WOLF HOWLS

- » Arkansas State is in its second season under head coach **Bryan Hodgson**, who led the Red Wolves to their first 20-win season and was a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award - presented annually to the nation's top first-year head coach.
- » A-State is seeking its third straight win - and ninth consecutive home victory - Thursday, hosting former Sun Belt Conference mate UT Arlington.
- » The Red Wolves topped 16th-ranked Memphis on Sunday, 85-72, for their highest-ranked win in program history and the first win over a top-25 opponent since 1991.
- » Redshirt senior **F Kobe Julien** was one of two Sun Belt players (out of 50 total) to be named to the Early-Season Watch List for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the nation's top mid-major college basketball player.
- » A-State ranks 10th nationally in 3-pointers attempted per game, averaging 30.1 tries from downtown.
- » The Red Wolves top the Sun Belt in rebounding (42.20), ranking 18th nationally, while also averaging the most offensive rebounds (14.00) per game to rank 29th in the nation.

- » Arkansas State is in its second season under the leadership of head coach Bryan Hodgson - a finalist for the 2024 Joe B. Hall Award, going to the nation's top first-year head coach.
- » The Red Wolves are taking on old Sun Belt foe UT Arlington in search of their third win in a row after toppling 16th-ranked Memphis on Sunday in front of a national TV audience.
- » Junior guard **Joseph Pinion** was the lead Tiger tamer on Sunday, recording career highs in points (22) and 3-pointers (5) while matching career bests in rebounds (8) and blocks (3) in the starting nod.
- » A-State was picked to win the Sun Belt Conference in this year's preseason coaches poll, earning 12 of 14 possible first-place votes. **Kobe Julien** was tabbed the preseason Player of the Year and First Team All-SBC, while **Taryn Todd** and **Izaiyah Nelson** were named Second and Third Team selections.

- » Improve Arkansas State to 8-3 on the year.
- » Bump A-State's all-time record against UT Arlington to 44-24 - 27-8 in Jonesboro.
- » Move the Red Wolves' winning streak against UTA to three games.
- » Mark a three-game winning streak for A-State.
- » Move the Red Wolves' home winning streak to nine games dating back to a 100-87 win over Ohio on Feb. 10, 2023.
- » Improve A-State's home record in the Bryan Hodgson era to 16-3.
- » Be better than a loss...

KNOW THY FOE

- » Arkansas State faces yet another opponent picked inside the top 2 of its conference on Thursday, facing UT Arlington.
- » The Mavericks, which were picked second in the WAC, are 4-5 on the year. However, they're getting close to full strength with former Kentucky and Villanova Wildcat Lance Ware making his debut. Ware is averaging 14.8 points and 7.3 rebounds in four games this year.
- » A-State and UTA have played 67 times previously, tying for the fifth most-played series in school history. The sides were conference mates in both the Sun Belt and Southland before UTA's exit in 2022.
- » Aside from Ware, Jaden Wells (14.7) and Raysean Seamster (11.9) average in double-figure scoring for UTA. Wells paces the WAC in 3-point percentage (40.8 percent), treys per game (3.22) and 3-pointers made (29) while attempting a league-leading 71 from deep. Brody Robinson tops the WAC in assist/turnover ratio (2.58)
- » UTA shoots 39.4 percent from 3-point range, which ranks 21st nationally, while ranking among the top 50 in adjusted tempo (71.1 possessions per game). They average 25.1 3-pointers attempted per game, the most in the WAC.

- » Arkansas State notched its highest-ranked win in program history, toppling Memphis by its largest margin of victory against the Tigers since 1947.
- » **Joseph Pinion** was one of four double-figure scorers, carding 22 points on five made 3-pointers, along with eight rebounds and three blocks.
- » **Dyondre Dominguez** (19), **Taryn Todd** (17) and **Kobe Julien** (12) joined Pinion in double-digit scoring.
- » The Red Wolves broke a 20-game skid against ranked opponents with the win.
- » A-State forced Memphis into a season-high 20 turnovers while holding it to a season-low 35.6 percent from the field.

BLUFF CITY BEATDOWN

- » Let's talk a little bit more about the Red Wolves' 85-72 win at Memphis on Sunday, shall we?
- » A-State's win was its first in Memphis since March 18, 1991 - a game played in the Mid-South Coliseum.
- » It also marked A-State's first road win against a ranked foe since a 1985 victory at No. 18 Iowa.
- » A-State handed Memphis its first non-conference home loss as a ranked team since Georgia on Jan. 4, 2020, while also becoming the first non-power conference team to beat a ranked Tigers team inside FedExForum since Murray State in 2011.

