- WOLF HOWLS**
- » Arkansas State is in its second season under head coach **Bryan Hodgson**, who led the Red Wolves to their first 20-win season and was a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award - presented annually to the nation's top first-year head coach.
 - » A-State opens a three-game home stand on Tuesday, hosting in-state rival and former Sun Belt counterpart Little Rock. The meeting is the 96th all-time contest between the teams - the most-played series in program history.
 - » The Red Wolves dropped a hard-fought 88-79 decision at No. 2 Alabama on Friday night, overcoming a 16-point deficit to tie it at 70 with 7 minutes to play.
 - » KenPom rates A-State's schedule as the toughest in the Sun Belt.
 - » A-State was picked as the overwhelming favorite in the Preseason Sun Belt Conference Coaches Poll, earning 12 of 14 first-place votes and 193 of 196 possible total points.
 - » Redshirt senior F **Kobe Julien** was named the Preseason SBC Player of the Year and earned a First-Team All-SBC nod, while senior G **Taryn Todd** and junior F **Izaiyah Nelson** were tabbed to the second and third teams, respectively.

- » When scoring 40+ points in the paint, the Red Wolves are 12-4 under Hodgson - 1-0 this season.

GREAT EXPECTATIONS

- » Hopes are higher than Mount Magazine for the 2024-25 season in Jonesboro after A-State won 20 games last season and reached the final of the Sun Belt Conference Tournament.
- » The Red Wolves garnered 12 of 14 possible first-place votes in the preseason Sun Belt Conference Coaches Poll to be picked to win the league, while other outlets also have the Scarlet and Black at or near the top of the 'Belt.
- » *Blue Ribbon Report* has forecasted the Red Wolves to win the conference, with **Kobe Julien** tabbed by the outlet as the Player of the Year. Julien also received praise from *Lindy's*, being named the preseason Player of the Year and the "Best NBA Prospect".
- » *Lindy's* also tabbed the Red Wolves as the top squad, while CBS Sports named A-State No. 70 in its Top 100.
- » In *CollegeInsider's* preseason Mid-Major Top-25, A-State came in at 17th.

SAME LEAGUE, NEW SQUAD

- » Redshirt senior **Kobe Julien** is taking the court for Arkansas State this season after transferring from conference counterpart Louisiana in the offseason.
- » The former Ragin' Cajun was picked by the league's coaches as the Preseason Player of the Year after leading the conference in scoring last season (17.3). Not only that, he's the **ONLY** player to return from last year's All-SBC first and second teams.
- » His preseason praise doesn't stop there though, as *Blue Ribbon Report* also tabbed him as the Preseason Player of the Year.
- » Julien made a strong opening-week impression, leading the team in scoring (17.0) with a game-high 20 points at No. 2 Alabama on Friday.

TODD BACK FOR ROUND 2

- » Senior guard **Taryn Todd** returns to Jonesboro for his final season of college basketball after leading Arkansas State in scoring (12.8) a season ago - earning Third Team All-SBC honors.
- » This year, Todd earned Preseason Second Team all-league acclaim to his resume and looks to conclude his collegiate career on a high note.
- » After opening the season with just 7 points vs Akron, he scored 18 on Friday night at No. 2 Alabama.

MAYORAL DUTIES

- » Redshirt senior **Avery Felts** is climbing up the career charts for 3-point shooting, and the “May- or of Bono” is set for his final season of passing legislation from long range.

- » Junior forward **Izaiyah Nelson** was among the most improved players in the Sun Belt last season. He led the Red Wolves in blocks and rebounding, establishing himself as one of the more dominant rim protectors in not only the league, but nationally.
- » The Preseason Third Team All-SBC selection enters this season fourth in school history in career blocks, with his 73 swats last year being third most in program history.

TWO FORDS, ONE GARAGE

- » Junior guard **Derrian Ford** returns as one of the best 3-pointer shooters in the league, making a team-best 64 treys a season ago.
- » Another Ford - **Terrance Ford, Jr.** - is looking to return back to his freshman season form after missing nearly all of last season due to injury. The Chicago native was a 40-percent shooter from the perimeter as a rookie, averaging 10.8 points and 1.3 steals. In his lone extended appearance, he scored 9 points with a 6-for-7 clip at the foul stripe versus Jackson State.
- » Both started in last Monday's season opener, with Derrian scoring 15 and Terrance tallying 7 points and 5 assists.

SHARE THE WEALTH

- » Arkansas State was among the most unselfish squads in the Sun Belt last season, averaging 14.5 assists per game to rank fourth in the league. It also tallied the second-most assists in a single season in school history (536) - the most since 1987-88.
- » The Red Wolves had 15-plus assists in 17 games, including five past 20 dimes. The 17 games with 15 or more helpers was the most since 2021-22 (19).
- » A-State also had a dozen games with an assist percentage of 60 percent or greater.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

- » Points did not come at a premium for Arkansas State in the first year of the Bryan Hodgson era and resulted in a program-record 2,917 points scored.
- » The Red Wolves dropped 85 or more in six league games (90+ in 5 games) to average a conference-leading 81.1 points in SBC play. It was the first time ever an A-State team eclipsed 85 points six or more times since conference affiliation began in 1964-65.
- » The Scarlet and Black also scored 75-plus in 14 of 18 conference games, the most since doing so 14 times in 1997-98.
- » The Red Wolves eclipsed the 90-point threshold seven times this season - the most since 2001-02 (7) - including three 100-point efforts for the first time since 2002-03.

