

# ARKANSAS STATE POSTGAME NOTES Arkansas State vs Old Dominion | September 24, 2022 | S.B. Ballard Stadium

#### TEAM:

- Senior QB James Blackman, senior RB Johnnie Lang, junior DL TW Ayers and sophomore OL Ethan Miner were A-State team captains and represented the Red Wolves at midfield for the coin toss.
- Soph. WRs **Reagan Ealy** and **Adam Jones**, along with redshirt freshman OL **Noah Smith**, made their first career starts.

#### **OFFENSE:**

- Junior RB **Brian Snead** recorded his fourth rushing touchdown of the season. He has posted at least one running score in each of his three games played this year.
- Junior WR **Jeff Foreman** posted four receptions for 115 yards and a TD all season highs. Foreman posted the fourth 100-yard receiving game of his career. A-State has now had a wide receiver post at least 100 yards in four consecutive games for the first time since at least 2000.
- Senior QB **James Blackman** passed for over 200 yards and at least one TD for the third time in four games this season. He completed his fifth TD pass of the season.
- Junior QB **AJ Mayer** posted his second rushing TD of the season and led A-State with seven rushes for 46 yards.

### **DEFENSE:**

- Arkansas State held an FBS opponent scoreless for an entire half for the first time since taking a 6-0 lead into the locker room at halftime against Louisiana on Nov. 7, 2020.
- Sophomore DL **Ethan Hassler** posted his first career sack, while RS Fr. **Dennard Flowers** posted the second of his career.
- Redshirt-senior LB Jordan Carmouche led A-State with 10 tackles, his second consecutive outing with double figure stops.

## **SPECIAL TEAMS:**

- Sophomore P **Ryan Hanson** recorded a season-high three punts inside the opponent's 20 yard line. Dating back to last season, he has at least one in each of the last four games that he has attempted a punt.
- True freshman PK **Dominic Zvada** made his only FG attempt of the game, which covered 44 yards. He is now 6-for-6 on his field goal attempts with three of those covering at least 40 yards.