PINION FROM THE PERIMETER

- » Junior guard **Joseph Pinion** was stellar in his first start at A-State on Sunday at Memphis.
- » Morrilton's finest made his moments count against the Tigers, recording career highs in points (22) and 3-pointers made (5), while matching his career-high totals in rebounding (8) and blocks (3).
- » Pinion enters Thursday leading the Red Wolves from beyond the arc, making 20 from downtown with a 40.8-percent clip. On the year, he's 47.7 percent from the field.

DEFENSIVE DUBS

- » We all know that Arkansas State can score the basketball, but the Red Wolves have won games on defense this year as well.
- » A-State has limited four opponents to 64 points or less: Little Rock (63), Stephen F. Austin (49), Lane College (60) and Jackson State (64). Under Bryan Hodgson, the Red Wolves are 9-0 when limiting their opponent to 64 points or fewer - 4-0 this season.
- » The Red Wolves enter Thursday's game ranked second in the league in field-goal percentage defense (38.6), while ranking 38th nationally in in 3-point field-goal defense (.282).
- » That has reflected in the analytics as well, with A-State ranked among the top 75 nationally on KenPom in defensive efficiency at 99.8 points allowed per 100 possessions. The mark ranks 71st nationally and tops in the Sun Belt. The Red Wolves are also top 30 in effective field-goal percentage defense, allowing a 44.5-percent clip (28th).

TURN IT OVER

- » Staying on the defensive end... Arkansas State has forced double-digit turnovers in nine of its first 10 games to open the season and ranks fifth in the conference in turnover margin (+0.9)
- » In Sunday's win over Memphis, A-State forced a season-high 20 turnovers - the most in the Bryan Hodgson era and most since forcing 24 against Lyon College in 2022. It was the most takeaways against a Division-I foe since 20 against Louisiana on Feb. 5, 2022.

PAINT PARTY

- » Anyone who's watched Arkansas State under Bryan Hodgson knows that the Red Wolves rely heavily on not only shots from the perimeter, but also shots close to the basket.
- » When scoring 40+ points in the paint, the Red Wolves are 13-4 under Hodgson - 2-0 this season after a 42-point output inside last Friday versus Indiana State in The Bahamas.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

- » Arkansas State has been a strong rebounding squad so far in the Bryan Hodgson era, setting a program record for rebounds (1,419) and offensive rebounds (489) last year.
- » This season, A-State is on track to do the same thing, topping the Sun Belt in rebounds per game (42.20) and offensive rebounding (14.00), while ranking second in defensive rebounding (28.20).
- » The Red Wolves enter Thursday having recorded 40-plus rebounds in eight of 10 contests to start the season, including a season-best 51 against Lane.
- » Forward **Rashaud Marshall** leads the Pack on the glass with 72 boards (7.2/game), ranking fourth in the Sun Belt.

WATCH ME, WATCH ME

- » Redshirt senior and Preseason SBC Player of the Year **Kobe Julien** has raked in several preseason and early-season honors so far this season.
- » Julien most recently was one of 50 players - and just two from the Sun Belt - named to the Early-Season Watch List for the Lou Henson Award, presented annually to the top player in mid-major college basketball.
- » He is the first Red Wolf up for the award since Norchad Omier in 2021-22.
- » Julien is currently No. 3 on the Sun Belt's active leading scorers list with 1,259 career points.

JULIEN TO THE LINE...

- » While we're talking about Kobe, he also has a knack for getting to the line.
- » Last season at Louisiana, he made the second-most free throws in the conference (131).
- » This year with the Red Wolves, he has picked up where he left off, ranking eighth with 31 makes from the stripe and sixth with 45 attempts.

TARYN CAN FILL IT UP

- » Senior guard **Taryn Todd** returns to Jonesboro for his final season of college basketball after leading Arkansas State in scoring (12.8) a season ago - earning Third Team All-SBC honors.
- » This year, Todd earned Preseason Second Team all-league acclaim to his resume and looks to conclude his collegiate career on a high note.
- » The Canadian guard once again is among the team's top scorers, averaging a team-high 13.6 points after scoring 17 at Memphis Sunday. He has scored in double figures a team-leading seven times this year.

MAYORAL DUTIES

- » Redshirt senior **Avery Felts** is climbing up the career charts for 3-point shooting, and the "Mayor of Bono" is in his final season of passing legislation from long range.
- » After knocking down three from deep last Thursday night, he moved up to seventh in program history in career triples (172) and needs just three to tie for sixth. His total ranks third among active Sun Belt players entering Thursday.
- » Felts is also climbing up the career games played charts, entering Thursday's game sixth in school history with 126 games played, which is tied for fifth among active Sun Belt players.

