of just six players in the conference to tally 30 or more points in a game this year.
- ▶ The Auburn transfer is A-State's leading scorer (14.3) entering Saturday's contest, while ranking second in the conference in field-goal percentage (51.4%). Patton did not play on Thursday (game-time decision), so hopefully can help the Red Wolves return to its high-scoring form against the Trojans.
- ▶ Patton has scored 10 or more points in 12 of her 15 games played this season, with her 30-point performance versus App the first by an A-State player since Dec. 20, 2016 (Jada Ford vs. Northern Kentucky).

CHASING 1K

- ▶ A pair of Arkansas State guards have a chance to join the 1,000-point club this season in **Jireh Washington** and **Morgan Wallace**. Both players could even eclipse the mark this weekend.
- ▶ Wallace is the team's active career leader in scoring with 1,008 points, becoming the 25th player in program history to score 1,000 points in a career. Meanwhile, Washington is close behind at 996 points after Thursday's 25-point outing - just **FOUR** points shy. There are 25 players in program history who have scored 1,000 points or more and Wallace is just the eighth player in program history to score 1,000 points and grab 700 rebounds in a career.
- ▶ Should both players succeed this season, it will mark just the SIXTH time an A-State team had 2 or more 1,000-point scorers on the same team (1986-87; 1991-92; 1992-93; 2005-06; 2015-16).

ON THIS DAY - JANUARY 22

- ▶ Since the 1991-92 season (first season in SBC), Arkansas State has played eight times on January 22, owning a 6-2 ledger.
- ▶ Last season, A-State dropped a tough 67-65 overtime contest at home to Louisiana.
- ▶ **1905:** "Bloody Sunday," marking the beginning of the Russian Revolution.
- ▶ **1945:** The first commercial TV station west of the Mississippi River opens in Hollywood, California.
- ▶ **1969:** Roy Campanella and Stan Musial elected to the baseball Hall of Fame... and not unanimous because, well, baseball voters...

"THE ZOOM WHERE IT HAPPENS"

- ▶ Aaron Burr wanted to be in the "Room Where It Happens," but it's also a big deal to be in the ZOOM where it happens... Arkansas State women's basketball began weekly Zoom media conferences at the beginning of league play, and it has set the tone for the last couple of contests.
- ▶ In each of the last three Zooms, Interim Head Coach **Destinee Rogers** has called out individual players who need to have a big game in her past two zooms. That message seems to have gotten across well, as both players absolutely have gone off in the last three games.
- ▶ On Jan. 3, Rogers called out both **Keya Patton** and **Trintee Jackson** by name, and both responded well, with Patton scoring 30 points and earning Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week honors while Jackson notched a double-double with 16 points and 10 boards.
- ▶ Last Tuesday (Jan. 10), Rogers said that **Jireh Washington** and **Morgan Wallace** needed to step up. And step up they did, to the tune of 25 points and a double-double of 16 points and 10 rebounds, respectively, against Appalachian State on Thursday.
- ▶ This Tuesday, Rogers challenged freshman guards **Jade Upshaw** and **Lauryn Pendleton** to step up their game this weekend against South Alabama and Troy.

"IT MUST BE NICE TO HAVE WASHINGTON ON YOUR SIDE"

- ▶ It's definitely nice to have an All-Sun Belt Conference performer like **Jireh Washington**. Despite missing the last 11 games of last season, she still earned a preseason Second Team nod.
- ▶ Washington has started to return to form after recovering from a season-ending injury last year. The junior missed the first three games of the year but put together a career-best performance on Thursday, scoring 25 points against Appalachian State, going a perfect 7-for-7 at the free-throw line.
- ▶ Washington has actually scored 25 in two of the last three games after dropping 25 against South Alabama on Thursday, where she went 9 of 11 from the free-throw line.

ROGERS TAKES OVER AS INTERIM HEAD COACH

- ▶ **Destinee Rogers** has stepped in as the program's interim head coach for the remainder of the regular season after the sudden resignation by now-former head coach Matt Daniel on Monday night. Rogers was tapped as interim on Dec. 14 prior to A-State's 81-47 wallop of MVSU.
- ▶ The win over the Delta Devils wasn't just her first career win as a collegiate head coach, however. Rogers made Arkansas State Athletics history as the first African-American woman to not only lead an A-State program but also to win a game in that capacity.
- ▶ Rogers has been on staff at A-State since 2019-20, being promoted to Associate Head Coach prior to last year.