EXPERIENCE ABOUNDS

- » Arkansas State is in small company as one of 18 squads with five or more players in at least their fifth season of college basketball.
- » The Red Wolves have five players who fit the bill: two fifth-years (**Zane Butler & Dyondre Dominguez**), two sixth-years (**Avery Felts** and **Taryn Todd**) and one seventh-year (**Kobe Julien**).

FAST & FURIOUS (& EFFICIENT)

- » Arkansas State's offense was among the fastest in the league last season, averaging nearly 70 possessions per night.
- » Despite that uptick in pace, the Red Wolves boast the league's most efficient offensive unit with a rating of 115.3 in Sun Belt Conference games. Their overall efficiency rating of 113.5 is the program's best in the history of KenPom, dating back to 1999, while the KenPom rank of 133 was the second-best in 25 years.

- » A-State returns eight players from last season's team, including leading scorer Taryn Todd and leading rebounder/shot blocker Izaiyah Nelson. Derrian Ford also returns for his second season, as well as perimeter standouts Dyondre Dominguez, Avery Felts and Zane Butler.
- » Terrance Ford, Jr., is back from injury and looks to assume Fields' mantle as PG, while Jacob St. Clair is back after redshirting his first season.
- » Eight newcomers also grace the roster, including three of the highest-rated signees in program history: Josh Hill, Justin Johnson and R'Chaun King.
- » A-State also picked up four Division-I transfers out of the portal, led by SBC scoring leader Kobe Julien (Louisiana). Rashaud Marshall returned to NEA after a season at Ole Miss, while Joseph Pinion comes to A-State after two years in Fayetteville. Cody Head joined the Red Wolves following a standout rookie campaign at Lipscomb. Out of the JUCO ranks, Kameron Johnson joins younger brother Justin on the squad.

IRON SHARPENS IRON

- » Arkansas State's schedule was tough last year with multiple high-major road tests. This year features more home games, but still a tough slate to prepare for Sun Belt Conference play - and possibly further.
- » In the first two weeks alone, the Red Wolves will face four teams all picked second or better in their respective leagues.
- » As of Monday, A-State's docket is ranked by KenPom as the toughest in the Sun Belt.

FINAL FIVE MINUTES

- » The final five minutes of a game were key for Arkansas State a season ago, and that remained on Monday
- » When leading with five minutes remaining in regulation, the Red Wolves are 21-2 in the Bryan Hodgson era, while going 0-16 when tied or trailing at the under-5 mark.

SECURE THE BANK

- » Home-court advantage is a huge deal, and that is no different for the Red Wolves.
- » Last season, A-State finished the home slate with a 10-3 ledger in the friendly confines and a +9.4 scoring margin. Below is a breakdown of the Red Wolves' statistics at home versus on the road.
- » The Red Wolves totaled 37,746 fans at its 13 home dates for an average of 2,904 - both the most since the 2016-17 season.

HEAD COACH BRYAN HODGSON



Bryan Hodgson, one of the nation's top first-year head coaches in 2023-24, is entering his second season at the helm of the Arkansas State men's basketball program in 2024-25.

Regarded as one of the top recruiters and assistant coaches in the nation with 16-plus seasons as a collegiate coach, Hodgson was announced as the program's 17th head coach on March 22, 2023.

Hodgson - a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award, presented to the nation's top first-year head coach - guided the Red Wolves to one of its most successful seasons in program history in 2023-24. Under his watch, A-State was one of just two programs under a first-year head coach to win 20 or more games over Division-I foes. Hodgson was also one of five first-year coaches to lead their team to 20-plus wins in their inaugural season after inheriting a 20-plus loss team.

A-State ended the year as one of the hottest teams in the country with wins in 12 of the final 16 contests, ending the year in the semifinals of the Ro College Basketball Invitational - the program's first postseason appearance since 1999 that included its first postseason victory since 1991.

After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, the Red Wolves went on to finish fourth in the conference standings and reach the championship game of the conference tournament for the first time since 2007. Hodgson became the first head coach since Chris Beard in 2019 to guide a team to the Sun Belt Conference championship game in their first season.

The Red Wolves broke numerous single-season school records in Hodgson's inaugural year, setting new program-best marks in scoring (2,917 points), field goals made (1,021) and attempted (2,313), 3-pointers made (341) and attempted (991) along with total rebounds (1,419) and offensive rebounds (489). That excitement, combined with a stellar final half of the season, led to A-State hosting its first nationally-televised game since 1997 - a 79-71 victory over Troy on ESPNU.

Hodgson came to Arkansas State after spending the last four seasons at the University of Alabama, which followed stops at the University of Buffalo (2015-19), Midland (Texas) Junior College (2013-15), Jamestown (NY) Community College (2010-13) and Fredonia State (NY) University (2007-10).