- » Junior forward **Izaiyah Nelson** was among the most improved players in the Sun Belt last season. He led the Red Wolves in blocks and rebounding, establishing himself as one of the more dominant rim protectors in not only the league, but nationally.
- » The Preseason Third Team All-SBC selection enters Thursday fourth in school history in career blocks, with his 73 swats last year being third most in program history.
- » A chart displaying his improvement from Year 1 to Year 2 is below.
- » After missing the first five games of the season to injury, Nelson has returned to the floor and recorded season bests in points (14) and re-bounds (9) on Thursday against Jackson State.
- » Nelson enters Thursday with 120 rejections - fourth most in school history and second most among active Sun Belt players.

TWO FORDS, ONE GARAGE

- » Junior guard **Derrian Ford** returns as one of the best 3-pointer shooters in the league, making a team-best 64 treys a season ago. He enters Thursday averaging 10.2 points per contest after scoring in double digits all three games in The Bahamas, including a season-high 18 versus Indiana State.
- » Another Ford of no relation - **Terrance Ford, Jr.** - is looking to return back to his freshman season form after missing nearly all of last season due to injury. The floor general from Chicago has filled the point guard spot well so far, with 29 assists on the year.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

- » Points did not come at a premium for Arkansas State in the first year of the Bryan Hodgson era and resulted in a program-record 2,917 points scored.
- » The Red Wolves dropped 85 or more in six league games (90+ in 5 games) to average a conference-leading 81.1 points in SBC play. It was the first time ever an A-State team eclipsed 85 points six or more times since conference affiliation began in 1964-65.
- » The Scarlet and Black also scored 75-plus in 14 of 18 conference games, the most since doing so 14 times in 1997-98. The Red Wolves eclipsed the 90-point threshold seven times - the most since 2001-02 (7) - including three 100-point efforts for the first time since 2002-03.
- » This year, A-State has scored 80 or more five times, going 5-0, as well as 79 in its lone loss at No. 2 Alabama.

SHARE THE WEALTH

- » Arkansas State was among the most unselfish squads in the Sun Belt last season, averaging 14.5 assists per game to rank fourth in the league. It also tallied the second-most assists in a single season in school history (536) - the most since 1987-88.
- » The Red Wolves had 15-plus assists in 17 games, including five past 20 dimes. The 17 games with 15 or more helpers was the most since 2021-22 (19). This season has featured three games with 15 or more assists.
- » A-State also had a dozen games with an assist percentage of 60 percent or greater. This season, it has three games with that mark.

FAST & FURIOUS (6 EFFICIENT)

- » Arkansas State's offense was among the fastest in the league last season, averaging nearly 70 possessions per night. It also posted the league's highest efficiency rating of 113.5 - the program's best in the history of KenPom (since 1999).
- » This year, that trend of A-State ranking among the league's top teams on offense has continued once again, entering Thursday with an efficiency rating of 105.5 (points scored per 100 possessions).
- » The Red Wolves have also improved defensively, leading the league in defensive efficiency and ranking top 100 nationally after ranking near the bottom of the conference last year.

THREE'S COMPANY

- » Make no mistake... When Arkansas State takes the court, a plethora of 3-pointers WILL be taken.
- » A-State set the single-season program record for 3-pointers made (341) and attempted (991) a season ago, which means the famous 3-point balloon at First National Bank Arena should be at the ready at any moment this year.
- » Nearly half (46.6%) of A-State's shot attempts have come from the perimeter, the third highest percentage in the league entering Thursday.
- » A-State enters its contest against UTA averaging 31.2 3-point attempts per contest - 10th most nationally. It averages 9.4 makes per outing, which is good for third in the conference.
- » Thursday night's counterpart also leads its league with 25.1 attempts and 9.9 makes per game, the latter ranking among the top 50 in the nation. So, it's safe to say there will be plenty of action from beyond the arc.
- » Defensively, the Red Wolves have locked down the perimeter well, allowing opponents to shoot just 28.2 percent from downtown - top 40 nationally.
- » Along the same vein, A-State has held five of its foes to below 30 percent from beyond the arc.