ANOTHER TRIP AROUND THE SUN

- ▶ Arkansas State is in its 31st season of Sun Belt Conference play and looks to continue its success against league foes, owning a 239-129 (.649) all-time mark against current conference members. A-State joined the league prior to the 1991-92 season, owning a 267-213 (.556) all-time mark in league play entering Saturday.

TRINITEE'S TRANSFORMATION

- ▶ Forward **Trintee Jackson** has been one of the most improved players in the Sun Belt Conference over the past two seasons in multiple areas, including upping her minutes played per game from 6.8 in 2019-20 to 15.4 a season ago. Because of that, Jackson went from averaging just 3.0 points and 2.9 rebounds to becoming a key impact performer who averaged 7.9 points and 5.0 rebounds while shooting 48.0 percent from the floor.
- ▶ That has continued into this season, where she is averaging the most minutes of her career (22.1), and as a result, becoming a force in the post in the Sun Belt Conference. Jackson leads the Sun Belt with 4.1 offensive rebounds per game (13th in NCAA), while ranking second in total rebounds (156) and rebounds per game (9.2). When she's not scoring or attacking the glass, she's getting to the foul line, attempting a league-leading 94 free throws entering Saturday. In conference games, Jackson is tied with **Morgan Wallace** for second in the conference at 10.2 boards per game, while also averaging 12.0 points in league action.
- ▶ Jackson owns eight career double-doubles, but six of them have come this season, which is second-most in the league.

HISTORY MADE

- ▶ After taking over as interim head coach prior to A-State's contest on Dec. 14 against Mississippi Valley State, **Destinee Rogers** made history with the 81-47 victory.
- ▶ Rogers' win marked the first win in Arkansas State athletics history by an African-American woman. That milestone drew attention from other coaches on the national stage, with South Carolina head coach Dawn Staley sending a video message to Rogers as well as a piece of her championship net (**Rogers got the net on Tuesday**). Hall-of-Famer Sherri Coale also reached out to Rogers to provide encouragement and insight.

NEW YEARS RESOLUTIONS

- ▶ January is normally a month in which many people (attempt to) set the tone of the new year... often, unfortunately, giving up on it within the first three weeks or so. However, Arkansas State has traditionally fared well right after the turn of the calendar.
- ▶ Since the 1991-92 season (first season in the Sun Belt), A-State is 157-92 (.631) in the month of January, including 24 seasons with a .500 or better mark in the month. The Scarlet and Black has gone undefeated twice during that stretch, going 9-0 in both 1996-97 and 2015-16.

"I WANNA GO FAST!"

- ▶ Just like racing legend Ricky Bobby, Arkansas State wants to go fast. They have played a fast brand of basketball early on this season, and it's showing both on the scoreboard and in the advanced metrics.
- ▶ According to HerHoopStats.com, the Red Wolves rank 10th nationally (out of 356 teams) in possessions per 40 minutes ("Pace"), averaging 77.8 possessions per 40 minutes against Division I foes. A-State's 78.2 points per game against D1 opposition is also inside the top 15 in HHS's rankings (12th as of Jan. 21).
- ▶ In conference play, A-State is even faster through five games... The Red Wolves top in the league in conference-play scoring (83.4) and are second in pace (79.2 possessions/40 min.) as of Friday.

ALL GAS, NO BRAKES

- ▶ Speaking of scoring, Arkansas State has picked up the pace scoring-wise over the last several games. Already having scored 70-plus in seven straight games and in eight of the last nine before scoring just 65 on Thursday at South Alabama.
- ▶ The Red Wolves scored 80-plus in three straight conference games for the first time since January-February, 2000 (4 in a row versus New Orleans, South Alabama, Louisiana, & Little Rock).

GRAB THE WINDEX!

