



ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES

Arkansas State vs ULM | October 1, 2022 | Centennial Bank Stadium

TEAM:

- Senior QB **James Blackman**, senior RB **Johnnie Lang**, junior CB **Samy Johnson** and sophomore safety **Justin Parks** were A-State team captains and represented the Red Wolves at midfield for the coin toss.
- Sophomore LB **Cam Jeffery** made his first career start ... He was one of 10 underclassmen (Fr./So.) to start today's game for the Red Wolves. A-State has started at least seven underclassmen in every game this season.

OFFENSE:

- Senior RB **Johnnie Lang** became the first A-State player to post a receiving and rushing TD in the same game since Marcel Murray and Warren Wand against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 10, 2018 ... Lang recorded his second receiving TD this season and third of his career. Adding a kickoff return touchdown, Lang becomes the third player in Sun Belt Conference history (since 2000) to have a rushing, receiving and kickoff return touchdown in the same game, first since T.Y. Hilton (FIU) did so against ULM in 2010. He is the 15th FBS player in that span to accomplish the rushing, receiving and kickoff touchdown in the same game.
- Senior QB **James Blackman** threw multiple TD passes in a game for the third time this season and 18th time of his career. He has connected with eight or more receivers in each game this season.
- Junior RB **Brian Snead** posted a season-high 74 rushing yards and his fifth and sixth rushing TDs of the season. It marked his second game this season with multiple rushing scores.
- Senior WR **Te'Vailance Hunt** recorded his first receiving TD of the season and eighth of his career, seventh with the Red Wolves.
- Arkansas State's 45 points were its most against a Sun Belt Conference opponent since defeating ULM 48-15 on Dec. 5, 2020.

DEFENSE:

- Arkansas State limited ULM to 290 total yards, fewest against a Sun Belt Conference opponent since Texas State had 227 on Oct. 26, 2019.
- Redshirt freshman DE **Dennard Flowers** posted a sack for the third consecutive game. He is the first player to log a sack in three consecutive games since Dajon Emory did so over the final three games of the 2018 season.
- Redshirt senior LB **Jordan Carmouche** tied for the team lead with six tackles and added his first career sack while tying his career high with two tackles for loss.

SPECIAL TEAMS:

- True freshman kicker **Dominic Zvada** converted his only field goal, which covered 46 yards. He is now 7-of-7 on the season, including 3-of-3 from 45-plus yards. His three made field goals from 45-plus are the most by an A-State kicker in a season since Bobby Zalud (5-of-8) in 2011.
- Senior RB **Johnnie Lang** posted a 98-yard kickoff return for a TD, the first kickoff return for a score by an A-State player since Alan Lamar against South Alabama last season ... It was also the first at home since Kirk Merritt vs Georgia Southern on Nov. 23, 2019.