ROSTER NUGGETS

- » Arkansas State lost assist-machine Caleb Fields to graduation (and an overseas career), but it brings back most of last season's major contributors.
- » A-State returns eight players from last season's team, including leading scorer Taryn Todd and leading rebounder/shot blocker Izaiyah Nelson. Derrian Ford also returns for his second season, as well as perimeter standouts Dyondre Dominguez, Avery Felts and Zane Butler.
- » Terrance Ford, Jr., is back from injury and looks to assume Fields' mantle as PG, while Jacob St. Clair is back after redshirting his first season.
- » Eight newcomers also grace the roster, including three of the highest-rated signees in program history: Josh Hill, Justin Johnson and R'Chاون King.
- » A-State also picked up four Division-I transfers out of the portal, led by SBC scoring leader Kobe Julien (Louisiana). Rashaud Marshall returned to NEA after a season at Ole Miss, while Joseph Pinion comes to A-State after two years in Fayetteville. Cody Head joined the Red Wolves following a standout rookie campaign at Lipscomb. Out of the JUCO ranks, Kameron Johnson joins younger brother Justin on the squad.
- » If handedness is your thing, you'll be pleased to know that A-State has four southpaws on the squad: Derrian Ford, Taryn Todd, Dyondre Dominguez and Cody Head.

IRON SHARPENS IRON

- » Arkansas State's schedule was tough last year with multiple high-major road tests. This year features more home games, but still a tough slate to prepare for Sun Belt Conference play.
- » In the first two weeks alone, the Red Wolves faced four teams all picked second or better in their respective leagues.
- » With the exception of three opponents in The Bahamas, every non-conference opponent A-State has on its schedule was picked either first or second in their respective leagues.

FINAL FIVE MINUTES

- » The final five minutes of a game were key for Arkansas State a season ago, and that has remained the case through three games this season.
- » When leading with five minutes remaining in regulation, the Red Wolves are 27-2 in the Bryan Hodgson era (7-0 in 2024-25), while going 0-18 when tied or trailing at the under-5 mark.

SECURE THE BANK

- » Home-court advantage is a huge deal, and that is no different for the Red Wolves.
- » Last season, A-State finished the home slate with a 10-3 ledger in the friendly confines and a +9.4 scoring margin. Below is a breakdown of the Red Wolves' statistics at home versus on the road.
- » So far this season, that trend has continued with A-State averaging 77.6 points and going 5-0 in FNB Arena.
- » The Red Wolves have finished .500 or better on their home court for nine seasons in a row.

HEAD COACH BRYAN HODGSON



Bryan Hodgson, one of the nation's top first-year head coaches in 2023-24, is entering his second season at the helm of the Arkansas State men's basketball program in 2024-25.

Regarded as one of the top recruiters and assistant coaches in the nation with 16-plus seasons as a collegiate coach, Hodgson was announced as the program's 17th head coach on March 22, 2023.

Hodgson - a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award, presented to the nation's top first-year head coach - guided the Red Wolves to one of its most successful seasons in program history in 2023-24. Under his watch, A-State was one of just two programs under a first-year head coach to win 20 or more games over Division-I foes. Hodgson was also one of five first-year coaches to lead their team to 20-plus wins in their inaugural season after inheriting a 20-plus loss team.

A-State ended the year as one of the hottest teams in the country with wins in 12 of the final 16 contests, ending the year in the semifinals of the Ro College Basketball Invitational - the program's first postseason appearance since 1999 that included its first postseason victory since 1991.

After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, the Red Wolves went on to finish fourth in the conference standings and reach the championship game of the conference tournament for the first time since 2007. Hodgson became the first head coach since Chris Beard in 2019 to guide a team to the Sun Belt Conference championship game in their first season.

The Red Wolves broke numerous single-season school records in Hodgson's inaugural year, setting new program-best marks in scoring (2,917 points), field goals made (1,021) and attempted (2,313), 3-pointers made (341) and attempted (991) along with total rebounds (1,419) and offensive rebounds (489). That excitement, combined with a stellar final half of the season, led to A-State hosting its first nationally-televised game since 1997 - a 79-71 victory over Troy on ESPNU.

Hodgson came to Arkansas State after spending the last four seasons at the University of Alabama, which followed stops at the University of Buffalo (2015-19), Midland (Texas) Junior College (2013-15), Jamestown (NY) Community College (2010-13) and Fredonia State (NY) University (2007-10).

Rated as the No. 2 recruiter nationally by 247Sports.com, Hodgson played a vital role in recruiting top-15 classes each of his four seasons in Tuscaloosa. Alabama, the overall No. 1 seed in 2022-23, posted a 92-42 record, and advanced to the Sweet 16 twice in three-straight appearances at the NCAA Tournament since Hodgson joined head coach Nate Oats in Tuscaloosa. In total, Hodgson brought 15-plus seasons of collegiate coaching experience to Jonesboro, including six of the last seven NCAA Tournaments and a combined 15-2 record in Division I conference tournaments.