- ▶ Arkansas State has two of the top rebounders in the Sun Belt Conference this season in **Trinitee Jackson** and **Morgan Wallace**.
- ▶ Jackson has done a nice job cleaning up the glass, leading the team and ranking second in the Sun Belt with 156 boards. She is tops in the conference on the offensive glass, grabbing 4.1 offensive boards per game (70 total). Wallace is second on the squad with 145 rebounds, but is also moving up the career charts in A-State history, ranking seventh all-time in career boards (725). Wallace is just the ninth player in school history with 700 or more rebounds and the eighth with 700 boards and 1,000 points. **MORE ON PAGE 9.**

"YOUNG, SCRAPPY & HUNGRY"

- ▶ Arkansas State has one of the top freshmen in the country in rookie **Lauryn Pendleton**. The Little Rock native was included in Howard Megdal's list of the freshmen who might be the next big names in women's college basketball on FiveThirtyEight.com.

THREE'S A CROWD, FOUR'S A PARTY

- ▶ Arkansas State has had three or more players record double-digit scoring in all 18 games this season.
- ▶ Dating back to the 2012-13 season, A-State is 110-64 (.632) when three or more players score 10 or more points.
- ▶ In its win over Appalachian State on Jan. 13, all five starters scored 10 or more points for the first time since **Feb. 7, 2019, versus South Alabama**.

GETTING TO THE LINE

- ▶ Arkansas State is among the nation's best at getting the free-throw line this season, ranking second nationally (behind Saturday's foe) with 400 free-throw attempts and third with 283 made free throws, both of which rank second in the Sun Belt.
- ▶ Individually, **Trinitee Jackson** and **Morgan Wallace** top the Sun Belt in free-throw attempts and makes, respectively. Jackson has attempted 94 foul shots, which is top 30 in Division I while Wallace has made 74 of her 90 attempts, which is 36th most nationally. Wallace is also second in the conference in free-throw percentage, at 82.2 percent.
- ▶ Wallace is also climbing up the career charts in free throws made, entering Saturday ranked sixth all-time at A-State in the area with 343 makes at the charity stripe. She ranks inside the top 40 among active Division I players in both free throw attempts (30th - 484) and makes (35th - 343).

TAKE IT TO THE BANK!

- ▶ Arkansas State is in its 35th season inside First National Bank Arena, formerly the Convocation Center (aka "The Convo"), owning a 338-120 (.738) ledger.
- ▶ A-State has posted four straight seasons above .500 at "The Bank," and just two sub-.500 marks in 34 seasons. The Red Wolves are 8-2 this season in the friendly confines. With just three home games left in the regular season, A-State has clinched a winning record in the building for the fifth year in a row.

"A LITTLE HELP FROM MY FRIENDS"

- ▶ Arkansas State played incredibly unselfish basketball in its season-opening win over Central Baptist College, handing out 18 assists to 26 made field goals for a ~nice~ 69.2 assist percentage. A-State then recorded a 61.5 percent assist percentage (24 assists/39 field goals) versus McNeese on 11/15.
- ▶ In its win over McNeese on 11/15, A-State handed out 24 assists. A-State has posted back-to-back 20-assist outings, delivering 20 assists on 28 field goals against MVSU on Dec. 15 for a season-best rate of 71.4 percent before handing out a season-high 27 on 40 made buckets versus Hendrix on Dec. 19 (67.5 percent).
- ▶ Most recently, the Scarlet and Black delivered 23 assists on 34 made field goals in its win over ULM (Jan. 8), for a mark of 67.6 percent. On Saturday, the Red Wolves dished out 19 dimes on 27 buckets (70.4 percent).
- ▶ Arkansas State has handed out 15 or more assists in eight games so far this season, surpassing last season's total (6).

TAKE IT AWAY

- ▶ Last season, A-State forced 16 or more turnovers in 11 games, including 20 or more in five games. The Red Wolves forced double-digit turnovers in all but two games.
- ▶ A-State got off to a strong start this season, having forced 15 or more takeaways in 14 of its 18 outings, including 20 or more five times. In its win over Ozarks (11/23), the Red Wolves forced 31 turnovers - the most by an A-State team since Nov. 12, 2010 (32 vs Texas A&M-Corpus Christi).
- ▶ Going back to the start of the 2019-20 season, Arkansas State has forced double-digit turnovers in all but four games including 19 games with 20 or more.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

- ▶ ... find out what it means to me ...
- ▶ Arkansas State junior guard **Jireh Washington** received some preseason hype from the Sun Belt Conference coaches, being tabbed a preseason Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference member.
- ▶ The Memphis native received Third Team honors after a strong 2019-20 season and was on track to another award-winning season before her year was cut short to injury after 11 games.