Rated as the No. 2 recruiter nationally by 247Sports.com, Hodgson played a vital role in recruiting top-15 classes each of his four seasons in Tuscaloosa. Alabama, the overall No. 1 seed in 2022-23, posted a 92-42 record, and advanced to the Sweet 16 twice in three-straight appearances at the NCAA Tournament since Hodgson joined head coach Nate Oats in Tuscaloosa. In total, Hodgson brought 15-plus seasons of collegiate coaching experience to Jonesboro, including six of the last seven NCAA Tournaments and a combined 15-2 record in Division I conference tournaments.

In his time with the Crimson Tide, Hodgson helped the program claim its first regular season conference title since 2002, first conference tournament title since 1991 and first Sweet 16 appearance since 2004. Four Alabama players have been drafted to the NBA since 2020 after the program had one selection from 1992-2019.

In 2022-23, Hodgson assisted as Alabama was one of only two teams nationally, joining Houston, to rank in the top-15 in both defensive adjusted efficiency (No. 5) and in offensive adjusted efficiency (No. 15) according to KenPom. Alabama, winner of the SEC regular season and SEC Tournament crown, made its ninth NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in program history, its second appearance in the span of three seasons. Two Crimson Tide players - Brandon Miller (2nd, Charlotte Hornets) and Noah Clowney (21st, Brooklyn Nets) - went on to be selected in the first round of the 2023 NBA Draft.

After finishing the 2019-20 season with a 16-16 record and 8-10 mark in SEC play, Alabama finished the 2020-21 campaign ranked No. 5 in the final Associated Press poll, highest in program

history at the time. The Crimson Tide's 26 overall wins were the second-most in school history, while the Sweet 16 appearance in the 2021 NCAA Tournament was the first for Alabama in 17 years. Alabama clinched its first regular season title in 19 years and captured the SEC Tournament title for the first time in 30 years.

Hodgson blazed a trail to Canada as he signed the first Canadian players in Crimson Tide program history - Joshua Primo and Keon Ambrose-Hilton - Canada's No. 1 and No. 3-ranked players, respectively, in 2020. He followed that by getting a third Canadian, Charles Bediako, to Tuscaloosa in 2021. Primo spent the 2020-21 season with Alabama before being selected 12th overall in the 2021 NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

In addition to ranking as one of the top recruiters in collegiate basketball, Hodgson was named to The Athletic's Top-25 up-and-coming coaches and one of the top 50 Most Impactful High Major Assistant Coaches. He was invited to participate in the prestigious 2020 TopConnect Seminar which identifies the top assistants in the country and connects them with mid-major athletic directors. Previously, Hodgson was one of 30 assistant coaches named to the 2016 Under Armour 30-under-30 Team by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Hodgson spent four seasons (2015-19) with Oats at the University of Buffalo, where together they took the program to unprecedented heights. Hodgson helped guide the Bulls to three NCAA Tournament appearances and three Mid-American Conference Tournament championships, while also earning a pair of MAC regular season titles. Buffalo reached the Round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament in 2018 and 2019.

During his time at Buffalo, the Bulls were ranked for 20 weeks in the Associated Press Top-25 throughout the 2018-19 season marking the first time in school history the program had earned a national ranking. Buffalo went on to climb as high as No. 14 in the nation - the highest ranking by any MAC team in the past 40 years.

In the 2018-19 campaign, the Bulls finished with an impressive 32-4 overall record with the 32 victories marking the most in program history and most-ever by a MAC program. Coupled with a 27-9 mark in 2017-18, Buffalo had a combined 59-13 record from 2017-19 setting the best two-year stretch in school history.

In addition to his recruiting prowess, Hodgson is also known for his ability to develop talent. During his four seasons at Buffalo, nearly every player on the roster made tremendous strides on the court, none more so than 2019 MAC Player of the Year CJ Massinburg, who finished his career as a three-time All-MAC honoree and second in school history with 1,990 career points and 273 career treys. He went on to be named an honorable mention All-American by the Associated Press as a senior.

Hodgson served two seasons, one in a volunteer capacity, as an assistant coach at Midland (Texas) College, where he helped lead the team to a six-win turnaround during the 2014-15 season.

A western New York native, Hodgson served as an assistant coach from 2010-13 at Jamestown Community College. In his time at JCC, he coached 14 players who received scholarships to four-year schools after their graduation while nine were all-region players.

Hodgson played collegiately for two seasons at Jamestown CC, serving as a two-year captain, before heading to Fredonia State. While at Fredonia State, he served as an assistant coach and earned his undergraduate degree in sports management in 2011. He later earned his masters degree in education from the University of the Southwest in 2015.

Adopted at the age of two, Hodgson has been an active participant in Big Brothers, Big Sisters Program throughout his career. He is the founder and president of Coaching Love, Inc., established to benefit at-risk youth, particularly those in the foster care system and those waiting to be adopted.

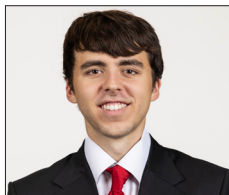