In his time with the Crimson Tide, Hodgson helped the program claim its first regular season conference title since 2002, first conference tournament title since 1991 and first Sweet 16 appearance since 2004. Four Alabama players have been drafted to the NBA since 2020 after the program had one selection from 1992-2019.

In 2022-23, Hodgson assisted as Alabama was one of only two teams nationally, joining Houston, to rank in the top-15 in both defensive adjusted efficiency (No. 5) and in offensive adjusted efficiency (No. 15) according to KenPom. Alabama, winner of the SEC regular season and SEC Tournament crown, made its ninth NCAA Sweet 16 appearance in program history, its second appearance in the span of three seasons. Two Crimson Tide players - Brandon Miller (2nd, Charlotte Hornets) and Noah Clowney (21st, Brooklyn Nets) - went on to be selected in the first round of the 2023 NBA Draft.

After finishing the 2019-20 season with a 16-16 record and 8-10 mark in SEC play, Alabama finished the 2020-21 campaign ranked No. 5 in the final Associated Press poll, highest in program

history at the time. The Crimson Tide's 26 overall wins were the second-most in school history, while the Sweet 16 appearance in the 2021 NCAA Tournament was the first for Alabama in 17 years. Alabama clinched its first regular season title in 19 years and captured the SEC Tournament title for the first time in 30 years.

Hodgson blazed a trail to Canada as he signed the first Canadian players in Crimson Tide program history - Joshua Primo and Keon Ambrose-Hilton - Canada's No. 1 and No. 3-ranked players, respectively, in 2020. He followed that by getting a third Canadian, Charles Bediako, to Tuscaloosa in 2021. Primo spent the 2020-21 season with Alabama before being selected 12th overall in the 2021 NBA Draft by the San Antonio Spurs.

In addition to ranking as one of the top recruiters in collegiate basketball, Hodgson was named to The Athletic's Top-25 up-and-coming coaches and one of the top 50 Most Impactful High Major Assistant Coaches. He was invited to participate in the prestigious 2020 TopConnect Seminar which identifies the top assistants in the country and connects them with mid-major athletic directors. Previously, Hodgson was one of 30 assistant coaches named to the 2016 Under Armour 30-under-30 Team by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC).

Hodgson spent four seasons (2015-19) with Oats at the University of Buffalo, where together they took the program to unprecedented heights. Hodgson helped guide the Bulls to three NCAA Tournament appearances and three Mid-American Conference Tournament championships, while also earning a pair of MAC regular season titles. Buffalo reached the Round of 32 in the NCAA Tournament in 2018 and 2019.

During his time at Buffalo, the Bulls were ranked for 20 weeks in the Associated Press Top-25 throughout the 2018-19 season marking the first time in school history the program had earned a national ranking. Buffalo went on to climb as high as No. 14 in the nation - the highest ranking by any MAC team in the past 40 years.

In the 2018-19 campaign, the Bulls finished with an impressive 32-4 overall record with the 32 victories marking the most in program history and most-ever by a MAC program. Coupled with a 27-9 mark in 2017-18, Buffalo had a combined 59-13 record from 2017-19 setting the best two-year stretch in school history.

In addition to his recruiting prowess, Hodgson is also known for his ability to develop talent. During his four seasons at Buffalo, nearly every player on the roster made tremendous strides on the court, none more so than 2019 MAC Player of the Year CJ Massinburg, who finished his career as a three-time All-MAC honoree and second in school history with 1,990 career points and 273 career treys. He went on to be named an honorable mention All-American by the Associated Press as a senior.

Hodgson served two seasons, one in a volunteer capacity, as an assistant coach at Midland (Texas) College, where he helped lead the team to a six-win turnaround during the 2014-15 season.

A western New York native, Hodgson served as an assistant coach from 2010-13 at Jamestown Community College. In his time at JCC, he coached 14 players who received scholarships to four-year schools after their graduation while nine were all-region players.

Hodgson played collegiately for two seasons at Jamestown CC, serving as a two-year captain, before heading to Fredonia State. While at Fredonia State, he served as an assistant coach and earned his undergraduate degree in sports management in 2011. He later earned his masters degree in education from the University of the Southwest in 2015.

Adopted at the age of two, Hodgson has been an active participant in Big Brothers, Big Sisters Program throughout his career. He is the founder and president of Coaching Love, Inc., established to benefit at-risk youth, particularly those in the foster care system and those waiting to be adopted.