RED WOLVES PICKED 10TH IN PRESEASON

- ▶ In the preseason coaches poll, however, the Red Wolves did not receive as much hype, being picked to finish 10th in the Sun Belt Conference.
- ▶ The league moved back to a 1-12 standings format after being in a divisional-only schedule in 2020-21 due to COVID-19. Teams will play a similar schedule this season, facing "division" foes twice and cross-divisional opponents once.

GRAND THEFT BASKETBALL

- ▶ Thievery is not tolerated, but on the basketball court, it's encouraged.
- ▶ A-State swiped 25 steals in its over the University of the Ozarks, the second most in school history. It was just the sixth time ever the Red Wolves had recorded 20 or more steals in a contest and the second time over 25. The last time that happened? Nov. 21, 1991, when the Scarlet and Black swiped a program-record 28 at Northeast Louisiana.

COVID CANCELLATIONS

- ▶ With the rise of the Omicron variant, COVID-19 is rearing its highly-contagious head yet again, and Arkansas State has had to wait longer than expected to open up its home league slate. Back-to-back home outings versus Georgia State (Jan. 1) and Louisiana (Jan. 6) were canceled due to COVID-19 concerns with those programs.
- ▶ The Sun Belt policy states games that cannot be played due to COVID-19 will be canceled and considered a no-contest and will not be rescheduled. The minimum threshold required to compete is seven (7) student-athletes (scholarship or non-scholarship), plus one full-time coach. If a team meets that minimum threshold, they are required to play. Teams may choose to play with less than the minimum threshold.
- ▶ Seeding in the Sun Belt Championship will be based on overall conference winning percentage. However, teams will be required to play a minimum of 80% of the average number of conference games played in order to use their overall conference winning percentage for seeding in the conference championship. Teams falling below the 80% threshold will be seeded at the bottom of the championship bracket with overall conference winning percentage, among the teams that fall below the threshold, being used to determine their seed for the tournament.

NEW VOICE ON THE MIC

- ▶ Fans will hear a new voice on the radio when Arkansas State takes the court this season, as Cade Carlton begins his first season as the play-by-play announce for the Red Wolves women's basketball team.
- ▶ Carlton, a 2021 A-State alumnus, takes over for longtime voice Keith Merritt.

JONESBORO, Ark. – Junior guard Morgan Wallace posted her eighth career double-double to help the Arkansas State women's basketball team take a one-point lead into the fourth period against Sun Belt Conference regular-season champion Troy, but the Trojans were able to pull away over the final 10 minutes for a 91-81 victory Saturday at First National Bank Arena.

A-State (11-18, 8-10) was led by three players scoring in double figures, including Wallace with a team-high 16 points to go along with a career-high-tying 15 rebounds. Sophomore guard Jireh Washington and junior forward Peyton Martin added 14 and 12 points, respectively, for the Red Wolves.

Despite the setback, A-State actually posted a .400 field goal percentage to the Trojans .366 mark. However, Troy (25-4, 16-2) took 12 more shots thanks in part to 24 offensive rebounds it turned into 26 second-chance points. The Trojans held a 59-46 overall advantage on the boards and also committed five fewer turnovers on the day.

The game featured seven ties and 10 lead changes before Troy took the advantage for good in the fourth period. A-State limited Troy to no better than a 31.8 field goal percent in each of the first three periods, but the Trojans connected on 58 percent of their shots over the final 10 minutes.

The Red Wolves led for nearly 16 of the game's first 30 minutes and staked claim to a narrow 62-61 advantage after three periods of action, but Troy struck first in the fourth and wouldn't trail again.

Martin connected on a jumper in the paint to tie the score at 65-65 with 8:31 remaining before the Trojans responded with a 12-1 run over the next to four minutes to take a 77-66 lead. A-State was unable to get closer than seven points the rest of the way.

Although A-State scored the game's first 10 points, it led just 25-24 at the end of the first period. Troy was able to take a 42-41 advantage into the locker room. The Red Wolves overtook the Trojans in the third, building an eight-point lead, 60-52, with 2:14 left in the period. However, the visitors closed the period with a 9-2 run to take the momentum heading into the final period.




